KALAHANDI AT A GLANCE

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION:

KALAHANDI occupies the South Eastern portion of Orissa and is situated between 100°3'N & 21°5'N latitude and 82°30'E & 83°47'E longitude. It is bounded in the North by the district of Raipur(M.P), Bolangir & Nuapara. In the West by Raipur district & Nuapara dist. in the South by Raigada dist. and in the East by Phulbani district. Total Geographical area of the district spread over 8197.4 sq Km. with a break of rural & urban areas covering 8151.96 sq Km and 45.44 sq Km respectively.

LITERACY OF THE DISTRICT:

The total literates in the district of Kalahandi stand at 294617 having a rural urban break up of 253897 (RURAL) & 40720 (URBAN). The total number of male literates comes to 22222 while that in case of the female comes to 72394. The total literacy rates for the district is 31.08 % with male female break ups at 46.85 % and 15.28 % respectively. The rural literacy rates is 28.78 % in the district with male female break ups at 44.69 % and 12.96 %. The urban literacy rates is 61.08 % with male female break ups 74.48 % and 47.91 % respectively.

EDUCATION SCENARIO :

The Kalahandi Education entire Bhawanipatna was created in 14th August 1975. There are two Education districts; one is Bhawanipatna and other is Dharma garh with one C.I. Office. Kalahandi Revenue district has 10 Degree Colleges, 14 Junior Colleges, 6 Vocational Higher secondary Schools, One Secondary Training School, One D.I.E.T., 198 High Schools, One Deaf-dumb School, One Blind School, One Sanskrit School, 1450 Primary Schools, 350 Upper Primary Schools, One Navodaya Vidyalaya, One Teacher Training college, One Law College, One I.T.I., 660 N.F.E Centres, 24 numbers of H&TW Department Primary & Upper Primary schools.

WELFARE OF SC/ST

The main strategy of the welfare of the SC/ST of the district is to promote education and remove economic and special disabilities of the SC & ST to achieve the basic objective of growth with social justice. During 1997-98 the main thrust has been given to the development of education to SC & ST. In order to bring these communities into the mainstream of administration special attention is being given to uplift their education, economic and social condition by the state Govt. so to achieve the objectives ITDP, Micro project & MADA pockets have been introduced.

In Kalahandi welfare deptt. undertaken for continuation 12 nos. of High Schools, 5 nos. of Ashram High Schools, 3 nos. of Residential Sevashram Schools, 5 nos. of Kanyashram, 25 nos. of sevashrams, 24 nos. of Pw Schools Hostels, supply of N.T. books reading & writing materials, providing water supply facilities to Sevashrams, & High Schools, construction of 3no of school building where there is no school and amount of Rs.60 lakhs is proposed during 1997-98.

Highlight of 1997-98 AWP & B and Achievements of D P E P. Kalahandi

In the year 1997-98 following are the achievements of Kalahandi DPEP in the field of Tribal Education

1. State level workshop on preparation of tribal attitudinal training module, in which the tribal resource group of Kalahandi district participated
2. Orientation of formation of TRG In this workshop 25 TRG members have been trained up
3. Training of teachers on attitudinal issue

Out of 13 blocks eight blocks are with high tribal population. This year only teachers of six blocks were trained up. Total programme in 6 blocks were 18 in which 710 teachers were trained up between November, 15 to November 30, 1997. Rest teachers will be trained up in May, 1998. The proposal is placed in AWP&B 1998-99.

A brief Description of the Activities of Annual Work Plan and Budget , 1998-99 for tribal issues

Followings are the main activities of tribals issues which would be taken up in the district to improve the teaching qualities of teachers as well as the children. The strategy also would be to mobilize and sensitize the field officers in intervention areas.

Awareness Campaign

1. Tribal Leaders Orientation Programme.
2. Adivasi Gitkudia Sammitan
3. Printing of Tribals Aware Posters
4. Adivasi Shisumela

Training & Workshop

1. Tribal Area Teachers Orientation Programme
2. Training to (RC Co ordinator
3. Collection of Tribal Oral Tradition to prepare Supplementary Reader for Tribal Children and Picture Dictionary
4. Training to W.F.O. and H.M.s of Ashram School
5. Training to teachers in tribal language and context for classroom transaction for the tribals children in three blocks of Kalahandi.
6. Study on an intensive case study of children of special focus group out of school.
7. Seminar on Tribal Children.
8. Study on effectiveness of Ashram Schools for the development of education for tribal girls children.
9. Study on causes of dropout and lack of achievement among the tribal girl children
10. Workshop of Tribal Resource Group on tribal education and training module.
11. Sharing Workshop of TRG on Social Assessment Study and on Attitudinal issue
12. TRG Workshop.
13. Supply of free reading and writing materials to SC/ST students.

DETAILS OF ACTIVITIES FOR 1998-99 AWP&B :

Training to tribal area Teachers on attitudinal issues

The main objectives of this training is ;

1. Sensitisation and identification of teachers on attitudinal issues.
2. Identify the current social bias and which stand against the tribal education.
3. To use tribal folklore in the learning and teaching for the tribal children.
4. To understand the psychology of a tribal child.
5. Making the teachers rethink their traditional teaching practices and style

In 1997-98 AWP&B the target was to training 600 teachers in 15 programme. But in 18 programme total number of teachers was trained up was 710 in 6 blocks out of 8 blocks of Kalahandi. In 1998-99 the target is to train up all teachers of the left out 2 blocks and the rest teachers of the 6 blocks, those have not got the training. Therefore 30 programmes have been proposed to train up 1200 teachers in 1998-99 session in Summer vacation.

Meeting to Tribal Leaders to develop school community relationship

Meeting of tribal leaders will be conducted in a phased manner in order to develop a better relationship between community and the school

Objectives

- To orient them about DPFP activities
- To apprise them about their role and responsibility in the context of tribal education
- To find out the needs and aspirations of the community in the context of primary education
- To find out information about tribal societies, value language and the factors inhibiting the development of tribal communities

Printing of Posters

Posters especially designed for tribal area on primary education, community participation, gender discrimination will be printed and distributed among the tribal communities to develop awareness among them

Collection of folk literature for supplementary reader in tribal area

Collection of folk literature and its use in tribal education is a special area of intervention. The educators have to understand the tribal outlook to discover the rich cognitive ability inherent in tribal culture, more specially among the boys and girls.

Traditional learning materials will be enriched by providing materials from tribal folklore. Under this item following activities will be taken up

Adivishi Geet Kudia Sammilani

In Kalahandi there are so many verbal poets those can compose immediately poem after knowing the context. In tribal dominated pockets of Kalahandi their number is more and they are popular for their songs

Objectives

1. To create awareness among the tribals and rural people.
2. Tribal People can be easily motivated by these poems.
3. Create inspiration among the traditional poets.
4. Community mobilisation can take place easily and immediately.

Training to CRC Co-ordinators

It has been planned to orient all CRC Co-ordinator on D.P.F.P intervention in the context of tribal education. It has been proposed to conduct two training programmes, the duration of which will be 4 days

Objective

- (a) To orient about D P E P activities in general and its intervention in line tribal education in particular.
- (b) To develop a tribal out look removing their preconceived biasness
- (c) To develop an attitude of belongingness and appreciation towards tribal society and culture
- (d) Developing an attitude for inter cultural acceptance

Training to WEO and H.M. of Ashram Schools

It has been planned to conduct a two days training programme of WEO & HM of Ashram School

Objectives

1. To sensitise them to need for ensuring quality primary education in tribal area as a natural goal and necessity.
2. To motivate these personnels to work effectively for achieving, and activising DPEP's objectives in tribal areas.
3. To enable them to appreciate the strengthen problems, compulsions and need of tribal communities.
4. To enable these officials to perceptive how they may play a positive role in various developmental programmes for these tribals.

Intensive case studies of children of Special Focus Group

A study on " Intensive Case Studies of children of Specially Focus Group" has been proposed to be undertake during 1998-99.

Objectives

- 1 To know the dropouts among different tribal community
- 2 To know the informal and traditional learning pattern of the children of special focus group
- 3 To know the learning strategies used by the children.
- 4 Finding the special characteristics of the tribal child.
- 5 To find out the factors that may enhance education of tribal children.
- 6 To know the problem of tribal children in classroom adoption of two Ashrams for organisational development
7. Two Ashram Schools managed by the Welfare Department will be adopted for organisational development.

MAJOR ISSUES

Following are the problems in the field of educating the tribal children.

1. Most of the parents are first generation learners or say non-literates.
2. The tribal women are almost illiterates
3. Acute poverty due to complete dependency on local forests, where as the rapid deforestation has debackled their normal living standard.
4. Education does not fulfil their immediate need so they do not afford to it.
5. Adequate educational facilities and infrastructures are not available in the tribal area.
6. Most of the tribal children help their parents in income generating activities.
7. Indifferent attitude of parents towards educating their children.
8. Tribal culture and values have no place in school environment.
9. Tribal self image, oral tradition, wisdom and knowledge, community life and values are not reflected in curriculum.
10. No specific intervention have yet been undertaken for development of tribal children in the field of education.

SPECIAL SCHEMES UNDERTAKEN BY THE WELFARE DEPARTMENT FOR THE EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR THE TRIBAL PEOPLE

I.T.D.A

In Kalahandi, Th.Rampur I.T.D.A was grounded in the year 1979 covering two Blocks of this district namely Th.Rampur and Lanjigarh which comes under the sub-plan area w.e.f. 31.12.1977. Total area of this two Blocks are 23.50 Sq.KMs. Total population of this two block are 1,16,751. Out of which 60,874 are STs constituting 52% of the total population. Both the blocks having 12 GPs and Th.Rampur block having 293 villages where Lanjigarh has 471 villages covering by I.T.D.A.

The Primary objectives of the I.T.D A is to impliment welfare programme inorder to improve the economic conditions of the Tribal through execution of verious infrastructural development works and individual benefit or family oriented scheme. During 6th. Plan period to onwards besides different develop ment programmes for the education development construction of school and hostel for the Tribal. A sum of 70 Lakhs is proposed for educational development and income generating activities during 1997-98. Rs.2,00,000/ is proposed for financial year 1997-98 for repairing 5 Nos. of ST villages assistance to Tribal women is sanctioned as 2 Lakhs to 40 Tribal women.

MICRO PROJECT (K.K.D.A)

One Micro Project KKDA is constituted for the development of the primitive tribes of Kutia Kandha those who are living in the Lanjigarh Block. The project comprises 8 villages of Lanjigarh G.P and 10 villages of Chhatrapur G.P & the list of villages, total household population-wise and G.P-wise given bellow.
