

These results have assumed high importance for enabling students to enter job market as well as for pursuing higher education. The result at the end of class XII is all the more significant as this leads students to enter tertiary level of education, including academic and professional courses of the university level.

The information that COBSE had sought also has a bearing on the management of the process of examination. I am sure, this study will be of immense value to members of COBSE and other stakeholders alike. I will plead with my colleagues in different boards to ensure that they provide us data on time to enable us to carry out the work of this nature on a regular basis. I am sure, Boards who have not been able to provide us their results would kindly ensure that information is provided to COBSE within a time-frame.

A STUDY OF EXAMINATION RESULTS, 2004

RATIONALE

Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, Department of Secondary and Higher Education had assigned COBSE to carry out a comparative analysis of the external examinations conducted by various Boards/ Councils of Secondary and Senior Secondary Education.

The need to analyse external examination results and to communicate them to the students and teachers with a view to improve their performance was being felt. Unless examination results are properly and systematically analysed, it is difficult to make any impact on the quality of question papers. In the absence of systematic analysis of examination results, it is also difficult to state how scientific was the process of assigning marks to various questions. Lately, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India wanted to know from some of the boards about the time taken by them in conducting examinations and declaring results vis-à-vis other boards/councils in the country. It has been felt that timely declaration of results is important for students to seek admission to various professional courses and institutions of higher learning. Keeping these issues in view, a study of examination results at secondary and higher/senior secondary level was undertaken by COBSE. This will help many boards to apply corrective measures to improve their own process of declaring results within minimum possible time.

OBJECTIVES

The specific objectives of the study were to:

- Find out time taken by different boards/councils in conducting examinations and declaration of results for secondary and senior secondary levels;
- Find out pass percentages of students in regular and private streams;

- Participation and pass percentages of scheduled castes and scheduled tribe students; &
- Participation and pass percentages of girls.

METHODOLOGY

In order to collect information for comparative study, COBSE developed a tool and circulated the same among all the boards/councils of secondary and senior secondary examinations in the country.

This was the first attempt to collect such types of information. The overall response of boards/councils was satisfying. In all, 32 Boards/Councils have responded to COBSE's request, in this regard. A list of the boards/councils who sent the information relating to examination results is given at Annexure-I. Some of the boards/councils have not supplied information in the desired manner. For example, Chhattisgarh Board of Secondary Education sent results for the year 2002-03, which could not be taken into account since information requested for was for the year 2003-04. COBSE appreciates the difficulties of Boards/Councils in interpreting and analysing such type of data. Realizing the fact that there is always room for improving, it is hoped that, in future, the boards/councils would provide information in the desired format.

THE ANALYSIS

The information received from the boards/councils was divided into following three parts:

- Time taken for completion of examination process
- 2. Time taken for declaration of results, &
- Number of students appeared and passed in examinations

These are discussed in seriatim in the subsequent paragraphs.

1. Time taken for completion of examination process

(a) Secondary Examination

Nineteen Boards of Secondary Education have provided information about examination

process i.e. number of days taken for completion of secondary examination. Five Boards have not provided information about actual dates of start/completion of examinations. Detailed information is given in Annexure -II.

A table showing the status of completion of examination process is given below:

It can be seen from the above table that West Bengal Board of Secondary Education took only 9 days for completion of examination process. West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education took the maximum number of days i.e. 46 days. There are eight Boards, which took 10 to 15 days to complete examination process. They are: Board of School Education, Orissa [10 days], Nagaland Board of Secondary Education [13 days], Rabindra Mukta Vidyalaya, West Bengal [13 days], Mizoram Board of School Education [14 days], Gujarat Sec. & H.S. Education Board [15 days], Jharkhand Academic Council [15 days], Board of Secondary Education, Manipur [15 days] and State Board of School Education, Tamil Nadu [15 days]. Five Boards took 16 to 25 day to complete examination process - Board of Secondary Education, Andhra Pradesh [16 days], Board of Secondary Education, Assam [16 days], Goa Board of S&HS Education [17 days], M.P.

State Open School [17 days] and Central Board of Secondary Education [23 days]. Five Boards took 27 to 46 days for completion of examination process – Board of School Education, Haryana [27 days], Punjab School Education Board [29 days], Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [29], Tripura Board of Secondary Education [29 days] and West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education [46 days].

(b) Senior Secondary Examination

Sixteen Boards has supplied information about examination process. Seven Boards/Councils have not provided data regarding start/completion date of examinations. The detailed information is given in Annexure – III.

A table given below shows number of days taken for conducting senior secondary examination.

It can be seen from the above table that minimum and maximum number of days taken for completion of examination are 13 and 45 days respectively. The minimum days [13 days] was taken by Board of School Education, Haryana. Eight Boards/Councils took 15 to 20 days. They are: Gujarat Secondary & H.S Education Board [15 days], Board of Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala [16 days], Punjab School Education Board [Science & Commerce -16 days], Department of Pre-University, Karnataka [17 days], M.P. State Open School [17 days], Mizoram Board of School Education [17 days], Assam Higher Secondary Education Council [20 days] and Goa Board of S & H.S. [20 days]. Seven Boards/Councils reported number of days taken for completion of examination ranging from 24 to 45 days. They are: Tripura Board of Secondary Education [24 days], Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [Arts & Commerce - 27 days], HP Board of School Education [31 days], Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi [33 days], Jharkhand Academic Council [Science – 33 days], [Arts & Commerce – 36 days], Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [Science – 37 days], Bihar Intermediate Education Council [38 day], Punjab School Education Board [Humanities & Vocation - 44 days] and West Bengal Board of Secondary Education [45 days].

2. Time taken for declaration of results

(a) Secondary Examination

Nineteen Boards of Secondary Education/Council have provided the information about time taken for declaration of results for secondary examination. Five Boards have not provided this information.

It can be seen from the above table that minimum number of days taken for declaration of result is reported by Board of Secondary Education, Andhra Pradesh [28 days]. The maximum number of days taken for declaration of result was reported by Tripura Board of Secondary

Education [86 days]. Five boards took 34 to 43 days to declare results. They are: Goa Board of S&HS Education [34 days], Board of School Education, Haryana [37 days], Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [39 days], State Board of School Education, Tamil Nadu [41 days]

and Mizoram Board of Secondary Education [43 days]. Eight Boards took 60 to 70 days for declaring results – Board of Secondary Education, Manipur [60 days], Rabindra Mukta Vidyaiaya, West Bengal [60 days], Jharkhand Academic Council [62 days], Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi [63 days for Chennai & Ajmer region], [65 days for Delhi, Allahabad, Chandigarh & Guwahati regions], M.P. State Open School [63 days], West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education [65 days], Board of School Education, Orissa [66 days], Nagaland Board of Secondary Education [70 days]. Five boards reported 71 to 86 days for declaration of results. They are: West Bengal Board of Secondary Education [71 days],

Gujarat Secondary & H.S. Education Board [74 days], Punjab School Education Board [80 days], Board of Secondary Education, Assam [81 days] and Tripura Board of Secondary Education [86 days].

(b) Senior Secondary

Sixteen Boards of Secondary Education/Council have provided the information about time taken for declaration of results for secondary examination. Eight Boards have not provided information.

A table showing the picture of completion of examination process is given below.

It can be seen from the above table that minimum number of days taken for declaration of result is reported by HP Board of Secondary Education [26 days - Science Stream]. The maximum number of days taken for declaration of result was taken by Assam Higher Secondary Education Council [87 days - Arts & Commerce Stream]. Nine boards took 37 to 50 days to declare results. They are: Department of Pre-University, Karnataka [37 days], Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [37 days -Commerce Stream], Gujarat Secondary & Higher Secondary Education Board [38 days - Science Stream], Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [40 days - Commerce Stream], Mizoram Board of Secondary Education [46 days], Board of School Education, Haryana [47 days], Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi [50 days - Chandigarh, Ajmer, Chennai & Guwahati regions], Jharkhand Academic Council [50 days - Science Stream] and Punjab School Education Board [50 days - Science & Commerce Stream]. The time taken by rest of the boards is between 51 to 87 days. The boards are: Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [51 days - Arts Stream], Tripura Board of Secondary Education [52 days], Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi [53 days – Delhi & Allahabad regions], Goa Board of S&HS Education [53 days], Gujarat Secondary & H.S. Education Board [53 days – General], Jharkhand Academic Council [53 days – Arts Stream], HP Board of School Education [54 days – Humanities], Punjab School Education Board [65 days – Humanities & Vocation Streams], Assam Higher Education Council [73 days – Science & 73 days – Arts & Commerce Streams], M.P. State Open School [76 days] and Bihar Intermediate Council [80 days].

3. Number of students appeared and passed in Examinations

(a) Secondary Examination

COBSE received response from 24 State Boards of Secondary Education. A table showing number of students appeared (regular/private), passed (regular/private), pass percentages and SC & ST-wise is given in Annexure - IV. The analysis of the data is given below.

(i) General Category Students

- Out of 57.90 lakh students appeared in examination in year 2004 as regular students, 31.99 lakh were boys and 22.59 lakh were girls. Two boards [Haryana and Tripura] have not provided break-up of boys and girls. Hence, the total is not matching.
- Out of 8.99 lakh students appeared as private students in examination, the number of boys and girls was 4.96 lakh and 3.20 lakh respectively.
- 33.52 lakh regular students passed examination and the pass percentage was 57.89%. The pass percentage of boys was 59.46% and the girls 64.19%.
- The pass percentage of girls was 4.73% more than the boys.
- The result of private students was not encouraging. The overall pass percentage was 37.89. The boy's percentage being 37.84 and the girls 41.92.
- The pass percentage of private girl students was 4.08% more than the boys.
- The highest pass percentage of regular students was reported by Board of Secondary Education, Andhra Pradesh [80.41%], followed by State Board of School Education, Tamil Nadu [77.36%], Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi [76.62%], Nagaland Board of Secondary Education [72.03%], West Bengal Board of Secondary Education [71.61%], West Bengal Board of Madrasah [65.97%], Punjab School Education Board [65.91%], Jharkhand Academic Council [60.96%], Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [60.08%], Board of School Education, Haryana [59.17%], Goa Board of Sec. & H.S. Education [57.47%], Gujarat Sec. &

- H.S. Board [52.69%], Board of School Education, Orissa [52.26%], Tripu:a Board of Secondary Education [50.64%], J&K State Board of School Education [50.34%], Board of Secondary Education, Assam [49.80%], Uttaranchal Shiksha Evm Pariksha Parishad [48.12%], Board of Secondary Education, Manipur [39.43%], M.P. State Open School [37.30%], Mizoram Board of School Education [37.00%], Rabindra Mukta Vidalaya, West Bengal [29.93%], Madhmik Shiksha Mandal, M.P. [28.46%] and Madhmik Shiksha Mandal, Bhopal (Corres.) [7.43%]. Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & H.S. Education has not provided information about general category students.
- The highest pass percentage of private students was reported by West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education [63.42%] followed by West Bengal Board of Secondary Education [50.49%], Board of Secondary Education, Andhra Pradesh [50.20%], Nagaland Board of Secondary Education [40.76%], Board of School Education, Orissa [36.46%], Board of Secondary Education [35.28%], Uttaranchal Shiksha Avm Pariksha Parishad [29.05%], Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi [28.71%], Board of Secondary Education, Manipur [24.89%], Board of School Education, Haryana [24.31%], J&K State Board of School Education [21.42%], Madhmik Shiksha Mandal, M.P. [17.96%]. Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [15.02%], Mizoram Board of School Education [8.25%] and Goa Board of Secondary & H.S. Education [2.86%].

(ii) Scheduled Caste Students

 The total number of scheduled caste regular students who appeared in secondary examination was 8.25 lakh, out of which 3.51 lakh were girls and 4.74 lakh were boys. 0.37 lakh private students appeared in the examination and the boys and girls number being 0.24 lakh and 0.13 lakh respectively.

- The highest number of scheduled caste regular students appeared was reported by Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & H.S. Education [2.03 lakh]. The number of students appeared in examination reported by other boards are: Tamil Nadu [1.58 lakh], Andhra Pradesh [1.31 lakh] and West Bengal [1.23 lakh].
- The pass percentage of regular scheduled caste students and private students was 61.27% [5.06 lakh] and 2.99% [0.09 lakh] respectively. Nagaland Board reported highest pass percentage of scheduled castes regular students [81.90%] followed by other boards: Andhra Pradesh [74.47%], Tamil Nadu [66.51%], CBSE [62.85%], Tripura [60.45%], Maharashtra [60.00%], West Bengal [58.96%], West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education [58.33%], Jharkhand [55.81%], Punjab [54.65%], Assam [48.73%], Rajasthan [47.80%], Orissa [41.38%], M.P. State Open School [41.27%], Goa [40.36%] and Rabindra Mukta Vidyalaya, West Bengal [28.02%].
- 0.37 lakh scheduled caste private students appeared, out of which only 8668 [2.99%] have passed. West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education reported highest pass percentage of private students [51.92%]. The pass percentage of other boards is: Orissa [38.37%], Nagaland [37.70%], Assam [33.08%], CBSE, New Delhi [12.59%] and Rajasthan [7.56%].

(iii) Scheduled Tribe Students

 In secondary examination 3.30 lakh scheduled tribe regular students appeared, out of which 2.10 lakh were

- boys and 1.20 lakh were girls. The highest number of scheduled tribe students was reported by Maharashtra [0.88 lakh].
- The total number of scheduled tribe private students appeared was 0.44 lakh [boys: 0.27 lakh and girls: 0.17 lakh].
- The overall pass percentage of scheduled tribe regular students was 52.34. The highest pass percentage has been reported by Board of Secondary Education, Andhra Pradesh [80.28%] followed by the Boards of Nagaland [70.86%], Tamil Nadu [63.10%], Punjab [56.43%], Maharashtra [55.60%], Rajasthan [52.93%], Jharkhand [52.71%], W. B. Madrasah [50.00%], CBSE, New Delhi [45.73 %], Goa [41.09%], Orissa [39.97%], West Bengal [39.93%], M.P. State Open School [39.22%], Assam [33.96%] and Tripura [23.43%].
- The highest pass percentage of scheduled tribe private students was reported by Nagaland [40.11%]. The pass percentage reported by other boards is as follows: CBSE, New Delhi [31.92%], Orissa [31.03%], Assam [30.95%], Maharashtra [18.80%], W.B. Madrasah Education [15.00%] and Rajasthan [11.49%].

(b) Senior Secondary Examination

COBSE received response from 23 State Boards/Councils of Secondary/Higher Secondary Education. A table showing number of students appeared (regular/private), passed (regular/private), pass percentages and SC & ST-wise is given in Annexure – V. The analysis of the data is given below:

(i) General Category Students

 Out of 29.85 lakh students appeared in senior secondary examination in year 2004 as regular students, 16.42 lakh were boys and 11.09 lakh were girls. Since

- three boards/council [Haryana, Orissa and Tripura] have not provided break-up of boys and girls and hence the total is not matching.
- Out of 3.39 lakh students appeared as private students in examination, the number of boys and girls was 1.40 lakh and 0.70 lakh respectively.
- 20.13 lakh regular students have passed examination and the pass percentage was 67.42%. The pass percentage of boys was 65.35% and the girls 72.12%.
- The pass percentage of girls was 6.77% more than the boys.
- The result of private students was 43.88%. The boys pass percentage being 30.31 and the girls 35.26.
- The pass percentage of private girl students was 4.95% more than the boys.
- The highest pass percentage of regular students was reported by Bihar Intermediate Education Council [85.94%] followed by Jharkhand Academic Council [83.42%], Board of Secondary Education of Rajastan [81.26%], Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi [80.36%], Council of Higher Secondary Education, Orissa [79.51%], Goa Board of S&HS Education [74.59%], Uttaranchal Shiksha Evm Pariksha Parishad [72.95%], Punjab School Education Board [68.78%], Madhmik Shiksha Mandal, M.P. [65.22%] Meghalaya Board of School Education [62.12%], Gujarat Secondary & H.S. Education Board [60.78%], HP Board of School Education [60.54%], "Board of Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala [59.23%], Deptt of Pre-University, Karnataka [57.61%], Assam Higher Secondary Education Council [55.49%], Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur [54.75%], Tripura Board of Secondary Education [48.80%],

- Board of School Education, Haryana [39.21%], J&K State Board of School Education [38.95%], Mizoram Board of School Education [34.84%], M.P. State Open School, Bhopal [34.01%] and West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education [34.01%]. Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & H.S.Education has not provided information about general category students.
- The highest pass percentage of private students was reported by Council of Higher Sec. Education, Orissa [75.43%]. The pass percentage reported by other boards/councils is as under: Gujarat [57.81%], Uttaranchal [47.46%], Madhya Pradesh [36.48%], Rajasthan [34.42%], Karantaka [31%], CBSE, New Delhi [30.86%], Jammu & Kashmir [23.85%], Meghalaya [22.91%] and Goa [17.24%]. Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur has provided separate information in respect of private students who have appeared in the examination but they have not provided separate information in respect of students who have passed examination. Hence, regular students passed out information include regular as well as private students.

(ii) Scheduled Caste Students

- In all 3.21 lakh scheduled caste regular students appeared in senior secondary examination, out of which there were 1.24 lakh were girls and 1.83 lakh boys. 0.15 lakh private students appeared in the examination, out of which 4,386 were girls and 0.10 lakh boys.
- The overall pass percentage of scheduled caste regular students was 59.12 and private students 32.89.
- Maharashtra reported highest number of regular student [1.38 lakh] who appeared in the examination.

- The highest pass percentage in respect of regular students was reported by Jharkhand Academic Council [79.64%] followed by Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [78.10%], Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi [77.94%], Council of Higher Secondary Education, Orissa [71.45%], Goa Board of S&HS Education [70.09%], Punjab School Education Board [62.15%], HP Board of School Education [60.98%], Maharashtra State Board of S&HS Education [57.02%], Tripura Board of Secondary Education [53.16%], Department of Pre-University, Karnataka [45.91%], Board of Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala [41.21%] and M.P. State Open School, Bhopal [30.51%].
- The highest pass percentage of private passed students was reported by Maharashtra State Board of S&HS Education [44.11%]. The pass percentages reported by other Boards are: Board of Secondary Education, Rajasthan [31.44%], Department of Pre-University, Karnataka [27.56%] and Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi [25.11%].
- The following boards/councils have not provided information about scheduled caste students: Assam, Bihar, Gujarat, Haryana, Jammu & Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Uttaranchal and West Bengal.

(iii) Scheduled Tribe Students

 In senior secondary examination 1.32 lakh scheduled tribe regular students appeared, out of which 0.79 lakh were

- boys and 0.39 lakh girls. Council of Higher Secondary Education, Orissa has not provided information about scheduled tribe boys and girls separately. The highest number of scheduled tribe students was reported by Maharashtra [0.47 lakh].
- The total number of scheduled tribe private students appeared was 7,561.
 The boards/councils of Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Kerala, MP State Open School, Bhopal, Punjab and Tripura have not provided break up of boys and girls separately.
- The overall pass percentage of scheduled tribe regular students was 60.93%. The highest pass percentage has been reported by Jharkhand Academic Council [81.77%] followed by the Boards of Rajasthan [73.15%], Orissa [68.04%], Goa [61.02%], Himachal Pradesh [60.33%], CBSE, New Delhi [57.26%], Punjab [56.62%], Maharashtra [52.65%], Karnataka [47.06%], Tripura [39.23%], Kerala [39.18%], and M.P. State Open School [25.40%].
- 7,561 scheduled tribe private students appeared in the examination. The number of boys and girls being 5,499 and 2,062 respectively. The overall pass percentage of scheduled tribe students was 27.36%.
- The highest pass percentage for scheduled tribe private students was reported by Maharashtra [45.39%]. The pass percentage reported by other boards is as follows: CBSE, New Delhi [34.05%], Karnataka [28.38%] and Rajasthan [22.10%].
