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EDUCATION

During the previous Plan period there has been a massive expansion in the elementary education sector which resilted in achieving near 100% enrolment. However while attempt.ing such massive expansion of educational facilities the qualitative aspects had more or less been ignored. During the VII Plan period the emphasis therefore will be to streingthen the quality side of the educational system by strengthening the schools with libraries, scientific equipments, furnitures and buildings. It is proposed to clear the entire backlog of land acquisition and building proposals as well as supply of furniture to these schools. The backlog in appointment of teachers in the elementary education sector is also proposed to be cleared. In consultation with the Central Building Mesearch Institute and in collaboration with the District Rural Development. Agercy it is proposed to put up low cost school buildings constructed with the indegeneous materials under either NREF or RLGP. It is also proposed for the first time to take up the task of covering drop outs in the age group of 11-14 through a net work of non formal centres under the scheme of Universalisation of Elementary Education. To give fillip to scientific and inquisition approach among children it is proposed to set up a science corner in each of the middle school and strengthen the laboratories in he high / higher secondary schools. Similarly to prepare the children with achieving of INSAT facility in the wake of setting up of a T.V. centre at Pondicherry it is proposed to supply T.V. sets to the middle / high / higher secondary schools under Audio Visual Education. Vocationalisation of higher secondary education and study of vocational trades in the middle and high schools is proposed to encourage further with appointment of qualified teachers and supply of tools and raw materials. It is proposed to introduce atleast one vocational trade in each of the higher secondary schools of this territory. With the introduction of incentives like free supply of text books, stationeries, uniforms, etc. at the primary stage the drop cut rate would be effectively curbed. It is now proposed to tackle the drop out comparatively much higher in the ? middle school level in the same manner. It is therefore proposed to provide similar incentives to the children studying in the middle school level (VI to VIII standard i.e. 11-14 age group) while continuing the incentives in the primary stage. The coverage under attendance scholarship at the middle school level as well as the merit prize and merit cum means scholarship to girl students are intended to be enhanced.

Under University Education it is proposed to start 14 new courses of which 7 are in the P.G. level in the six degree colleges. It is primarily to help students of this Union Territory to fulfil their aspirations of higher education who otherwise are dependent on a few seats made available to them in the colleges of neighbouring states on reservation basis. It is also proposed to start part time M.Phil course in three subjects and to start an evening college exclusively for the girls.

Under Technical Education the Engineering College sanctioned during the preceeding year will be set up. The existing Polytechnic will be further strengthened to take up two more diploma courses in the emerging area and one more diploma course as well as provide facility exclusively for the students coming from vocational education sphere to help their vertical mobility. As desired by the Ministry of Home Affairs, two new technical institutions will be put up in minority concentrated areas like Karaikal and Mahe viz. a Polytechnic and a Junior Technical School respectively. In view of the enthusiastic participation of women in the diploma courses it is proposed to put up a women's Polytechnic during the VII Plan.

The Phy-sical Education, Sports and Youth Welfare activities will be given an impetus by strengthening further the administrative hierarchy as well as continuing the setting up of a multi purpose sports complex beside continuing other sports activities. Similarly recreational activities for the children during out of school hours will also receive further impetus with the setting up of a minimal bhavan in each commune of this Union Territory by further strengthening the administrative machinery. The library movement also will be continued by opening of new branch libraries in the remote areas especially Scheduled Caste hamlets.

The activities under Adult Education will be continued and further strengthened to achieve complete eradication of adult illiteracy by 1990.

To sum up the thurst of the VII Plan will be to bring in a qualitative improvement in the Elementary and Secondary School level by clearing the backlog of teachers, physical facilities, buildings, etc. as well as to give impetus to scientific approach among the teachers. The other high-lights of the Plan will be to introduce increasing degree of vocationalisation of education from the middle school level to higher secondary school level.
