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

TIERINTARA EDUCATION :

1 Education.

In order to look after 30,000 of the very large number of under-age children (below 6 year) attending Primary Schools, 1000 Pre-Primary Centres will be opened at the rate of 1 centre for every 30 such children. One Matron/ Stip dary teacher will be engaged at Rs. 100/-p.m. in each Pre-Primary Centre and teaching materials worth Rs. 200/will also be purchased for each Centre. 100 such centres her been opened during 1978-'79. In 1979- 80, 200 Centres will be opened - 120 in the valley and 80 in the hills.

A sum of Rs. 20.00 lakhs will be required for the schema luring the 6th Plan Period.

- 2. Expansion of Facilities(salaries and non-teacher cost) :
 - (A) <u>Full Time</u> :
 - (i) Primary(Classes I-V)
 - (a) <u>Teacher Cost</u> :-

During the 6th Plan Period 438 single-teacher Lower Primary Schools will be opened in the schoolless villages - 428 in the Hills and 10 in the Valley. Another 1654 L.P. Schools(Classes I-II) will be upgraded to full fledged Primary Schools(Classes I-V) -854 in the Hills and 800 in the Valley. 2 additional teachers will be given to each of these up-graded - schools during the 6th Plan. 356 private Primary Schools - 315 in the Hills and 41 in the Valley will be given grant-in-aid for appointment of one teacher each.

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Altogether 4102 teachers - 2451 in the Hills and 1651 in the valley will be appointed during the 6th Plan Period for the Primary Education Programme.

During 1979-80, 660 teachers (400 in the Hills and 260 in the valley) will be appointed for (a) oppening 110 single-teacher schools - 100 in the Hills and 10 in the valley and (b) class III will be opened in all the 1654 existing L.P. Schools to be upgraded. No additional teacher will be provided for 1104 such schools during 1979-80. Only 550 L.P. Schools - (300 in the Hills and 250 in the valley) which may not be able to run class-III without additional teachers will be given 1 teacher each during the year.

The amount required for the year for teacher cost at Rs. 460/- p.m. per teacher in the Hills and Rs. 377 p.m. in the valley for 8 months will be Rs. 22.60 lakhs. A sum of 3.40 lakhs (Rs. 2.00 lakhs for the Hills & Rs. 1.40 lakhs for the valley) will also be spent as non-teacher cost during the year :

(ii) <u>Middle (Classes VI-VIII)</u>:

During the 6th Plan 240 existing Primary Schools. (40 in the Hills and 200 in the Valley) will be upgraded to Middle Schools. 80 Prime Middle Schools (46 Hills and 30 Valley) will be given grant-in-aid. Each of these upgraded and Added Schools will be given 5 teacher. Over and above this, 165 Science Teachers (77 in the Hills and 88 in the Valley) will be appointed in the 165 existing Middle Schools which have no qualified Science teachers. Altogether 1765 teachers (507 Hills and 1258 valley) will be appointed during the 6th Plan for expansion of Middle Education.

During 1979-80, 485 teacher (163 in the Hills and 322 in the Valley) will be appointed for 6 months at Rs. 616/- p.m. per head in the Hills and Bs. 493/-p.m. per head in the Valley. A sum of Rs. 25.55 lakhs will be required as teacher cost. Another sum of Rs. 2.00 lakhs

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will also be spent as non-teacher cost as shown below :-

(B) <u>Non-Formal Education(Part time)</u> :

During the 6th Plan Period 15,000 children in the age group 6-11 and 7,500 children in the age group 11-14 will be brought under the Non-Formal Education Programme 500 Centres for Primary Education and 250 Centres for Middle Education will be opened during the Plan Period. 3000 children of 6-11 and 1500 children of 11-14 will be brought under the programme every year.

During 1979-80, 100 Non-Formal Education Centres for Primary Education at the cost of Rs. 1,700/- per Centre (23 in the Hills and 77 in the valley) will be opened. 50 Centres for Middle Education (15 in the Hills and 35 in the Valley) at the cost of Rs. 2,700/- per Centre will also be opened. Administrative and Supervisory Staff will be appointed for proper implementation of the Programme.

The amount required for expansion of facilities during the 6th Plan is \mathbb{R}_{*} 425.00 lakhs. Amount required during 1979-80 is \mathbb{R}_{*} 47.65 lakhs(24.80 lakhs Hills and 22.85 lakhs valley).

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3. <u>Incentives</u> :-

Incentive programmes will be taken up from the year 1979-80 onwards. A sum of No. 17.00 lakhs will be required for the scheme during the 6th Plan.

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i) Free Books and Stationeries :

Free text books and stationeries will be given to 10,000 Primary pupils (4000 in the Hills and 6000 in the valley) each year @ Rs. 15/- per pupil. Similarly 3000 Middle pupils (1000 in the Hills and 2000 in the Valley) will be given books and stationaries worth Rs.50/-(per head each year. For 1979-80 a sum of Rs. 3.00 lakhs will be required.

v) Others :-

(a) Merit Scholarships :-

100 Primary and 50 middle scholarships will be given every year to meritoricus pupils @ R. 15/-p.m. and R. 25/- p.m. per pupil respectively. A sum of R. 0.35 lakhs will be required for 1979-80.

(b) Special Pre-Matric Scholarships :-

Special programme for SC/ST in the form of Pre-matric Scholarships for 1000 SC/ST pupils (900 ST pupils in the Hills and 100 SC in the valley) be given every year @ Rs. 10/- p.m. per head. A su of Rs. 1.20 lakhs will be required for 1979-80.

For 1979-80 a sum of Rs. 4.55 lakhs will be required for the programme as detailed below :-

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4. Construction of Buildings :

Programme for construction of new school buildings and extension of existing schools in the valley have been proposed under the State Plan. For the hills the construction programme will be proposed in the Central Additive Scheme of the Sub-Plan.

210 Primary School buildings in the Valley - 200 for buildingless schools and 10 for schooless villages will be constructed during the 6th Plan. 800 existing Lower Primary school buildings will be extended by 1 room each for their up-gradation to full fledged Primary Schools. 200 Primary school buildings will also be extended by 2 rooms each for their upgradation to Middle Schools. Existing Primary School buildings will be repaired and maintained. A sum of Ms. 190.00 lakhs will be required for the building programme during the 6th Plan.

6. QUALITATIVE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMME :

i) <u>Socially Useful Productive Experience</u>.

Socially useful productive experience will be introduced in 3000 Primary Schools (1500 in the Hills and 1500 in the valley) and 500 Middle Schools (160 in the Hills and 340 in the Valley) during the 6th Plan. Elementary teachers will be given Orientation Training for implementation of programmes. Simple implements and raw materials including vegetable and flower seeds will be provided for each school. A sum of Rs. 150/will be spent for each Primary School and Rs. 300/- for each Middle School. A sum of Rs. 6.00 lakhs is propose for the scheme during the 6th Plan.

In 1979-80, 750 Primary Schools (375 in Hills & 375 in Valley) and 125 Middle Schools (40 in the Hill & 85 in Valley) will take up the programme.

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ii) Science Education Programme. :

All the 3000 Primary Schools and 500 Middle Schools will be covered under the improved method of Science Education Programme. A sum of m. 32.00 lekhs will be required for this scheme during the 6th Plan Period.

During 1979-80, 500 Primary Schools (200 in the Hills and 300 in the Valley) will be covered under programme. A sum of Rs. 500/- will be spent on each school for imparting a 4-week orientation training to the teachers and supply of Science Kits to the Schools. Primary science text books in Manipuri will be produced for which a sum of Rs. 1.00 lakh is propos Similarly, teachers from Middle schools will be given 8 weeks' orientation Training and science kits will also be supplied to the schools. A sum of Rs. 3,000/will be spent for each school.

Science text books in Manipiri will also be produced for Class-VI. Science Seminars, workshops and other activities will also be taken up.

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II. <u>SECONDARY EDUCATION</u> :

During the 6th Five Year Plan facilities for Secondary Education will be expanded and existing facilities will be consolidated by providing additional staff and equipments as required under the new pattern of Secondary Education. Programme for implementation of 10+2 pattern of Education. Vocationalisation at the +2 stage will be taken up. Incentives will be provided in the form of books, stationeries and scholarships. School buildings will be extended, teachers' quarters & hostels will also be constructed. Quality Improvement ...Programme including strengthening of Science Education will be taken up.

A sum of Rs. 200.00 lakhs has been proposed for the 6th Plan for Secondary Education. - Rs. 120.00 lakhs for programme & Rs. 80.00 lakhs for capital expenditure.

For the year 1979-80 a sum of Rs. 25.00 lakhs is proposed - Rs. 15.00 lakhs for programme & Rs. 12.00 lakhs for capital expenditure.

Programme for 1979-80 :

1. Expansion of facilities :-

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(i) Institutional :-

The Government recently took over 107 Aided Secondary Schools. The total number of Government Secondary Schools has thus been increased to 157 (4 Hills & 110 valley). These schools will be strength by appointment of additional staff & purchase of equi ments etc. A sum of Rs. 2.00 lakhs is proposed for the scheme (Rs.0.70 lakhs for hills and Rs. 1.10 lakhs for valley).

2. Grant-in-aid to Non-Government Schools :

Out of the 80 purely private schools in the State 8 most deserving schools (4 in the Hills and 4 in the valley) will be given regular grant-in-aid during the year. A sum of Rs. 2.00 lakhs is proposed (Rs.1.00 lakh for Hills and Rs. 1.00 lakh for valley).

3. _ Implementation of 10+2 Pattern :

For implementation of the 10+2 pattern additional teachers will be appointed & existing teachers will be given orientation training. Teaching of Science in Higher Secondary Schools will be strengthened. A token provision of R. 1.50 lakhs is proposed (Rs.0.50 lakhs for Hills & Rs. 1.00 lakh for valley).

4. Vocationalisation of +2

Vocational survey will be organised in the hill districts & valley areas of the State. One school will introduce vocational courses. A token sum of Rs. 1.00 lat is proposed for the year.

5. Incentives :

Book Banks will be opened in 30 schools (12 in the Hills & 18 in the valley) for which books worth & 5000--will be given to each school. A sum of & 1.50 lakhs is required for the purpose. Special scholarships for SC/ ST & other poor & needy students will be given to 400 Secondary Schools pupils. A sum of & 1.00 lakh is proposed (Rs.0.40 lakhs for the Hills & Rs. 0.60 lakhs for valley).

6. <u>Construction of Buildings</u> :

10 teachers' quarters costing &. 25,000/- each will be constructed for Secondary Schools in the Hills. 11 Secondary Schools buildings (3 in the Hills 8 in the valley) will be extended at the cost of Ms. 50,000/- each. A sum of Ms. 5.50 lakhs will be required for this purpose.

7. Improvement Programme :-

(i) Strengtheing of Science Teaching.

Each Secondary School will be given at least one more science teacher so that each of them has two science teachers - one for Physical Science and Mathematics and another for life sciences. During the year 1979-80 70 science graduate teachers will be appointed (20 in Hills and 50 in the Valley). District Level and State Level Science Exhibitions will be organised. Science Clubs & Hobby Centres will be opened in selected Secon Schools. Selected teachers will also be given Orient Training in Science. A sum of Rs. 3.00 lakhs (Rs.1.00 i for Hills & Rs. 2.00 lakhs for valley) is proposed for year, 1979-80.

(ii) Work Experience/Socially useful productive experience

25 Secondary Schools (7 in the Hills and 18 in the valley) will introduce work experience programme. A sum of Rs. 4,000/- will be provided for each school for the programme.

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1. Elementary Stage :-

(a) During the 6th Plan Period 1000 Matrons/Stipendiary teachers will be given short term training course in nursery education to look after 30000 under-age children attending Pre-Primary Centres.

(b) 4000 Primary teachers will also be given training during the Plan period. The 4 Teachers' Training Institutions will be improved by strengthening their staff, purchasing additional equipments and extension of the institutional and hostel buildings. Deputation allowance @ R.50/per month per head will also be given to teacher trainees. A sum of Rs. 36.50 lakhs will be required for the scheme during the 6th Plan Period.

2. Secondary Stage :-

The intake capacity of the Government Post-Graduate Training College will be increased by 100 per year for which additional staff will be appointed, furniture and equipment purchased & buildings extended. A sum of R. 14.60 lakhs will be required for the purpose.

Contact-cum-Correspondence Courses will be organised for training of 400 Secondary School teachers in collabration with NCERT. A token provision of R. 2.00 lakhs is proposed.

Inservice Training Programme will also be organised for Secondary School teachers in/Post Graduate Training College. A sum of Rs. 2.00 lakhs is proposed.

The State Institute of Education will be strengthened by appointment of additional staff and construction of its own building for which a sum of Rs. 16.40 lakhs is proposed.

A separate State Institute of Science Education will be opened for properly looking after Science Education Programme in the State. A sum of No. 28.50 lakhs is proposed for staff, equipments & buildings etc.

The total requirement of teacher education during the 6th Plan is Rs. 100.00 lakhs (Rs. 56.00 lakhs for programme and Rs. 44.00 lakhs for buildings).

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IV. UNIVERSITY EDUCATION :

During the 6th Five Year Plan the Directorate of College and University Education will be strengthened. The J.N.U. Centre of Post Graduate Studies will be given grants for new programmes not covered by the U.G.C. Grants. The 15 Governmen Colleges including 9 Aided Colleges taken over by the Government recently will be improved. Deserving un-aided colleges will be given regular grants-in-aid. Colleges and University teachers will be encouraged to go in for Research work. Studenwelfare programme will be taken up. More Post-Matric Scholarships will be provided. Matching grants will be given to deserving colleges to enable them to lift U.G.C.grants. College and Hostel buildings will be improved/extended. A sum of ks. 290.00 lakhs including a token provision of Rs. 1.00 lakh for development of the J.N.U. Centre of Post Graduate Studies to a full fledged State University is proposed.
