INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances do exist in the field of Educational Development just as in urbanisation, industrialisation, distribution of Income and wealth etc. with a view to highlight the rational imbalances in the educational sector, the Ministry of Education and Culture brings out the publication "Educational Statistics : District-wise" quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. Thereafter it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each state every five year by the ministry of Education and Culture. ~~and finally~~, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this ministry in respect of some of the states.

3. For making inter-district comparisons possible, some important indices such as enrolment ratios, percentage of trained teachers and percapita expenditure on education have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and hence the need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

II AREA AND POPULATION

4. There were 5 districts in Nagaland in 1971. After reorganisation of the state in 1977 the number increased to 7 the total area of the state remaining the same. In 1971, Kohima had the highest area of 7209 sq. Kms. followed by Tuensang (5466 Sq.Kms.) and Mokokchung (3852 Sq. Kms.). The district-wise area figures after the reorganisation could not be available for 1977. District-wise details of area, population and density of population for 1971 have been given in Statement 1.

5. In 1971, Nagaland had a population of 5.15 lakhs (2.75 lakh males and 2.40 lakh females). There was not much variation of population in the three districts in 1971. For 1977, the total population of the state is estimated to have increased to 6.30 lakhs (3.29 males and 3.01 females) among the districts the highest population was in Kohima (1.59 lakh) followed by Tuensang (1.33 lakh) and the estimated population is the lowest in case of Wokha (0.47 lakh) in 1977.

6. The overall density of population per Sq.Km. was 31 in 1971 for the state as a whole the Density of population was the highest (44) in case of Mokokchung followed by Tuensang (32) and Kohima (24) in 1971. The population density could not be compiled for the year 1977 as the district-wise area figures are not yet available. Table.1 below gives a general view of the extent of variation in area, population and density of population.

registrar general of India. District-wise population for
the age groups 0-11, 11-14 and 14-17 for both the years
of the report has been calculated using the following
formula.

8. To get sex-wise break-up of the total population
of different age-groups for the districts, after calculating
the total population the girls population is estimated from
the above formula with the difference that total population
is replaced by girls population. The boys population is
compiled by simple residual method viz. Boys population in
the age group 6-11 = Total population of 6-11
age group - total girls population in the age group 6-11

whole state was estimated to be 72.0 thousand (36.1 thousand boys and 35.9 thousand girls) forming 11.4% of the whole population of the state in 1977.

10. Similarly the estimated population of the age group 11-14 works out to 43.6 thousand (22.0 thous. boys and 21.6 thods. girls) constituting 6.9% of the total population in 1977.

11. 14-17 age group population of the state was 33.1 thods. in 1971 which is estimated to increase to 43.5 thods. forming 22.4 thou. boys and 21.1 thod. girls in 1977. The total 14-17 age group population of 1977 was 6.9% of population of the whole state.

12. Thus of the total population of 6.30 lakhs the school going population in age group 6-17 years was 1.59 lakh (0.80 lakh boys and 0.79 girls). In 1977 the population in the age-group 6-11 years constituted 25.2 of the total population among the males it formed 24.3 % but in case of females it was 26.2%. District-wise details of population for different age-groups have been given in the statement 2.

III LITERACY

13. According to 1971 Census the effective literacy viz. the number of literates per one hundred of population excluding the 0-4 age-group was 27.2 for the whole state. It was 34.8 for males and 18.5 for females. Among the three districts of the state the highest literacy (38.0) was in Mokokchung followed by 30.8 in Kohima. In Tuensang district the literacy

was very low i.e. only 13.1. The details are given in Statement No.3.

IV. GENERAL VIEW

(a) INSTITUTIONS:

14. The total number of educational institutions in the state was 296 in 1971. Their number increased to 1017 by 1977 showing average annual growth rate of 4.1%. Among the districts the number of institutions was the highest (446) in Kohima and the lowest (97) in case of Mon. The district-wise details are given in statement No.4.

(b) ENROLMENT:

15. The total enrolment in all types of institutions was 1.41 lakh in 1971 which increased to 1.65 lakh in 1977 with an annual growth rate of 1.9% during the period of 6 years. Among the districts, the percentages are. was the highest (30.8) in Kohima followed by Mokokchung (21.0) and the lowest percentage share was for Mon (4.9) in 1977.

16. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment in all types of educational institutions was 40% in 1971 which increased to 40.9% by 1977. Among the districts the percentage of girls was the highest (45.9%) in Mokokchung and the lowest (32.0% in Mon).

17. The total enrolment in all types of institutions as percentage to the total population was 23.8% in 1970-71 which increased to 26.1% in 1976-77 at state level. The percentage of enrolment was the highest (34.2%) in Mokokchung and the lowest (10.4%) in Mon. in 1977.

(c)

TEACHERS:

18. The total number of teachers teaching in all types of educational institutions was 2,502 in 1970-71 which increased to 8,698 by 1976-77 showing an average annual rate of growth of 10.4% during the period under review.

19. The total number of school teacher in the state was 315 (6427 men and 1548 women) in 1976-77. Out of these trained teachers were 2477 (2021 men and 456 women). Thus there were only 29.6% trained school teachers at the state level. The percentage of trained male teachers was 31.4 whereas for the female the corresponding percentage was 23.4% only. Among the districts the percentage of trained teachers varied from 38.2 in Wokha to 18.9 in Mon. Districts wise details of trained and untrained school teachers have been given in Statement No.7.

(d) EXPENDITURE:

20. The expenditure incurred in the state on all types of institutions was Rs 187.45 lakhs in 1970-71 and by 1976-77 it increased to Rs 456.29 lakhs showing an average annual growth rate of 20.9%. The highest percentage share of expenditure was in Kohima district (33.3) and the lowest in Wokha (5.5) in 1976-77.

21. The expenditure on education per head of institution increased from Rs 17,441 in 1970-71 to 28,509 in 1976-77 at the state level. Among the districts the expenditure per head of institution varies from Rs 34852 in Zunneboto followed by Kohima (Rs 34,170) to Rs 18,548 in Wokha in 1976-77.

22. The expenditure on education per head of population was doubled from Rs 56.4 in 1970-71 to Rs 72.8 in the

year 1976-77. For the year 1976-77 it varied from Rs 110.9 in Zunheboto followed by Kohima (Rs 95.7) to mon (Rs 33.1) District-wise details showing expenditure on education can be seen from statement No.6.

(e) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF S.C. AND S.T.

23. In Nagaland there is no population of scheduled castes. In 1976-77, the share of scheduled tribe students in all types of institutions in the state was 94.3%. In six districts except Kohima (85.9%) the percentage was more than 95. Extent of coverage for scheduled tribe students was 106.4 in 1976-77 for the state as a whole. The district-wise details can be seen from the statement No.9.

V. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

24. There are no pre-primary schools in the state.

VI. PRIMARY EDUCATION:

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

25. The total number of primary schools increased from 663 in 1970-71 to 1052 in 1976-77. This shows an average annual increase of 5.3% during this period. The highest number of primary schools were reported in Kohima district having a percentage share of 26.7% followed by Tuensang (17.0%).

26. In 1970-71 the average area served by a primary school was 18.7 Sq.Kms. at state level. In 1976-77 this information could not be compiled as district-wise figures are not available.

27. Average population served by a primary school was 583 in 1970-71 which increased to 792 in 1976-77 showing that schooling facilities slightly decreased during the period of 6 years as primary school was available for the population of 593 in 1976-77. Among the districts population served by a primary school varied from as low as 449 in Zunneboto to as high as 1197 in Mon. In Kohima the population served by a primary school was 51.

28. The total number of teachers in primary schools of Nagaland further increased from 2,068 in 1970-71 to 4,753 in 1976-77. This implies that the number of teachers increased at an average annual rate of 10.6% during the period under consideration. The percentage share of teachers in Primary Schools was the highest (26.5%) in Konyima and the lowest (4.1%) in Mon. In 1976-77 out of the total number of teachers, 1252 or 26.3% were women teachers. District-wise details of primary schools, teachers, area served by a primary school and population served by a Primary school are given in Statement No.11.

(b) ENROLMENT:

29. The total enrolment in primary schools of Nagaland increased from 71.7 thousands in 1970-71 to 93.5 thousands in 1976-77. In classes I-V the enrolment was 58.9 thus. (52.3 thous. boys and 36.6 thous. girls) in 1970-71. This increased to 118.4 thou. (57.7 thous. boys and 60.7 thou. girls) by 1976-77 at an average annual growth rate of 2.0% during the period of six years. The annual growth rate for boys was +0.9% and for girls 6.4% showing that girls education was showing improvement at a faster rate.

30. The enrolment ratio at the primary stage which is defined as the percentage of enrolment in classes I-V to the total population in the age group 5-11 gives an index of the facilities created at the primary stage of

education. This percentage was 109.5 in 1970-71 and the same increased to 164.4 in 1976-77. The enrolment ratio increased from 160.4 in 1970-71 to 187.4 in 1976-77 in case of boys whereas for girls this ratio increased from 117.7 in 1970-71 to 141.3 in 1976-77. Taking boys and girls together the enrolment ratio was more than 100 in all the districts except one for which the percentage was 72.1 in 1976-77. District-wise details of enrolment are given in Statement No.12.

(c) ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T.

31. Out of total enrolment of 88.9 thod. in classes I-V all were scheduled tribe students in 1970-71. In 1976-77, of the total enrolment of 116.4 thod., 112.9 thod. (64.7 thod. boys and 48.2 thod. girls) belonged to scheduled tribes forming 95.3% whereas the percentage of scheduled tribe population was 80.0%. Thus the extent of coverage in 1976-77 works out to 107.5..

32. District-wise details of scheduled tribe enrolment are given in statement no.13.

The coefficient of equality or extent of coverage is defined as

I = Percentage of enrolment of S.C./S.T. to the total enrolment

Percentage of population of S.C./S.T. to the total population.

(d) Expenditure (Provisional):

33. The total expenditure on primary schools increased from Rs 9.04 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs 171.86 lakhs in 1976-77.

This gives an average annual growth rate of 4.2% during the period under consideration. Expenditure incurred on primary schools as percentage to the total expenditure on education was 50.8% in 1970-71 at the state level which increased to 57.5% in 1976-77 for the state as a whole. In four of the seven districts the percentage was more than that of the state average. The expenditure on primary schools as percentage to the total expenditure on education was the highest (46.4%) in Mon district and the lowest in Wokha (29.0%).

34. The average expenditure incurred on a primary school was Rs 7,819 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs 10,290 by 1976-77 for the state as a whole.

35. The expenditure on primary schools as per head of population was Rs 13.4 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs 27.3 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 the expenditure per capita was the highest in Zunheboto (Rs 49.1) and the lowest in Wokha (Rs 19.2).

36. The average cost per student was Rs 96.3 in 1970-71 at the state level. This increased to Rs 183.8 during the period of 6 years. Among the districts the cost per student varies from Rs 300.1 in Zunheboto followed by Rs 276.0 in Mon to Rs 102.5 in Wokha. There was negative correlation between the cost per student and teachers pupil ratio at state level.

37. In primary schools the teacher pupil ratio was 1:25 in 1970-71 at the state level which decreased to 1:20 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 teachers pupil ratio varied from 1:29 in Phek to 1:15 in Zunheboto. District wise details of the expenditure on primary schools, per capita expenditure, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio are given in Statement 14. Summary picture of expenditure 1976-77 is given in Table A.2 below.

VII. MIDDLE SCHOOL SECTION

a) INSTITUTIONS AND BACKGROUNDS

33. The total number of middle schools in Nagaland was 210 in 1970-71. This increased to 259 in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth of 3.9%. Among the districts the highest number of middle schools is in Kohima (71) followed by Tuensang (51) and the lowest in Mon. (12) for the year 1976-77. The average area served by a middle school in the state was 78.7 Sq.Kms. in 1970-71. For 1976-77 this index could not be compiled district-wise as area figures are not yet available.

39. In 1970-71 on an average a middle school was available for a population of 2,452. The situation improved slightly during the period of 6 years as on average a middle school was made available for every population of 2,416 persons in 1976-77. The population served by a middle school varies from 1,691 in Pnek (ranking top position) to the lowest of 6,483 in Mon district.

40. The total number of teachers teaching in the middle schools of the state increased from 1,723 in 1970-71 to 2,246 in 1976-77 at an average annual growth rate of 5.1% of the total number of teachers only 332 or 14.8% were women. District-wise details of middle schools and teachers are given in Statement No. 15.

(b) ENROLMENT:

41. The total enrolment in middle schools of Nagaland was 29,982 in 1970-71 which increased to 37,358 in 1976-77. Among the districts the highest enrolment in middle schools was reported by Kiphire (11,28) followed by Mokokchung (9,051) and the lowest was in Pnek (1,090) during the year 1976-77. At the same time enrolment in classes VI-VIII was 18,763 (11,485 boys and 7,278 girls) in 1970-71. This increased to 25,828 (15,297 boys and 10,531 girls) showing an average annual compound growth rate of 3.3%. The corresponding growth rate for boys was 5.5% and for girls 7.5 %. This shows that the girls education is improving at the middle stage.

42. The enrolment ratio at the middle stage which is defined as the percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age group 11-14 gives an index of facilities created at the middle stage education. For the state as a whole the enrolment ratio increased from 52.6 in 1970-71 to 59.2 in 1976-77. In case of boys the corresponding increase in enrolment ratio was from

51.7 to 69.5 and for girls⁻¹⁴⁻ from 42.6 to 48.6 during the period under consideration. In 1976-77 the percentage enrolment was the highest in Kohima (81.3%) followed by wokha (68.8) and the lowest was in Mon. (18.2). Incase of 4 districts the enrolment ratio was higher then that for the state as a whole. The enrolment ratio in case of girls was the highest in Kohima (74.2) and the lowest in Mon (7.4). The sex-ratio of enrolment in classes VI-VIII viz enrolment of girls for every 100 boys was 63 in 1970-71 which increased to 69 in 1976-77. District-wise details are given in statement No.16.

(c) ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T.

43. In 1970-71 the total enrolment of scheduled tribes in classes VI-VIII was 100% as the entire population consisted scheduled castes.

However in 1976-77 of the total enrolment 89.9% students belonged to scheduled tribes. The percentage coverage of scheduled tribe boys population was 90.2 and for the girls 89.4. The co-efficient of equality or the extent of coverage of scheduled tribe students was 112.9 in 1970-71.

In 1976-77 the extent of coverage works out to 101.5. District-wise details of stage-wise enrolment and percentage coverage are given in Statement.17.

(d) EXPENDITURE :

44. The total expenditure on all middle schools in the state increased from Rs54.2 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs116.2 lakhs by 1976-77 showing an annual growth rate of 18.9% during the period under consideration. On an average

the expenditure incurred on a middle school was Rs 25,073 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs 44,872 in 1976-77. The expenditure on middle schools as per head of population also increased from Rs 10.6 in 1970-71 to Rs 15.4 in 1976-77. The highest expenditure per head of population was Rs 27.6 in Phek district followed by Tuensang (Rs 26.1) and the lowest in Mon (Rs 9.1).

45. In 1970-71 the expenditure on middle schools formed 29.1% of the total expenditure on education in the state. This percentage decreased to 25.5 in 1976-77. Among the districts the percentage of expenditure on Middle schools varies from 39.2 in Tuensang followed by 38.9 in Phek to 16.6 in Zunheboto.

46. The average cost per student in middle schools for the state as a whole was Rs 181.9 in 1970-71. This increased to Rs 305.6 in 1976-77. Among the districts the average cost per student varies from the highest Rs 890.7 in Phek to the lowest to Rs 149.3 in Wokha.

47. It can be observed from the Statement 18 that cost per student has a negative correlation with teacher pupil ratio. This implies that the average cost per student is the highest where the teacher pupil ratio is the lowest.

Teacher pupil ratio in the middle schools remained the same at 17 for 1970-71 and 1976-77. Looking at the district-wise position, the teacher pupil ratio varies from 26 in Mokokchung to 5 in Phek.

District-wise details of expenditure are given in Statement No.1c whereas Table 3 below summarises position of expenditure in the districts in 1976-77.

VIII. HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION
INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS.

48. There were 56 higher secondary schools in 1970-71 in the state which increased to 90 in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 10.1%. The highest number of higher secondary schools was in Kohima (29) and the lowest in Mon (4).

49. In 1970-71, on an average a higher secondary school was available for every 295.1 Sq.Kms. It has not been possible to compile this index for 1976-77 as figures on areas of the revised districts for 1976-77 are not yet available.

50. At the state level a higher secondary school was available for every 9,196 persons in 1970-71. The position improved during the period under consideration as a population of 3,923 was being served by a higher secondary school in 1976-77 at the state level. Among the districts the population served by a higher secondary school varies from 4,564 in Mokokchung to 19,450 in Mon.

51. The number of teachers working in higher secondary schools in the state increased from 651 to 1,319 during the period under consideration showing an average annual growth rate of 17.1% of the total number of teachers, 350 were women forming 26.5%. District-wise details of institutions and teachers can be seen from statement 19.

(b) ENROLMENT:

52. The total enrolment in higher secondary schools of the state was 19,608 in 1970-71 which increased to 25,080 in 1976-77. Enrolment in classes IX-XI increased from 9,624 (6223 boys and 3,401 girls) to 12027 in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 4.2% during the period. The corresponding growth rates for boys and girls were 4.0% and 4.4% respectively.

53. At the state level the enrolment ratio at the high/higher secondary stage i.e. enrolment in classes IX-XI as a percentage of population in 14-17 age group was 29.1 in 1970-71 which slightly decreased to 27.6 in 1976-77. In case of boys it decreased from 35.5 to 34.5 whereas for girls it declined from 21.3 to 20.4 during the period under consideration. Among the districts the enrolment ratio varies from 52.1 in Mokokchung to 6.1 in Mon. District-wise details of enrolment are given in Statement No. 20.

(c) ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND ST.

54. In 1970-71 all the students enrolled in classes IX to XI were of scheduled tribe community only whereas in 1976-77 93.8% of the total number of students belonged to scheduled tribes. The corresponding percentage for boys and girls were 94.3 and 92.8 respectively. In 1970-71 scheduled tribe constituted 58.6% of the total population in the state and therefore the extent of coverage or the coefficient of equality of scheduled tribes in 14-17 age group is 12.9 at the state level in 1970-71.

55. In 1976-77, the extent of coverage was estimated to be 105.9 for the state as a whole. District-wise details of enrolment of scheduled tribe students in classes IX-XI are given in statement 21.

(d) Expenditure:

56. Total expenditure on higher secondary schools in the state was Rs 38.25 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to Rs 103.67 lakhs in 1976-77 at an annual increase of 28.5%. Among the districts the highest share of Rs 37.65 lakhs or 36.3% was incurred on the secondary schools in Kohima district. Percentage of expenditure on higher secondary schools to total expenditure on education was 20.4 in 1970-71 which increased to 22.7 in 1976-77 for the state as a whole.

57. Expenditure on higher secondary schools as per head of population was Rs 7.4 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs 16.5 in 1976-77. From the district-wise breakup, it is seen observed that the expenditure per head of population varies from Rs 25.8 in Wokha followed by Rs 23.8 in Kohima to Rs 8.5 in Mon.

58. Average cost per student in high/higher secondary schools was Rs 245.1 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs 413.4 in 1976-77. Among the districts, the average cost per student varied widely from Rs 1066.7 in Wokha to Rs 309.2 in Kohima. In 4 of the seven districts in the state the cost per student in high/higher secondary schools is above the state average. There exists a negative correlation between the cost per student and teacher pupil ratio among the districts viz. average cost per student is the highest where the teacher pupil is lowest and vice versa.

Teacher pupil ratio was 1:24 in 1970-71 in higher secondary schools in the state which improved to 1:19 in 1976-77. Among the districts the teachers pupil ratio varies from the highest of 1:25 in Kohima to the lowest of 1:11 in Wokha district. The details of expenditure can be seen from the Statement No.22. Table No.4 Summarises district-wise percentage expenditure on higher secondary schools, expenditure per head of population and the average cost per student.

IX: PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION:

59. Total number of vocational, professional, special and other educational institutions of school level was 145 comprising 3 teacher training schools and 141 institutions of social adult education.

1970-71. This number increased to 203 constituting 3 teacher training schools and 200 of social adult education.

60. The total number of teachers in these institutions was 168 including 141 for social adult education schools in 1970-71. Number of teachers increased to 220 (217 men and 3 women) in 1976-77. This number includes 200 teachers meant for institutions of social and adult education.

61. The total enrolment in professional and vocational (school) education increased from 2,912 (1839 boys and 1073 girls) in 1970-71 to 5,602 (4,522 boys and 1,170 girls) in 1976-77 showing an increase of during the period under consideration.

62. In 1970-71 all students enrolled in these institutions were of scheduled tribe community. In 1976-77 also 5,632 of 5,692 students were of this community.

63. Total expenditure on all types of professional and vocational (school) institutions was Rs 12.59 lakhs in 1970-71. This amount included Rs 8.58 lakhs for teacher training schools and Rs 1.42 lakh for social adult educational institutions. In 1976-77 an amount of Rs 2.44 lakhs was incurred on institutions of social adult education. District-wise details of institutions enrolment, teachers and expenditure can be seen from Statement 23.

A. HIGHER EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS:

64. In Nagaland there were 4 institutions of higher education in 1970-71. The number of these institutions increased to 10 by 1976-77. Out of these 10 .. . 7 were Arts, Science and Commerce colleges and 1 college of education

and 2 non affiliated institutions imparting courses of below degree level. Among the districts 5 colleges were in Kohima alone. There were 2 Pre-degree colleges, one each in Kohima and Zunheboto. There is no college of degree level in the three districts of Pnek, Zunheboto and Mon in the State.

65. Total number of teachers in all the institutions of higher education at the state level increased from 73 in 1970-71 to 160 in 1976-77. District-wise details of institutions and teachers are given in Statement no.24.

(b) ENROLMENT:

66. Total enrolment in all types of institutions of higher education increased from 1254 in 1970-71 to 2,704 in 1976-77 with average annual increase of 18.4% during the period under review. In 1976-77, of the total students 2,313 (85.5%) were studying in Arts, Science and Commerce colleges, 113 in institutions for education : 111 in affiliated and 278 in non-affiliated institutions imparting professional education courses of below degree level. District-wise details of enrolment of higher education are given in statement 25. District-wise position of enrolment in general education and professional education has been given statement 26.

(c) ENROLMENT OF S.C. AND S.T.

67. In 1970-71 all the students studying in higher education in the state were scheduled tribes where as in 1976-77 enrolment of scheduled tribes in all institutions of higher education was 2,255 (1753 boys and 493 girls) forming 83.4% of the total enrolment in all the colleges in the state. The corresponding percentage for S.T.


boys and S.T. girls are 82.5% and 59.0% respectively. Coefficient of equality of scheduled tribes therefore worked out to be 94.1 in 1976-77. District-wise details of scheduled tribes in institutions of higher education can be seen from the Statement No.27.

(d) EXPENDITURE:

68. Total expenditure incurred on institutions of higher education in the state increased from Rs 13.02 lakhs in 1970-71 to Rs 54.53 lakhs in 1976-77. The annual increase in the expenditure thus works out to 6% during the period under review of total expenditure in 1976-77, Rs 42.39 lakhs (65.7%) was made on institutions of general education and the remaining Rs 22.14 lakhs (34.3%) on Institutions of Professional Education. The expenditure on general education constitutes Rs 57.70 for Arts, Science and Commerce colleges and Rs 4.69 lakh for college of education. District-wise details of expenditure on institutions of higher education are given in Statement 28.
