## INTRODUCTION

The educational facilities in Panjab during the post-Independence era took a long stride at all stages of education, both in rural as well as urban areas. At the earlier stages of education this was necessitated for the fulfilment of the Directive Principles of the Constitution to provide free and compulsory education to all children up to the age of 14. In view of the public demand at other stages, the expansion was done. As a result, a large number of institutions were opened and existing ones upgraded. Where old traditions and conventions prevented girls from attending co-educational institutions separate institutions for girls were opened.

Earlier four surveys were got done at National Level was detailed below:-

The reference date for the present survey i.e. the fifth All India Educational Survey was decided to be September 30, 1986. It had the following main objectives:-

- i) To assess the present position of educational facilities at various school stages, in respect of coverage of school going population, the distance to be covered by a child to reach the school, enrolment in general and of scheduled caste and scheduled tribes children and girls in particular.

ii) To assess the availability of physical facilities like school buildings, playgrounds, drinking water within the school, furniture, medical check up, other equipment, incentive schemes and the number of beneficiaries.

iii) To assess the position of inputs like blackboard and chalk, library, laboratory, book banks, etc.

iv) To know about the academic and professional qualifications of working teachers with special reference to teaching of science and mathematics and to determine attrition rates in the teaching profession.

v) To prepare block maps, showing habitations, existing educational facilities, and proposed provision of facilities in a planned manner over a period of time.

## CHAPTER I

### (Educational facilities )

1.1. a) The State of Punjab has 12 districts which are divided into 113 Development Blocks in the Rural area. The Urban area is not included in the development Block. The State is having 12294 inhabited villages and 413 uninhabited villages, whereas in all there are 13492 habitations in the State.

The estimated population of these villages is 137,35,536 out of which 27 % are Scheduled Castes.

b) There are 113 towns (Urban area) with an estimated Population of 5238676 out of which 18% are scheduled castes. The estimated Population of Urban slum areas is 119310.

1.2 i) 11637 habitations of the State have Primary School/ Section in the habitation whereas 1513 habitations have Primary education facility within 1 Km. Thus 99.6% of the total Population has got Primary Education facility within the habitation or 1 Km. Only 0.4% of the total population has to go to a distance of more than 1 Km for Primary Education in Rural Area, which is quite a negligible percentage.

1.3. i) There are 45 habitations having more than 300 Population and have no Primary school in the habitation nor within 1 Km. The percentage of unserved habitations with a population of 300 & above comes to 0.33 according to the norms fixed at National Level.

ii) 2986 habitations of the state have upper Primary facility in them whereas 8922 habitations have got this facility within 3 Kms. Thus 92.5% of the population of the State has got

Upper Primary facility in the habitation or within 3 Kms, distance. The National norms fixed is 3 Km. for Upper Primary. Only 75% population of the State is not within the approach of 3 Kms. for upper Primary. Upgradation is being done in a phased manner to cover more population within an approach of 3 Km.

ii) Out of total habitations of 13492 only 775 habitations having a population of 500 & more have no facility for upper Primary in the habitation or within 3 Kms. (i.e. the National Norm). Thus the percentage of unserved habitations comes to 5.74 for which upgradation of Primary Schools is proposed at State Level.

iii) 1772 habitations have got secondary facilities in them thereby serving 32.7% of the population within the habitations. Under the norms fixed by the Central Govt. at National Level 93.9% of the total population is being given the facility of secondary Education within a distance of 8 Kms. Only 1.1% of the population is not being given the facility of secondary education at a distance of more than 8 Kms. The State Govt. is trying to keep the National Norms within it's meagre finances in a phased programme.

## CHAPTER-II

2.1 i) There are 98 independent Pre-Primary Schools in the State whereas there are 445 Pre-Primary Stages attached to other schools. Thus the total number of Pre-Primary stages in the state becomes 543 out of which 298 are located in Rural Areas. The percentage of Urban Pre-Primary stages is 45.12

ii) There are 2087 Balwadi/Anganwadi schools out of which 94.78% are located in Rural Areas.

2.2 Out of 12838 Primary Schools in the State 11799 are Rural. The percentage of Rural Primary Schools is 91.91 most of the Primary Schools are co-educational the percentage goes to 97.34. In all there are 176 Girls Primary Schools in Rural & Urban both. The percentage of girls Primary Schools in the State is 0.01 which is quite negligible. Most of the Primary Schools are co-educational.

2.3 a) There are 1445 Upper Primary (Middle )Schools out of which 90.52% are Rural. 3.94 % Upper Primary Schools are Girls. 0.52% Boys and in all 95.43% upper Primary Schools are co-educational. Most of the Middle Schools are co-educational.

b) Out of 2247 High Schools 77.08% are co-educational, 9.30% are Boys and 13.62 % purely girls. 78.82% schools are located in Rural Areas.

c) There are 283 Hr.Sec. Schools in the State out of which 21.55% are purely girls schools 33.57% Boys and the remaining 44.88% co-educational 32.51% of the Hr.Sec. Schools are located in Rural Area and 67.49% in Urban Areas.

### CHAPTER III

3.1 a) The total enrolment in Primary classes (I-V) is 1907993 out of which 45.58% are girls. The rural enrolment of Primary classes is 81.4%. In rural areas the percentage of girls in Primary classes is 45.12 whereas in Urban areas it is 47.56.

b) The total enrolment in Upper Primary classes (VI-VIII) is 727747 out of which 41.86% are girls. The rural enrolment of Upper Primary is 509632 which is 70.03% of the total Upper Primary enrolment. In rural area 65.91% are girls and in Urban area the percentage of girls comes to 46.83

c) The total enrolment in Secondary classes (IX-XII) is 343099 out of which 40.62% are girls. The rural enrolment in secondary classes is 59.33% whereas in Urban areas the rural percentage of girls in secondary classes comes to 45.15.

3.2 a) The stage wise percentage of scheduled caste students in the state is given below:

Primary Deptt. (Classes I-V) = 32.44

Upper Primary Deptt. (Classes VI-VIII) = 22.83

Secondary Deptt. (Classes IX-XII) = 1.25

b) There is no scheduled Tribe in the State.

c) i) Gross enrolment Ratio of Primary Department is 94.71 and in Rural Areas it becomes 103.44.

ii) Similarly gross enrolment Ratio of Upper Primary Department is 59.94 and in Rural Areas it becomes 56.97.

iii) Age-specific ratio for 6-11 & 11-14 years is 94.71 and 59.94, respectively.

d) Percentage of girls amongst scheduled caste students in Primary stage is 43.9, in Middle stage it is 29.5 and in secondary stage it comes to 29%.

CHAPTER IV

4.1 a) In all, there are 103035 teachers in the State out of which 47.77% are female teachers. School-wise number of teachers and percentage of the female teachers is shown below:-

b) The average number of teachers in Primary Schools is 3.70 per school, but there are 174 Primary Schools having no teacher and 1464 schools are single teacher schools.

c)i)The percentage of female teachers at Primary stage is 55.12 whereas the percentage of trained teachers in this stage comes to 93.81. Pupil Teacher Ratio at this stage is 37.63

ii) The percentage of female teachers at Upper Primary stage is 41.77 whereas the percentage of trained teachers in this stage comes to 93.03. Pupil Teacher Ratio at this stage is 31.92.

iii)The percentage of female teachers at secondary stage is 38.44 whereas the percentage of trained teachers in this stage comes to 99.70. Pupil teacher ratio at this stage is 14.06.

iv) The percentage of female teachers at Hr.Sec. stage is 46.37 whereas the percentage of trained teachers in this stage comes to 99.24. Pupil teacher ratio at this stage is 39.82.

d) There are 1464 single Teacher Primary Schools and 174 Primary Schools have got no teacher while the functioning of the school is done by deputing teacher from other school. The Percentage of single teacher schools is 11.40 while the percentage of zero teacher schools is 1.36.

CHAPTER V

---

5.1 Out of 11799 Primary schools in the Rural Areas 92.70% schools have got buildings while 7.30% Primary Schools in Rural Areas have no building and are using open space or thatched huts. In urban areas 94.51% Primary schools have building and the remaining 5.49% Primary Schools have no building.

In all over the state 92.85 % Primary schools have got Buildings and 7.15 % are without building.

5.2 85.24% Primary Schools have Pucca Buildings while 6.56% have got partly Pucca buildings and in Rural Areas 84.91 are Pucca and 6.68 Partly Pucca % .

5.3. 259 Primary schools have no room i.e. 2.02% Primary schools have got no room and in Rural areas the percentage of no room schools comes to 1.91.

5.4 1371 Primary Schools have got 1 Room each as such the percentage of one room schools becomes 14.57 in the state and in Rural areas the percentage of single room schools is 14.87.

5.5 4456 Primary schools have got 2 rooms each, as such the percentage of 2 room schools comes to 34.71 and, in Rural area the percentage of 2 room Primary schools is 36.40.

## CHAPTER VI

6.1 (i) There are 529 Non Formal Education Centres of Primary level functioning in the State out of which 50 Centres are in Urban area. 90.55% are located in Rural Areas.

ii) The enrolment of Non Formal Education at Primary stage is 14495 out of which 47.45% are Boys. The enrolment in Rural Areas is 13418 which becomes 92.57% of the total enrolment. 47.33% enrolment of rural areas is of males.

6.2 i) There are 97 Non Formal Education Centres of Upper Primary level out of which 21 are urban and the remaining 78.35% located in Rural areas.

ii) The enrolment of Non Formal Education at Upper Primary stage is 2042 out of which 43.83% are boys and the remaining 56.17% are girls. The enrolment in Rural Areas is 1407 at Upper Primary stage of Non Formal Education out of which the percentage of males comes to 44.92 and the remaining 775 are girls.
