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FOREWORD

The Third All India Educational Survey was started at the begining of 1974 with specific objective to provide data on school education about availability of schooling facilities (particularly in the rural areas), enrolment, teachers, equipment, etc. The Second All India Educational Survey was conducted in 1965 but compared to that the scope of the present survey was larger in respect of items on which information was collected and the types and levels of education covered.

The survey has been conducted in collaboration with the Departments of Education in the States and the Union Territories. Because of the large scope and coverage of the present survey two different strategies were adopted for processing and tabulation of data. While for some data it was decided to have manual tabulation first at the block level and further at the district and state levels, for the other set of data it was found more convenient to go in for computer processing.

Some of the States have finalised the manually prepared state tables. Others are in the process of completing this work. The computerised tables are likely to take some more time. As there is demand from several quarters to provide data on selected important items as early as possible, it has been decided to compile and release some selected tables for each state separately out of the manually prepared tables received from the different states.

Keeping in view this specific objective, the present set of "Selected Tables of Tripura" is being issued to provide minimum essential data for the benefit of educational planners, administrators and other interested persons. The set includes ten tables

three relating to institutions by stage and type, four relating to availability of schooling facilities in rural areas and three relating to enrolment. The reference date for the data contained in these tables is December 31, 1973.

Compilation of these tables has been possible largely due to the co-operation of Department of Education, Tripura. I express my gratitude to the Director of Education and the State Survey Officer who had the main responsibility for preparing the manual State tables and to Shri R.R. Saxena who compiled this set of selected tables in the present form out of the tables received from Tripura.

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Introduction

1.1 There are 3 districts in Tripura which includes 5229 villages comprising 6050 habitations and 6 urban areas. At the time of 1971 Census the population of the rural and urban areas was 1393982 and 162360 respectively. The rural population consitituted 89.57% of the total population. The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes constituted 12.39% and 28.95% of the total population respectively.

The estimated population in the rural areas as on 31.12.1973 was 1563307.

1.2 Educational Pattern

The educational pattern in the State is:

Primary stage - classes I to V

Middle stage - classes VI to VIII

High(Secondary stage) - classes IX to X

Hr. Secondary stage - classes IX to XI

1.3 For purposes of this survey a section in a particular stage is defined as comprising the independent schools alongwith those attached to the schools at other stages. For example the total number of primary sections provided include the independent primary schools together with primary stages attached to middle, high and higher secondary schools. This is true in respect of middle, high and higher secondary sections also.

There are 1759 primary sections in the State of which 1687 (95.91%) are located in rural areas. The number of middle sections are 367 of which 320 (87.19%) are in rural areas. Out of 38 secondary sections 37 (97.38%) are in rural areas. Out of 70 higher secondary sections 42 (60.00%) are in rural areas.

1.4 Schooling facility

1.4.1 <u>Primary stage</u> - At this stage 54.76% of the rural population has schooling facility in their own habitation and another 27.58% at a distance of 1 km. Thus about 82.35% of the total rural population is served by a primary section upto

a distance of 1 Km.

1.4.2 <u>Middle stage</u> - 64.40% of the population in rural habitations is served by middle schools or sections existing within 3 kms. of habitation of residence though only 19.34% of the population has this schooling facility in the habitation of residence.

1.4.3 <u>Secondary stage</u> - At this stage 26.58% of the population under discussion is served by high schools exist either in the habitation of residence or within a distance of 5 kms. though only 2.88% of the population is having this facility in the habitation of residence.

1.4.4. <u>Higher Secondary Stage</u> - At this stage only 3.25% of the population in rural habitations is served by facilities in the habitation of residence though about 54.38% of the population is served by schools within a walking distance of 8 kms.

1.6 Enrolment

The total enrolment at primary stage is 196646 and girls constitute 40.38% of this enrolment. Enrolment in rural areas is 176367 which is about 89.69% of the total enrolment in the state. Proportions of girls in rural and urban areas are 39.51% and 47.85% respectively.

Considering the pupils in the age group 6 to less than 11 and children in the age group 6 to 11 the proportions come out to be 70.42% and 100.35% for rural and urban areas respectively.

At the middle stage i.e. classes VI to VIII enrolment in rural and urban areas is 30128 and 11505 respectively and of these 36.52 and 49.27% are girls. Enrolment in rural areas constitutes about 72.37% the total enrolment.

Pupils in these classes belonging to 11 to less than 14 years age group constitute only 21.29% and 101.56 of the child population in respective. groups in rural and urban areas.

At secondary stage the enrolment falls further. For classes IX & X total enrolment is 9828 and 7463 for rural and urban areas, and the proportions of girls in the two cases are 32.87% and 45.13% respectively.

For class XI enrolment figures are 2555 and 2875 in rural and urban areas respectively. The proportion of girls at this stage is 28.26% and 40.00% respectively.

For PUC class enrolment in rural and urban areas are 11 and 173 respectively. The proportion of girls in these areas are 9.09% and 27.75% respectively.
