25-GENERAL EDUCATION (P) UNIVERSITY AND
HIGHER EDUCATION WRITE UP ON DRAFT ANNUAL
DRAFT ANNUAL PLAN 1989-90

The collegiate and University Education is of recent past in Nagaland which needs both qualitative improvement and quantitative expansion. Presently the Colleges in the State are under North Eastern Hill University. There are 13 Degree and 4 Pre-University Colleges. Out of the Degree Colleges one is a pure Science College and another has Science Wing attached.

1. ESTABLISHMENT OF UNIVERSITY:

The Government of Nagaland proposed to have one University of its own. This has been approved by the Government of India and while laying the foundation stone of the University at the proposed site at Lumami the Honourable Prime Minister has announced that the proposed University will be a Central University. Land of about 1000 acres has been acquired for the purpose. Necessary survey works has also been carried out. An amount of Rs.5.00 lakhs Rs.3.00 lakhs and Rs.50.00 lakhs has been spent during 1985-86, 1986-87 and 1987-88 respectively for establishment/ Running of the Planning Committee, Jungle clearance, Survey works, and other infrastructural facilities. Since the proposed University will be a Central University a token amount of Rs.10.00 lakhs has been kept during 1988-89 for maintenance of the Planning Committee and other infrastructural facilities. During 1989-90 an amount of Rs.10.00 lakhs has been promised to be kept for the same purpose.

2. GOVERNMENT COLLEGES:

There are at present 5 Government Colleges out of which Sao Chang College was taken over during 1984, Zunheboto College was taken over during 1986 and Mount Tiyi College was taken over during 1987. Due to dearth of Plan fund these Colleges are being run in make-shift buildings and with a skeleton Number of staff members.

Science College, Kohima is the only College offering Science studies in the State, where as in the Fazl Ali College the Science section has just been introduced. It is necessary to immediately strengthen the Science College, Kohima and Science section of Fazl Ali College by providing additional class rooms and minimum numbers of staff members.

and by extending the Laboratory facilities as the Class-rooms Laboratory in these colleges are over-crowded/congest.

A. CREATION/MAINTENANCE OF POSTS:

With a view to strengthen the Manpower position the three new Government Colleges it is required to create the following posts:-

For Maintenance of the posts already created during the 7th Five Year Plan and for creation of the above mentioned posts provision of Rs.35.00 lakhs has been proposed during 1989-90.

B. CONTINGENCIES:

With a view to strengthen the Physical facilities of the 5 Government Colleges a provision of an amount of Rs.7.00 lakhs has been kept for providing Teaching Materials, Laboratory Equipments, Chemicals furniture, Reading Materials etc.

C. PURCHASE/MAINTENANCE OF VEHICLE:

During the current period 6 Nos of Buses has been purchased for the Government Colleges. To maintain these Buses a provision of Rs.6.00 lakhs has been kept during 1988-89.

D. EDUCATIONAL TOUR:

To widen the outlook of the students and as a part of the co-curricular activities students are to undertake Educational Tour. To continue with the scheme a provision of Rs.1.10 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

E. POST MATRIC MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS:

To encourage the Local talented students State Government is providing Merit Scholarships to the students

After passing H.S.L.C. examination upto the Post Degree level. To continue with the scheme a provision of Rs.2.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

• RESEARCH GRANT:

To encourage the Local talented College Lecturers for higher studies a provision of Rs.0.50 lakh has been kept, and to award Research Scholarships to the M.Phil and Ph.D. students an amount of Rs.0.50 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

• GRANT-IN-AID:

At present there are 11 academic, 3 Theological and 4 Law Colleges in the State under Private management. Grant-in-Aid is being paid to these College managements to assist them in running their Colleges. To continue the system a provision of Rs.10.00 lakhs has been kept during 1988-89.

• TAKING OVER OF PRIVATE COLLEGES:

The Department proposes to take over one College per district in the State in accordance with the decision taken earlier. Five Districts namely:- Kohima, Mokokchung, Pionsang, Zunheboto and Wokha have one Government College each. Now the District of Mon and Phuk remain. To take over these two Colleges a provision of Rs.20.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90

• BUILDING CONSTRUCTION:

The main problem in the Department is construction of College Buildings and few other buildings. As of now there are 20 items of on going works which were taken up prior to 1988-89. Out of which 3 items have been completed and 17 items remain as spill over works. Planning Commission has clearly instructed that during the remaining period of the 7th Five Year Plan, the Department should concentrate on completion of the spill over works only. In order to complete the 17 items of spill over works during 1989-90 provision of Rs.99.90 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90. Following is the sectoral break-up:-

1. University	- Rs.5.00 lakhs
2. College Education	- Rs.50.90 lakhs
3. Professional College	- Rs.9.00 lakhs
4. Direction & Administration	- <u>Rs.40.00 lakhs</u>
	Total:- Rs.95.90 lakhs

MINOR WORKS:

To maintain the building structure and during the Plan period a provision of Rs.2.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

PROFESSIONAL COLLEGES:

• EDUCATION/MAINTENANCE OF POSTS:

Nagaland College of Education is the lone Teachers Training Institute at Degree level, and the College is very much over crowded to cater the needs of the Schools. It is essential to further strengthen the College. Creation of the following posts during 1989-90 has been proposed:-

Lecturer	- 2 Nos (English and Psychology)
Art and Craft Instructor	- 1
Laboratory Assistant	- 1
Library Attendant	- 1

To maintain the posts already created and to create the above mentioned posts a provision of Rs.7.00 lakh has been kept during 1989-90.

CONTINGENCIES:

To provide the College with necessary teaching Aids and Materials a provision of Rs.1.00 lakh has been kept during 1989-90.

CONVEYANCE/M-INTENCE OF VEHICLES:

The major part of the B.Ed and U.G.T.T. Course is the practical teaching in the Schools. Each trainee has to give 6 lessons in actual classroom situation which has to be supervised by the faculty. The faculty ~~there~~ has to supervise 3000 trainees every year which means supervision of 3000 classes spreading over as many as 10 different schools in Kohima. As some of the schools at Kohima are situated away from the town, both trainees and faculty have to be dropped at schools so as to maintain uniformity in timing and effective implementation of the programme. In this circumstances lecturers are left with no conveyance facilities. In the absence of proper conveyance often the classes are left un-supervised which is very much resented by the Headmasters of the respective schools where the programme is conducted.

For the genuine purpose stated above the College requires a light Vehicle. A provision of Rs.1.50 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90 for purchase of a Jeep or Car.

1. DIRECTION AND ADMINISTRATION:

a. CREATION/MAINTENANCE OF POSTS:

The Directorate of Higher and Technical Education was established during 1983. As per the staffing pattern of the other Directorates this Directorate has not been provided with any suitable hands to formulate and deal with the Planning papers. For effective formulation of the Plan documents and for smooth implementation of the Plan schemes and to strengthen the Directorate it is proposed to create the following few posts during 1989-90.

To maintain the posts already created and to create the above mentioned posts a provision of Rs.7.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

b. CONTINGENCIES:

To provide the required office equipments a provision of Rs.2.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

c. PURCHASE/MAINTENANCE OF VEHICLES:

During the current Plan period Directorate has procured one Mini Bus(for staff)one Car and one Jeep. To maintain these vehicles a provision of Rs.1.00 lakh has been kept during 1989-90.

4. 100% CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEMES:

a. HINDI TRAINING COLLEGE:

In view of the decision taken earlier that the present Hindi Training Institute will be up-graded to Hindi Training College at Dimapur with 100% Central Assistance a provision of Rs.20.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90,to start the initial work for up gradation.

d. POST MATRIC CENTRAL SCHOLARSHIPS:

All the Nagaland Post Matric students who do not get any other Scholarships are given Post Matric Central Scholarship...

per the National pattern the expenditure as per 1984-85 level is to be incurred out of 'NON-PLAN' fund. The additional needs over this level is to be provided under 'PLAN' by the Centre. Anticipated expenditure during 1988-89 is Rs.40.00 lakhs under 'PLAN'. A provision of Rs.45.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90 to continue the scheme.

TECHNICAL EDUCATION : ANNUAL PLAN 1989-90.

1. KHELHOSHE POLYTECHNIC:

The present khelhoshe polytechnic, atizou imparts Diploma course in Civil, electrical and mechanical Engineering. The polytechnic has been established during 1972. Manpower requirement have been partially provided upto 1987-88. Creation of few more posts are also in progress during 1988-89. To maintain the posts already created a provision of an amount of Rs.6.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

The following provisions has kept during 1989-90 to continue the scheme:-

Rs.8.10 lakhs has been kept f.r complete construction of the ongoing items of works viz-playground, Infirmary building workshop etc, and an amount of Rs.0.80 lakhs has been kept for maintenance of the building already constructed during the plan period.

2. WOMEN POLYTECHNIC:

All India Council for Technical Education has approved establishment of one Women Polytechnic at Kohima during 1985-86 due to delay caused in acquiring the land and due to paucity of fund the Polytechnic could not have come in existance till now. During 1988-89 arrangements are being finalised to start the Polytechnic in temporary buildings. Creation of posts as per the recommendation of the AICTE are in a finalising stage. For creation of the posts a provision of Rs.6.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

For providing necessary infrastructural facilities viz office equipments, Training materials teaching aids etc. a provision of Rs.10.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

Since the location of the Polytechnic is away from the town a Bus is to be provided to the Polytechnic for use of the staff and students. a provision of Rs.4.00 lakhs has been kept during 1988-89 for the purpose.

With a view to complete the construction of the Main Institute Building and three workshops a provision of Rs.30.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

.. SCHOLARSHIPS:

Local students are being encouraged to study the various engineering Courses in Diploma and Degree level by giving them Scholarships, Bookgrants, re-imbursement of Training expenses etc. Students sponsored by the State Government for various Engineering courses from 1985-86 academic year Scholarships etc are to be paid out of the 'FLAN' fund. For this a provision of Rs.10.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

.. STATE COUNCIL FOR TECHNICAL EDUCATION:

For conducting examinations on Technical education and for awarding Diploma, State Council for Technical Education has started functioning from 1986. For maintenance of the council a provision of Rs.7.60 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90.

.. SCIENCE CENTRE:

It is agreed to set up one Science Centre at Dimapur with the NSCM and the NBC. The share being 50:25:25 respectively a provision of Rs.5.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90 for the purpose as state share.

5. REGIONAL SCHOOL OF MINING ENGINEERING:

NBC has agreed to establish a Regional School of Mining Engineering in Nagaland. As per terms and pattern of the NBC State Government is to provide the necessary infrastructural facilities viz-approach road, Electricity, Water Supply etc. For this a provision of Rs.10.00 lakhs has been kept during 1989-90 also.
