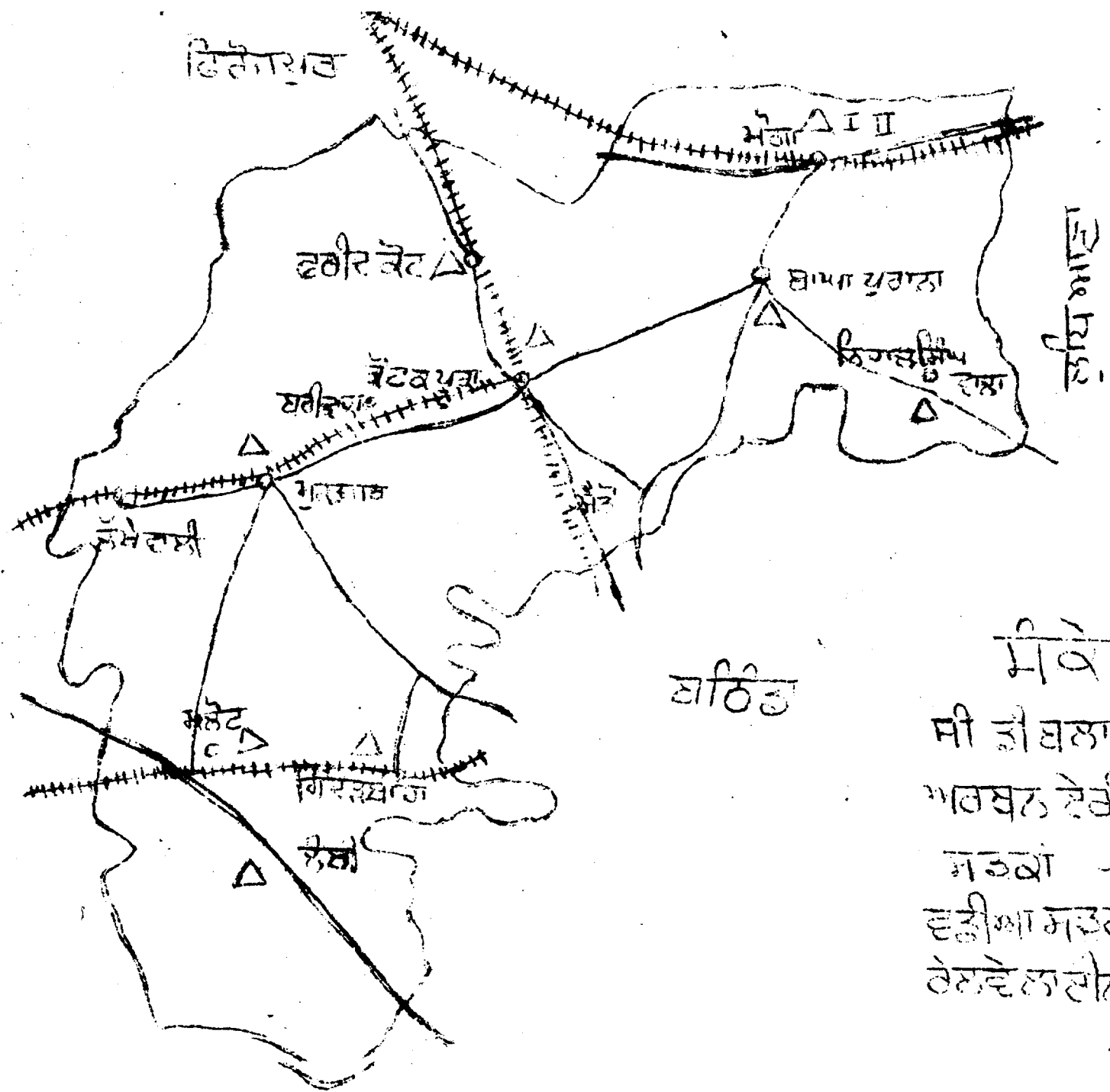

PART I

CHAPTER I

1.1 GENERAL INFORMATION

BRIEF HISTORY OF FARIDKOT

The district of Faridkot, twelfth of the State, is located in the Malwa Region of the State of Punjab. This Region i.e. Malwa Region has from remote times occupied a conspicuous place in the history of India. The brave Malois of South West of Punjab, who have reputation of presenting gallant resistance against Alexander the Great, resided here for centuries before they moved further ahead into the plains now called Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh. The very name of the Region i.e. Malwa is an indication of the Great impact made by these ancient tribes in this land. Then there came the Rajputs... Bhattis and Panwars... whose contribution to the social and cultural life of the people of this region even exceeds that of Malois.

The Bhatti Chief's grand son Mokal is believed to be actually founder of erstwhile Mokal Har. A fort was being constructed. A famous Sufi Saint SHAIKH FARIDKOTI happened to be passing by was forced to labour i.e. BEGAR. A miracle came to pass as the legend goes. The basket of the earth was seen floating into the air without any visible physical support. The then ruler

"THE RAI" begged pardon of the SHIKH FARID and named this fort as FARIDKOT.

FARIDKOT was the capital of the erstwhile Faridkot state. In 1948, the Faridkot state was merged into P.P.S.U. and the town became the part of BHATINDA DISTRICT. The city was neglected city in the P.P.S.U.

In 1972 during the Chief Ministership of Giani Zail Singh the Faridkot district was created in the revenue map of the country by carving two tehsils of Moga and Muktsar from Ferozepur and Faridkot of Bhatinda district.

AREA

The total area of Faridkot district is 5470 Sq. Km.

ADMINISTRATIVE STRUCTURE

The Faridkot district has been divided into three sub-divisions viz. Faridkot, Moga and Muktsar.

i) FARIDKOT.

It has been divided to two C. D. Blocks viz. Faridkot & Kotkapura (Jaitu is a sub-tehsil).

ii) MOGA

Moga Sub-division has been divided to four C. D. Blocks Moga I, Moga II, Nihal Singh wala & Bagha Purana. (Nihal Singh wala is also sub-tehsil).

iii) MUKTSAR

This Sub-division has four C. D. Blocks viz. Muktsar, Kot Bhai, Malout and Lambi. Where as Giddarbahi, Malout and Lambi are sub-tehsils.

TOWNS AND VILLAGES

There are 11 towns and 578 villages out of these villages 568 are inhabited while 13 are uninhabited i.e. Becharag.

RELIGIOUS PLACES OF HISTORICAL IMPORTANCE

The district has the shrine of the Sufi Saint 'SHEIKH FARID' at Faridkot & Godri Sahib, Faridkot.

Gurdwara Gongsar at Jaitu, Gurdwara Jand sahib (Faridkot), Takhtupura (Moga), are also of historical importance.

In the religious sikh history Gurdwara DARBAR SAHIB & TIBBI SAHIB (Muktsar) has a significant place. Every year a melā is held on MAGHI DAY. The Gurdwara was erected in memory of forty muktsas who sacrificed their lives for Guruji.

There is one Home Science Institute (Govt.) (run by the Punjab Agricultural University) at Kouni, Tehsil Muktsar.

There are four training colleges for graduate teachers in

this district.

1.2 FIFTH ALL INDIA EDUCATIONAL SURVEY.

The Block Primary Education Officers at least one from each C. D. Block alongwith District Education Officer, (Primary & Secondary) were trained for the collection of data.

At the district level Mrs. Kailash Kapoor, Headmistress, Government High school, Chugina & Shri Kuldip Chander, Lecturer, Govt. JBT Institute, Faridkot, assisted by Shri Darshan Kumar Jashi, were assigned the duty to scrutinize and tabulate the data. They took keen interest in completing the assignment. They put hard labour with zeal and responsibility to complete the work. The efforts of Shri Kuldip Chander who has experience of consolidating the survey data are appreciable. District Education Officer, (Primary) gave full co-operation to the staff.

The data was collected in VIF & SIF. (village information forms & school information forms)

a) VILLAGE INFORMATION FORMS.

Village information forms include name of the village & serial number according to census of 1981. Population of all community and scheduled castes & scheduled tribes according to the census of 1981, estimated population on 30.9.1986 were entered. Estimated child population in different age group were also asked for. Habitations of the village alongwith educational facilities were also collected. Information regarding adult centres, Balwaris & pre-primary coaching centre, if any, with enrolments were asked for.

b) SCHOOL INFORMATION FORMS

School Information Forms asked for the information viz area, management (Government, Local Bodies, Private aided, Private un-aided, type of school, classes taught, medium of instructions, type of school buildings,

Area of the school campus (covered and un-covered separately), class rooms, black boards, furniture (classwise & sectionwise), library (according to number of books), games material, drinking water facility, urinal and lavatories, (separate for teachers, girls/women & common) & number of teachers (trained and untrained) (sexwise, qualificationwise & departmentwise :- Primary, upper primary, secondary & Senior Secondary). Number of scheduled CASTE teachers (sexwise & qualificationwise) was also asked for.

CONCEPT of habitation was the population of that village residing at some distance. And types of schools viz PRIMARY, UPPER PRIMARY (MIDDLE), SECONDARY & PLUS 2 STAGE at the school level.

CHAPTER II PRIMARY EDUCATION

There are 833 Primary schools, upper Primary (Middle) with six Primary sections, secondary schools with 17 Primary sections & senior Secondary schools with 11 Primary sections. Therefore, it can be said that number of primary sections is 867 in this district which are rendering valuable services to the masses for imparting primary education. So far Primary education is concerned the district administrator i.e. District Education Officer (Primary) directly supervised

by the Director of Public Instructions (Primary) Punjab, Chandigarh, is the overall incharge of Primary Education.

CHAPTER, III

UPPER PRIMARY EDUCATION

There are 109 middle schools, 223 secondary schools with upper primary sections & 24 senior Secondary schools with secondary and upper primary sections. It means 356 sections are serving the i upper primary stage in this district.

Out of the total habitations of 657, the children of 72 habitations have to walk upto 1 kilometre, 132 habitations have to walk upto 2 kilometres, 99 habitations have to walk upto 4 kilometre and 22 habitations have to walk more than 5 kilometre for receiving the upper primary stage education.

849 teachers are engaged to perform their duties to impart education to the children upto the upper Primary stage. Out of these 524 are male teachers while 325 are female teachers.

Schools imparting education to the upper primary education are attached with secondary/Senior Secondary under the complex scheme to enable these schools with the facilities of seeking guidance from the secondary and senior secondary schools to which these are attached.
