P R E F A C E


The Directorate of College Education, Rajasthan, Jaipur has been publishing Educational Statistics on Higher Education in Rajasthan every year. The present volume depicting a brief review of the achievements of the Department in the year 1977-78 is the fourth in the series.

Attempts have been made to present the data relating to student enrolment in general and professional education, number of institutions, teachers, scholars, examination results, budget etc. The present volume has a distinctive feature, i.e., it contains final data for the year 1976-77 and also for 1977-78. This is quite purposeful; for, it makes the comparative study possible. Tables containing subjects taught in all institutions of higher learning, institution-wise enrolment, etc. have also been added.

No year in the history of higher education in Rajasthan has seen such a tremendous quantitative expansion of colleges and student enrolment as has been witnessed in the year under review, that is, in the session 1977-78. This became possible because admission rules were relaxed, new colleges were opened and over a dozen Degree Colleges were raised to Post-graduate status.

This volume has been compiled and processed by Shri M M Gupta, Statistical Assistant and Miss Rosy Saxena, Computer, in the Statistical Cell of the Directorate. Their services are praise-worthy.

HIGHER EDUCATION IN RAJASTHAN

Rajasthan as it exists to-day on the political map of India is the second largest State with a population of about 3 crores. It was formed by the integration of 22 erstwhile princely States.

The beginning of first Five Year Plan found the State badly wanting in proper facilities for higher education. Besides one university, in the year 1950-51, there were 27 colleges for general education and 6 Colleges for professional education. The number of students receiving higher education at that time was about 10,300 (8700 in general education and 1,300 in professional and special education).

During the last 28 years of planned development of the State remarkable progress has been made in the expansion of facilities for higher education both for general and professional education.

At present, there are 3 Universities, 1 Deemed to be a University at Pilani, 110 Colleges for general education, 5 Medical Colleges 2 Engineering Colleges, 4 Agricultural Colleges (including University managed Colleges), 1 College of Veterinary Science, 22 Teachers Training Colleges, 27 Sanskrit and 3 Ayurvedic Colleges, providing various courses in general and professional education in the state.

The first University in the State - The University of Rajasthan located at Jaipur was founded in 1946. It is a teaching cum affiliating University, whose jurisdiction extends to the whole of Rajasthan subject to the provisions of the Acts of the Universities of Jodhpur and Udaipur and Birla Institute of Technology and Science at Pilani. This University has, at present, 28 teaching departments, 4 constituent colleges and 136 affiliated colleges with a total enrolment of nearly one lakh thirty three thousand students.

The Universities of Jodhpur and Udaipur were established in 1962. The University of Jodhpur was established as a multi-faculty teaching cum affiliating university with 2 associated colleges whose jurisdiction extends to the municipal town while the University of Udaipur which was conceived initially as a purely Agricultural University was converted

into multi-faculty teaching cum affiliating University in 1964. It has seven affiliated colleges. Though the jurisdiction of the University of Udaipur extends to the municipal limits of the city of Udaipur, Agriculture College at Jobner and Veterinary College at Bikaner are also its constituent colleges. In 1976-77, agricultural research in the State was also transferred to this University. The total enrolment of Universities of Jodhpur and Udaipur was 9,572 and 8,801 respectively during 1976-77.

Birla Institute of Technology and Science, Pilani was registered in 1964 under the Societies Registration Act 1956. A notification issued by the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare, Government of India, in 1964 declared it as an institute for higher education and as "Deemed to be University". It has an enrolment of 2,221.

Progress:

Rajasthan has recorded a tremendous progress in the field of higher education. The following table will give an idea about the growth of higher education in the State during the last 28 years.

The above table shows that the State noticed a good take off in higher education during the first two Plans where-as the growth rate during sixties and early seventies was relatively low.

There has been a sharp expansion of higher education during the year 1977-78, i.e. in the first year of the new government. During that year (1977-78) there has been a record increase in the student enrolment (i.e. by 33 per cent), addition of 12 Degree Colleges and up-gradation of 15 colleges from Degree to Post-graduate standard. In addition to this, in the existing colleges about one hundred new sections were started during the year 1977-78.

The location of educational institutions has been planned in such a way that there is at least one Post-graduate College in every district except in the district of Jalore and Jaisalmer where student population at Under-graduate level is insufficient to afford a Post-graduate college.

At present, facilities exist for imparting education in almost all subjects in the faculties of Arts, Social Sciences, Commerce, Natural and Physical Sciences, Law, Medicine, Engineering, Agriculture, Education, Ayurved, etc. at Degree and Post-graduate levels in the State.

Enrolment:

The contribution of Government and non-Government Colleges in the field of higher learning has been substantial. Out of a total enrolment in higher educational institutions in Rajasthan, 45 per cent students are enrolled in Government Colleges, 27 per cent in non-Government Colleges and 28 per cent in the Universities and their constituent Colleges.

Out of the total student population of 1.25 lakhs, 1,07,506 were registered under general education which can further be sub-divided under two heads: (a) showing enrolled strength of under-graduates totalling 89,722 and constituting 83.5 per cent; and (b) that of Post-graduates numbering, 17,784 and making 16.5 per cent. Of this enrolment 83.5 per cent students at the under-graduate level and 40.5 per cent at the Post-graduate level are studying in the Colleges and the rest (i.e. 16.5 per cent and 59.5 per cent respectively) in the Universities.

On comparing the district-wise strength of students in higher education, it will be noted that Jaipur has the largest number of students (34,771) and Jaisalmer the lowest number of students (168).

The ratio of boys and girls in higher education is 82:18. Special efforts have been made to enrol as many Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students in higher education as possible. The total number of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students studying in these institutions is 9,192.

Percentage of enrolment of students in the faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce was 45.7, 17.5 and 36.3 respectively. It may be mentioned that there has been a decrease of one per cent enrolment in the faculty of Arts and increase of 1.3 in the faculty of Commerce over the last session. There is a marginal decrease of 0.3 per cent in the enrolment of students in the faculty of Science. This is in accordance with the All India trend noticed by the U.G.C.

The number of students seeking professional education has increased from 6,877 in the year 1976-77 to 7,451 in the year 1977-78, registering an increase of 7.7 per cent.

A strength of 622 students has been enrolled for the degree of Ph.D. of which 451 are boys and 171 are girls. The number of Scheduled Tribe Research scholars is only 3 while there is none from the Scheduled Caste.

Teachers:

During the year 1977-78, 6,469 teachers working in Colleges and Universities were imparting education. Out of the total faculty strength, 36.3 (2347) per cent was working in the Universities and their Constituent Colleges, 46.5 (3013) per cent in Government Colleges and 17.2 (1109) per cent in Non-Government Colleges.

The above data reveals that about 36.3 per cent teachers impart education to 28.5 per cent students in the Universities while 26.5 per cent of students are being taught by 17.2 per cent teachers in aided colleges. This shows the imbalance in distribution of teachers and students between various categories of institutions.

16.5 per cent or 1,063 teachers were engaged in imparting professional education.

The pupil teacher ratio has been 23:1 during the year 1977-78. Last year it was 20:1. Thus pressure of students has increased this year. It is the highest in Aided colleges 32:1 and the lowest in the Universities and constituent colleges (17:1),. This ratio is 24:1 for Government Colleges and 7:1 for Professional Colleges in Rajasthan.

Budget Provisions:

The total budget provision on education in the State was Rs.101.8 crores in the year 1977-78, out of which about 11.4 per cent was provided for higher education. In the year 1978-79, a provision of Rs.12.63 crores has been made for higher education, out of total education budget of Rs.106.22 crores. Out of a total budget of Rs.12.63 crores 47 per cent will be spent on Government colleges, 38 per cent on Universities for non-technical education, 12 per cent on assistance to non-government colleges and the rest on miscellaneous items such as payment of scholarships, youth activities and administration of higher education in the State. It may be interesting to note that 47 per cent of the total State expenditure on education caters to the needs of 45 per cent students studying in Government Colleges while about 38 per cent budget provision has been made for 28 per cent students enrolled in Universities.

Faculty Improvement Scheme:

For development of the faculty, the Government accepted the 'Faculty Improvement Schemes' initiated by the University Grants Commission last year and deputed on full pay 139 faculty members serving in colleges to undertake Ph.D or M.Phil courses.

To improve the academic competence of college teachers and to impart up-to-date knowledge of their discipline, 16 State and National subject conferences were held in Universities and in affiliated colleges. Special orientation lectures were almost organised on topics related to the Planning in Rajasthan and the Planning in India by the Directorate of College Education in a few selected colleges.

Other Improvement Schemes:

The State Government has strengthened the existing physical and financial facilities in all the universities and affiliated colleges with the assistance of the U.G.C. The L.G.C. has sanctioned projects costing Rs.1.42 crores for Government colleges in the last 2 years, out of which U.G.C. share will be to the tune of Rs.83.37 lakhs. The balance will be met by the Government from its own resources. These developmental projects relate to improvement of library and laboratory facilities, construction of class-rooms, library blocks, laboratories, Non-resident student centres, teachers residence, etc.

Other Activities:

To extend financial help to the needy, meritorious and deserving students, a total of 5,399 scholarships of various kinds (National Scholarship, National Loan Scholarship, Need-cum-Merit, Lower Income Group, etc.) were sanctioned during the year 1977-78. The total amount disbursed was over Rs.41 lacs. 8,615 students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Communities and studying in colleges and universities were sanctioned scholarships by Social Welfare Department. 528 students belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe studying outside Rajasthan were also sanctioned scholarships. This is in addition to 10 per cent free-ships and 10 per cent half free-ships awarded to the students.

Extra and co-curricular activities such as N.S.S., N.C.C., Rover Scouting, Planning Forums, etc. are also being organised by all the colleges and universities so that the students get ample opportunities for the diversified development of their personality. The Directorate of College Education provides finances for these activities except for NCC which is wholly financed by the Director, NCC. At present, about 9,300 students are enrolled for N.S.S. About 10 per cent students are covered by NCC and Rover Scouting. Air Squadron has been engaged in imparting training to girls in Air Services.

To create an awareness of the need for planned development among students, Planning Forums have been set up in 119 Colleges and University departments. About 50 colleges are conducting socio-economic surveys on topics suggested by the State Level Committee under the co

supervision of Planning Forum Cell of the Directorate.

Adequate attention has been given to promote games and sports in the universities and colleges. The State Government has taken necessary steps to increase the facilities for higher education among girls. Teaching facilities in the faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce exist in Girls Colleges. These Girls Colleges have Post-graduate teaching facilities. Students Welfare activities are also being encouraged. Teachers having meritorious works to their credit are rewarded.
