The present issue of the "SOME BASIC STATISTICS OF TRIPURA-1990" is the thirteenth in the series. The main purpose is to highlight the major aspects of socio-economic development of the State during 1987-88 to 1990-91. To have complete picture of the changing economic situation of the State, it is presented in comparison with the situation in the preceding years.

In this issue one Table on Provisional results of 1991 Census, one Table on Immunization of Children against specified diseases and six Tables on Report of the Fourth Quinquennial Survey on Consumer Expenditure (43RD Round NSS) have been included. Provisional results of 1990 Economic Census have also been given in place of the results of 1980 Economic Census. Attempt has been made to up date the information of all statistical Tables on the basis of the latest available data relevant to the issue.

The Directorate of Statistics gratefully acknowledges the co-operation extended by various Departments/Organisations in bringing out this publication.

Suggestion for improvement of the publication are welcome.
