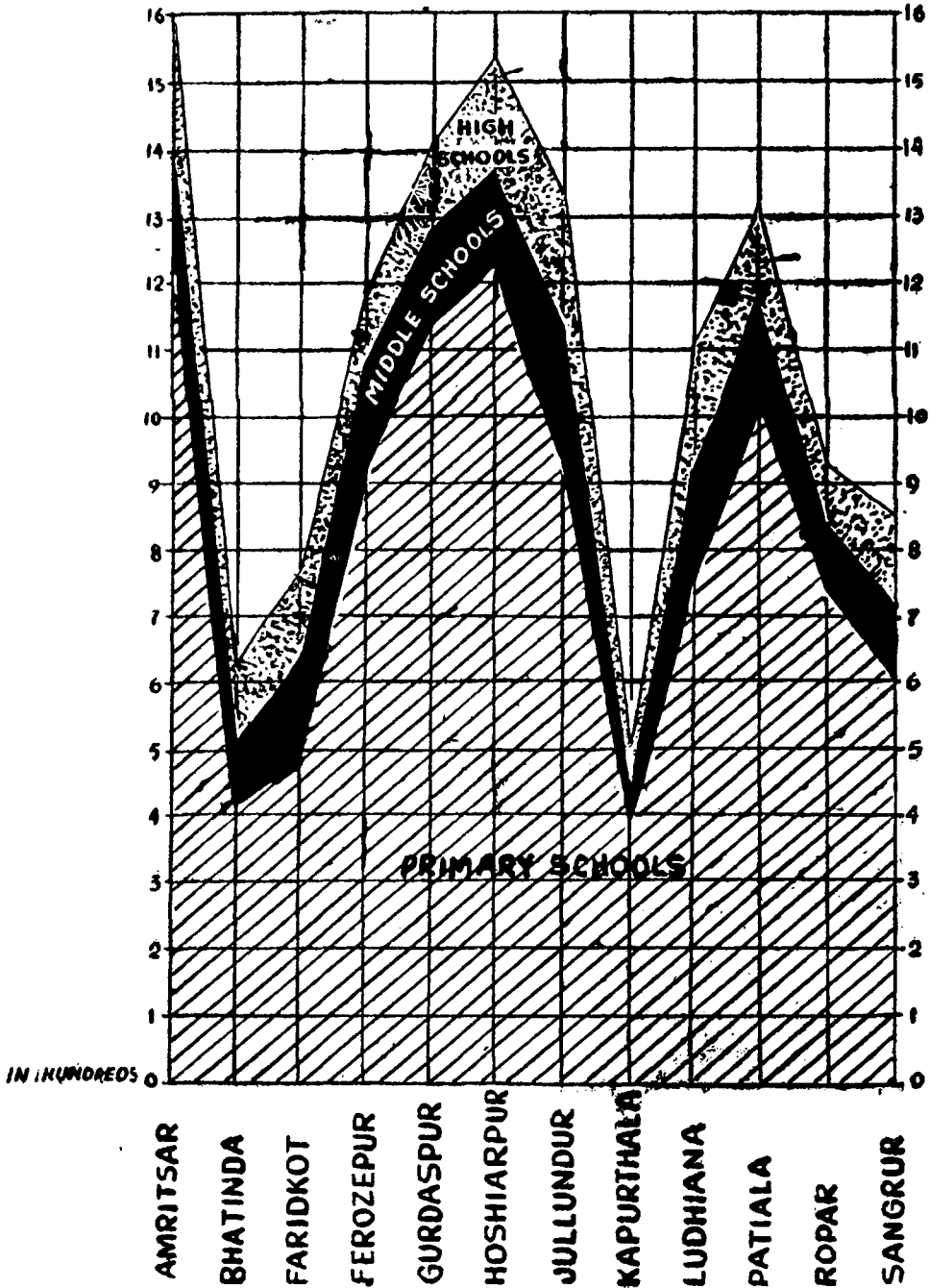

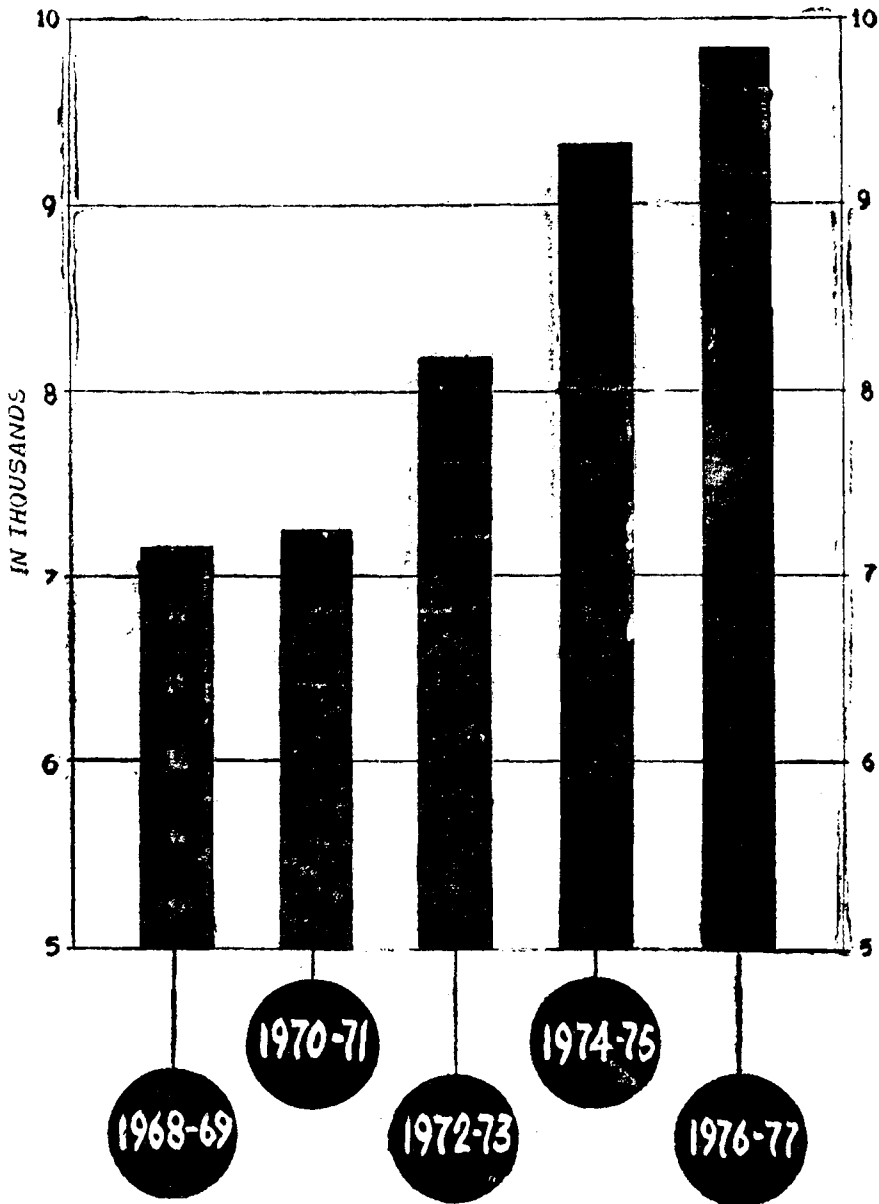

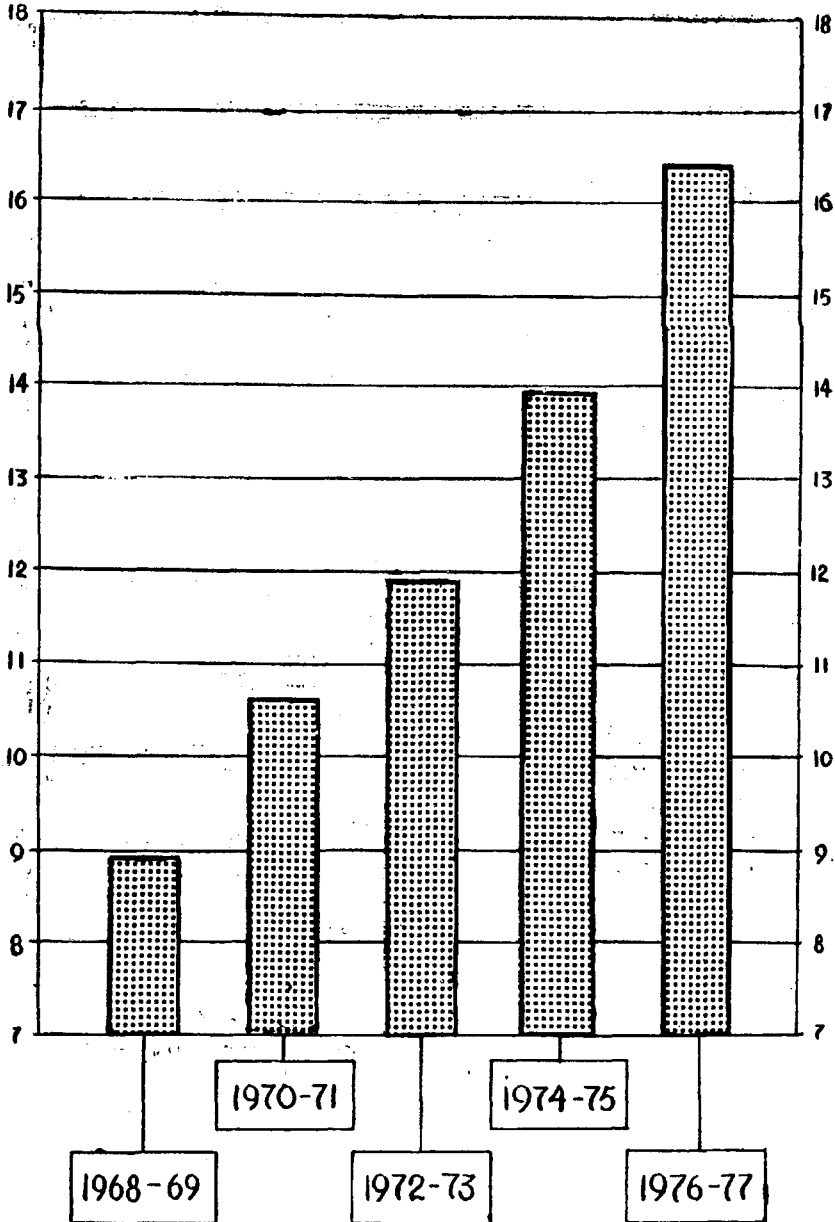

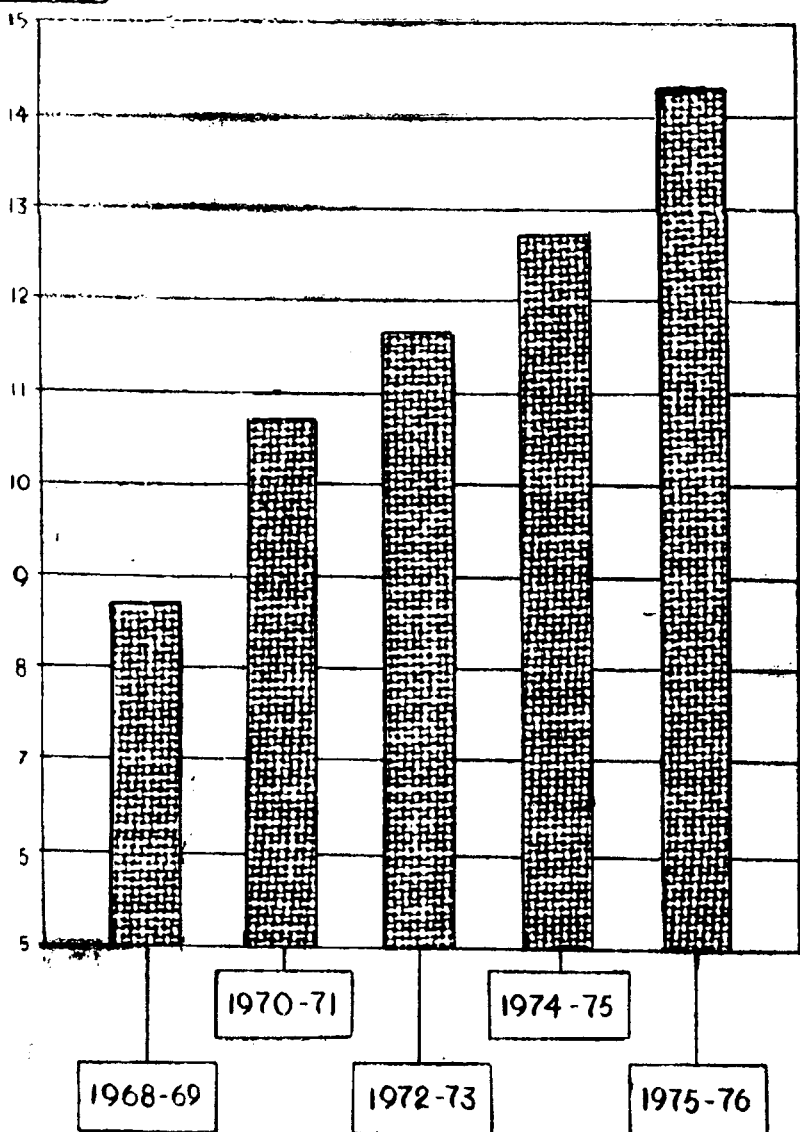

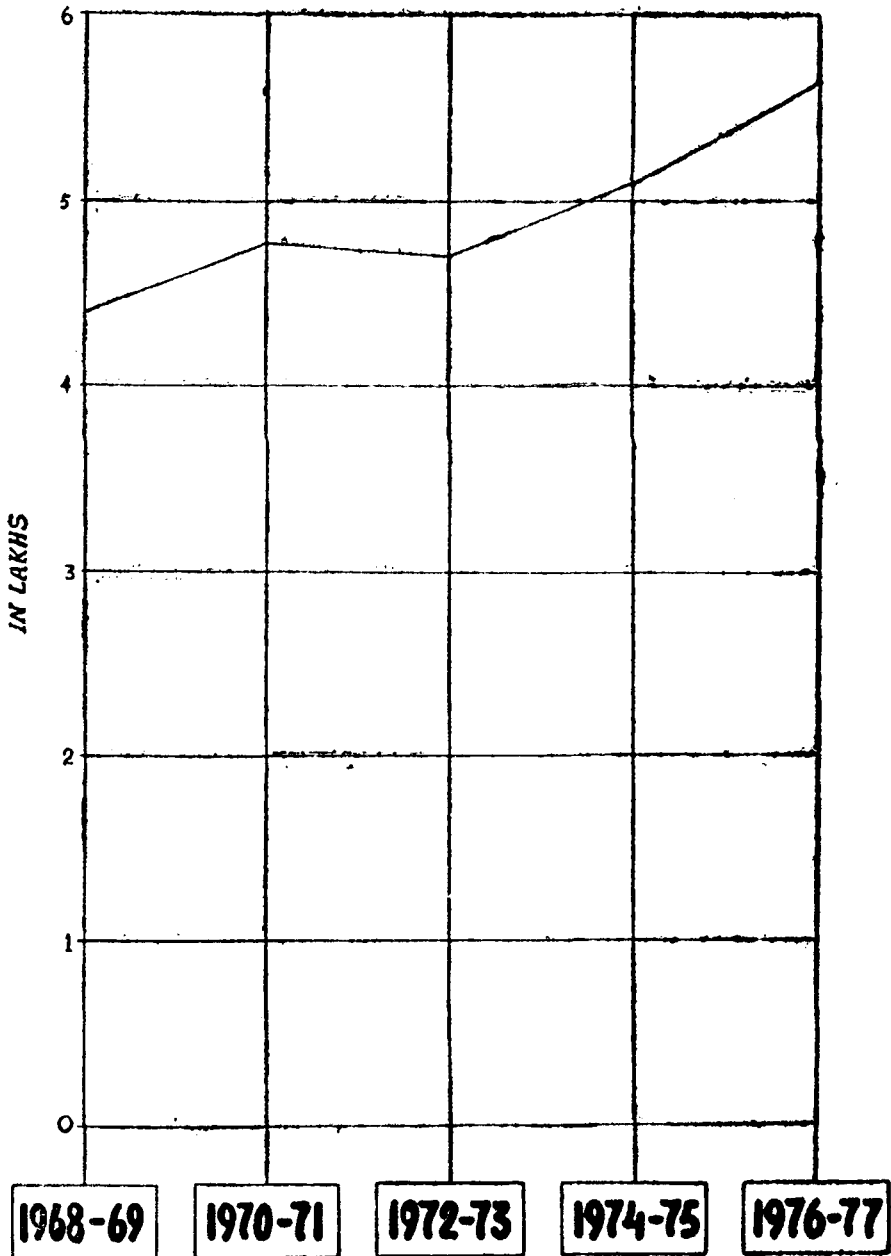

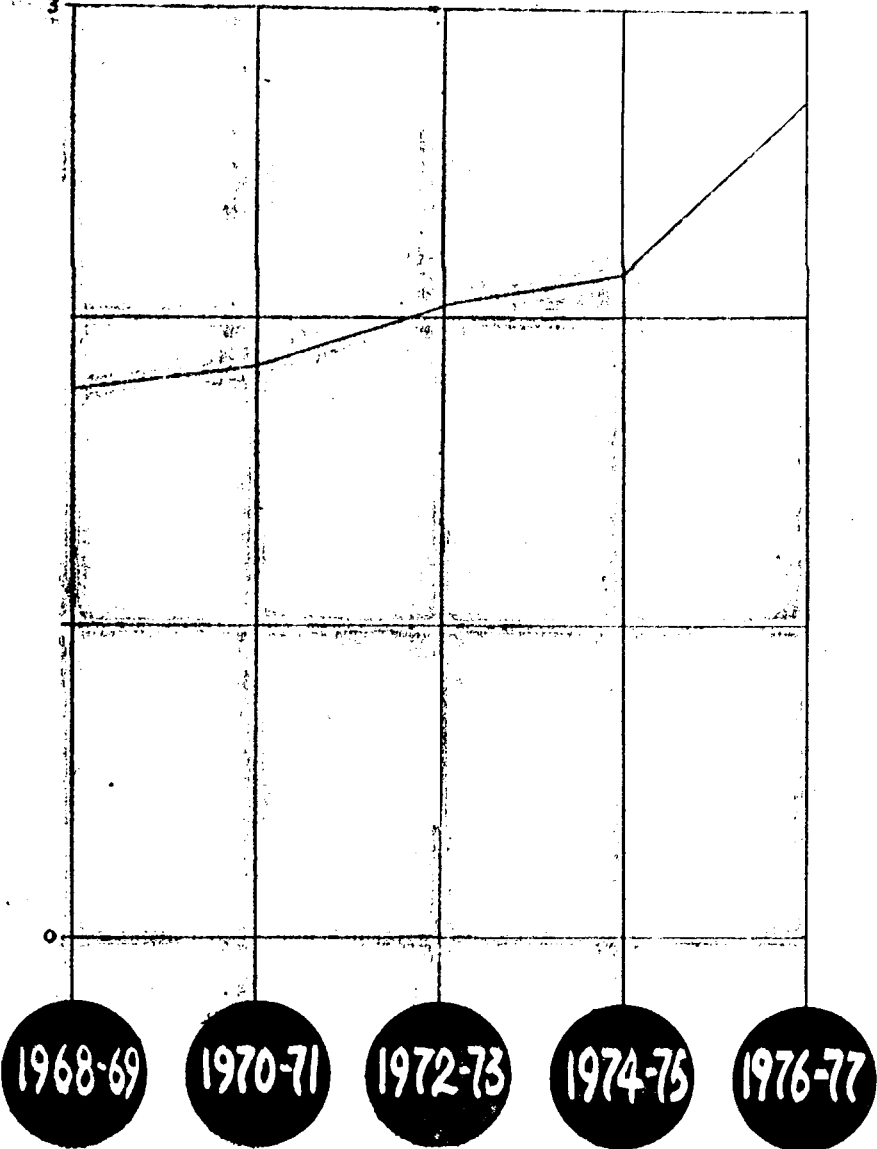
AGE GROUP 11-14

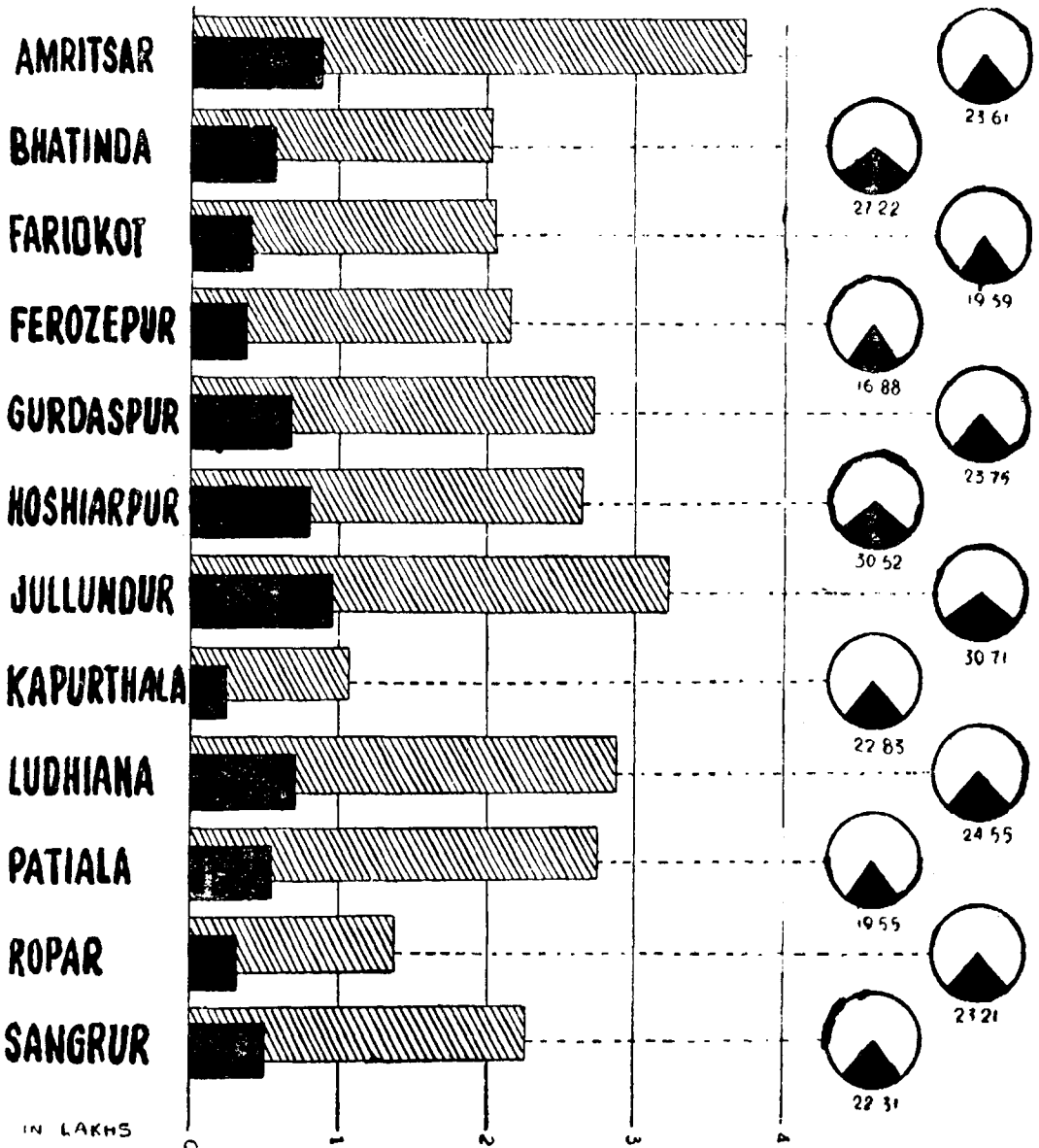

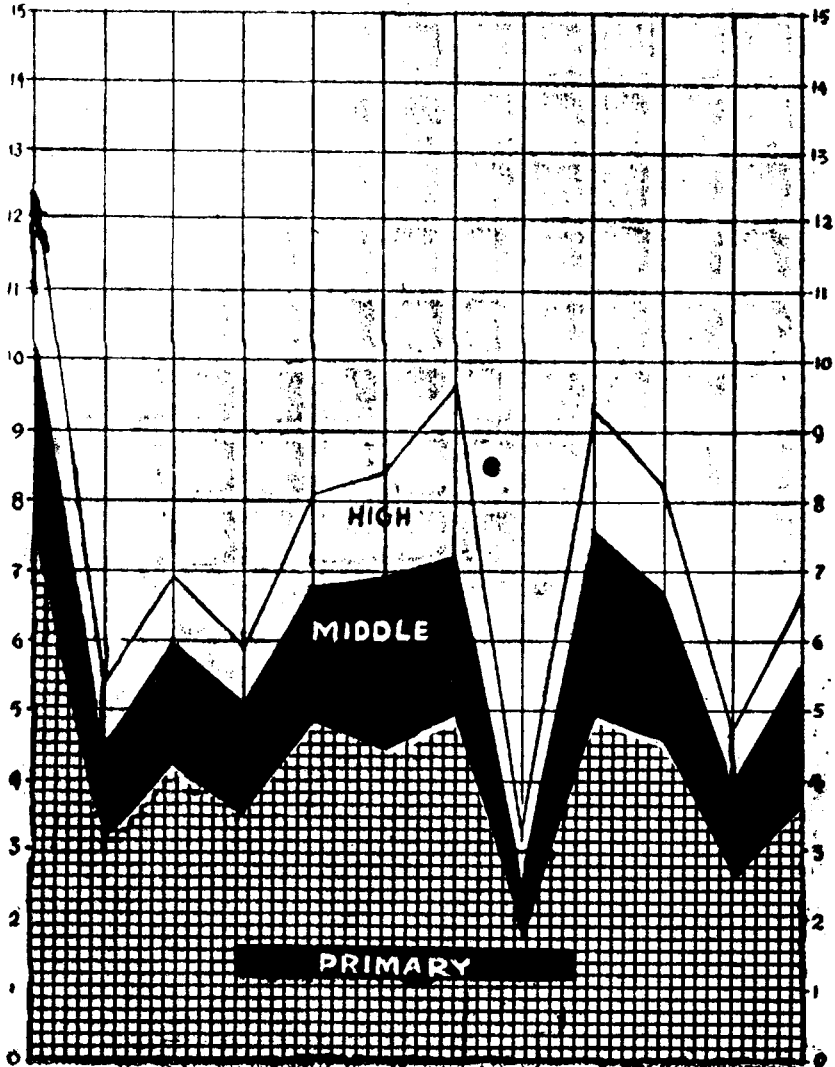

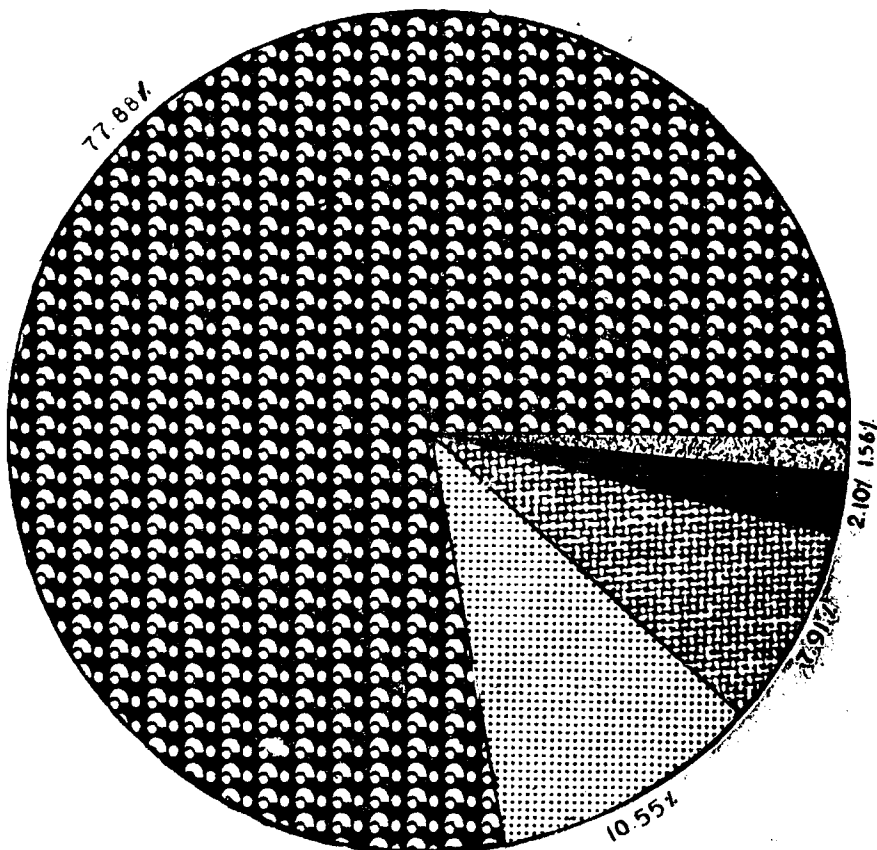
