FOR E W O R D

The Third All-India Educational Survey was started at the begining of 1974 with specific objectives to provide data on school education; about availability of schooling facilities (particularly in the rural areas), enrolment, teachers, equipment, etc. The Second All-India Survey was conducted in 1965 but compared to that the scope ofthe present survey was larger in respect of items on which information was collected and the types and levels of education covered.

The survey has been conducted in collaboration with the Departments of Education in the States and the Union Territories. Because of the large scope and coverage of the present survey two different strategies were adopted for processing and tabulation of data. While for some data it was decided to have manual tabulation first at the block level and further at the district and state levels, for the other set of data it was found more convenient to go in for computer processing.

Some of the States have finalised the manually prepared state tables others are in the process of completing this work. The computerised tables are likely to take some more time. As there is demand from several quarters to provide data on selected important items as early as possible, it has been decided to compile and release some selected tables for each state separately out of the manually prepared tables received from different states.

Keeping in view this specific objective, the present set of "Selected Tables of Orissa" is being issued to provide minimum essential data for the benefit of educational planners, administrators and other interested

persons. The set includes ten tables, first three relating to schools by stage and type, four relating to availability of schooling facilities in rural areas and the remaining three relating to enrolment. The reference date for the data contained in these tables is December 31, 1973.

Compilation of these tables has been possible largely due to the co-operation of the Department of Education of Orissa. I express my gratitude to the Director of Education and the State Survey Officer who had the main responsibility for preparing the manual State tables and to Shri Satvir Singh, Lecturer who has prepared these tables out of the manual tables received from Orissa.

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I N T R O D U C T I O N

- 1.1 Orissa State is divided into 13 administrative districts having 51,639 villages with 314 blocks, and 81 urban areas. The total number of habitations identified are 64,194 with an estimated population of 21,4,31,395 on 31st December 1973, as against 20099220 during 1971 Census. As per 1971 Census, the total population of scheduled castes is 31,03,244 (15.44%) in rural areas and 2,07,610 (11.25%) in urban areas. The population of scheduled tribes in rural area is about 24.5 present, whereas in urban areas it is about 8 percent according to the 1971 census. In rural areas/habitations are identified as being inhabited predominantly by scheduled castes.
- 1.2 Pattern of Education
- The pattern of education being followed, at present, is primary classes I-V, Middle VI-VIII, Secondary IX-X and Higher Secondary IX-XI.
- 1.3 Number of Sections and Schools (Table 1, 2 and 3)
- 1.3.1 There are in all 32,410 primary sections out of which 1440 are located in Urban areas.
- 1.3.2 At the Middle stage there are 5,275 sections of which 477 are in urban areas.
- 1.3.3 Of the 1974 secondary sections 323 are in urban areas.
- 1.3.4 There are only 14 Higher secondary sections out of which 9 are located in urban areas.
- 1.3.5 In addition, there are 147 Teacher Training Schools, 50 located in rural areas and 97 located in urban areas. As far as other schools (Sanskrit, Arabic, Urdu and Craft) are concerned, they are in all 261 in this State.

- 1.4 Schooling facilities in rural areas (Table 4,5,6 & 7)
- 1.4.1 Of the 64,194 habitations, 29,714 (46.28%) have primary sections in them and another 18,545 (28.83%) habitations within a walking distance of 1 Km. Thus there are 48259 (75.16%) habitations having primary schooling facilities either within themselves or at a walking distance of 1 Km.
In terms of population, 90.5% of rural population has primary schooling facilities at a distance of 1 Km.
- 1.4.2. Middle sections are available in 4647 (7.24%) habitations and in another 29,886 (46.55%) habitations have this facility up to a distance of 3 Kms. Thus 34533 (53.79%) habitations are having this facility upto a distance of 3 Kms. This facility covers 68.02% of the rural population.
- 1.4.3 At the secondary stage, 1546 habitations have this facility in them and another 29,591 upto a distance of 5 Kms. The secondary education facility is thus available to 31,137 (48.5%) habitations upto a distance of 5 Kms. covering 61.19% of the rural population.
- 1.4.4 At the Hr. Secondary stage, 5 habitations have this facility in them and another 82 up to a distance of 5 Kms. These 5 Hr. Secondary schools exist in the State under a special scheme, that is why majority of the habitations are not served by them within a distance of 5 Kms.
- 1.5 Enrolment (Table 8,9 & 10)
- 1.5.1 There were 22,68,844 students as on 31st Dec. 1973 at the primary stage, of which 20,50,816 (90.39%) were studying in rural institutions. Girls with 833376 enrolment constitute 36.73% of the total enrolment. Enrolment in classes I-V in age group 6 + to 10 + is around 53.49% in that age group.

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- 1.5.2 At the middle stage, in a total of 359343 students, 276391 (76.95%) are studying in rural areas. Girls enrolment 98,051 contributes 27.25% to the total enrolment. The enrolment in the age group 11 to 14 is around 13.13% of the population in this age group.
- 1.5.3 At the Secondary stage 140378 were studying, of which 95417 (67.97%) were in rural institutions. Girls enrolment constitute 19% of the enrolment at this stage.
- 1.5.4 At the Higher Secondary stage, in a total of 53,623 students, 36,087 (93.27%) students are studying in rural areas. Girls enrolment 9390 contributes 18.44% to the total enrolment at this stage.
