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## PREFACE

This brochure depicts the enrolment trends during the last 10 years (1969-1979) in various States and Union Territories in Classes I—V and VI—VIII, which normally comprises the elementary stage of education, corresponding to the population of the age-groups 6—11 and 11—14.

The enrolment figures given in this brochure have been compiled from the information supplied annually by the State Governments in the prescribed forms up to the year 1975-76. The data relating to 1976-77 has been compiled from the information supplied by the State Governments for our publication entitled "Selected Educational Statistics". The data relating to 1977-78 (likely achievement) and 1978-79 (targets) have been compiled on the basis of the information collected during the Annual Plan discussions.

While every care has been taken to compile this data accurately from the information supplied by the State Governments there may still exist some discrepancies which may be brought to the notice of the Ministry.

The enrolment ratios worked out in this publication are based on earlier projections of population for these age-groups, as worked out by R.G's. Office.

The Ministry of Education & Social Welfare take this opportunity to thank the State Governments who have supplied this data.

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## INTRODUCTION

This study relates to the enrolment trends during the last decade (1969-79) in various States and Union Territories in various classes constituting elementary stage of education, corresponding to the school going population of the age groups (6—11) and (11—14). The data contained in this brochure have been compiled from the information supplied annually by the State Governments in the prescribed forms up to the year 1975-76. The data relating to 1976-77 has been compiled from the provisional statistics published in Ministry of Education's publication entitled "Selected Educational Statistics". The data relating to 1977-78 (likely achievement) and 1978-79 (targets) have been compiled on the basis of the information collected during the annual plan discussions.

For working out the enrolment ratios of students studying in classes I—V and VI—VIII to the corresponding population of the age-groups (6—11) and (11—14), population projections provided by the R.G's office earlier have been taken into account for the sake of making a uniform comparative study for all the years forming the decade 1969 to 1979.

2. Statements Nos. I—III depict the All India picture of the progress of enrolment of Boys and Girls in classes I—V and VI—VIII, giving inter-alia the annual growth rate for all the years and the percentage coverage of the enrolment in classes I—V and VI—VIII to the corresponding school going population. It will be seen that while the total enrolment in classes I—V is likely to increase from 544 lakhs in 1968-69 to 740 lakhs in 1978-79, the average annual growth rate for this period comes to only 3.2%. Year-wise, the annual growth rate has shown an improvement from 2.1% in 1969-70 to 4.3% in 1978-79. The annual growth rate is varied during the period under report. This rate increased from 2.1% to 6.1% during the year 1968-69 to 1972-73. However the rate decreased 6.1% in 1972-73 to 1.8% in 1973-74, then increased to 2.1% in 1974-75 and again decreased to 1.2% in 1975-76. Thereafter the growth rate improved to 2.8% in 1976-77 to 5.1% in 1977-78 but it is likely to decrease to 4.3% in 1978-79. The enrolment ratio has also shown on the average will increase from 78.1% in 1968-69 to 81.9% in 1978-79, i.e. an increase of about 14% during the decade.

3. In case of classes VI—VIII, the enrolment is likely to increase from 125 lakhs in 1968-69 to 193 lakhs in 1978-79, giving an average increase of 4.6% over the decade. The annual growth rate has shown a varied trend during this period. While it decreased from 3.5% in 1969-70 to 2.6% in 1970-71, it again showed an increase to 2.8% in 1971-72 and 4.2% in 1972-73. But it again decreased to 3.8% in 1973-74 and 1974-75 improved to 7.2% during the current year but a decline is envisaged in the next year, when it is likely to come down to 5.8%. The enrolment ratios in classes VI—VIII to the population of the age-group (11—14) is shown to have increased from 33.5% in 1968-69 to 42.1% in 1978-79, i.e. an increase of 8.6% during the period of 10 years.

In case of Girls enrolment in elementary classes, the enrolment in classes I—V has increased by 85 lakhs during a period of ten years, giving an average annual growth of 3.2%. Similarly, in classes VI—VIII, enrolment of Girls has increased from 35.5 lakhs to 65.4 lakhs, registering an annual growth rate of 5.8%. In case of percentage of Girls enrolment to the total enrolment, the position is not very happy. It has improved from 37.2% in 1968-69 to only 38.8% during the period under study. In case of classes VI—VIII, the corresponding percentage has improved from 28.3% in 1968-69 to 33.9% in 1978-79.

4. Statement No. IV gives State-wise and Sex-wise picture of the enrolment trends in classes I—V. It is seen that there is a decrease in the enrolment in some of the States. While the decrease in enrolment

in advanced States like Kerala, Nagaland and Union Territories of Mizoram, Dadra & Nagar Haveli are understandable, because of the almost complete coverage of the school going age-group for these classes, the declining trend in the enrolment of classes I—V in comparatively backward States like Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir and Rajasthan in some years is disturbing.

5. Similarly, Statement No. V, which gives the enrolment figures in classes VI—VIII, year-wise, sex-wise and State-wise, the picture is not different from that depicted in case of the enrolment trends of classes I—V. Here too, the adverse enrolment trends in States of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Orissa and Manipur in some years do not depict a happy picture of the progress of universalisation of elementary education in these States. Even the low enrolment trends shown by States like Kerala, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Punjab and Union Territory of Goa, Daman & Diu are deferred to undesired in view of the efforts that are required to be made for achieving the target of universalisation of elementary education in these States.

6. Statement No. VI shows the year-wise improvement in the enrolment ratios of the age-group (6—11) in various States. It is distressing to note from this table that in the State of Andhra Pradesh the enrolment ratio showed a decline from 75.1% in 1968-69 to 73.1% in 1969-70 to 71.2% in 1970-71 to 70.6% in 1971-72 and 71.2% in 1972-73 and 1973-74, 71.1% in 1974-75 and 70.4% in 1975-76. It is likely to improve by 4% annually from 1976-77. Similarly, enrolment ratios have either remained static or improved by only 1% to 2% in States like Assam, Bihar, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal.

7. Statement No. VII depicts the position of enrolment ratios in classes VI—VIII to the population of corresponding age-groups (11—14) from year to year during the period under review in various States and Union Territories. Here too, the improvement in the enrolment ratios in all these years have not gone beyond 2% in most of the States and in few States like Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Karnataka and West Bengal, it has gone down in some years.

The main objective behind this study is to highlight the need to closely study the actual trends of enrolment in the States and ensure prompt remedial action as a measure to promote universalisation of elementary education.

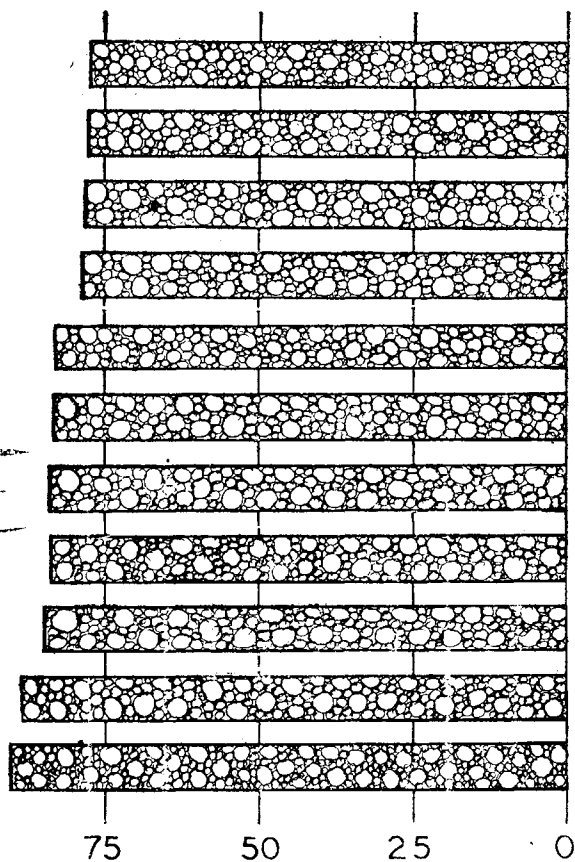

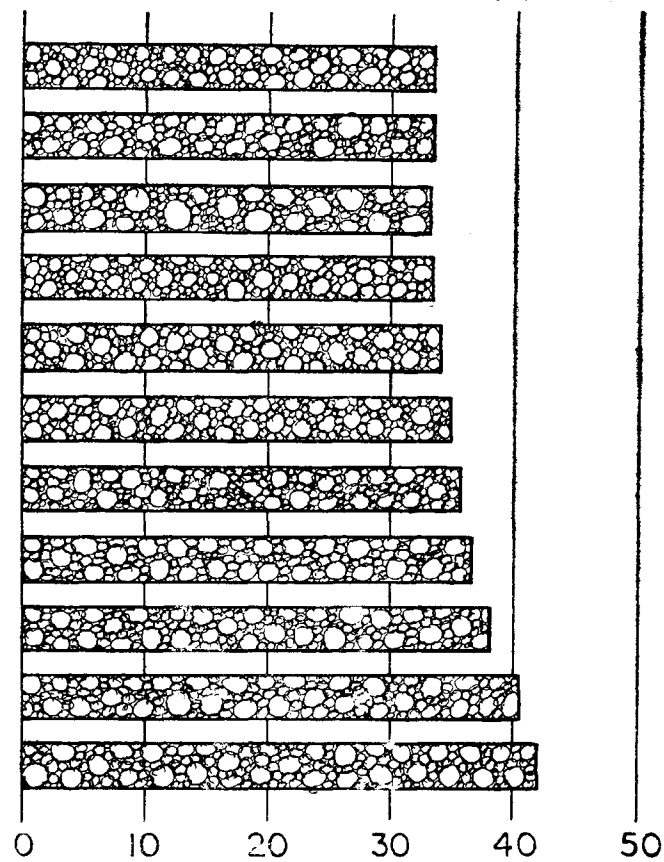

# PERCENTAGE OF ENROLMENT IN ELEMENTARY CLASSES TO THE CORRESPONDING POPULATION

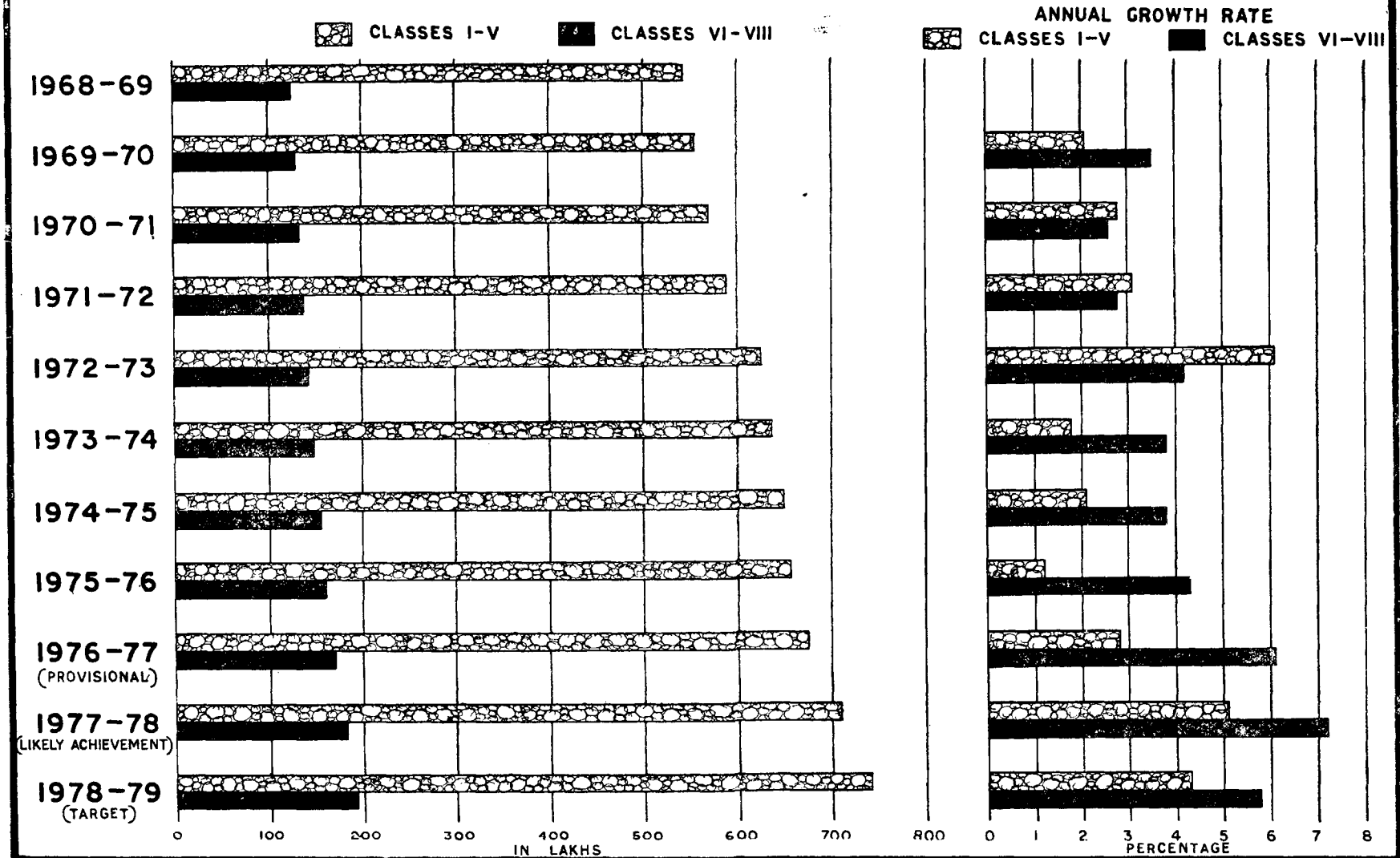
## CLASSES I-V
