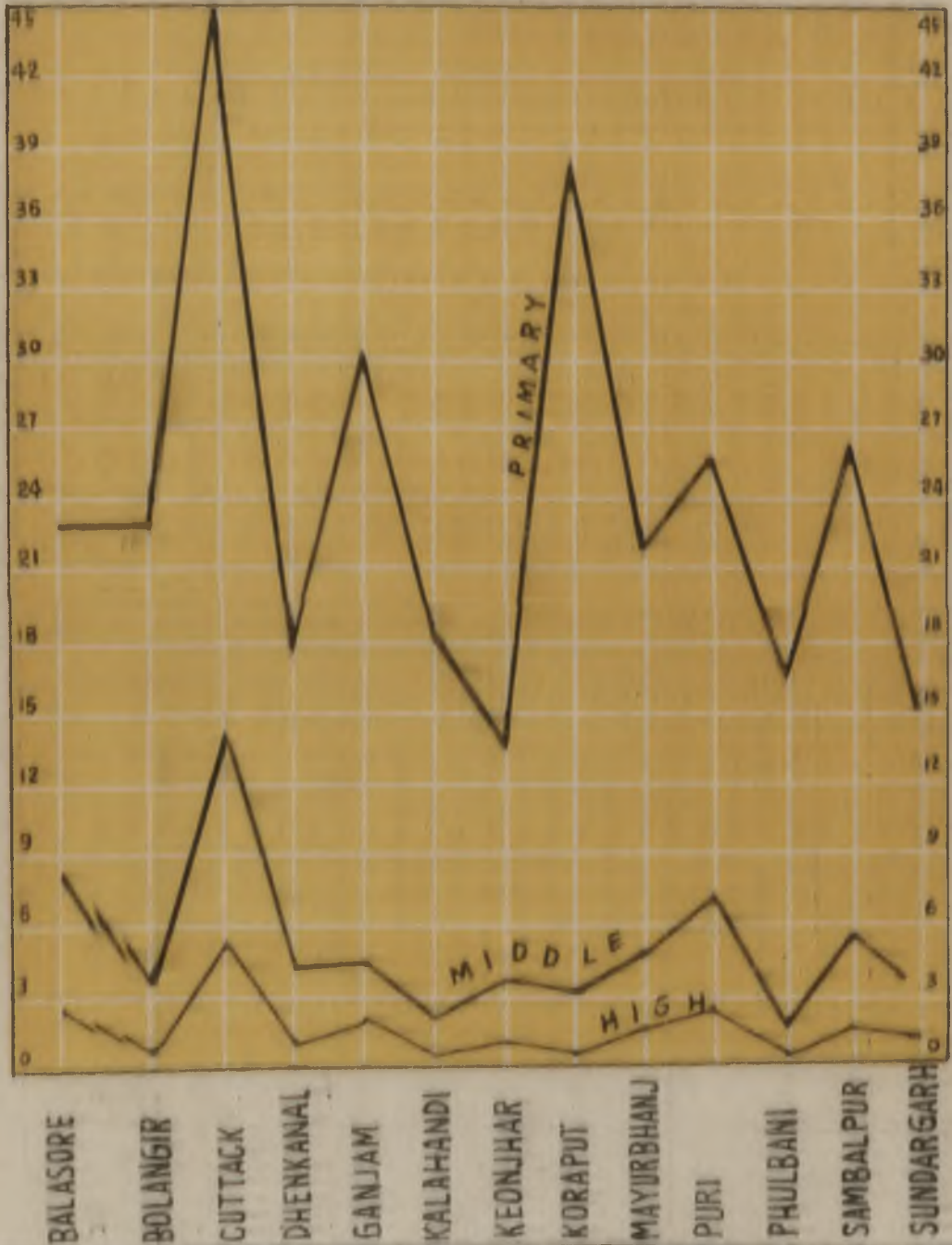

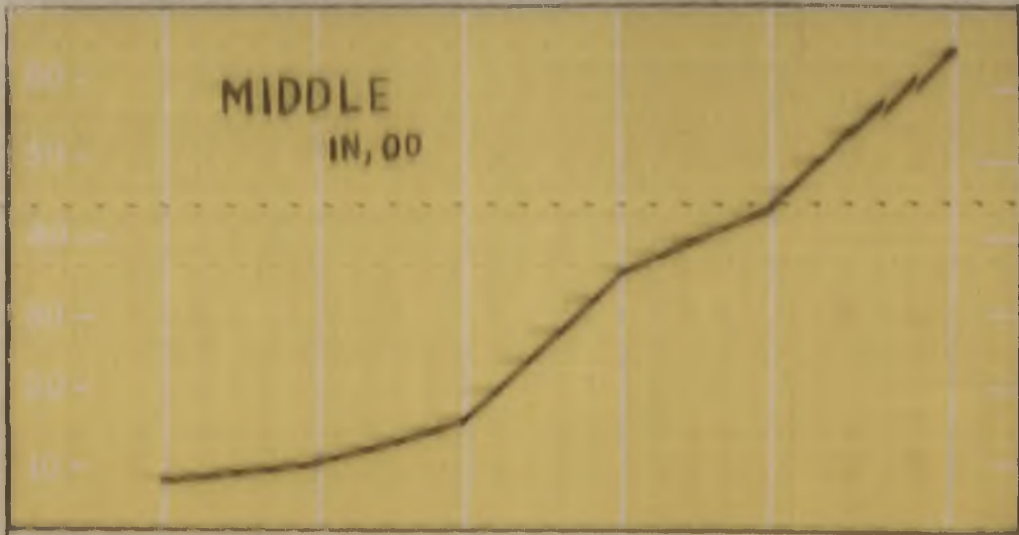

# NUMBER OF INSTITUTIONS AT DIFFERENT STAGES OF SCHOOL EDUCATION IN ORISSA, 1975-76

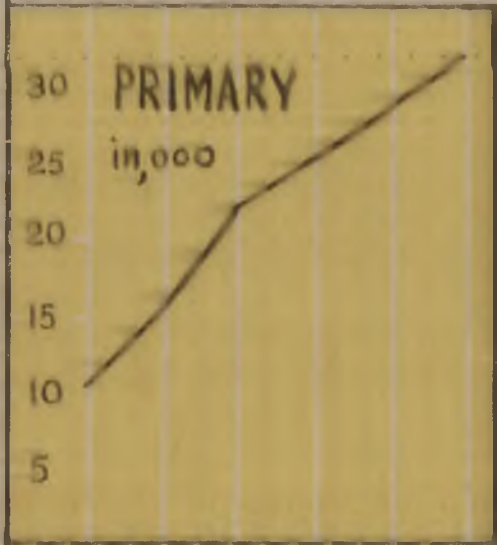

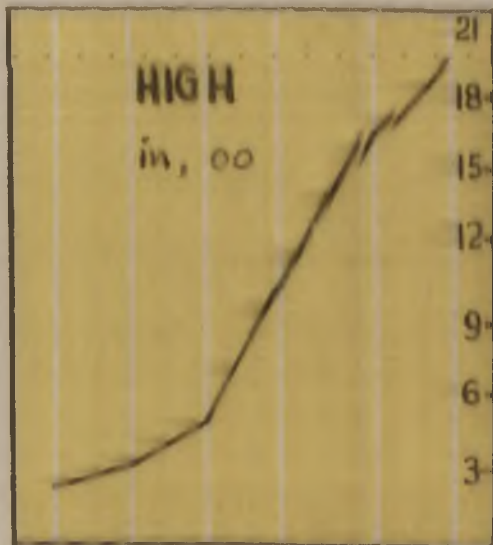
# GROWTH IN NUMBER OF SCHOOLS FOR GENERAL EDUCATION IN ORISSA

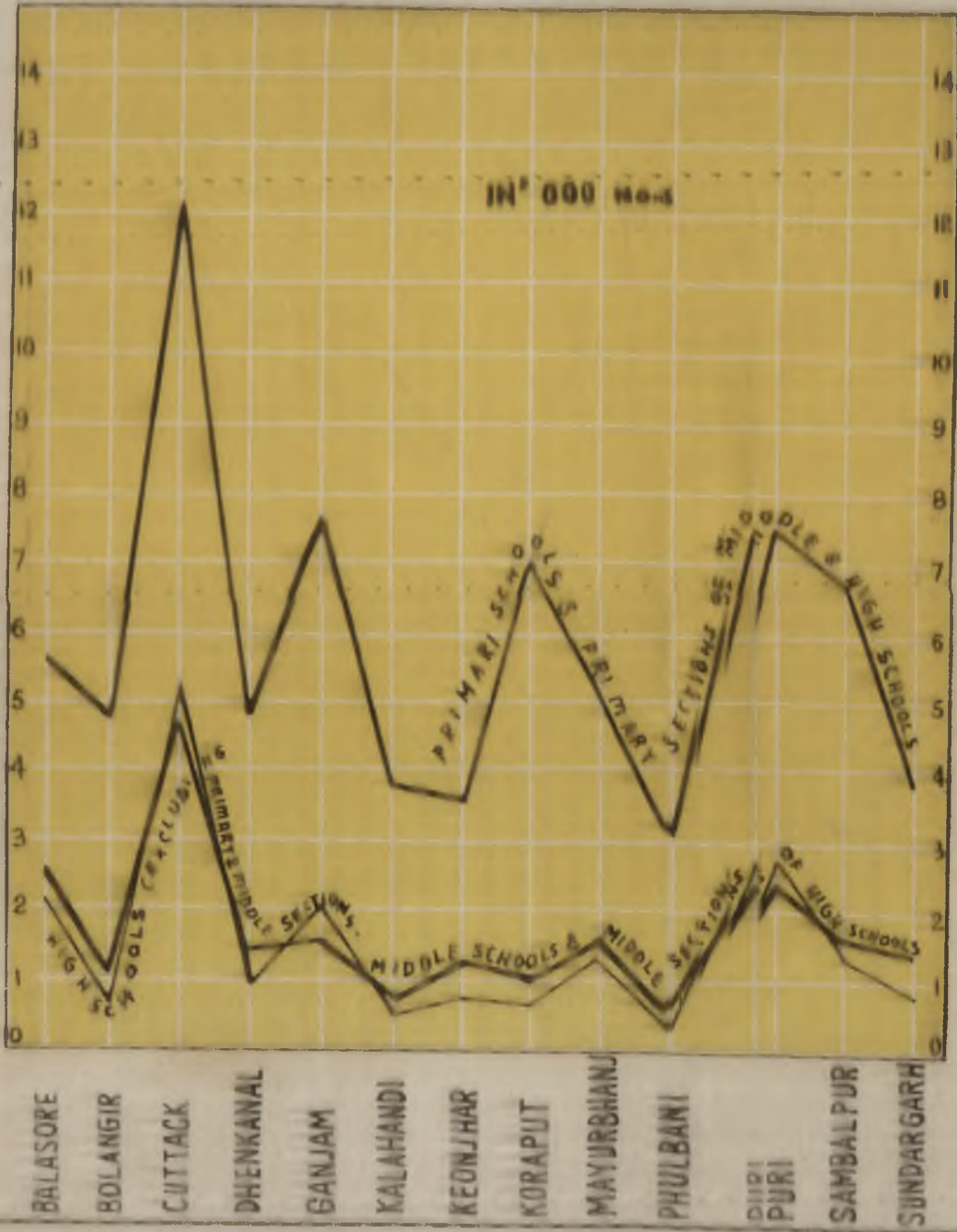

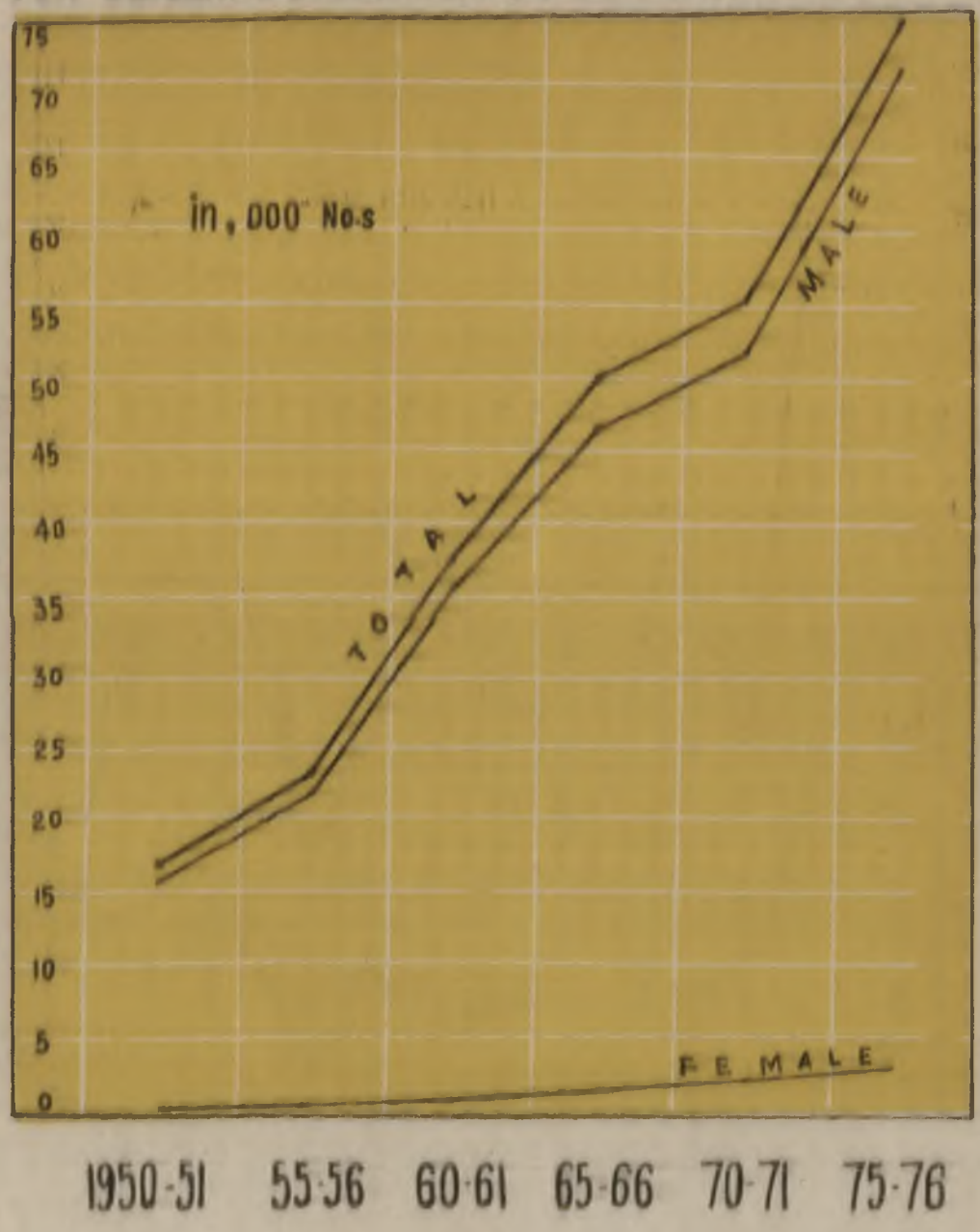

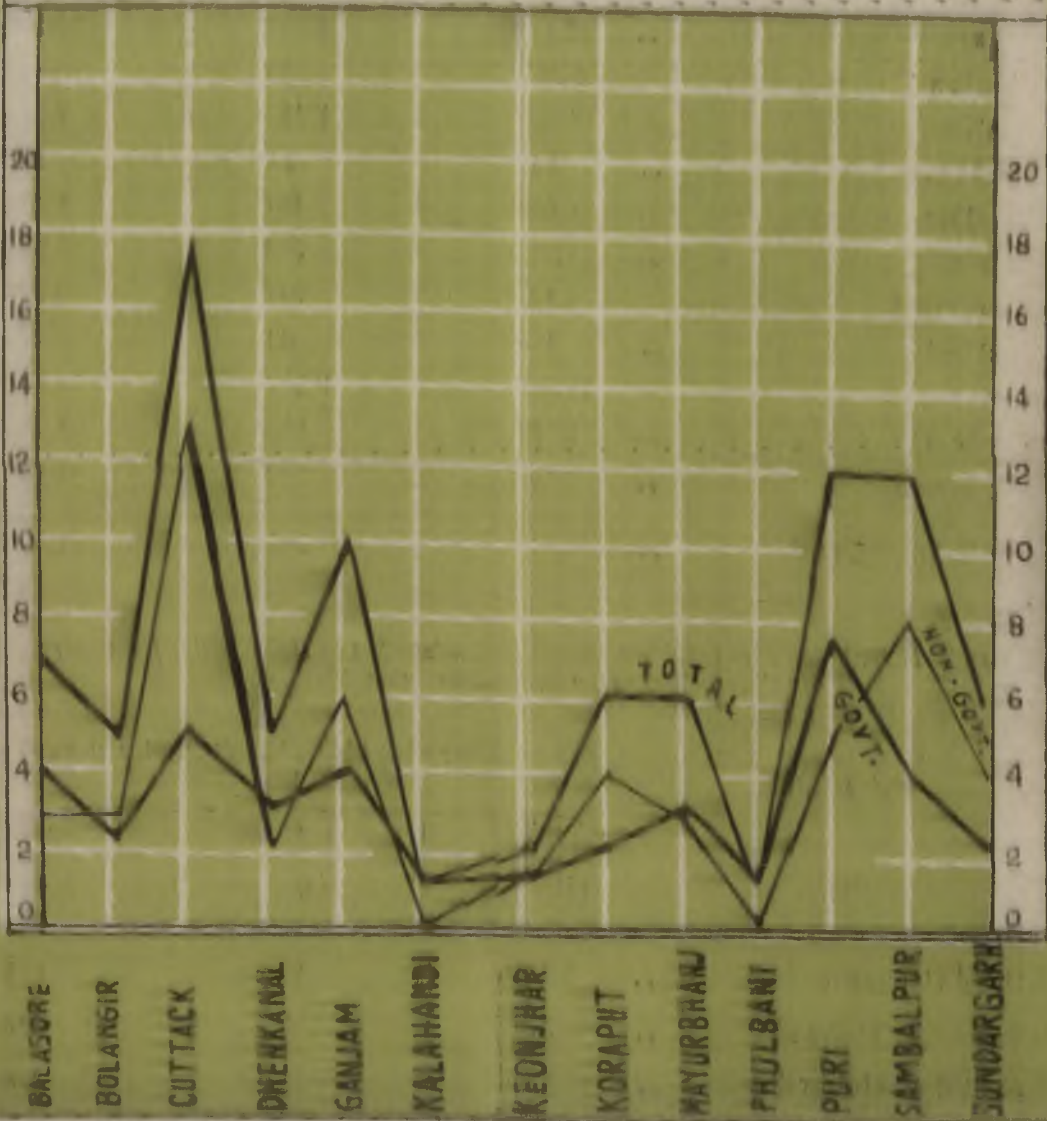

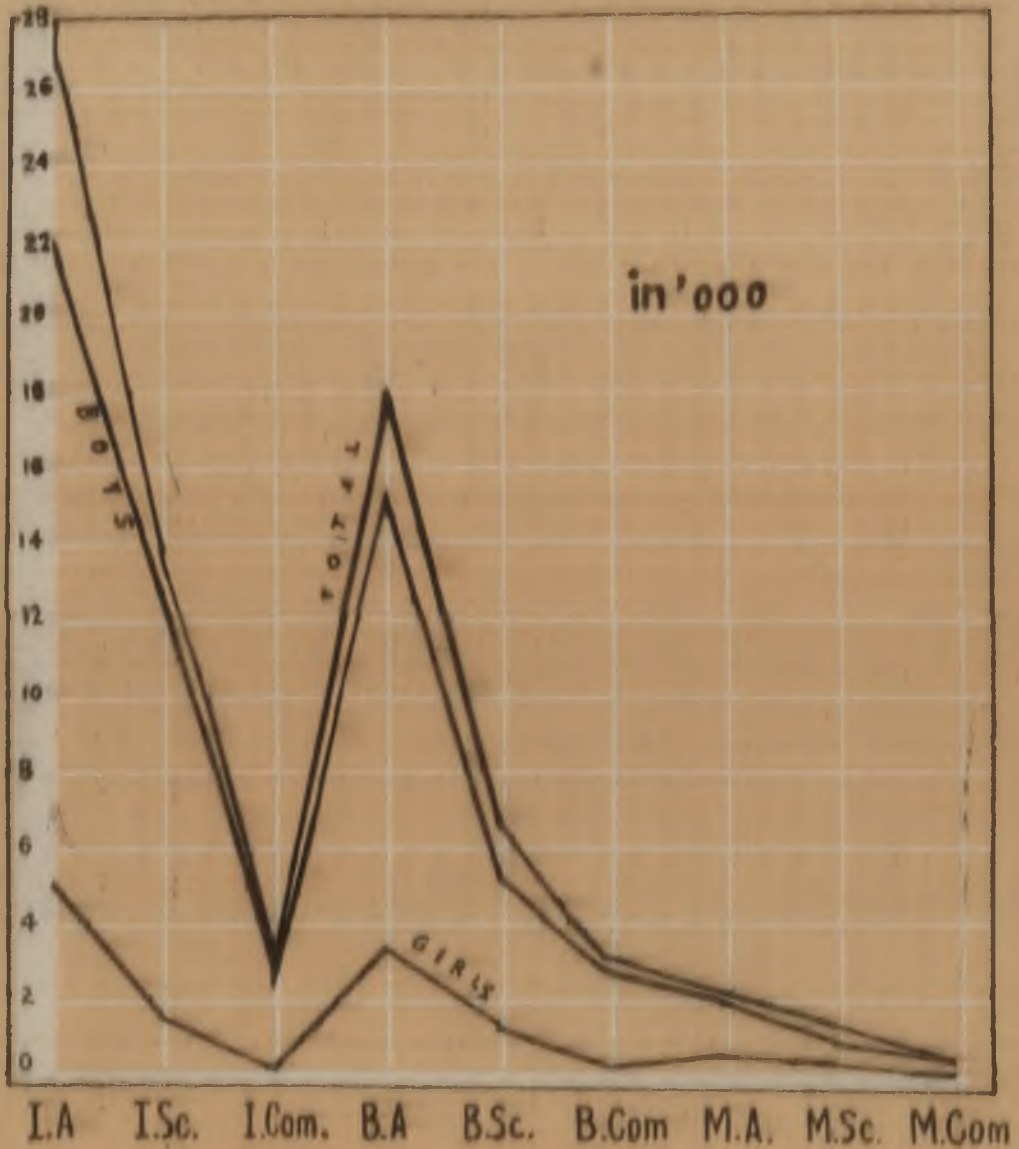
# PROGRESS OF GENERAL EDUCATION IN COLLEGES IN ORISSA FROM 1950-51 TO 1975-76

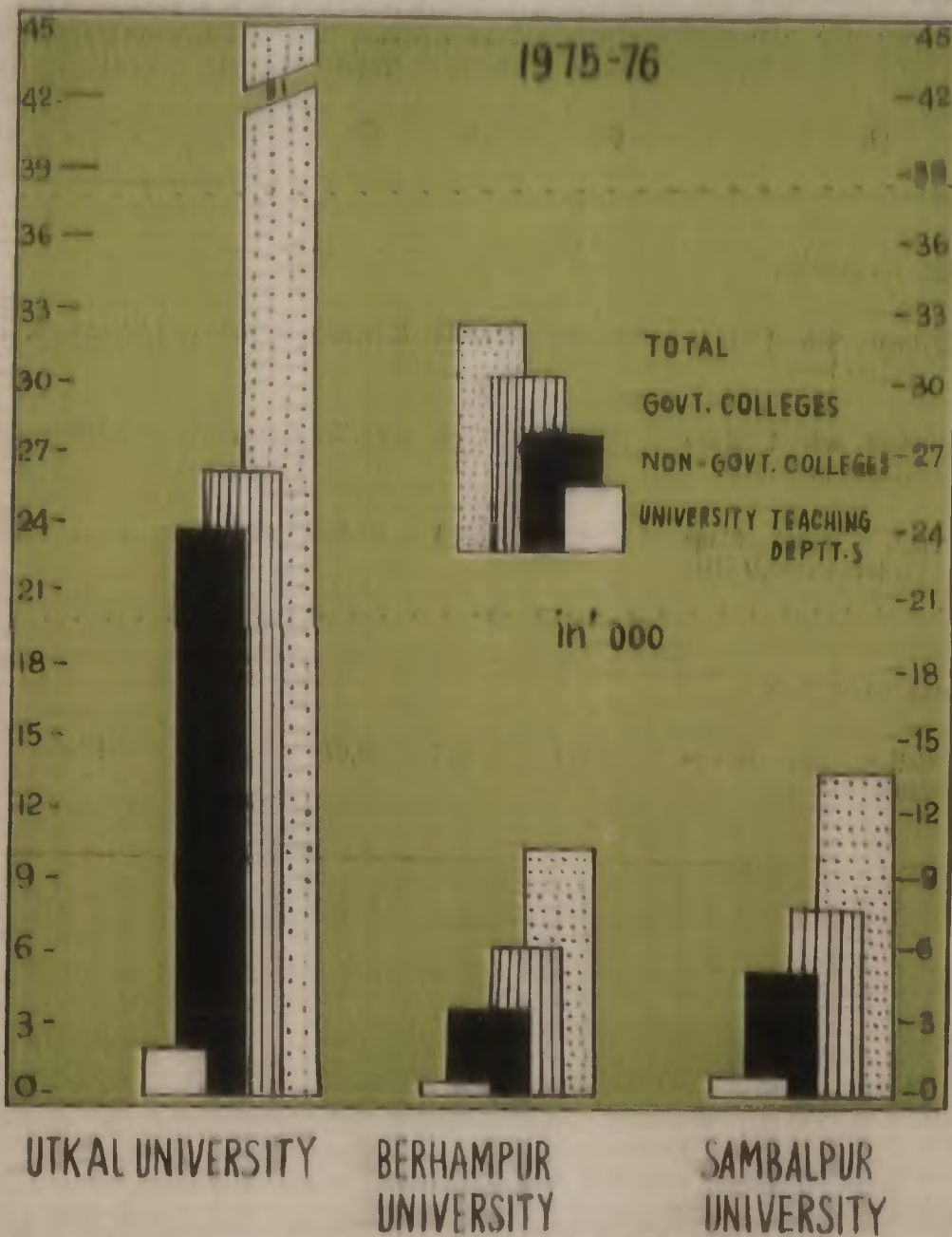

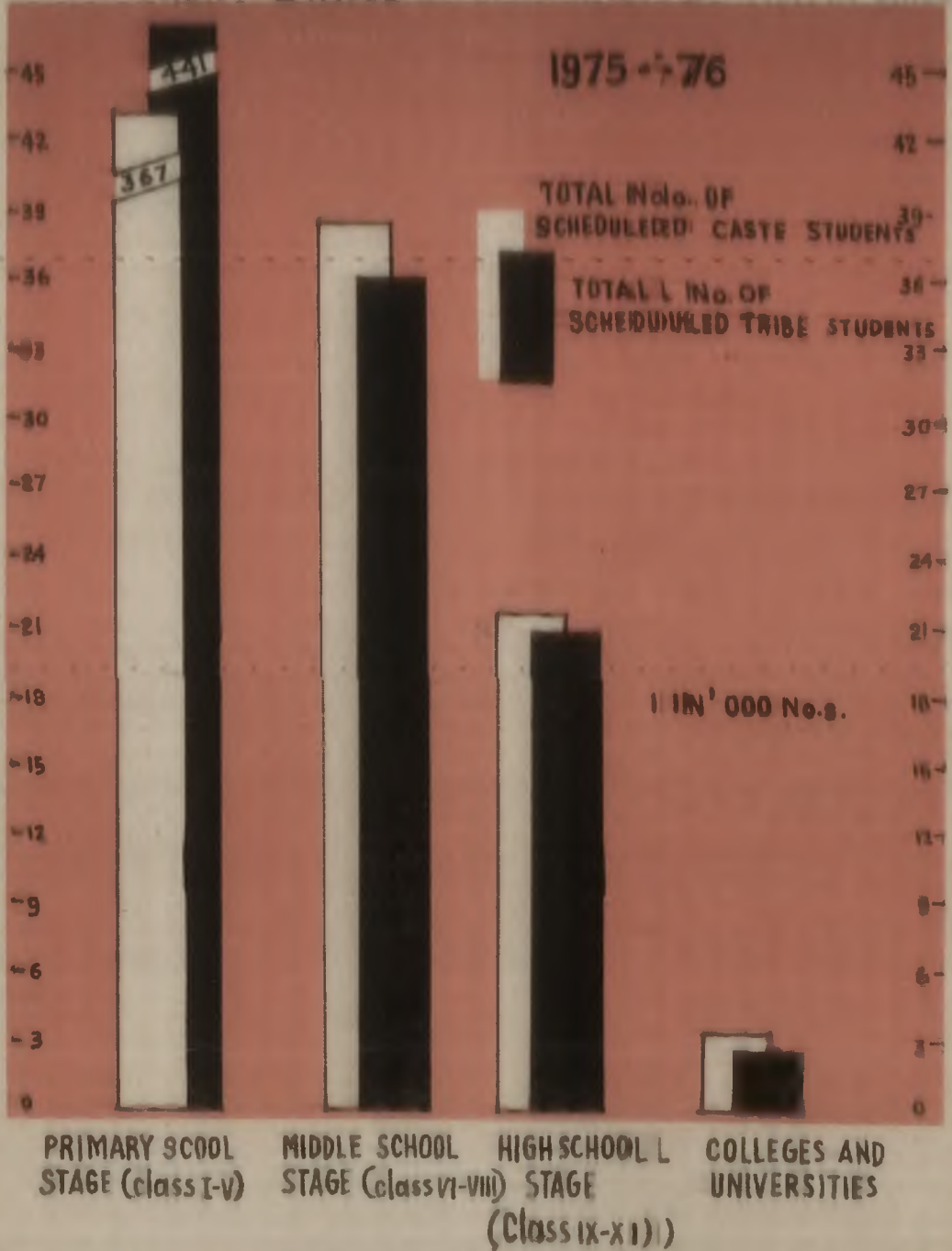

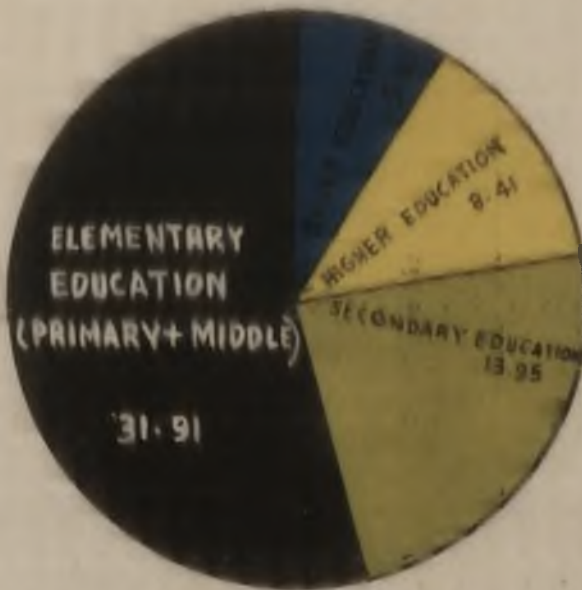

## NOTES—(A) School Stage—

(i) Pupils belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, Girls, children of class IV employees, Primary School teachers and ex-service personnel are exempted from payment of tuition fees.

(ii) Besides, 15 per cent of the number of pupils on the roll in respect of High Schools and 25 per cent in respect of Middle Schools are eligible for free studentship.

## (B) College Stage—

(i) Students belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes are exempted from payment of tuition fees.

(ii) Women students, whose parents/guardians do not pay any income-tax or agricultural income-tax are required to pay tuition fee at half of the usual rates on production of authentic income certificate.

(iii) Besides, 12.5 per cent of the total number of students enrolled are eligible for free-studentship.

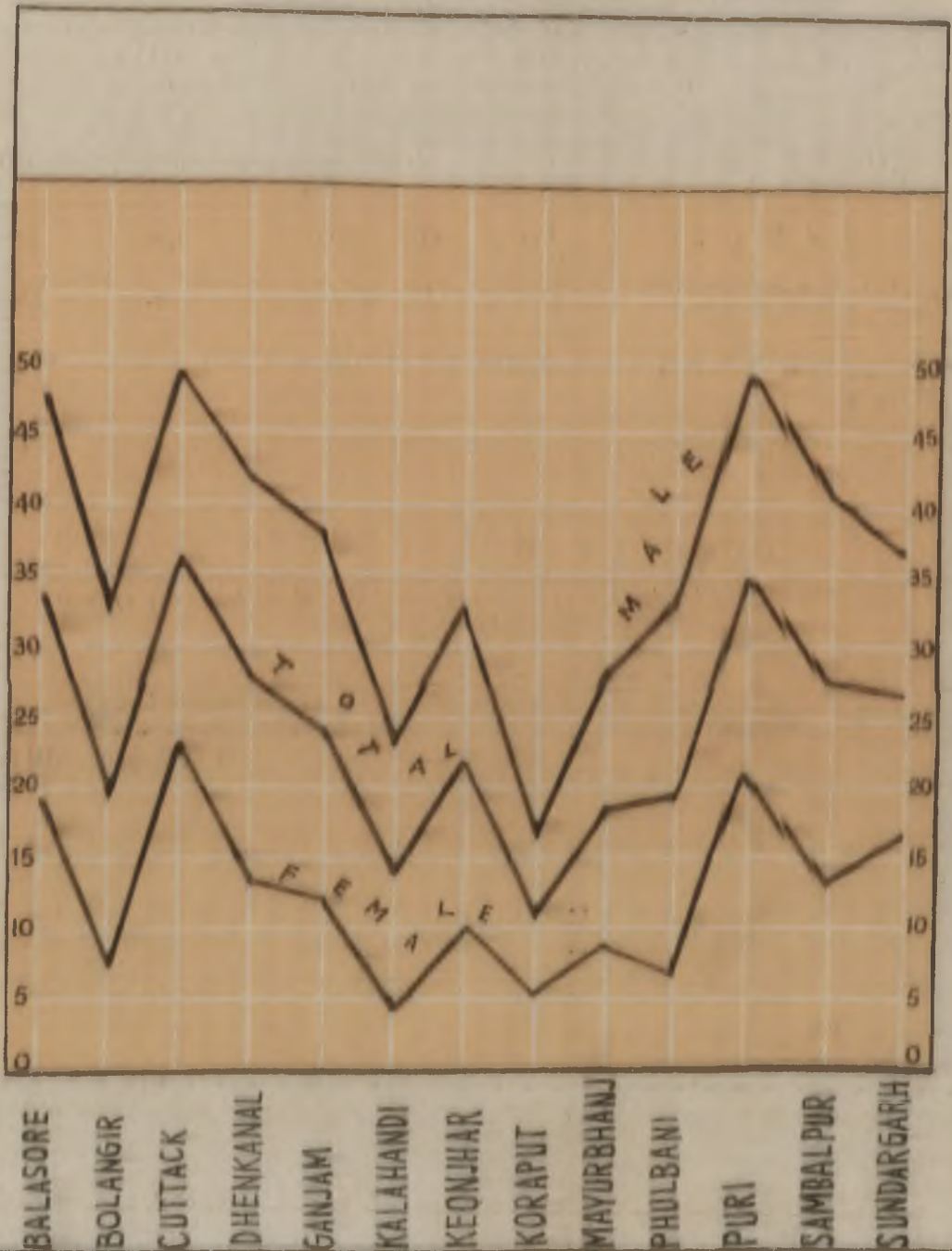

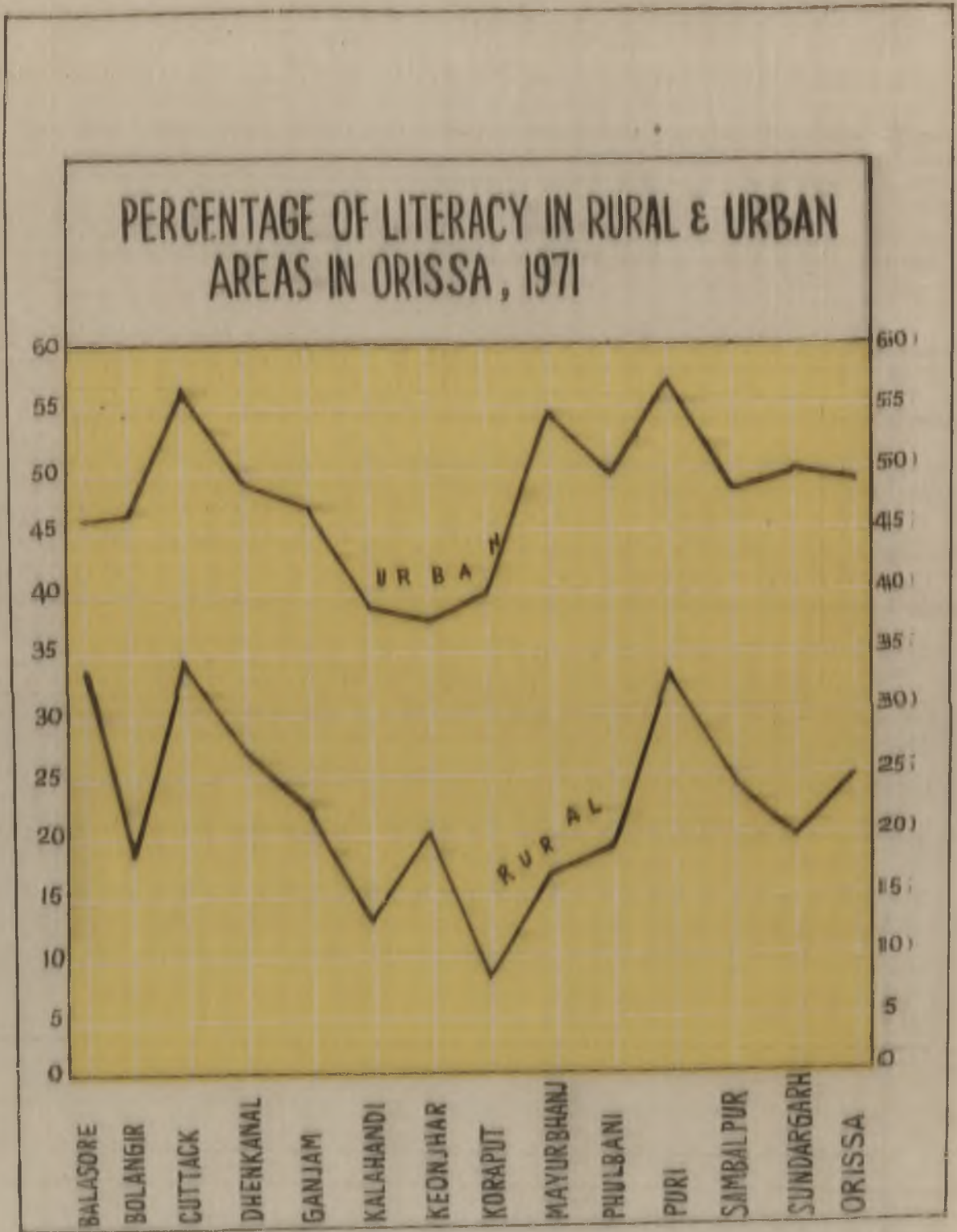

*Percentage of literacy in different districts of Orissa with rate of growth of literacy (1961—71).*

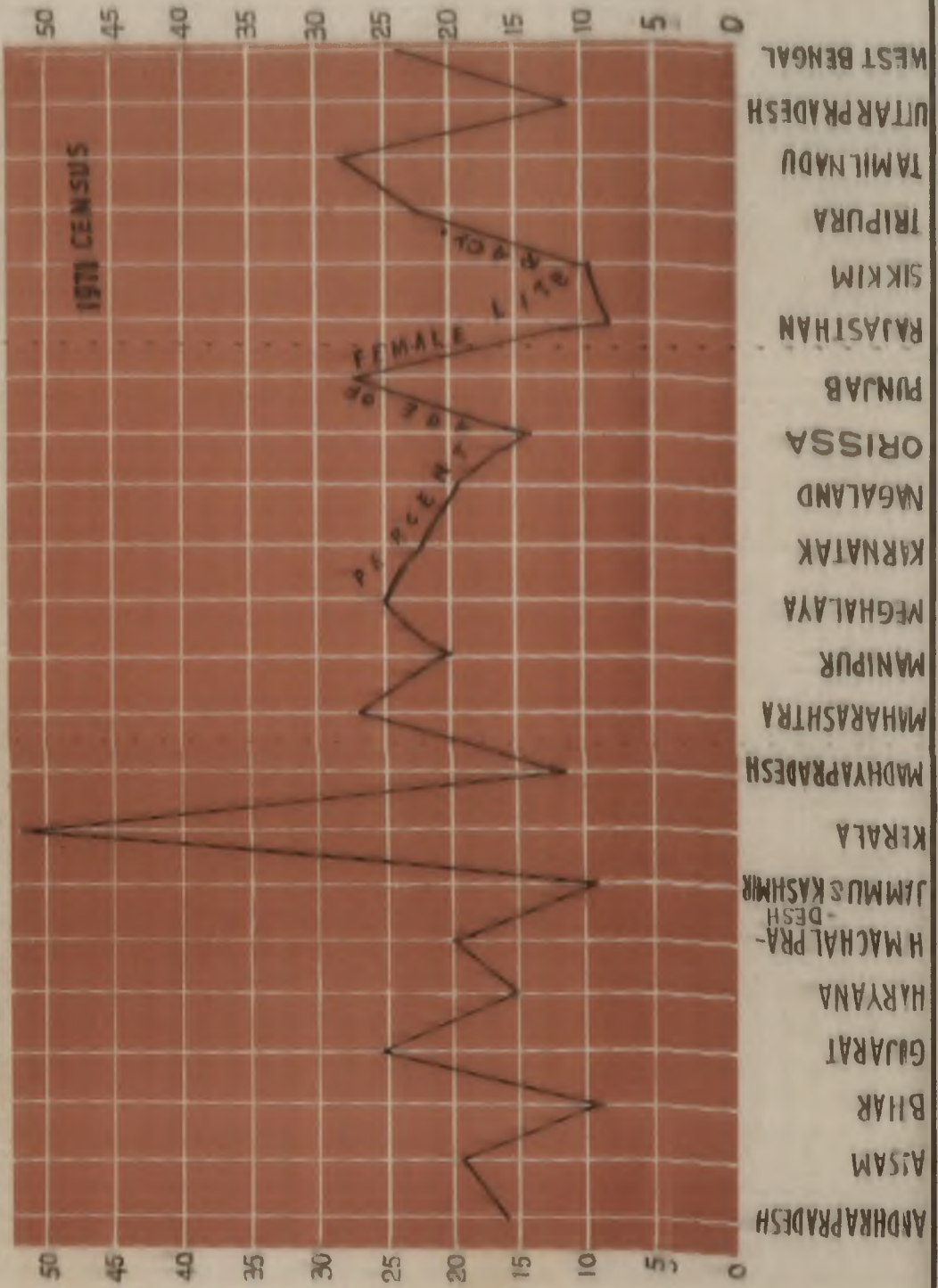

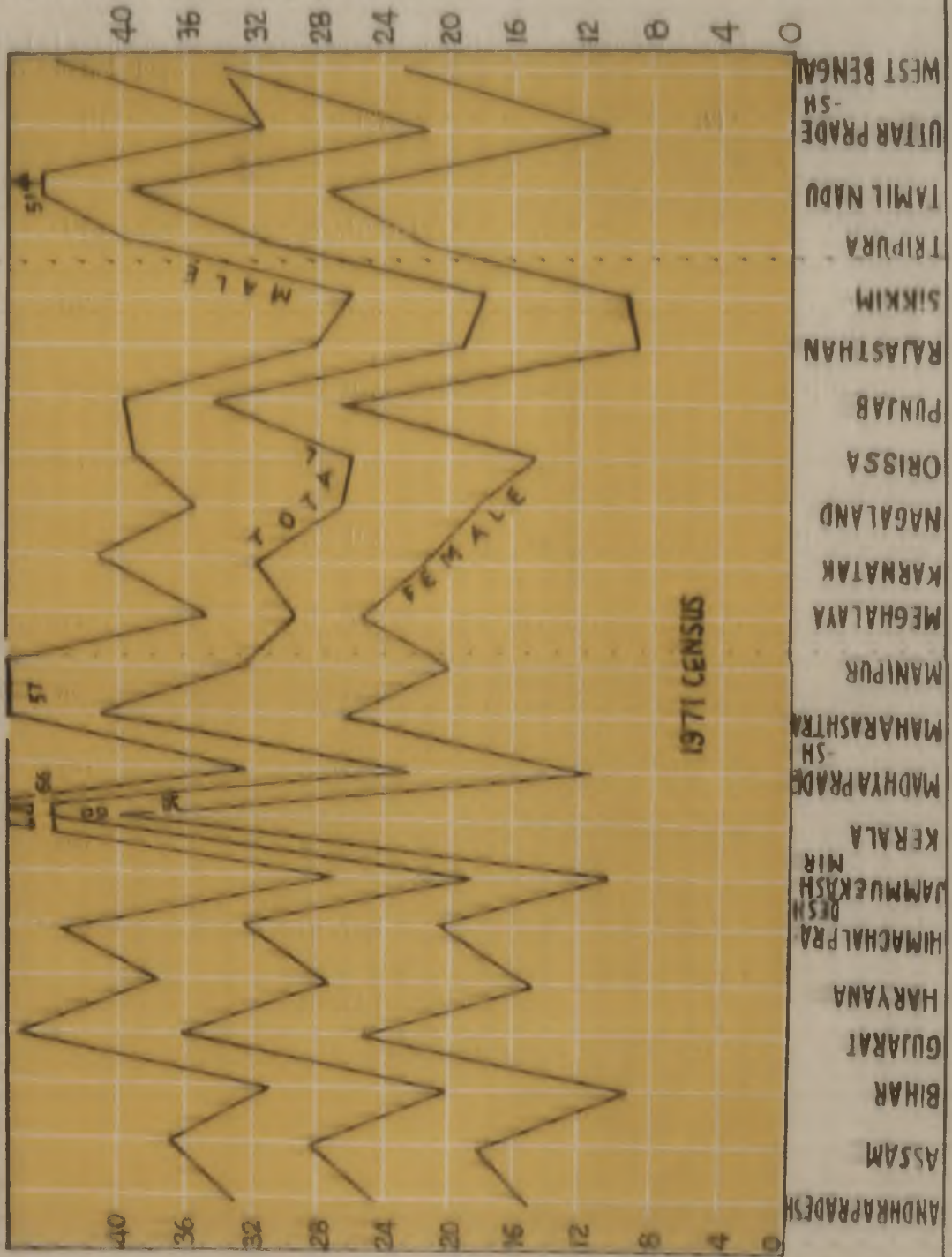
# PLACE OF ORISSA IN FEMALE LITERACY AMONG OTHER STATES OF INDIA

PERCENTAGE OF LITERACY IN ORISSA IN COMPARISON TO OTHER STATES OF INDIA

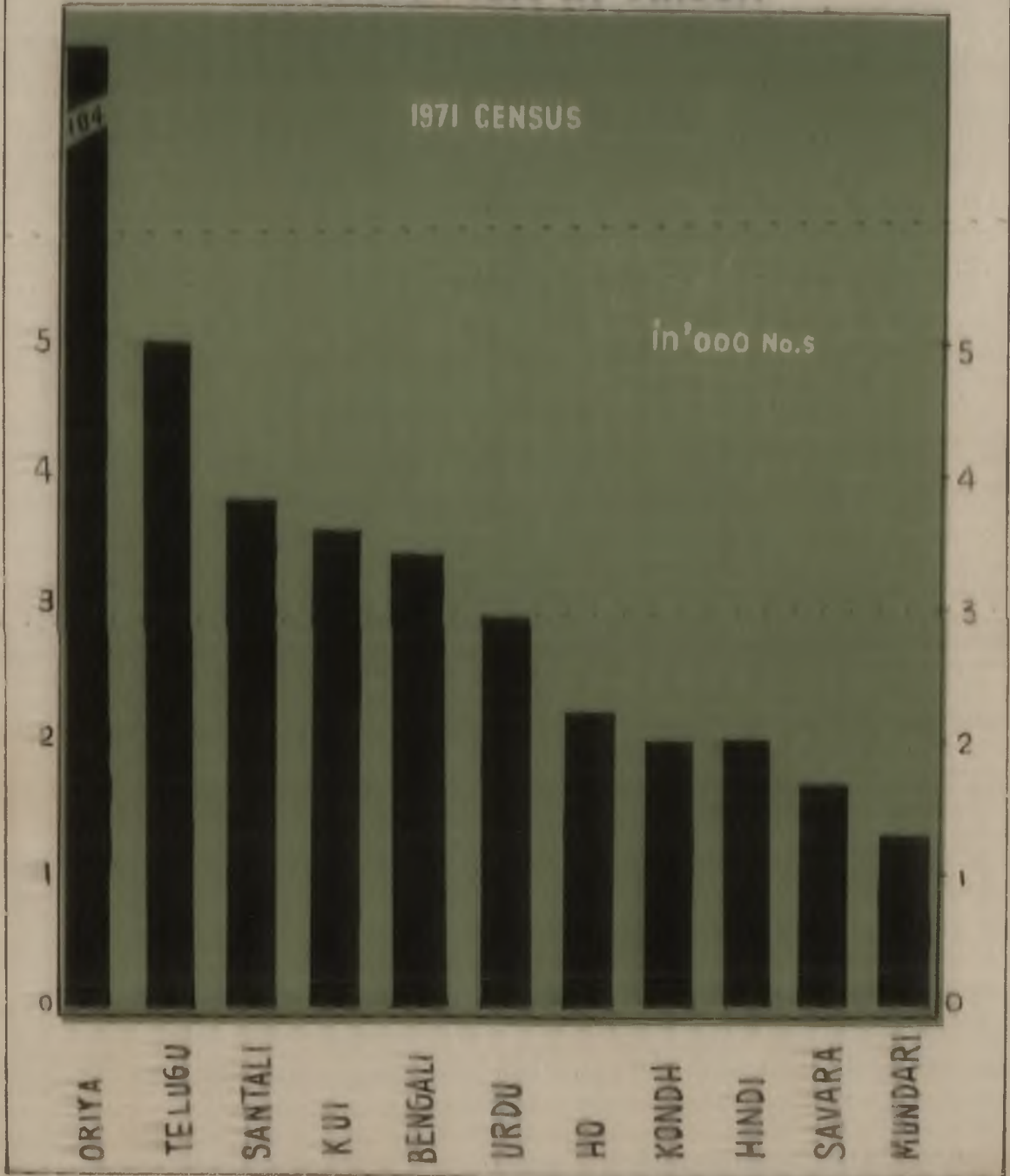

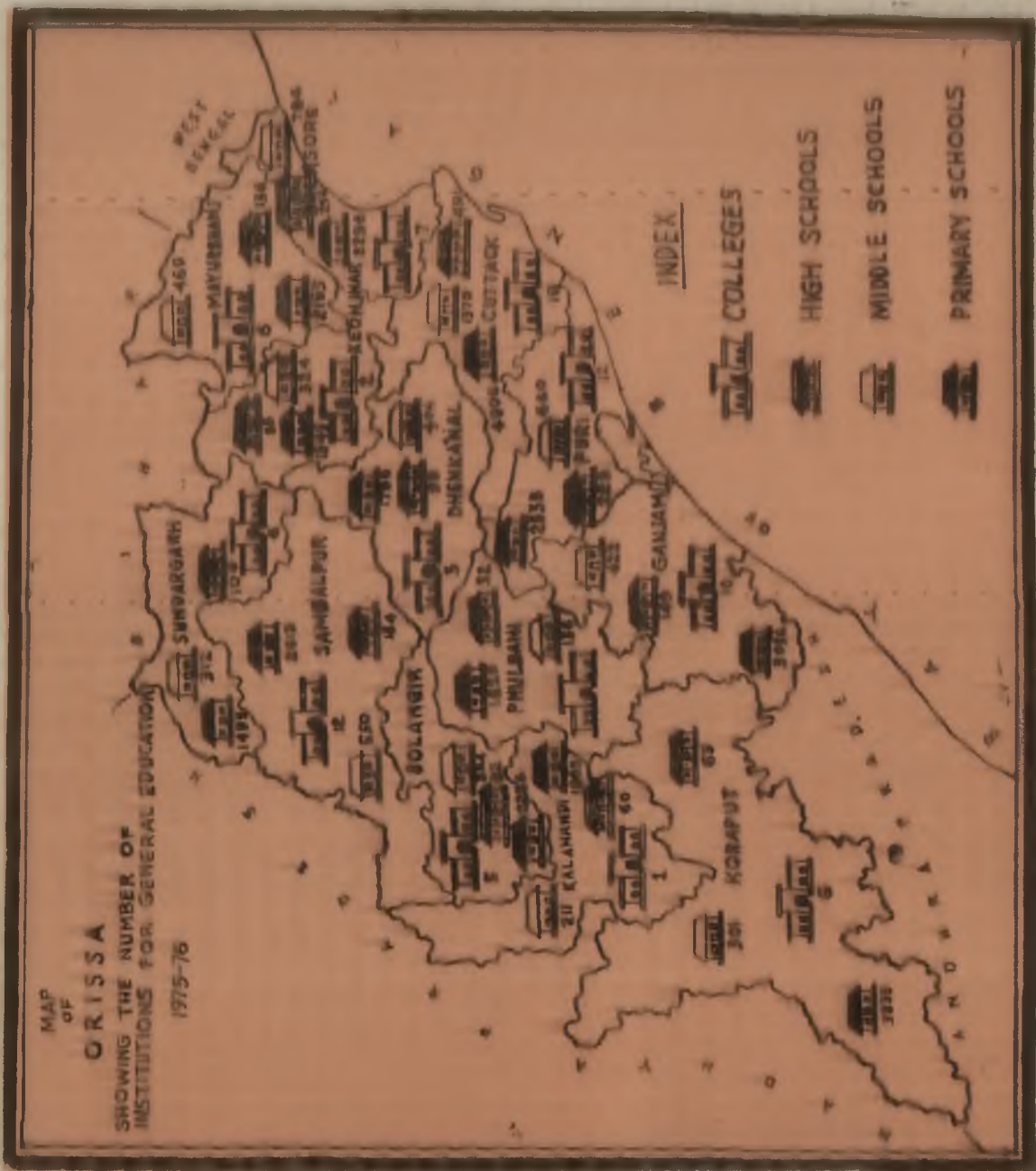
