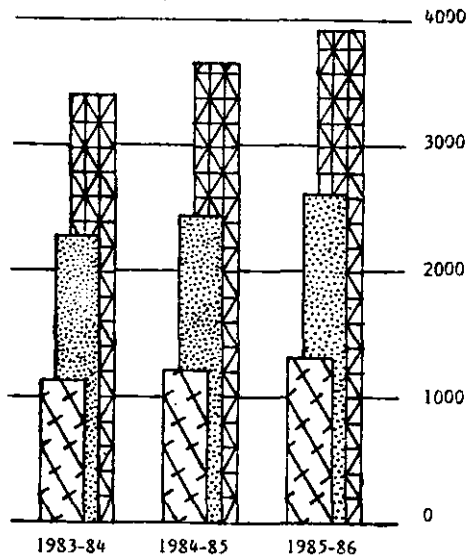

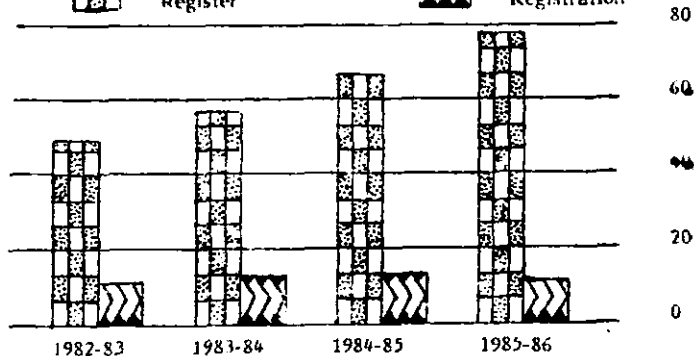
PERSONS ON LIVE REGISTER
