PREFACE

This statistical hand-book intends to present the educational profile of the State of Orissa as it is obtained in the closing year of the Seventh Plan period. It confines itself to the growth and progress of General Education with the year of reference being 1988-89. General Education comprises of Primary Education, Secondary Education, College and University Education, Adult Education, Non-Formal Education as also Teacher's Training and Physical Education. In consonance with the growth of population and the demand for re-orientation of academic curricula in line with the modernisation of courses, growth both horizontal and vertical have been taken note of. In sectors where special attention has been imperative, as in the programme of Universalisation of Primary Education and hundred per cent. literacy by the target dates fixed by the National Education Policy, 1986, greater attention has been paid to reflect the actuality of the situation obtained in the State, on the basis of the field survey and data collections made by the Directorate of Elementary Education. The spread of Education in the scheduled areas and disadvantaged pockets have been shown, reflecting need for crash programmes to be taken up for achieving the targets envisaged in the National Education Policy, 1986.

Inter-district disparities in educational development have been shown to indicate the steps to be taken by the administration for a balanced growth.

I am sure, this hand-book will provide a base-line data for formulation of the Eighth Plan. It is also hoped that this data will present the correct educational profile of the State.

I appreciate the hard work and sincere efforts put in by the staff more particularly Shri N. N. Dash, Statistical Officer, Shri D. Mishra, Statistical Investigator and Shri B. Behera, Junior Statistical Asst. of the Statistics Cell of the Elementary Directorate of Education for bringing out this hand-book right in time.

DEVELOPMENT OF GENERAL EDUCATION

The opening scene of educational development in Orissa after independence presented a very poor picture. The entire State of Orissa had 6,814 Primary Schools with an enrolment of 2.55 lakhs, 286 M. E. Schools with 32,000 and 106 Secondary Schools with 15,000 enrolment in 1947-48. The total number of Colleges (Arts, Science and Commerce) was only 12 with an enrolment of 4,104. There was only one University to cater to the needs of University education of the State. Such a bleak picture emerged at the advent of independence because of the wrong educational policy followed by the foreign Government in Pre-independent India.

Immediately after achievement of independence educational Policy of Government of India radically changed. Attention of Government was diverted from the elite class to the masses. Educational facilities expanded very rapidly. By the year 1950-51 number of Primary Schools rose from 6,814 to 9,801, M. E. Schools from 286 to 501, Secondary Schools from 106 to 172. Proportionate rise in the enrolment was also marked during the same period.

During the last 41 years significant rise in the number of institutions, teachers and enrolment may be seen from the following Table :—

PRIMARY EDUCATION—

Primary education is imparted in five classes i.e. from class—I to V in the State. There are 39,293 Primary Schools/Sections out of which 1,184 schools (Called Sevashrama) are managed by the Department of Harijan & Tribal Welfare and the remaining 38,109 schools are run by the Department of Education and Youth Services. Efforts have been made to provide primary education facilities at the door-step of children in order to ensure their access and participation in the education process. Yet approximately 12,000 habitations remain unserved by Primary Schools within easy walking distance of 1 km.

Although the gross enrolment ratio to the total child population in the age-group of 6-11 has been 99.92 per cent, the net enrolment ratio is 74 per cent. 25 per cent. children of over-age and under-age are on the rolls in Primary Schools. The drop out rate at the end of class-V was 77.8 per cent. in the year 1978-79 which has reduced to 48 per cent. by 1988-89.

Total enrolment in the Primary School/Sections is 35.02 lakhs in the year 1988-89. Total number of teachers is 90,540. The teacher-pupil ratio is 1:319. 75 per cent. of the Primary School teachers are trained.

For quite a long time compulsory primary education was the slogan for the political leaders of pre-independent India. After independence universalisation of Elementary Education is receiving the maximum importance in the above background. Constant efforts are being made to provide educational facilities for all the children in the State. But in Orissa where 40% of the area is covered by Tribal Sub-plan Blocks and 38% of the population belong to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, provision of educational facilities is quite an uphill task.

Over riding priority has been given to the programme of Universalisation of Elementary Education in the National Policy of Education, 1986. Universalisation of Elementary Education with special emphasis on access has been the directive of the Government. 1990 being the target year for Universalisation of Primary Education, the Technology Mission has taken up the responsibility of providing education for all children in the age-group of 6-11.

For qualitative improvement in the Primary Education, the Operation Black Board Scheme has been introduced. Fifty per cent. of the primary schools have been covered under the first and second phases of Operation Black Board Scheme. Out of the remaining 50%, 25% is being taken up during the current year under this scheme. Districtwise distribution of primary schools gives a comparative picture of development of Primary Education in different districts and imbalances which still exist at present. Efforts are being made to remove the disparities to a great extent.

MIDDLE SCHOOL EDUCATION

The number of Middle Schools in the State including the rural and urban areas was 7,150 according to fourth educational survey (1978-79) and the number of teachers and enrolment in these schools was 22,254 and 5.01 lakhs respectively. The middle sections available in the secondary level of education are accounted for in the aforesaid number of M. E. Schools/Sections. By 1986-87 the reference year for the Fifth Educational Survey, the number of M. E. Schools increased to 9,092 with a significant growth in the number of teachers and enrolment. Total number of teachers and enrolment in these schools for the year 1986-87 was 28,149 and 8.72 lakhs. Thus the institutional growth during the period 1978-79 to 1986-87 registers 27.02%, teachers 20.94% and enrolment 14.05%.

It may be seen from the number of institutions, teachers and enrolment of 1988-89, that the expansion of middle school education in Orissa during the period 1986-87 and 1988-89 holds utmost importance and the achievement indicates significant growth in all respects. Compared to 1986-87 the percentage of growth in case of teachers was 31.25 and enrolment 11.23.

As regards S. C. and S. T. students it is a tangible improvement marked in the statistical figures of 1988-89. There were 1,10,000 S. C. students and 1,13,000 S. T. students in the year 1986-87 and the percentage to total enrolment was 13.5 and 13.9 respectively. Due to adequate facilities extended by Government in the Tribal Districts, the enrolment figures of S. C. students rose to 1,35,000 and S. T. Students up to 1,20,000 in the year 1988-89. Percentage of enrolment of S. C. students to total enrolment came to 13.9 and 12.3 respectively in the State.

SECONDARY EDUCATION--

The total number of High Schools in the State during the year under report is 4,239. A population of 7,074 is served on the average by one High School. In other States of India, the population served by a High School is much more than what it is in Orissa. In Andhra Pradesh a High School serves a population of 11,000, in Bihar 19,000, in Gujrat 10,700, in Karnataka 9,700, in Kerala 10,500, in Maharastra 9,000 and in West Bengal 9,700. Compared with other States provision of High Schools in the State of Orissa is much better. The development of Secondary Education in the State records an increase of 95.61% over a period of 10 years, the number being 4,239. What is aimed at in respect of Secondary Education is consolidation and qualitative improvement rather than expansion in number. Science apparatus and science books are being supplied for qualitative improvement of Secondary Education in the State. The curriculum for Secondary Education is also modernised to incorporate modern developments in Science & Technology.

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION -

In order to produce educated employables vocational education has been introduced in the State with effect from the year 1987-88. 31 High Schools have been up-graded to Vocational Higher Secondary Schools in the year 1987-88 and 150 in the year 1988-89.

The following vocations have been introduced at the first stage in the vocational Higher Secondary Schools:-

NON-FORMAL EDUCATION -

Until recently the non-formal Education centres were being used as cheaper model primary schools in the State. These centres were being provided to the smaller habitations where a regular primary school was not considered viable from the stand point of population. But at the advent of opening of more primary schools in all the habitations having a population of 300 in non-tribal areas and 200 in tribal areas non-formal centres are now to serve real the purpose for which they are provided. Henceforward these centres are to be mainly run for the economically backward children who cannot avail full-time education for working children and for the drop outs, who are forced to discontinue education on economic fronts. 1,123 non-formal centres are now functioning as Madhyamik Chatsalis imparting education for Class VI-VII. One

hundred thirty eight projects are now functioning under the new Project Scheme under the Non-formal Education. 138 Co-ordinators are now being appointed for good administration of the Non-formal Education in the Projects and Supervisors are also being appointed for effective supervision.

TEACHER EDUCATION--

There has been unprecedented quality improvement of teacher education in the State under the National Policy of Education, 1986. 11 Government Secondary Training Schools have been converted and upgraded to District Institutes of Education and Training (DIET), one in each district, conducting training of inservice pre-service teachers for the primary schools. 50 Secondary Training Schools are continuing to function and 7 such Training Schools stand abolished. Two more Secondary Training Schools are likely to be converted to District Institutes of Education and Training this year.

Two Government Training Colleges located at Cuttack and Sambalpur have been upgraded to the status of Institute of Advanced Study in Education (IASE) in order to expand the facilities for research in the area of teacher education and training of inservice and pre-service teachers. Two other Government Training Colleges located at Angul and Bolangir have also been upgraded to the status of Colleges of Education (CTE) and the remaining two Government Training Colleges are proposed to be upgraded to CTEs during the current year.

HIGHER EDUCATION--

There are 5 Universities in the State of which 3 are meant for general and professional education. The University of Agriculture and Technology seeks to impart education in Agriculture with provision and facilities for extension services. Sri Jaganath Sanskruta Viswavidyalaya has been established for promotion of oriental learning and culture with special emphasis on sanskrit.

There has been tremendous expansion of collegiate education in the State during the current decade. The total number of colleges (Arts, Science and Commerce) was 92 in the year 1977-78 which has increased to 433 recording an increase of 370.65 per cent over a decade. Number of teachers and enrolment in higher education has a proportionate increase from 3,771 to 10,741 (college teachers) and from 0.79 lakhs to 2.61 lakhs (enrolment).

PHYSICAL EDUCATION--

Physical Education teachers are appointed in high schools and colleges to conduct games and sports activities in educational institutions. A college of Physical Education is run by Government at Cuttack with C. P. Ed. and

B. P. Ed. Courses. Liberal grants are given for development of physical education activities.

ADULT EDUCATION—

The history of adult education dates back to 1949. Over all these years the Adult Education Sector is taking steps for improving the literacy position of the State. In 1961 the percentage of literacy of Orissa was 21.7 which rose to 26.12 in 1971 and 34.12 in 1981. The need for accelerating the adult education activities was felt by Government and therefore, a separate Directorate for Adult Education was created in 1988 which is headed by the Director of Adult Education. The National Literacy Mission was launched in May, 1988. The State Literacy Mission was inaugurated on the same day. In pursuance of the objectives the N. L. M. adult education activity have been accelerated by the State Literacy Mission.

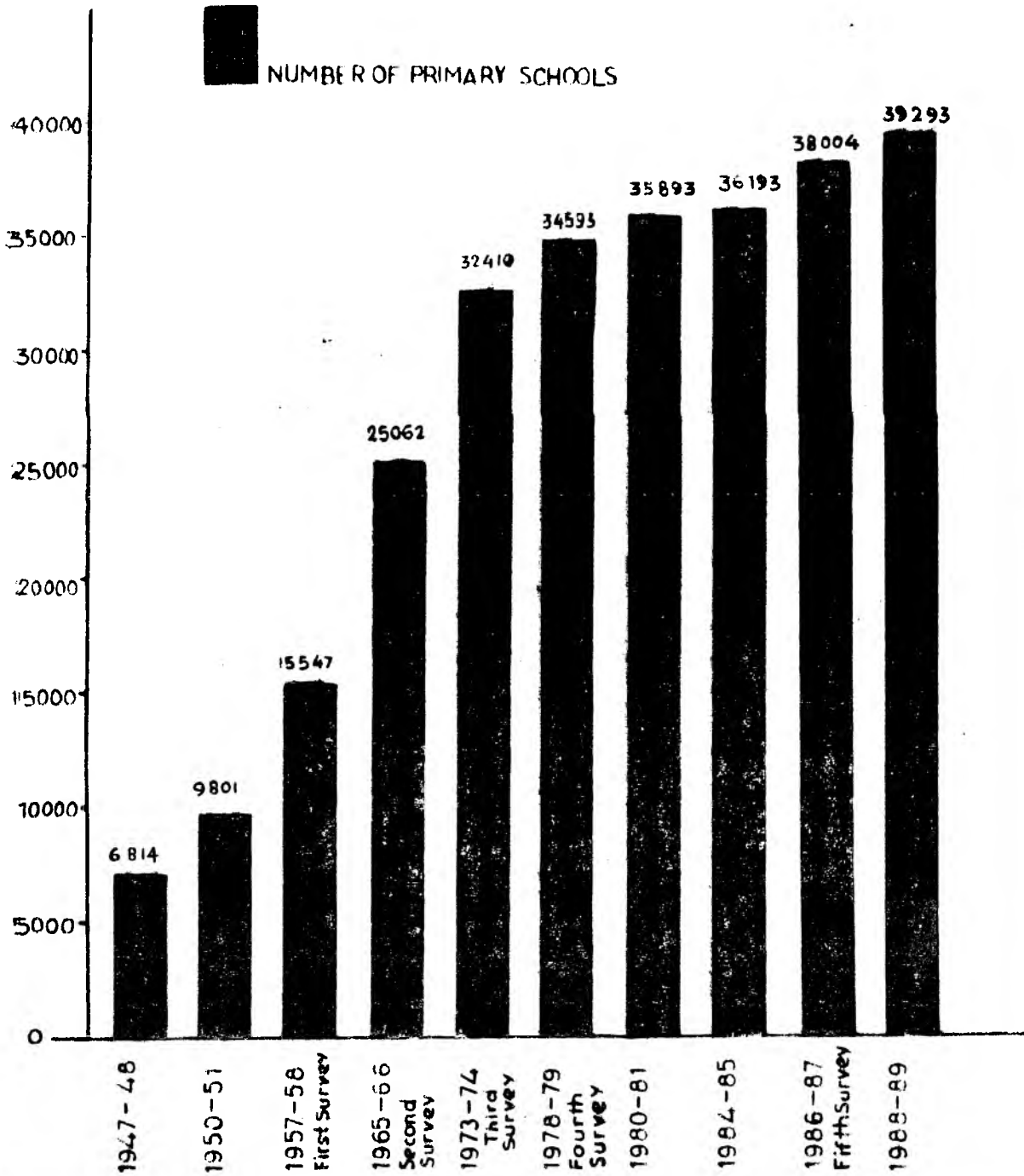

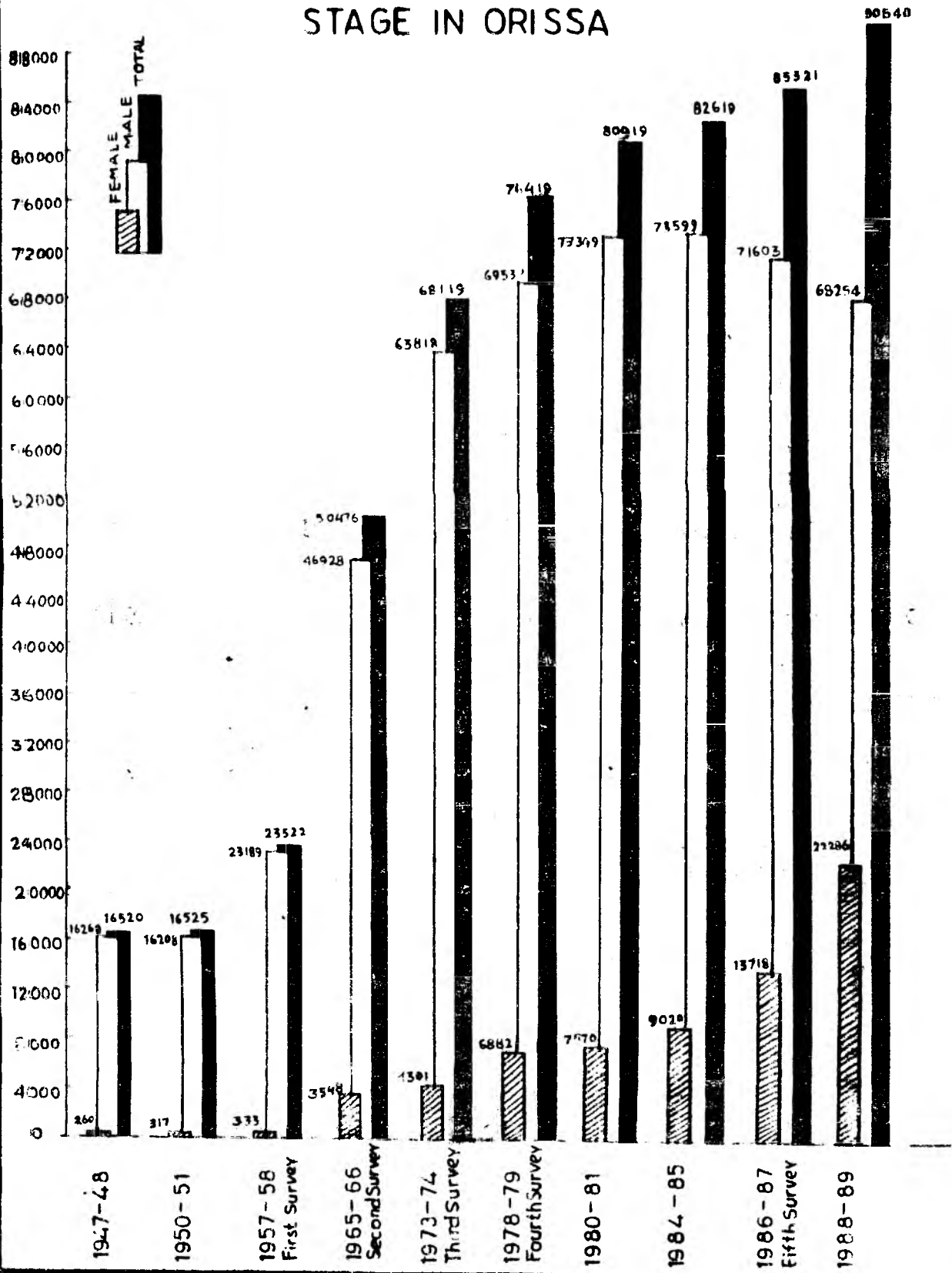
GROWTH IN NUMBER OF PRIMARY SCHOOLS IN ORISSA

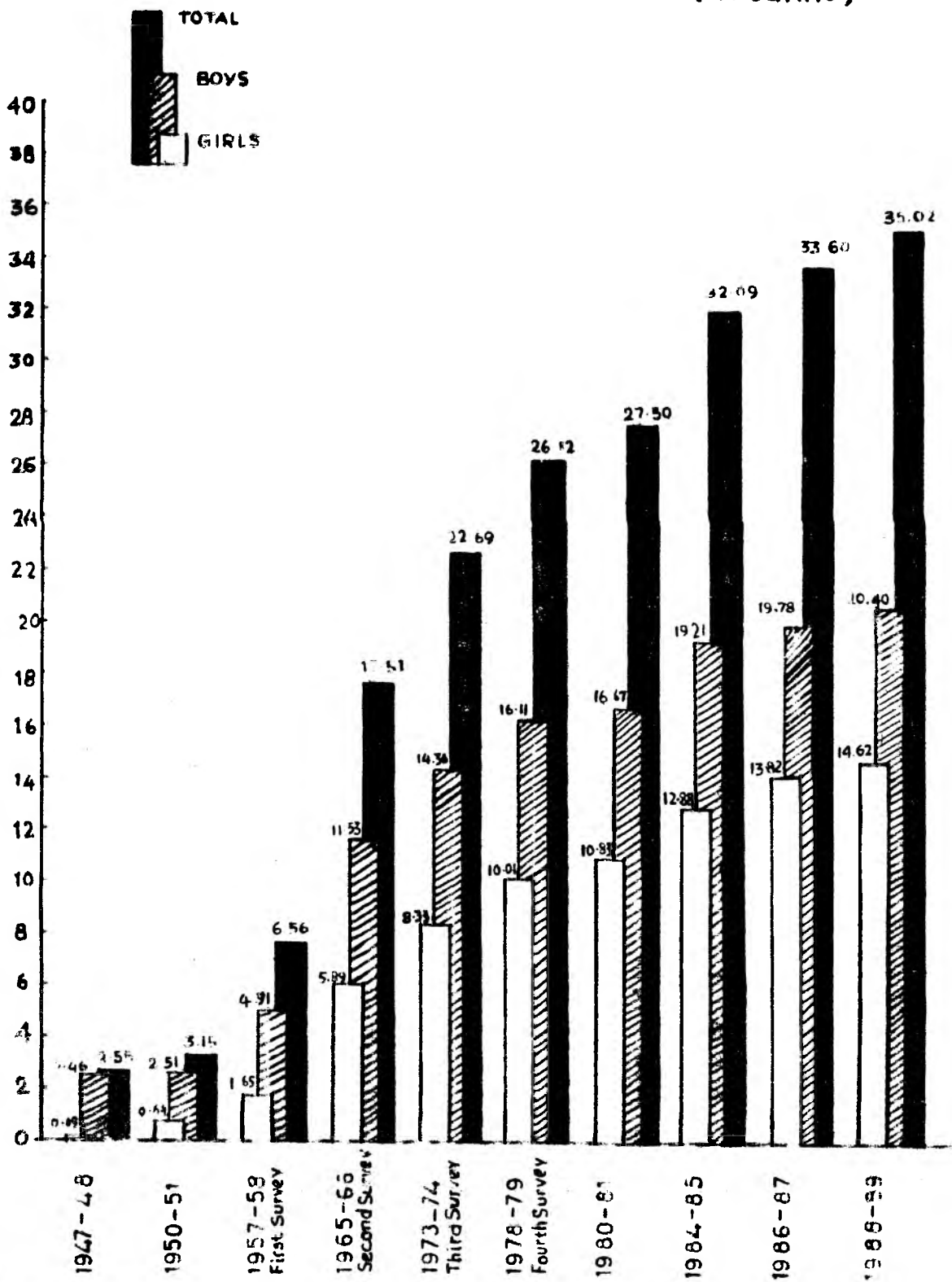
GROWTH IN NUMBER OF TEACHERS AT PRIMARY STAGE IN ORISSA

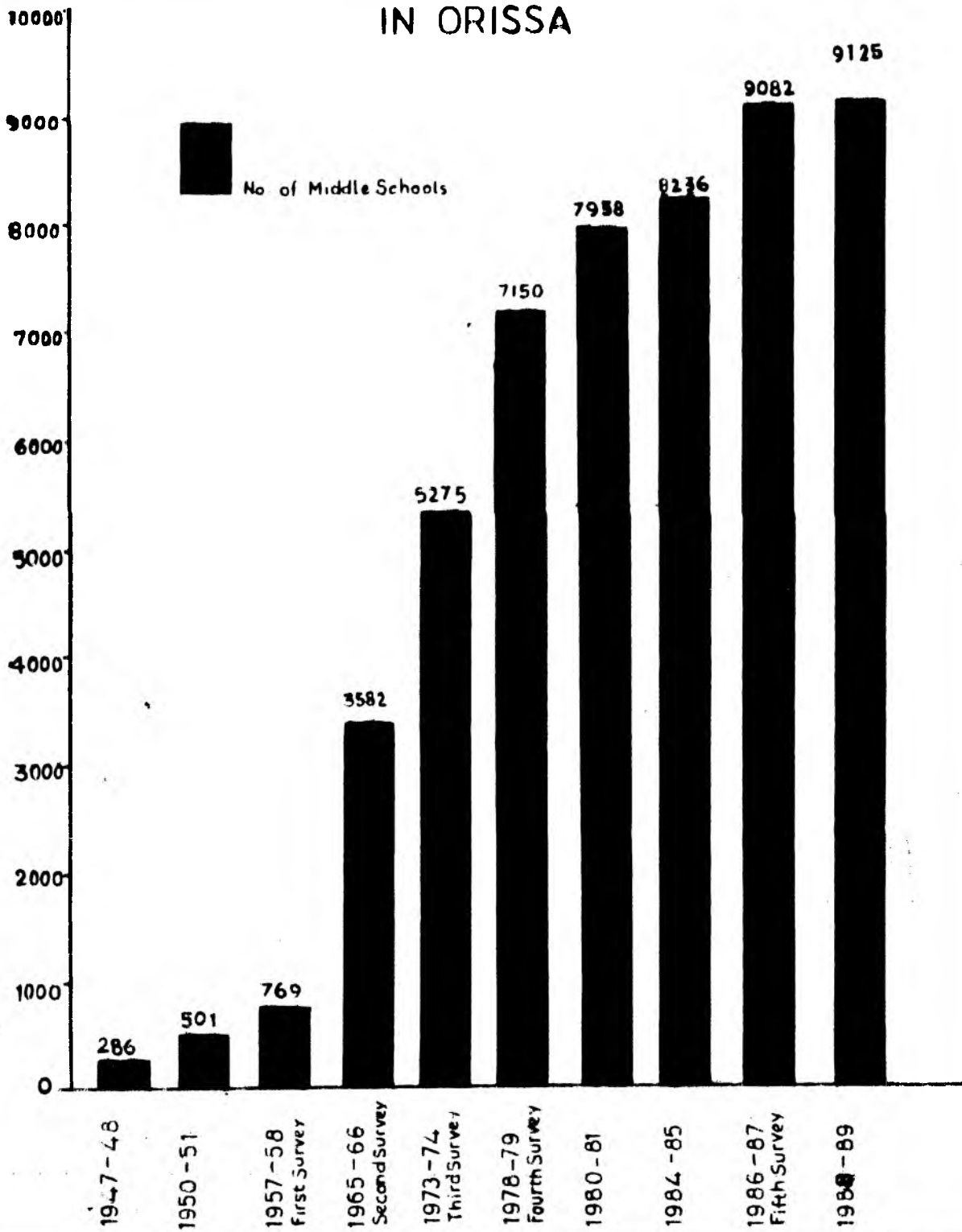

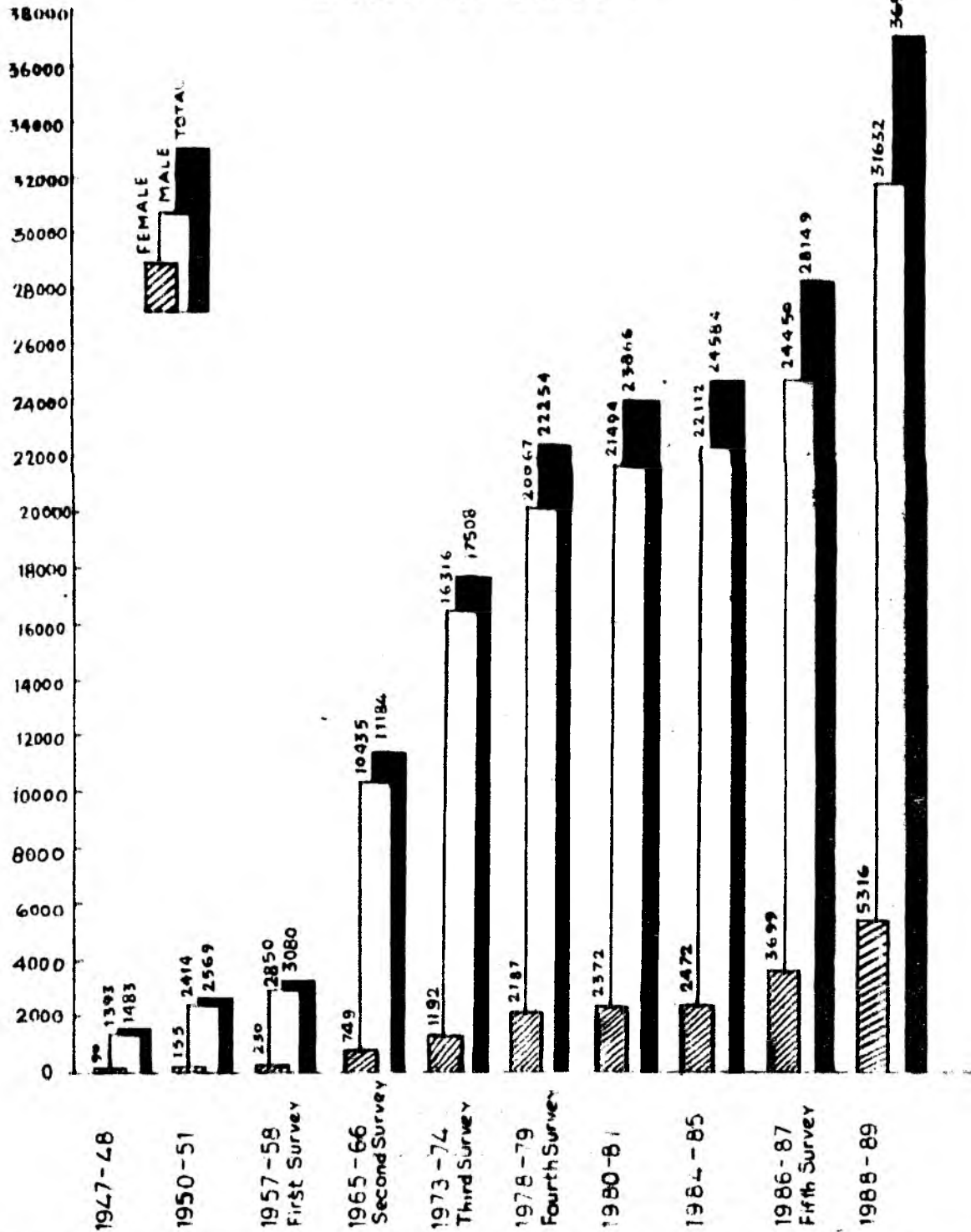
GROWTH IN NUMBER OF MIDDLE SCHOOLS IN ORISSA

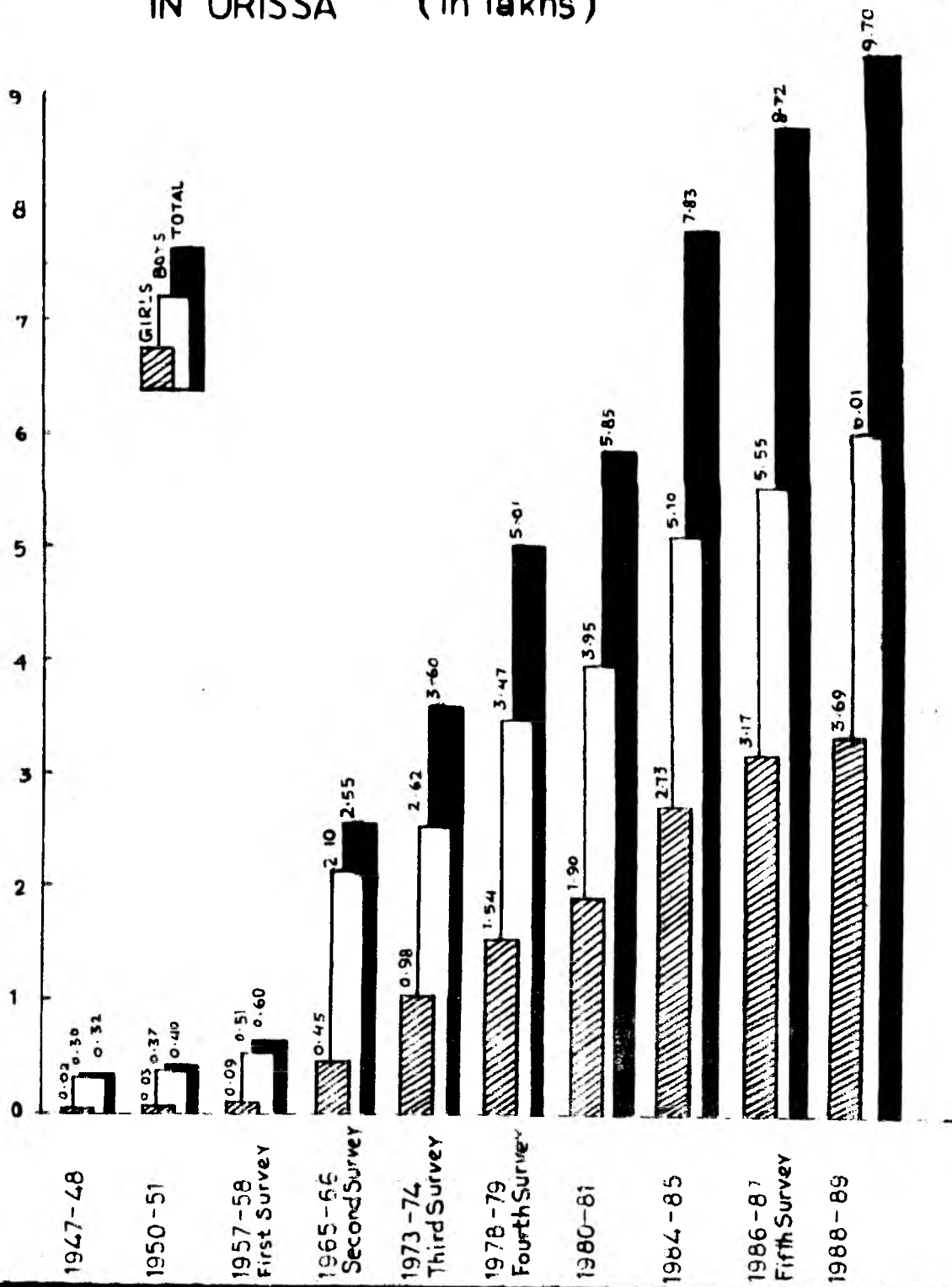
GROWTH IN NUMBER OF TEACHERS IN M.E. SCHOOL STAGE IN ORISSA

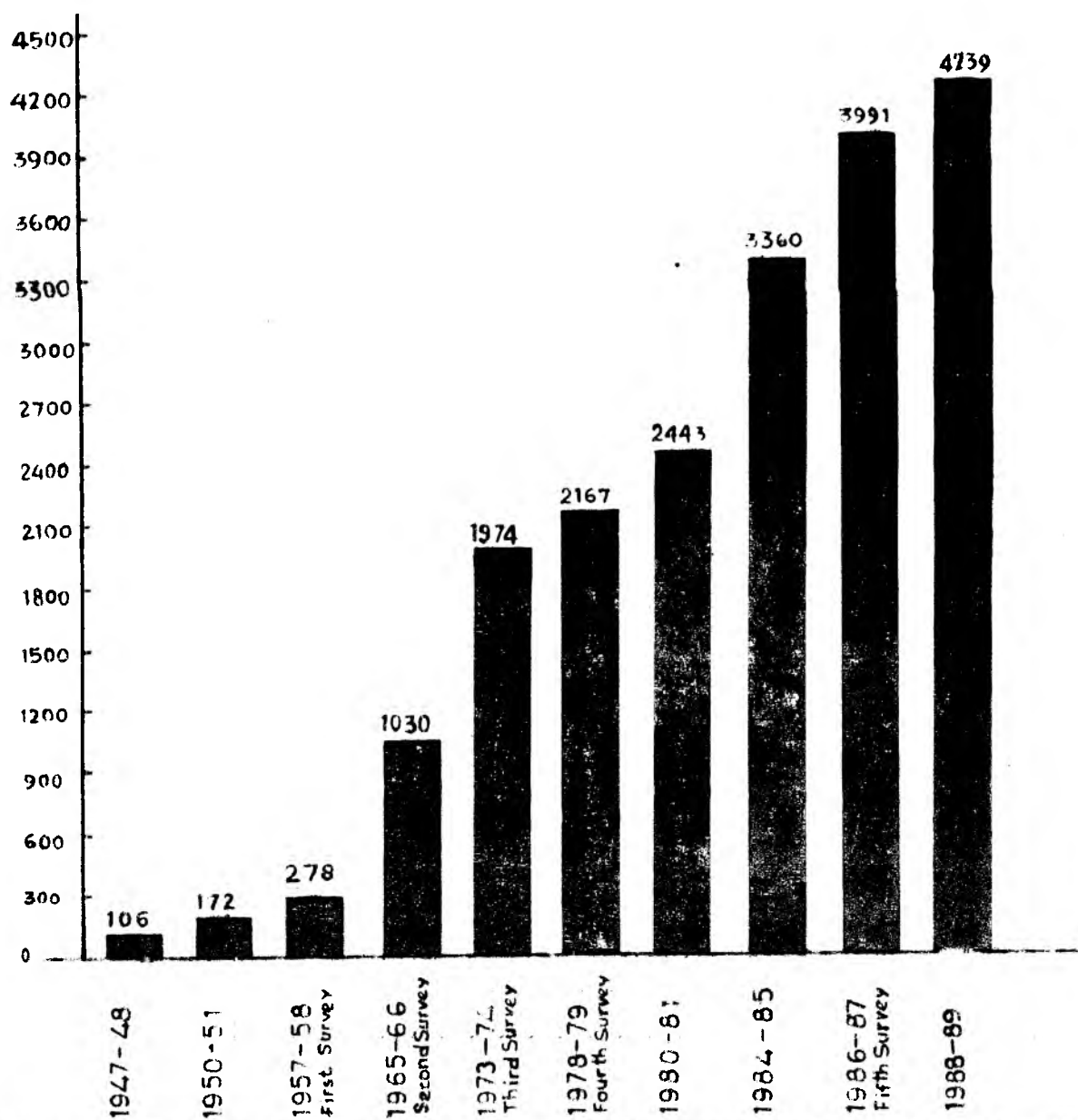

GROWTH IN NUMBER OF HIGH SCHOOLS IN ORISSA

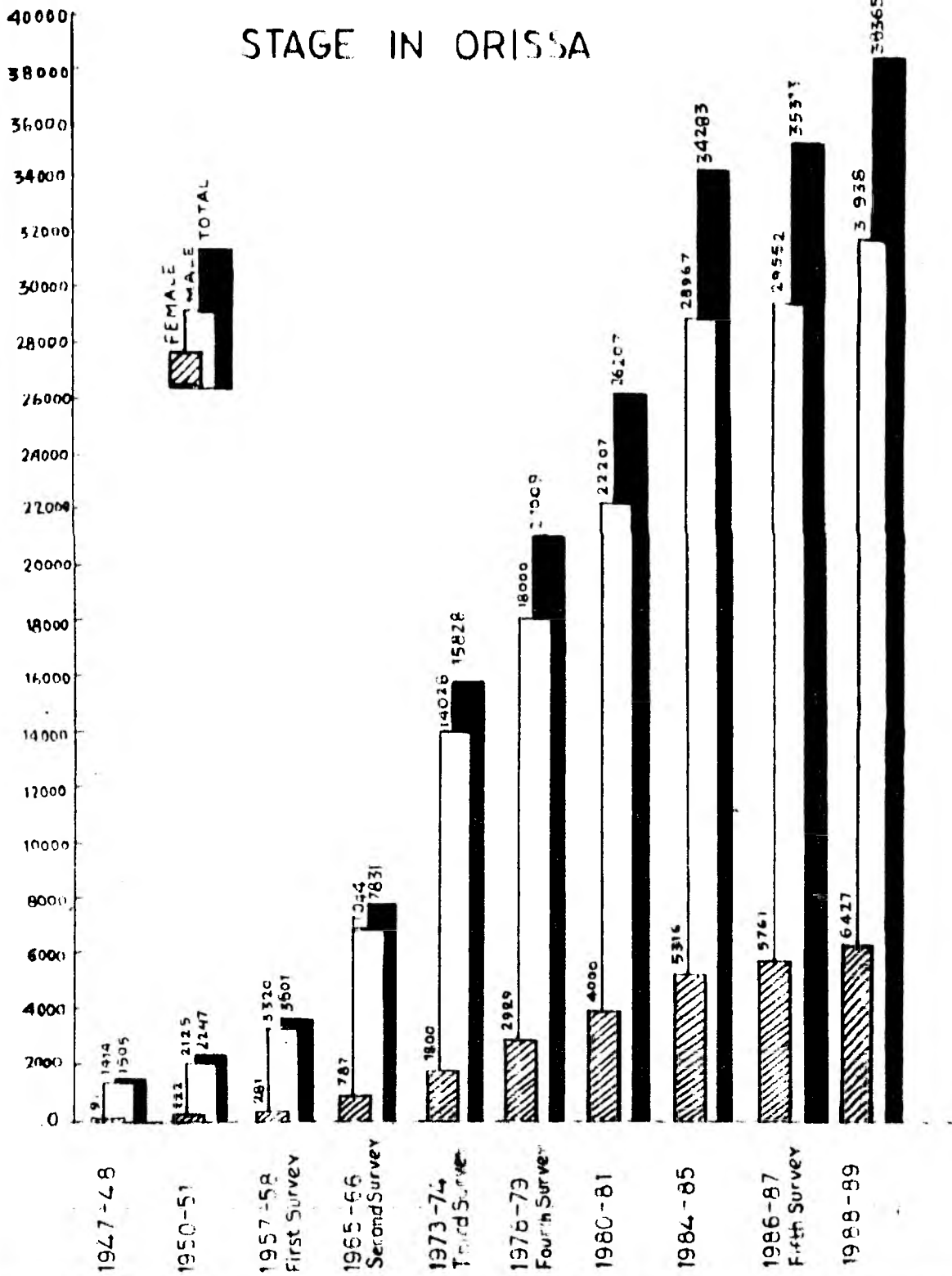

GROWTH IN NUMBER OF TEACHERS IN HIGH SCHOOL STAGE IN ORISSA

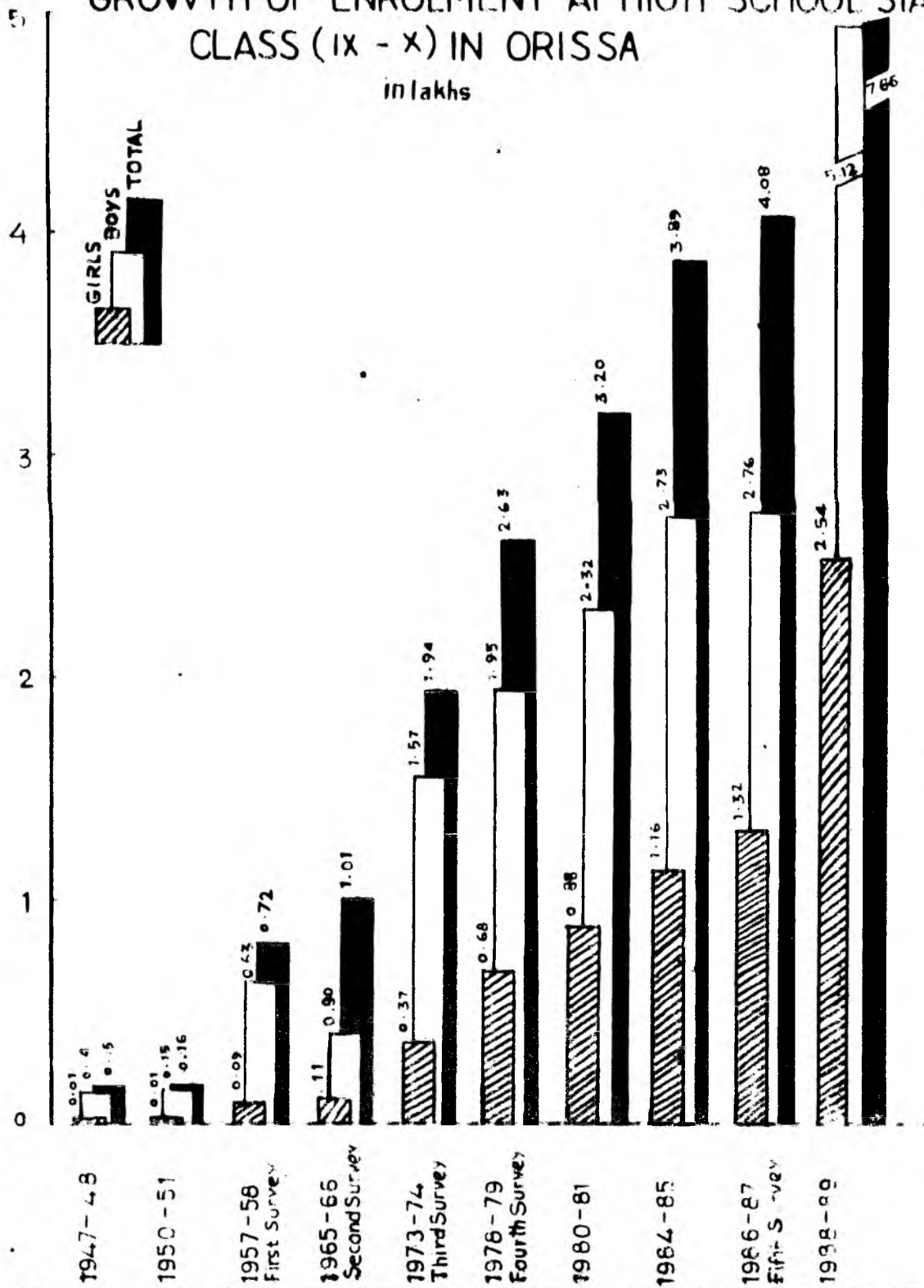

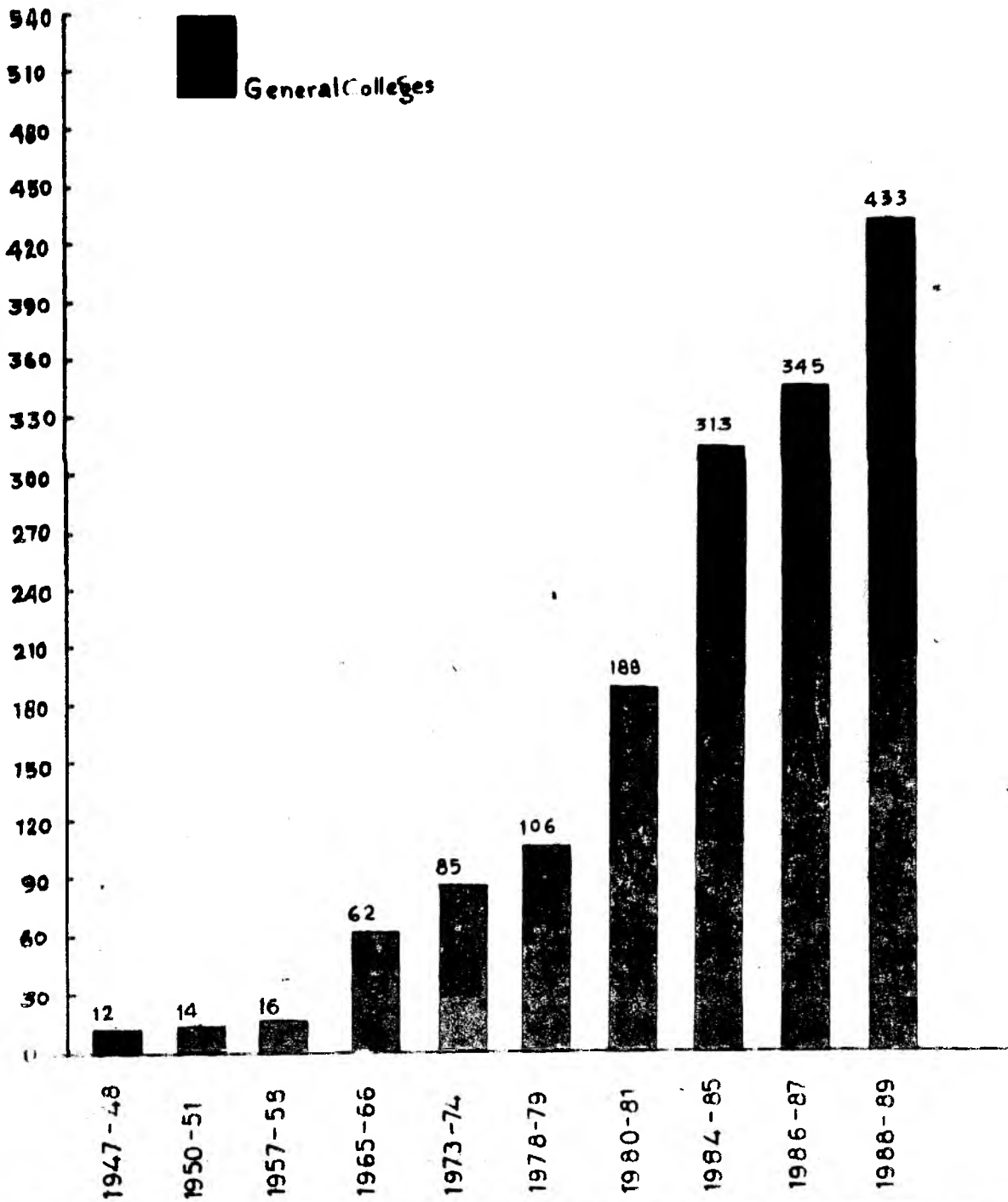

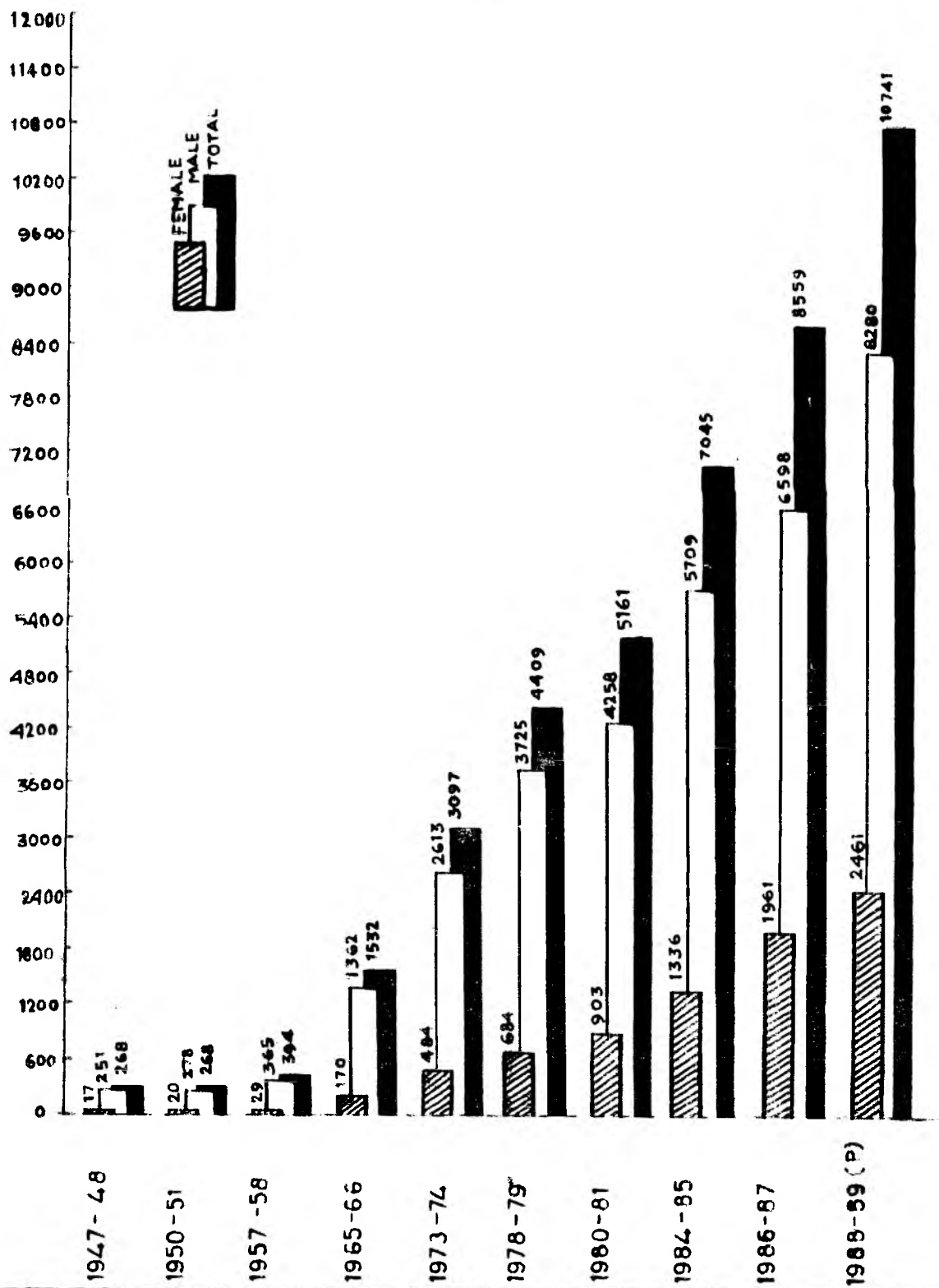
GROWTH IN NUMBER OF GENERAL COLLEGES IN ORISSA

GROWTH IN NUMBER OF TEACHERS IN COLLEGES FOR GENERAL EDUCATION IN ORISSA

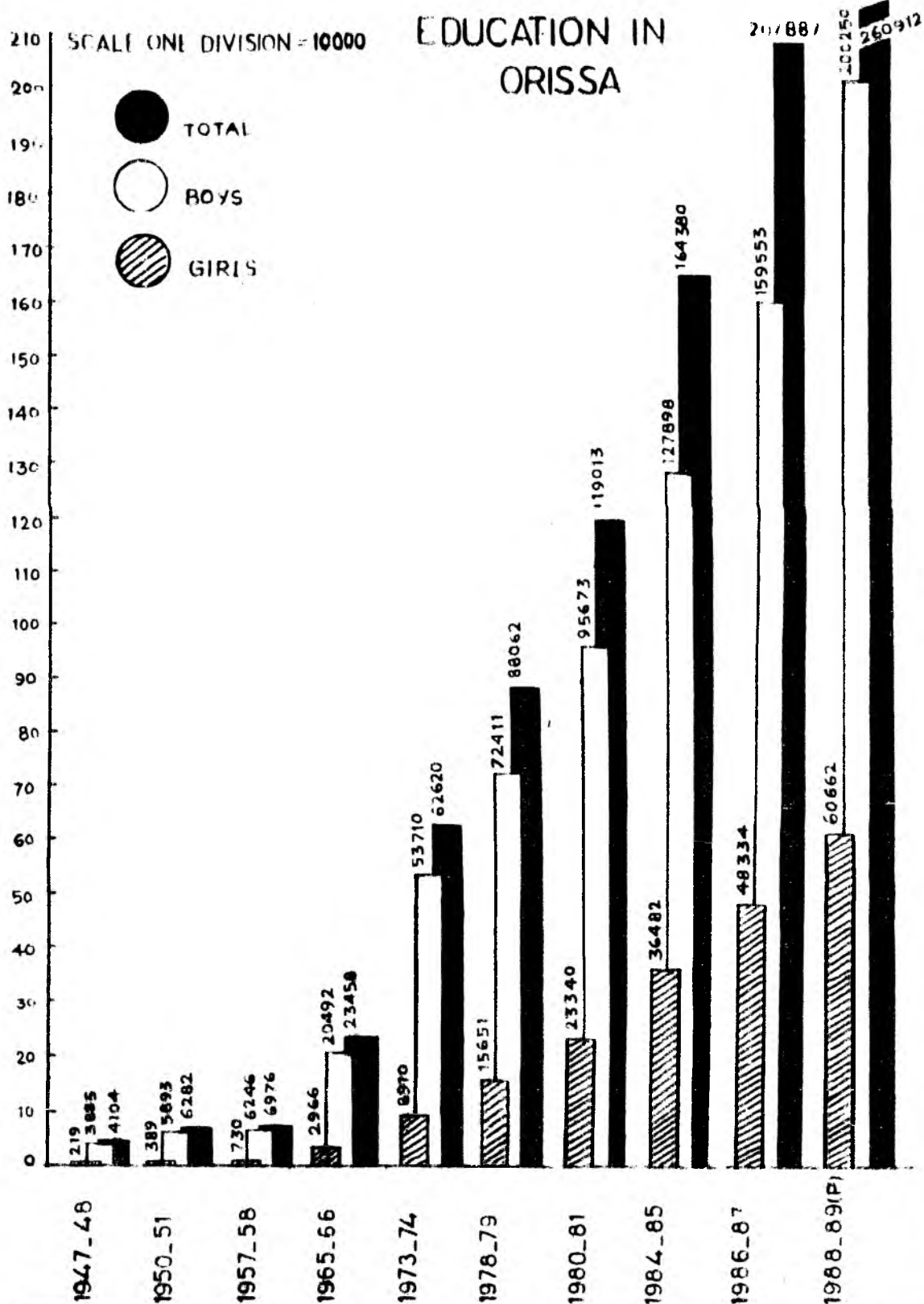
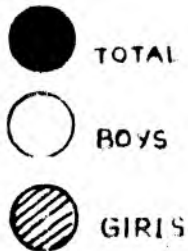

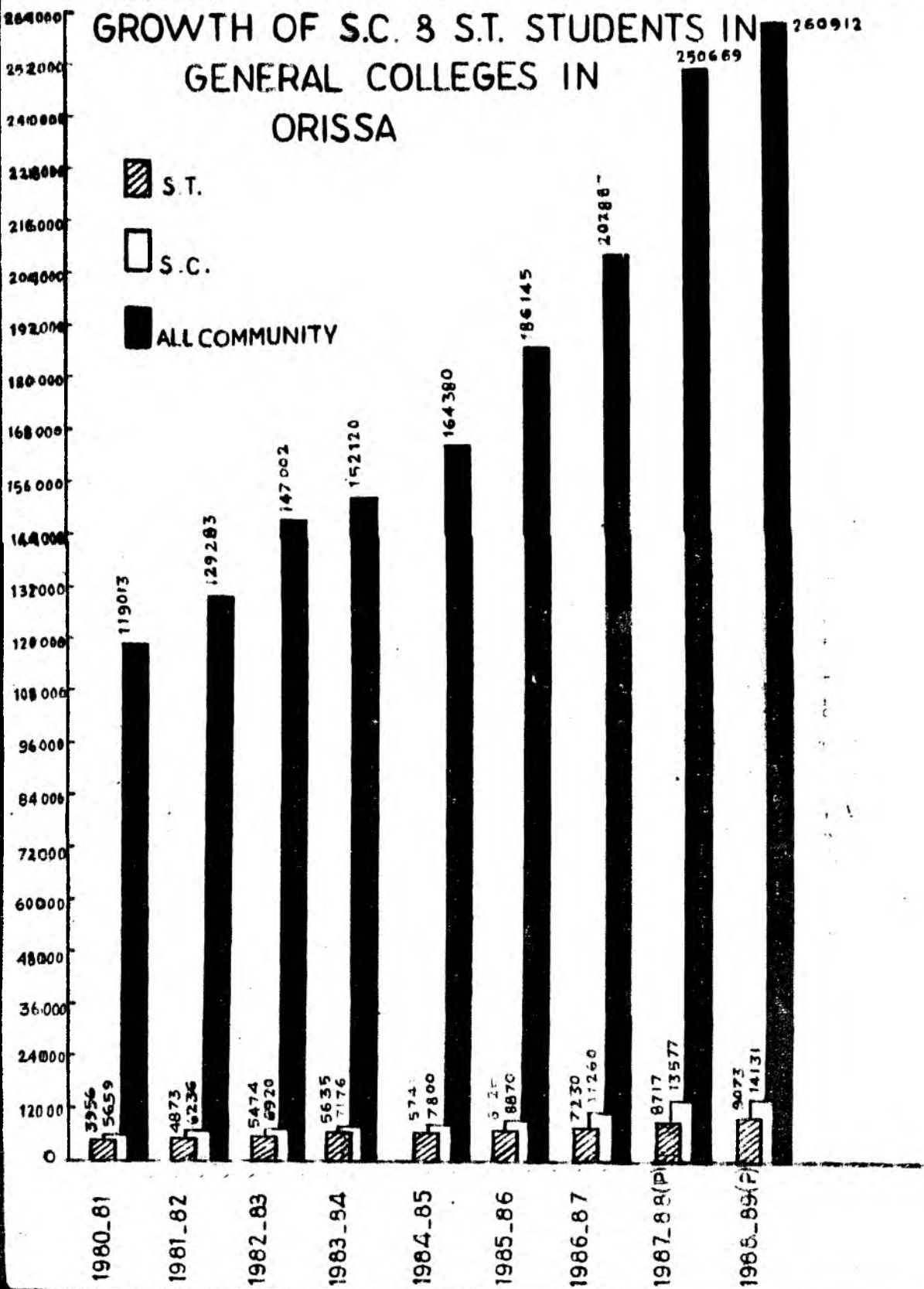

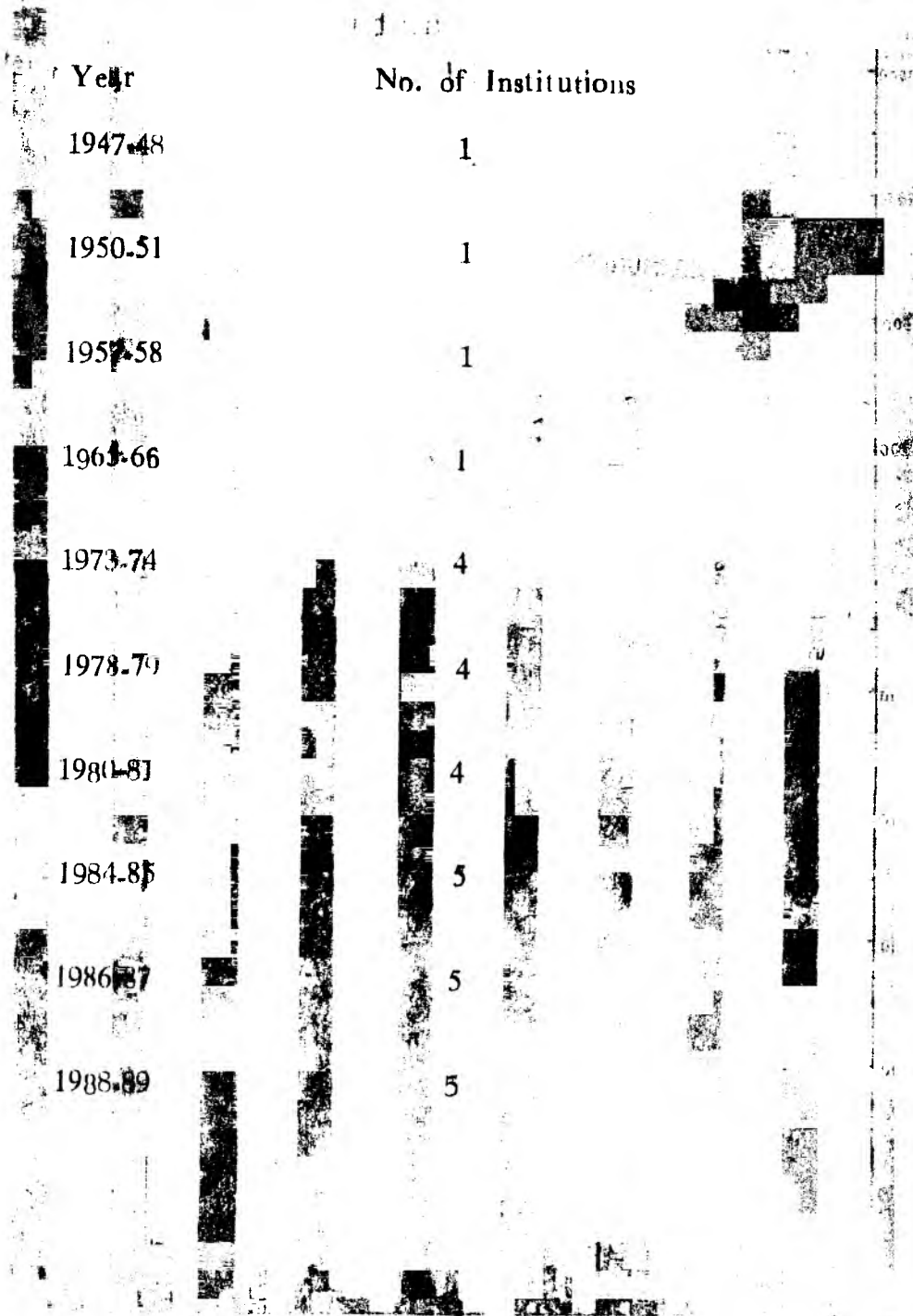

GROWTH OF S.C. & S.T. TEACHERS IN GENERAL COLLEGES IN ORISSA

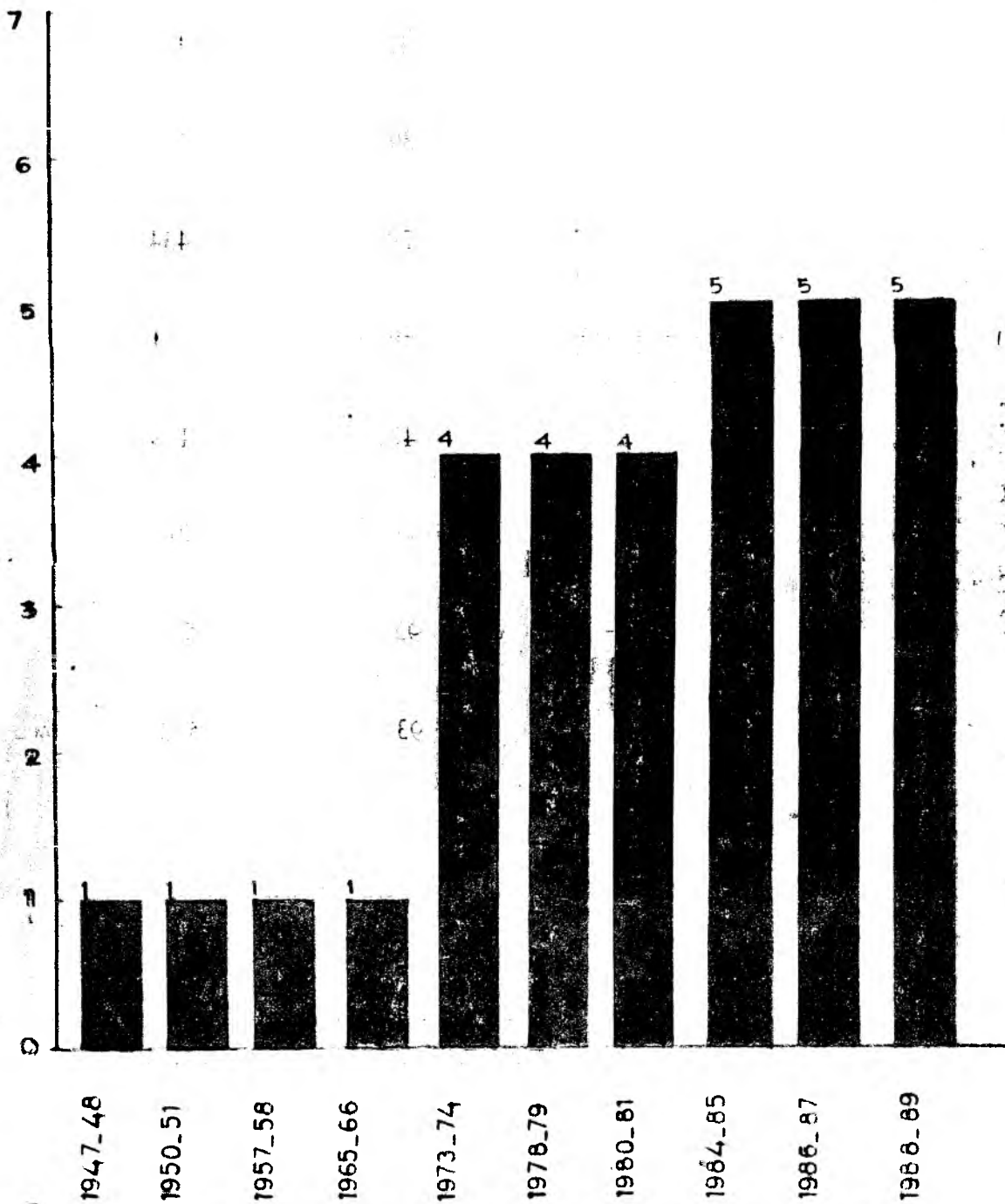

GROWTH IN NUMBER OF UNIVERSITIES IN ORISSA

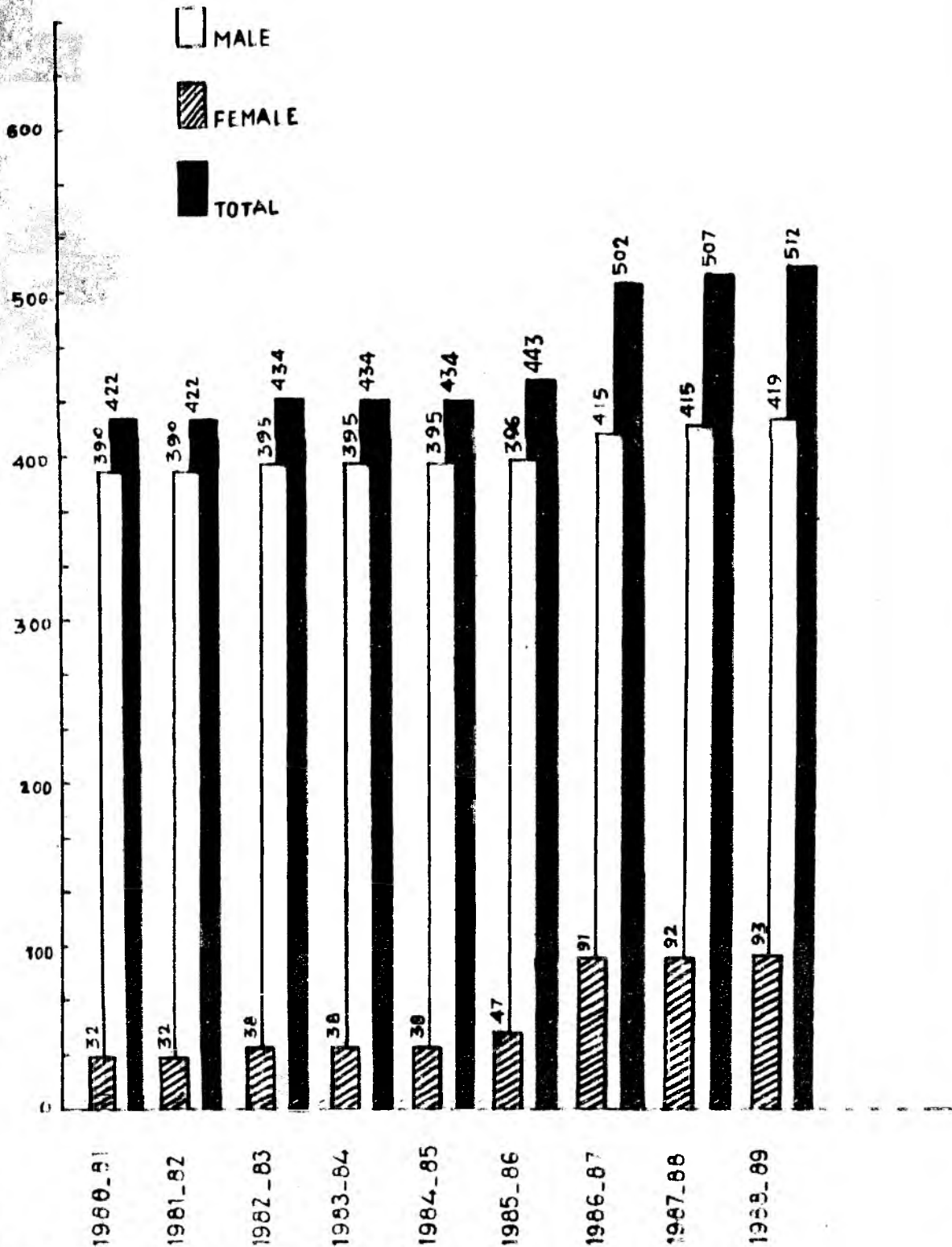

GROWTH IN NUMBER OF TEACHERS IN UNIVERSITIES IN ORISSA

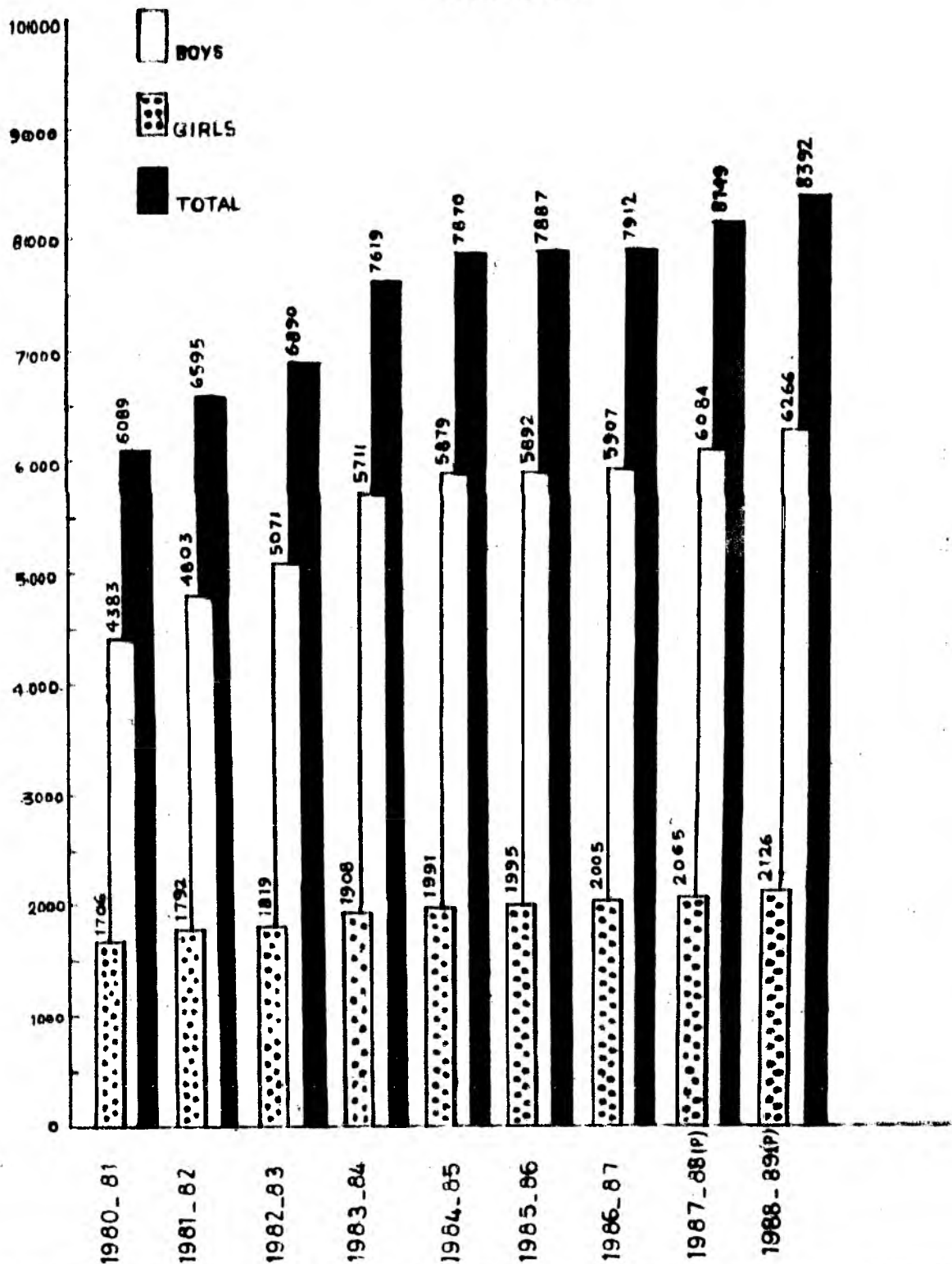
