


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EDUCATION IN TRIPURA

-A Reflection On Graphs



F O R E W O R D

The planners and administrators in education desire very often to know the trends of important educational characteristics like literacy, number of institutions, enrolment, etc. over a long period of time. To meet this specific requirement, the Statistics Section of the Directorate has prepared this volume which contains in all seventy Diagrams showing the trends of salient characteristics pertaining to the ten important sectors of education in the State. The trends are revealing and may be used in projections for future years.

To indicate the growth of the characteristics during all the earlier plan periods covering 23 years or so, most of the Diagrams presented in the volume are based on data for the years which are considered important from the point of view of planning as detailed below :-

1950 - 51	...	Pre-Plan year.
1955 & 56	...	End of First Five Year Plan vis-a-vis beginning of Second Five Year Plan.
1960 - 61	...	End of Second Five Year Plan vis-a-vis beginning of Third Five Year Plan.
1965 - 66	...	End of Third Five Year Plan.
1968 - 69	...	End of three Annual Plans vis-a-vis beginning of Fourth Five Year Plan.
1973 - 74	...	End of Fourth Five Year Plan.











Trends in female population, female literate and female illiterate population.

































Growth in the number of High Schools.




Growth in the number of Higher











The enrolment pyramid of school education in 1972-73







teachers at the Primary Stage





teachers at the Primary Stage





Teachers at the Primary Stage.





Trained and Untrained Male Teachers at the Middle Stage




Trained and Untrained Female Teachers at the Middle Stage.

Teachers at the Middle Stage





at the High/Higer Secondary Stage.





for general education.




Growth in enrolment of Colleges

Growth in enrolment of Colleges for general education




Trends in Boys' enrolment by courses in Colleges for

for General Education.





Trends in Girls' enrolment by courses in Colleges for General Education.





Trends in Total enrolment by courses in Colleges for General Education.





Trends in the number of teachers in Colleges for General Education.







Trends of enrolment in Social (Adult) Education Centres.













students at the Middle Stage.





students at the Middle Stage.





students at the Secondary Stage.













Amount spent on awards of scholarships, stipends and other financial concessions to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students.




















