




GROWTH IN NUMBER OF SCHOOLS FOR GENERAL EDUCATION IN ORISSA







Enrolment in different classes of school education as percentage of enrolment in class I in the year 1975-76






Total number of students in colleges for general education in different districts of Orissa during the year 1975-76





Actual Expenditure on General Education (Including works expenditure) in Orissa during 1975-76.






Percentage of literacy in different districts of Orissa with rate of growth of literacy (1961—71).


