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## दो शब्द

प्राथमिक एवं माध्यमिक शिक्षा निदेशालय, राजस्थान, बीकानेर द्वारा गत दो दशाब्दियों में शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में अर्जित उपलब्धियों को पुस्तकाकार दिया जा रहा है। निश्चय ही यह प्रसन्नता का विषय है। पुस्तिक के अलग-अलग अध्यायों में यथा सम्भव विस्तृत जानकारी देने का प्रयास किया गया है।

सकलित सूचना सारित्रणियों में शैक्षणिक संस्थाओं का सविस्तार विवेचन ही नहीं वरन् राज्य के लोगों की बढ़ती हुई शैक्षणिक आकांक्षाओं एवं राज्य द्वारा इन आकांक्षाओं की तुष्टि के लिए किये गये प्रयास स्पष्ट होते हैं। १९५०-५१ में राज्य में ४३३६ प्राथमिक, ७३२ उच्च प्राथमिक, १७५ माध्यमिक एवं १९५५-५६ में २८ उच्च माध्यमिक विद्यालय थे, जो १९७३-७४ में स्तरानुसार क्रमशः बढ़कर १९३९०, ४८३७, ८४७ एवं ५०१ हो गये। इस प्रकार प्रत्येक स्तर पर विद्यालय वृद्धि क्रमशः ४, ६, ४ एवं १७ गुना से भी अधिक रही।

इन दो दशाब्दियों में संस्थाओं में, छात्र नामांकन में भी लक्ष्य की ओर अग्रसर होने की प्रवृत्ति स्पष्ट दृष्टि-गोचर होती है। १९५०-५१ में ६-११ आयुवर्ग के १६.६ प्रतिशत, ११-१४ आयु वर्ग के ५.४ प्रतिशत एवं १४-१७ आयुवर्ग के १.८ प्रतिशत बालक-बालिकाएँ विद्यालयों में अध्ययन कर रहे थे, जबकि १९७२-७३ में क्रमशः इन आयु वर्गों में ५१.०, २४.१ एवं १३.८ प्रतिशत बालक-बालिकाएँ विद्यालयों में थे।

हमके प्रनुरूप शिक्षकों की संख्या में भी अचूक अभिवृद्धि हुई। १९५०-५१ में ७७२८ पुरुष, १००५ महिला अध्यापक प्राथमिक विद्यालयों में, ५५७० पुरुष एवं ९१६ महिला अध्यापक उच्च प्राथमिक विद्यालयों में तथा ३१३३ पुरुष एवं २३४ महिला अध्यापक माध्यमिक एवं उच्च माध्यमिक विद्यालयों में कार्यशील थे जबकि १९७२-७३ में प्राथमिक विद्यालयों में २४९६० पुरुष एवं ५४३२ महिला अध्यापक एवं २१२१ पुरुष एवं ३६७९ महिला अध्यापक माध्यमिक एवं उच्च माध्यमिक विद्यालयों में कार्यशील थे। इसी प्रकार प्रशिक्षित अध्यापकों के प्रतिशत में भी १९५०-५१ की अपेक्षा १९७२-७३ में प्राथमिक विद्यालयों में ५.५२ प्रतिशत उच्च प्राथमिक विद्यालयों में ५३.८ एवं माध्यमिक एवं उच्च माध्यमिक विद्यालयों में ३८.६ प्रतिशत वृद्धि हुई।

इस पुस्तिका में विश्वविद्यालय स्तर एवं महाविद्यालय स्तर की शिक्षा में इन २५ वर्षों में हुई प्रगति का उल्लेख भी किया गया है। इन दो दशकद्वियों में महाविद्यालयी सामान्य संस्थाओं में करीब ४ गुना एवं इनके नामांकन में ८ गुनी वृद्धि हुई है। व्यवसायिक, तकनीकी एवं संस्कृत शिक्षा की प्रगति का उल्लेख पुस्तक की प्रमुख विशेषता है।

किसी भी क्षेत्र में की गई प्रगति का सीधा सम्बन्ध, मद विशेष पर किए गये व्यय से है। जो राज्य के १९५०-५१ से १९७४-७५ तक प्राथमिक एवं माध्यमिक शिक्षा बजट में २५ गुना वृद्धि से स्पष्ट है। राजस्वाव की शैक्षणिक स्थिति का राष्ट्र के संदर्भ में मूल्यांकन किए जाने की दृष्टि से अन्तर्राज्यीय सारिणियां भी पुस्तक में दी गई है। जिनसे स्पष्ट होता है कि साक्षरता स्तर में सुधार करने के लिए अभी और प्रयत्न की आवश्यकता है।

पुस्तिका में प्रस्तुत सामग्री प्रथम बार किए गये नामांकन सर्वेक्षण का प्रतिफल है। अतः प्रस्तुत प्रकाशन अवश्य ही उन सब के लिए उपयोगी सिद्ध होगा, जो किसी भी रूप में शिक्षा एवं शैक्षणिक परिवेश से जुड़े हुए हैं। विशेष रूप से शिक्षा शास्त्री, शोध क्षेत्र में रत् शिक्षा अधिकारी इस पुस्तिक से अत्यन्त लाभान्वित हो सकेंगे।

## आमुख

प्रस्तुत पुस्तिका में राजस्थान में पिछले २५ वर्षों में हुई शैक्षणिक प्रगति से सम्बन्धित मूल समकों का समावेश किया गया है। इन दो दशाब्दियों में राजस्थान में शिक्षा के क्षेत्र में बहुमुखी प्रगति की है, जिसे इस पुस्तिका में दर्शाया गया है।

इस प्रकाशन में सम्मिलित किए गये समकों की शिक्षा निदेशालय, प्राथमिक एवं माध्यमिक शिक्षा तथा जस्यानय बीकानेर के सौखिकी अनुभाग द्वारा संचालित एवं अन्तिम रूप दिया गया है। मुझे विश्वास है कि प्रस्तुत पुस्तिका में उक्त समस्त लोगों के लिए रुचिकर होगी, जो राजस्थान के शैक्षणिक विकास में रुचिकर होते हैं।


