FOREWORD

The development process of a Nation need appropriate and adequate information flow from the lowest level of the administration to the highest decision making level. The most widely used data in Educational Planning are that of the All India Educational Surveys conducted by the National Council of Educational Research and Training from time to time.

National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) and National Informatics Centre (NIC) have initiated the 7th All India School Education Survey (AISES) as a joint project for creation of a uniform data base on School Education as reference date 30/09/2002. This project required a great deal of effort both from NIC Tripura State Unit and Education (School) Department, Govt. of Tripura for creation of this data base.

The present Survey used six schedules for collection of data covering every revenue village, urban area, recognized school and special school for the disabled. The number of data item on which the information were collected is very large. Further, mode of data collection being census type, volume of data has become very huge and the various processes involved before release of final statistics by the NCERT are data cleaning, analysis, tabulation and report writing. In order to make survey result available within the shortest possible time, it is planned to bring them in a phased manner. The present report of the Provisional Statistics is based on the tables generated from the 'Flash Statistics' sheets.

I am sure that this report will be useful to the planners, administrators and educationists and also to every-one who is interested in the educational welfare of the State.

P R E F A C E



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I : INTRODUCTION

Significance of the Survey:

There has been tremendous growth in educational facilities at all levels of education during the last 55 years of Independence. The growth in enrolment and schooling facilities at the primary and post primary stages of education was the result of the concerted government effort to implement the Directive Principle of the constitution to provide free and compulsory education up to the age of 14. The expansion at other stages was a consequence of the growing public demand for education in all sections of the society. For proper planning of schooling facilities at the grass-root level and for ensuring a balanced growth in all areas, rural and urban, it was felt that the educational statistics collected by the Ministry of Human Resource Development and other organizations annually from all the States, UTs in the country were not adequate as these statistics are more or less abstract in nature and do not cover the physical facilities available in the school and the extent of schooling facilities for different levels of school education available to the people at the grass-root levels. As a result, data gaps are noticed while formulating five year plans in particular. To bridge the data gaps the Ministry, therefore, asked the States, UTs through the NCERT to undertake All India Educational Surveys (AIES) from time to time. The present survey is the Seventh in the series of AIES. This Survey is renamed as 7th All India School Education Survey (AISES). It's date of reference is 30th September, 2002. It proposes to provide basic inputs required for future planning and management of school education, particularly, meeting the data needs for special initiatives in the field of elementary and secondary education.

Objectives of the Survey:

The special objectives of this Survey are as follows :-

- (i) To assess the availability of schooling facilities for primary, upper-primary, secondary and higher secondary stages within the habitations (including S.C/S.T) in different population slabs. In case the facility is not within the habitations, the distance at which available.
- (ii) To assess availability of basic facility in the recognized schools such as building, class-rooms, drinking water, electricity, urinals, lavatories, furniture for students and teachers, incentive schemes and beneficiaries and medical check-up and vaccination/ inoculation of students.
- (iii) To know class-wise enrolment (total, S.C, S.T and educationally backward minority community by sex) in Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary stages of recognized schools.

- (iv) To know the no. of children with disabilities enrolled at primary to higher secondary stages of recognized schools.
- (v) To find out the subject-wise enrolment by sex in academic stream and availability of qualified teachers at higher secondary stage of the school.
- (vi) To know the availability of science laboratories and library, physical education teachers, Librarian, guidance counselors, non-teaching staff in the recognized secondary and higher secondary schools.
- (vii) To assess the position of teachers (by sex and S.C/ S.T/ O.B.C/ Others) with academic and professional qualifications at different school stages in recognized schools.
- (viii) To find out distribution of recognized schools in regard to languages taught and languages used as medium of instruction.
- (ix) To find-out enrolment and teachers in primary/ upper primary classes of un-recognised schools.
- (x) To assess the position of enrolment and instructors in schools/ centres under Education Guarantee Scheme (EGS) and Alternative & Innovative Education (AIE).
- (xi) To find out no. of children and teachers by sex in pre-primary schools.
- (xii) To know the disability-wise enrolment, teachers, structural facilities, equipments and instructional material in special schools.
- (xiii) To find out the position of enrolment and teachers in oriental schools viz Moktabs, Madrassas and Sanskrit Pathshalas.
- (xiv) To estimate the class-wise enrolment by single age, new entrance, promotes, repeaters and attendance in the context of UEE under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA).

Operational aspects of the Surveys:

At the National Levels three organizations, namely, Union Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) and National Informatics Centre (NIC) are involved. The MHRD is to provide funds for

the Survey and administrative support. The NCERT is to share the responsibility of providing all academic inputs, management and co-ordination of Survey activity. The NIC will be responsible for computerization activities of the Survey and their co-ordination.

At the State level a State Survey Unit headed by the Director of School Education (Ex. Officio Director of Survey) was created and the State Survey Officer (SSO) is responsible for execution of all phases of the Survey activities. In addition District Survey Units headed by the District Survey Officer (DSO) at the District level and Block/ Town level Education Officer would be responsible for all the Survey activities within their respective District/Block/Town areas.

Besides, a State level Monitoring & Review Committee headed by the Commissioner, Education (School) Department was constituted for providing administrative and operational support to the State Survey Unit. The State Informatics Officer was included in the said committee for providing better co-ordination between the SSU and NIC.

To fulfill these objectives following tools were developed by the NCERT and canvassed to collect the relevant data from the sources :-

The first task of the Survey was to prepare comprehensive, up to data list of all recognized schools for each block/town (ward-wise in class-I cities i.e. more than one lakh population). Before starting of the data collection from the field necessary training was imparted to

the Survey officials at the State level for the DSOs and BEOs and at the district level for the concerned enumerators (teacher) involved in data collection.

The actual data collection was started from 10th March, 2003 i.e. immediately after General Assembly Election, 2003 of the State. When the said collection was over, manual scrutiny of all the filled in forms was undertaken 100% at the block level, 10% at the district level and 5% of each district on sample basis by the NCERT officials and State Survey officials. After that the District Survey Officers handed over the bundles of flash statistics sheets and main schedules separately of all the forms to the State NIC office at Agartala during June – July, 2003 for data entry. But actually the data entry work of 7th AISES Flash data was started from 8th March, 2004 by private data entry agency of New Delhi engaged by the NIC Head Quarter and completed the work by the end of May, 2004 after necessary validation which is approved by the NCERT.

The number of data items on which the information was collected is very large. Further, mode of data collection being census, volume of data has become very huge. The various process involved before release of final statistics are data cleaning, data analysis and tabulation. This process will take considerable time. In order to make available survey results within a shortest possible time, it is planned to bring out Provisional Statistics Report before the Main Report of the Survey is ready.

II : FINDINGS OF THE PROVISIONAL STATISTICS

During the reference date of the Survey i.e. 30/09/2002 there are 4 (four) Administrative Districts, 40 (forty) Development Blocks and 23 (twenty-three) Urban Areas including 1(one) Class I cities i.e. State Head Quarter Agartala.

The present Survey counted in all 7556 rural habitations in the State spread over 882 Revenue Villages as compared to 6802 habitations in Sixth All India Educational Survey. Thus, there is a growth of 11.08%. The number of habitations per village worked out to about 9 (Reference table PS-1).

Out of the total 7556 habitations, 2835 (37.52%) habitations are having the facilities of primary school/ section within the habitation itself and 5732 (75.86%) habitations are having the facilities of primary education within 1 k.m. On the other hand 907 (12%) habitations are having the upper primary schooling facilities within the habitation and 6038 (79.91%) habitations are having the upper primary education within 3 k.m. (Reference table PS-1).

There are 2054 primary schools out of which 1996 (97.18%) are in rural areas. There are 435 upper primary schools out of which 406 (93.33%) are in rural areas. There are 403 secondary schools out of which 362 (89.83%) are in rural areas. Again, there are 240 Higher Secondary schools out of which 161 (67.08%) are in rural areas. (Reference table PS-4 & P.S-2).

School building plays an important and vital role in proper functioning and development of schools. The conditions of school buildings sometimes distract the minds of the children and influence their performance in the school. The Government and Local Body spend a considerable amount of money every year on improvement of school buildings. Some important information on school buildings are available in the State Tables PS-5 to PS-16. It is seen from the State summary that 26.68% primary schools are having katcha building whereas 73.32% are having pucca/ partly pucca building. For upper primary there are 27.36% schools having Katcha building whereas 72.64% are having pucca/ partly pucca building. For Secondary, there are 18.11% schools having Kachcha building whereas 81.89% are having pucca/ partly pucca building. For Higher Secondary, there are 3.75% schools having Kachcha building whereas 96.25% are having pucca/partly pucca building. On a comparative study from the State summary on school building position it is seen that there has been a tremendous growth for pucca/ partly pucca buildings of all types of schools from the corresponding position in Sixth AIES.

The type-wise and class-wise enrolment details are available in the State Tables PS-17 to PS-31. From the State summary it is seen that the total enrolment in primary stage (I-V) is 4,49,465 out of which 2,14,520 (47.73%) are girls. The overall growth in enrolment as compared to Sixth AIES is 8.55% whereas for girls it is 13.24%. For upper primary stage (VI-VIII) the total enrolment is 1,80,513 out of which 85,548 (47.39%) are girls. The overall growth in enrolment as compared to previous AIES is 48.57% whereas for girls, it is 57.74%. For secondary stage (IX-X) the total enrolment is 82,637 out of which 38,386 (46.45%) are girls. The overall growth in

enrolment as compared to the 6th AIES is 42.93% whereas for girls, it is 54.20%. For Higher Secondary stage (XI-XII) the total enrolment is 29,861 out of which 12,404 (41.54%) are girls. The overall growth in enrolment as compared to the previous AIES is 39.08% whereas for girls, it is 59.66%. The overall enrolment for school education (I-XII) is 7,42,476 whereas for girls, it is 3,50,858 (47.26%). The overall growth in enrolment as compared to previous AIES is 20.76% whereas for girls, it is 26.97%.

There are 33,321 teachers working at all stages of education in the recognized schools in Tripura. Out of these, 27,477 (82.46%) are working in rural areas. There is an overall growth of 20.34% in compared to 6th AIES. Out of the total number of teachers, female teachers constitute 26.09% and male teachers 73.91%. The percentage of female teachers in primary, upper primary, secondary and higher secondary schools are respectively 19.06, 23.22, 25.76 and 34.48. Out of the total number of teachers in the State, 26.86% are working in primary schools, 17.02% in upper primary schools, 26.77% in secondary schools and 29.35% in higher secondary schools. There are 8,951 teachers working in primary schools, out of which 8,514 (95.12%) are working in rural areas. There are 5,672 teachers working in upper primary schools, out of which 5,160 (90.97%) are in rural areas. There are 8,918 teachers working in secondary schools, out of which 7,684 (86.16%) are in rural secondary schools. There are 9,780 teachers working in higher secondary schools, out of which 6,119 (62.57%) are in rural schools. The percentage increase in the number of teachers from the 6th AIES in respect of higher secondary schools is 60.93 whereas for rural areas it is 76.04. The detailed information in respect of all types of teachers are available in the State tables PS 32 to PS 43.

From the State tables PS 44 to PS 46 and State Summary it is observed that there were 16 (0.78%) primary schools in rural areas where no teachers was found to be posted on the date of Survey due to temporarily non-functioning of the schools. It is also seen that of the total 2054 primary schools, 172 (8.37%) were single teacher. Steps are being taken to provide additional teachers for all these single teacher primary schools mainly located in T.T.A.A.D.C areas. It is further seen that there were 569 (27.70%) schools which have 2(two) teachers and the rest 1,297 (63.15%) schools which have 3(three) or more teachers. Out of the total 58 primary schools in urban areas, 40 (68.97%) were found having more than 5(five) teachers. Further in urban areas 215 teachers school appear to be small in number i.e. 15 (25.86%). Thus the urban areas primary schools were having more number of teachers compared to rural areas primary schools.

From the Annexure-III, it is seen that the pupil-teacher ratio in primary schools is 23:1 whereas for upper primary schools the ratio is 20:1 and for secondary schools it is 23:1. The girls constitute about 47.26% of the total enrolment of school education. In rural areas, the same is 46.94%. Thus the boys-girls differentials are not very significant which may be considered as a good sign from the point of view of greater achievement of girls education. The corresponding figures in case of primary stage to higher secondary stages are 47.73%, 47.39%, 46.45% and 41.54% respectively. The same for rural areas are 47.62%, 46.89%, 45.15% and 37.42% respectively.
