REVISED VII FIVE YEAR PLAN 1985-90.

Sector : General Education.

Scheme No.1

1. Name of Scheme: Sports and Youth Welfare.
2. Objective of the VII Five Year Plan.

During the VII plan various schemes are proposed to expand sports activities in a big way. Details of programmes are explained below. The importance of participation in physical training and sports for good health, both physical and emotional, a high degree of physical fitness and emotional balance, increase in productivity both individual and national and also the social value of such participation as a beneficial avenue of release of surplus energies in a disciplined manner is universally accepted. Lakshadweep lags behind mainly because of its peculiar geographical position isolated from rest of India and acute shortage of surface communication and the socially and economic backwardness of the people and lack of enough infrastructure. During the VII Five Year Plan it is proposed to set sports councils, organise sports clubs, provide talent scholarships, set up coaching centres, give awards sportsman etc. Against the target of 76 posts in the original seventh plan, 9 posts have only been kept in the revised seventh plan. The building outlay in the original Seventh Plan was Rs. 131.14 lakhs. The requirement has been critically reviewed and the building outlay has been brought down to Rs. 23.50 lakhs, for completing the existing work.

1. Setting up of a sports council:-

There is no sports council in Lakshadweep. So far the Department of Education was looking after the affairs of sports in a very limited manner. Now activities have become many-fold, and many more are proposed to be implemented. Sufficient and timely attention is not possible in the absence of some agency exclusively for sports affairs. Besides, it is the policy of the Govt. of India, to set up sports council in all states and union territories where there are no sports council, at the earliest for the most effective sports council to promote sports and allied activities.

2. FORMATION OF SPORTS ASSOCIATIONS AND CLUBS.

Though a number of sports have become popular here during the last few years, so far no sports associations have



taken shape. As such there is no effective control, co-ordination and incentive/inspiration for the development of sports. Each sports must get due attention for its progress and to maintain the interest of the participants in that event. Due to lack of encouragement and support there are no sports clubs. It is therefore proposed to form various sports associations and to organise sports and arts, clubs and give them grant in aid and material assistance. Funds will be provided to meet the grant-in-aids in cash and kind for the functioning of the associations and clubs.

3. Organisation and association/clubs, sports & competitions.

Lakshadweep is a backward area having almost 100% scheduled tribe population. For the development of sports, efforts are required from the grass root level. Since the islands are 30 to 100 miles apart, each island has to be treated as the smallest unit and island level organisation is necessary for the formation of clubs, starting recreational activities, sports and competitions. For the organisation of clubs among the tribal population, conducting competitions etc. there must have somebody to organise. For this purpose it is proposed to provide one sports/in the department.

4. Setting up of Regional Coaching Centre and Sub Centres.

This scheme is to be implemented in collaboration with the NIS Patiala. For a long time NIS is persuing for the implementation. The NIS will provide the coaches for the Regional Coaching centre, but this U.I. has to meet the expenditure towards their travel expenses. Accommodation etc. provide the play ground and equipments, provide necessary ground personal etc. Besides, there must have at least 2 sub centres for coaching, and 3 coaches will have to be provided meeting the expenditure by this U.I. and all expenditure towards the running of these sub centres.

5. Awards for Special Distinction in sports.

This scheme envisages awards of cash/certificates or both as the case might be to the outstanding sportsmen/organiser, promoter of sports, for this funds will be provided.

6. Sports talent search scholarship.

This scheme is proposed to identify young promising sportsmen and nurture them by providing means for nutritious food for practice and development. There shall be 25 fresh



scholarship. The tenure of scholarship shall be for a maximum of 3 years. The scholarship will be made available in the form of cash at the rate of Rs. 100/- per month round the year. Funds will be provided for this scheme.

7. Sports and Cultural Festival.

For progress, competition is a must. To develop sports and arts, national integration and to keep up the national and local heritage, competitions of various levels and for various groups are proposed to be held separately for student and non-students. State level teams will also be selected and sponsored for participating in tournaments held at other parts of the country.

8. Celebration of the International Youth Year 1985

The Govt. of India have directed to celebrate the International Youth Year during 1985, spreading various developmental programmes for youth round the year 1985 and requested to make necessary infrastructure in advance during 1984 and make arrangements. A Committee has been constituted for drawing up programmes for this Union Territory under the guidelines issued by the Ministry. The details are not yet final. However a token provision of Rs. 5.20 lakhs is included for carrying out programmes.

9. Construction of Mini Stadiums.

There is no stadium in Lakshadweep. At least mini-stadiums are a must for the development of outdoor sports. During the Vith plan, the work of a mini stadium of Kavaratti was just started. It is to be completed.

10. Refresher training & seminar for physical education Personnel.

In order to keep the physical education personnel in touch with the modern trend and developments in the field of sports and physical education refresher courses will be arranged every year as far as possible.

11. Bharat Scouts and Guides.

At present there are only 10 boys scout units and 2 girls guides units. It is proposed to augment the scout and guide movement by adding 10 more scout units and 8 more girls guide units attached to schools. For training the personnel, supply of uniforms and training equipments, refreshments, washing allowance etc. and for holding camps, funds will be provided.



12. N.C.C. Units.

At present the total number of senior Division Naval NCC Unit is one and Junior Division NCC Naval Units 6. There are three more High Schools and one more college having no NCC Unit. During the VII the plan it is proposed to start one S.D.N.C.C. Naval Unit attached to the M.G. College, Andrott and 3 J.D. N. C.C. Units (Naval) attached to the High Schools Kadmat, Kilton and Chetlat. Besides, it is proposed to start 4 army wing NCC Units for girls attached to 4 High Schools funds will be provided for the salaries of 3 NCC Leaders, honorarium to 8 NCC Officers salary for 1 N.C.C. Clerk, training expenses for NCC Officers, maintenance of the units.

13. Establishing Sports Division Attached to High School.

The scheme of sports schools/sports division has been implemented in almost all states and U.T.s to impart sports training to the children of talents right from young days and make good sportsmen. So far Lakshadweep could not even start sports division to any of the schools. As such our talented young ones do not get the facilities to nurture their inborn talents. It is therefore proposed to start sports Division with residential facilities attached to one high school having coaching facilities and play grounds. One selected sportsmen will be provided hostel accommodation.

Hitherto the sports activities were looked after as a subject in the Directorate of Education. In order to have an efficient management of sports administration, Ministry of Human Resources have already created a post of Asst. Director of Sports and supporting staff.
