This volume on District-wise Educational Statistics for the state of Punjab is the sixth in the series of such volumes which will be brought out for all the States and Union Territories for the quinquennial year 1981-82. The main aim is to highlight the Inter-district variations in a State by giving educational data at district level with the help of some important indices, such as enrolment ratio, percentage of trained teachers, pupil-teacher ratio etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances increase or narrow down with time, the data for the year 1981-82 has been compared with that for the year 1976-77.

I take this opportunity to express my appreciation of the cooperation received from the Director of Public Instruction (Schools), Punjab and the Project Staff of the Planning, Monitoring and Statistics Division who have prepared this report.

INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances in the field of educational development exist in different parts of our Country due to social, environment and other factors. With a view to highlight these imbalances in the educational sector, Ministry of Human Resource Development brings out the Publication "Educational Statistics : District-Wise" quinquennially separately for States and Union territories.

2. A volume of this nature was brought out for the last quinquennial year of 1976-77 in respect of each State/UT by this Ministry.

3. In order to make inter-district comparison possible, some important indices like enrolment ratios, percentage of trained teachers, area served by a primary or middle school etc have been worked out for the years 1976-77 and 1981-82. These indices show wide range of variation among different districts which help in formulation of educational plans at district level.

II AREA AND POPULATION

4. Total area of the State as per 1981 census was 50,362 Sq. Kms. Among the 12 districts Perozapur has the biggest having area of 5874 Sq. Kms. At the same time the smallest district is Kapurthala having an area of 1633 Sq. Kms.

5. Estimated population of the state was 150.06 lakhs comprising of 79.93 lakhs males and 70.13 lakhs females in 1976-77. However as per 1981 Census, the total population has been reported as 167.39 lakhs forming 89.37 lakhs males and 78.02 lakhs females. Females formed 46.7% of the total population. Among the districts the highest population is reported for the Amritsar district (21.89 lakhs) and the lowest for Kapurthala (5.45 lakhs) in 1981-82

6. Density of Population was the highest in Jullundur (510 Per Sqr. Km.) and the lowest in Ferozpur (223 Per Sqr. Km.). For the state as a whole the density of population was 333 per Sqr. Km. 7 districts reported density of population to be higher than the state average. District-wise position of area, population and density of population is given in Statement No. 2.

7. Population of the whole State in 167.89 lakhs (89.37 lakhs males and 78.52 lakhs females) as per census in 1981-82. Thus female population worked out 46.7%. Among 12 districts maximum population was in Amritsar (21.89 lakhs) followed by Ludhiana (18.19 lakhs) and the smallest population was in Rojar (7.12 lakhs) in 1981-82. Density of population also increased from 298 per Sqr. Km. in 1977 to 333 per Sqr. Km. in 1981. District wise position is given in statement 2.

8. The population of different age groups for the State as a whole and different districts for the year 1976-77 and 1981-82 estimate on the basis of census figures for the years 1971 and 1981 respectively available from the office of the Registrar General of India. District-wise estimates of population in the age groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 have been based on the following formula :-

We assume that,

9. By using above formula total Population and girls Population has been estimated for each district and respective figures have been worked out for boys by simple subtraction method.

10. Similar formulae are used for estimating Population of the districts for age groups 11-14 and 14-17.

11. Of the total Population of 20.57 lakhs estimated for the age group 6-11 boys and girls formed 53.0% and 47.0% respectively for the year 1981-82. Similarly estimated Population of 11-14 age group is 11.85 lakhs forming 6.25 lakhs boys and 5.60 lakhs girls. For age group 14-17 the estimates are worked out 11.21 lakhs forming 5.92 lakh boys and 5.29 lakhs girls in 1981-82.

12. Thus of the total population of 167.89 lakhs , the school going population of 6-17 age is approximately 43.63 lakhs (23.07 lakhs boys and 20.56 lakhs girls) which formed 26.0% of the total population. District-wise details of population in the age group 6-11, 11-14 & 14-17 are given in Statement No. 3.

III- LITERACY

13. According to 1981 census the literacy rate for the State as a whole was 40.9%. For males it was reported as 47.2% and for females 33.9%. The literacy for S .C. Community was reported 23.9%. There is no Scheduled tribe population in the state. District-wise details can be seen from Statement No. 6.

(a) INSTITUTIONS

14. Number of institutions at school level increased from 14,432 in 1976-77 to 18734 in 1981-82 giving an increase of 29.8% during the period. Among 12 districts, Amritsar reported the highest number of all types of schools being 2217 and the lowest number (642) in Kapurthala. Five districts reported percentage share of more than 10 of the total number. District-wise details are given in Statement No. I.

15. The total enrolment in all types of recognized institutions of school level increased from 29.43 lakhs in 1976-77 to 30.87 lakhs or 4.9% during the period under review. Percentage share of enrolment in all schools was the highest in Amritsar (13.1%) followed by Jullundur (11.2%) and the lowest in Kapurthala (3.4%). In 1976-77 the girls were 42.1% whereas in 1981-82 it increased to 43.3% in all schools in the state. District-wise particulars are given in Statement No. 1 and 4.

(c) Extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes

Extent of coverage is defined as:

Percentage of enrolment of S.C./S.T. to total enrolment

16. Of the total enrolment 30,86,676 comprising 17,49,187 boys and 13,37,489 girls 816,763 belonged to Scheduled Castes, Percentage enrolment worked out to 26.5 (28.0% for boys and 24.5% for girls) for scheduled Castes Estimated extent of coverage for S.C. community comes to 98.5 for the state. It was the highest for the Hoshiarpur 108.4 followed by Ludhiana (108.3) and the lowest in Faridkot (80.8%). District-wise details are given in Statement No. 7.

(d) TEACHERS

17. There were 88,633 teachers in 1976-77 in all types of schools in the State which increased to 101,741 in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase of 14.8%. Among the districts Amritsar has the highest share of 12.8% followed by 11.1% in Jullundar and the lowest of 3.7% in Kapurthala during 1981-82. Women teachers formed 47.2%. It is very interesting to observe that Punjab had 96.7% trained teachers in all types of Schools during 1981-82. Percentage of trained teachers varied from 93.5% in Ferozepur to 99.8% in Bhatinda 1981-82. District-wise details can be seen from Statement No. 5.

V. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

Punjab

18. There are only two pre-primary schools in/ having one each in Faridkot and Sangrur. Enrolment in these Primary Schools was 222 In 1981-82. At the same time the enrolment in pre-primary classes was 7,430. Details for this sector of education are given in Statement No. 8 and 9.

VI. PRIMARY EDUCATION

- 6 -

(a) Institutions and Teachers

19. The number of primary schools increased from 9763 in 1976-77 to 12382 in 1981-82 in Punjab at an average annual growth rate of 9.2 %. Maximum number of 1488 primary Schools existed in Amritsar followed by 1436 in Hoshiarpur and the minimum number of such schools was 624 in Bhatinda in 1981-82. In 1976-77 a primary school served average area of 5.2 Sq. Km. the position has improved during the 5 Years review period and for every area of 4.1 Sq. Km. primary school was made available in 1981-82. At the same time a primary school was serving average 1536 habitants in 1976-77. Whereas in 1981-82 Position Improved and a primary school available for the population of 1356 persons. District-wise position can be seen from Statement No. 10.

20. Total number of teachers in primary schools in 1981-82 was 47,826 out of which there were 53.1% female teachers. Also of the 12 districts, 8 districts reported female teachers more than 50%. Teacher pupil ratio in the state was 1.39 which was the highest viz 1:50 in Bhatinda. Also of the total teachers of such schools in the state 99.5% were trained. Among 99.9% were trained and among women 99.1%. District-wise details are given in Statement No. 12

(b) ENROLMENT :

21. The enrolment in primary schools in Punjab was 18,70,860 in 1981-82 At the same time the enrolment in primary classes declined from 20,59,161 (11,49,679 Boys and 909,482 girls) in 1976-77 to 20,08,414 (11,04,826 boys and 9,03,588 girls) in 1981-82. The percentage of girls in primary stage of education was 44.2 in 1976-77 and 45.0 in 1981-82 respectively

22. The percentage of enrolment in primary classes to the total population of the 6-11 group viz., the enrolment ratio is the index of facilities created at the primary stage. In Punjab this percentage was worked out to be 97.6% during 1981-82. The corresponding enrolment percentage for boys & girls were 101.4% and 93.4% respectively. District-wise details can be seen from Statement 11.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES:

23. In 1976-77 in primary classes 27.3% were scheduled castes. S.C. Boys were 28.7% and S.C. girls 25.6. In 1981-82 of the total enrolment 594,962 belonged to S.C. Communities forming 29.6% (31.1% boys and 27.9% girls). Extent of Coverage of S.C. students at the primary stage of education in Punjab is worked out to be 110.0% in 1981-82. The corresponding coverage separately for boys and girls in primary classes of the State are worked out as 110.9% and 102.1% respectively during 1981-82. District-wise position can be seen from Statement No. 13

(d) PRIMARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS :

24. Out of 12,382 primary schools in the state 11,395 forming 92% were located in rural areas. Among rural areas of different districts 1488 were the highest in Amritsar and the lowest number was 486 in Kapurthala in 1981-82. The enrolment of children in these schools was 65,936. At the same time enrolment in classes I-V was 16,27,889 (904,140 boys and 7,23,749 girls) which formed 81% of total enrolment in these classes. Statement 14 gives district-wise details.

(e) HABITATIONS WITH OR WITHOUT PRIMARY SCHOOLS.

25. 12296 habitations have been reported in Punjab in 1981-82. As per Information received from the state Government all the villages possess educational facilities for primary Schools. District-wise position of habitations is given in Statement No. 15.

VII. MIDDLE SCHOOL EDUCATION.

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS.

26. Total number of middle schools in the Union territory declined from 1616 in 1976-77 to 1419 in 1981-82. The decrease in these Schools appears due to up gradation of middle schools in to secondary schools. Among the districts the highest number viz. 161 existed in Amritsar and Jullundur and the lowest in kapurthala (63). In 1976-77 average area served by a middle school was 31.2 km. the position deteriorated in 1981-82 for middle education sector due to up gradation in to secondary level.

27. In 1976-77 an average Population of 9286 persons was served by a middle school in the state but the facilities of availability of middle schools deteriorated as on an average a school was available for population of 11907 persons. However such position has happened due to up gradation of middle schools into high/higher secondary during the period under review. Statement 16 depicts district-wise position of middle schools and facilities.

28. In 1981-82 there were 9662 teachers comprising 5602 male teachers and 4060 female teachers in middle schools of the state. Among the districts the position of teachers employed in middle schools, varied from 1309 in Amritsar to 387 in Kapurthala. of these as many as 99.2% were trained in the state. 99.6 were trained male teachers and 98.5 female trained teachers. Details can be seen from statement 18.

(b) ENROLMENT :

29. Total enrolment in middle stage in the state was 562169 (352093 boys and 210076 girls) in 1976-77 which increased to 694149 (420114 boys and 274035 girls) in 1981-82. The annual growth rate is worked out at 8.6% during the period. Among the districts the enrolment varies from 88,719 in Jullundar followed by 84397 in Amritsar to 26766 in Kapurthala in 1981-82.

30. The percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the population of the age group 11-14 viz. enrolment ratio is the index of facilities available at the middle stage of education. In the Union territory this percentage is worked out to be 58.6 during 1981-82. For boys the enrolment percentage was 67.2 and for girls 49.0. The girls enrolment was the highest in Hoshiarpur (71.5%) and the lowest in Ferozepur (31.3%) District-wise details can be seen from statement 17.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTE

31. Out of total enrolment of 694149 in middle classes 141389 viz. 20.4% belonged to Scheduled Castes communities. Percentage enrolment for boys works out to 22.9% for girls 16.5% Extent of coverage for S.C. students works out to 75.7% in classes VI-VIII in 1981-82. District-wise details can be seen in Statement 19.

(d) MIDDLE EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

32. On comparing it has been seen that out of total number of 1410 middle schools in the state 1286 were located in rural areas only, The largest number 150 of middle schools are located in Jullundar followed by 131 in Amritsar and the lowest number viz 62 in Kapurthala in 1981-82. In middle classes in rural areas the total enrolment was 471433 which comprised 299593 boys and 171840. Information pertaining percentage of pucca schools and habitations have middle schools in rural areas could not be made available. Details can be seen from Statement 20.

ENROLMENT BY STANDARD IN CLASSES (I-VIII)

33. Statement 21 depicts class-wise enrolment in Classes I to VIII for each district separately. It has been observed that total enrolment for whole the state was 600681 in class I in 1981-82 but in the same year, enrolment in class VIII was 205525 being 34.1% of that in class I. Decreasing trend of enrolment has been observed in all the higher grades districts. This shows the prevalence of low retention rates or high drop out rate at the elementary stage. Percentage retention rates in different classes have been given for both sexes separately in the statement 21.

VIII. HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

34. Number of high/higher secondary schools in the union territory increased from 1664 in 1976-77 to 2419 in 1981-82. In 1981-82 these schools varied from 291 in Jullundar followed by 277 in Amritsar to 89 in Kapurthala.

35. On an average a secondary school was available for every 30.3 Sq. Kms. in 1976-77. But situation improved during the 5 years period and for every 20.8 Sq. Kms a school could be made available in 1981-82.

36. The average population served by a such school was 9018 in 1976-77 whereas in 1981-82 the same was available for average population of 6940 persons during 1981-82 showing improvement during the period. District-wise details can be seen in Statement 20.

37. In 1981-82 there were 41569 teachers comprising 24513/male teachers and 17056 female teachers, employed in high/higher secondary schools. It is interesting to note that in high/higher secondary schools of the state 99.1% teachers are trained. Among these male teachers are 99.4% trained and female teachers 98.5% trained. District-wise details can be seen Statement 24.

(b) ENROLMENT

38. In 1976-77 the enrolment in high/higher secondary classes was 270367 which increased to 341861 in 1981-82 at the average annual growth of 6.0% during the period under review. In 1981-82, the percentage of girls enrolment was 34.6% at state level.

39. The enrolment ratio in high school classes improved from 25.7% in 1976-77 to 30.5 in 1981-82. The enrolment ratio for boys & girls worked out separately 36.1% and 24.2% respectively in 1981-82. District-wise details are given in statement 23.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTE STUDENTS

40. Out of the total enrolment in high/higher secondary stage scheduled Caste students formed 14.1% in 1981-82. Boys were 16.5% and girls 10.2%. Among the districts the enrolment ratio varied from 22.4% in Hoshiarpur to 7.10% in Ferozepur. In 1976-77 the percentage for scheduled Caste students to total enrolment was 13.6% but for scheduled caste boys and girls the percentage was 15.8% and 9.7% respectively. In 1976-77 enrolment ratio was 13.6% (for boys 15.8% and girls 9.7%). In 1981-82 percentage of S.C. population to total population was 20.9%. Thus the extent of coverage in 1981-82 is worked out to be 52.4%. District-wise details are given in Statement 25.

(d) HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION IN RURAL AREAS

41. In 1981-82, 1768 of the total number of 2419 higher secondary schools were located in rural areas. Number of such institutions varied from 197 in Ludhiana to 10 in Ropar rural areas. The total enrolment in these high/higher secondary schools was 698,7 forming 60.3%. Enrolment of higher secondary classes (IX-XI) in these schools was 214,558 (161184 boys and 53374 girls) in 1981-82. District-wise details are given in Statement 26.

IX. PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL AND OTHER EDUCATION

42. A wide spread development in the field of professional, Vocational, Special and other education has been observed as the number of such institutions increased from 1387 in 1976-77 to 2521 in 1981-82. In 6 districts the institutions increased substantially but in other 6 districts the number of institutions declined.

43. Enrolment in these institutions increased from 48781 to 80894 during the period. The increase in enrolment works out to at the average annual ratio of 15.2%. It is also interesting to note that of the total enrolment in professional, vocational and special education girls formed 54.4% in 1981-82.

44. There were 2678 teachers forming 1140 men and 1530 women teaching in these institutions of professional, vocational special and other education during 1981-82. The number of teachers employed in such institutions was 898 in 1976-77.

45. It has been observed that 22.3% enrolment in these Institutions belong to scheduled Caste communities in 1976-77. However in 1981-82 of the total enrolment in these types of Institutions 31,995 or 39.5% belonged to Scheduled Castes. Of the total enrolment 53.2% belonged to girls in these Institution in 1981-82. District-wise details are given in Statement 27.
