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FOREWORD

The usefulness of education statistics, not only for educational planning and administration, but also for manpower planning and administration, requires no reiteration. It is now well recognised that such education statistics, to be meaningful, will have to include not only all levels of education and training, but the formal as well as non-formal facilities. The Ministry of Education and Social Welfare, therefore, extended the scope of the Third All-India Educational Survey to cover educational and training facilities, formal and non-formal, at all levels and assigned the responsibilities for survey of the various aspects to a number of agencies. The IAMR was assigned the survey of technical and vocational education and training facilities at the school level outside the university system.

- 2. This publication, one of a series of Statewise publications, relates to technical and vocational education and training facilities at the school level in the State of Manipur. It is hoped that this will be found useful by planners and administrators particularly in the State of Manipur.
- 3. The Institute of Applied Manpower Research Survey was initiated by Dr. L.S. Chandrakant, the then Director of the Institute, and coordinated, during the initial stages, by Prof. M. Muthukrishnudu, Chief Coordinator, who has since returned to the College of Engineering, Kakinada (Andhra Pradesh).
- 4. We are grateful to the members of the Advisory Committee formed for the Third All-India Educational Survey for their very useful suggestions on various aspects of the IAMR Survey. All the institutions identified and addressed for information have provided the necessary data; as such the response in the State is 100 per cent.

INTRODUCTION

This Report presents the survey data regarding technical and vocational education facilities at the school level outside the university system in the State of Manipur. These data are part of the Third All-India Educational Survey undertaken by the IAMR at the request of the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare. It is pertinent to note that it is for the first time that a survey of all technical and vocational education and training institutions including all formal and informal institutions imparting technical and vocational education and training at the school level has been made.

2. The First All-India Educational Survey conducted in 1957 by the Ministry of Education in collaboration with all States and Union Territories and the Second All-India Educational Survey conducted in 1965 by the Ministry of Education and Social Welfare and the Planning Commission through the National Council of Educational Research and Training covered only the school education. Keeping in view the extended scope and coverage of the Survey, it was decided to involve a number of agencies in the survey to look after different aspects of education. Specifically the following agencies were involved:

1.	National Council of Educational Research and Training	School Education

3. The IAMR survey of technical and vocational education at school level outside the university system is in two parts:

<u>Part I</u> is an inventory of the educational and training facilities in technical and vocational education as on 31st December, 1973. The various items of this inventory are:

- (a) number of institutions with characteristics such as their location, type of management, availability of hostel residence, etc.,
- (b) courses of study with information about their level, admission requirements, duration, selection procedure and number of reserved seats*,
- (c) staff-teaching and instructional staff and other staff, male and female, sanctioned and in position, etc.,
- (d) student population by courses of study and number passing out, and
- (e) recurring expenditure.

Part II is an indepth study of the organisational structure of this system of education with a view to prepare its profile in terms of the agencies responsible and their respective roles, their staffing pattern, methods of recruitment and promotional channels; finance, control and supervision of institutions; responsibility for development of adequate facilities; maintenance of quality and standard of education; scope and content of various regulations governing vocational education and training.

While the inventory of facilities is attempted on a Census basis, the indepth studies of the system are planned on a sample basis.

4. The All-India Report is being brought out as a separate document. This Report relates to Part I of the Survey for the State of Manipur.

^{*} All-India Directory of Technical and Vocational Education and Training Institutions, published separately, provides information on courses of study along with their duration, admission requirements, selection procedure, etc., for individual institutions.

The State of Manipur covers an area of 22,356 Sq. Kms. and is 5... sparsely populated. According to the 1971 Census, it had a population of 10,72,753 persons and a density of 48 persons per Sq. Km. About two-thirds of its population are engaged in agriculture. There is no large-scale industry. Handloom weaving is taken up by a large number of persons as a cottage industry. The other cottage industries are sericulture, manufacture of bamboo and cane articles, leather goods, edible oil crushing and rice milling. As per the 1971 Census count, 33 per cent of the State's population were found to be literate against the all-India average of 29.35 per cent. Most of the technical and vocational education and training institutions in the State have come up only during the last decade and are concentrated in the Central district. It is hoped that the present Survey data on the technical and vocational education and training for the State as well as for its districts will provide bench-mark data for the State's developmental programmes.

Advisory Committee

6. An Advisory Committee consisting of representatives from various ministries and other organisations was formed to guide the Institute in carrying out the Survey. The Committee has been meeting from time to time and has taken a keen interest in the Survey work. The composition of the Advisory Committee is given at Appendix I.

General Comments

- 7. Before comments on individual tables are made, it will be worth while here to list a few points of general nature.
 - (i) Reference Data: The reference date for most of the data, except where it is explicitly mentioned, is 31st December, 1973. This reference date has been adhered to on the advice of the Union Education Minister and the Advisory Committee on Third All-India Educational Survey. This was also the reference date in the earlier two All-India Educational Surveys. Further, this date is considered to be more convenient and useful for planning purposes. As far as enrolment and the staff position are concerned, the information is with reference to this date, but the statistics on intake capacity, out-turn and expenditure relate to the academic year 1972-73.

- (ii) Location of Institutions: The rural/urban classification of institutions has been attempted on the basis of the 1971 Census classification of villages and towns. The category of "semi-urban" was found to be redundant.
- (iii) <u>Co-educational Institutions</u>: The category of co-educational institutions has been merged with the category of "institutions for boys".
- (iv) <u>Sanctioned Intake</u>: The sanctioned intake for all the courses and institutions pertains to the seating capacity for the first year of the course except for the Industrial Training Institutes, where it is for the entire course.
- (v) Education and Training Facilities: Some of the institutions exclusively provided in-service training facilities, while a few others did so along with some educational and training courses. Both of them have been covered by the Survey. However, the in-service training institutions with courses of less than one month's duration have been excluded. Similarly, all courses of less than one month's duration have also not been taken into account while giving the statistics on intake, enrolment and out-turn.
- (vi) <u>Classification of Institutions</u>: The institutions have been categorised into the following 20 groups:
 - 1. Polytechnics
 - 2. Industrial Training Institutes
 - 3. Junior Technical Schools
 - 4. Crafts and Handicrafts Schools
 - 5. Industrial and Technical Schools
 - 6. Agricultural Schools
 - 7. Forestry Schools
 - 8. Veterinary and Animal Husbandry Schools
 - 9. Nursing, A. N. M. and Health Visitors' Schools
 - 10. Pharmacy Schools
 - 11. Other Para-Medical Schools
 - 12. Schools for Training in Co-operation
 - 13. Commercial Training Schools
 - 14. Schools for Village Level Officials
 - 15. Mining Schools

- 16. Fishery Schools
- 17. Schools for Music, Dance, Drama, etc.
- 18. Schools for Drawing and Painting
- 19. Special Schools
- 20. Other Schools

The above classification has been followed to enable an easy comparison with the statistics made available by different agencies. For example, only those institutions have been taken, as polytechnics, industrial training institutes, junior technical schools, nursing, auxiliary nurse midwifery and health visitors' schools, etc., which are so recognised by their respective managing organisations like the Ministry of Education, the Directorate General of Employment and Training, the Nursing Council of India, etc. The nomenclature of some institutions did not very clearly indicate the nature of the education and training offered by them. These institutions have, therefore, been classified after taking into account the content and level of their courses.

Out of the above listed 20 categories of technical and vocational education and training institutions, Manipur had only the following twelve types of institutions:

- 1. Polytechnics
- 2. Industrial Training Institutes
- 3. Crafts and Handicrafts Schools
- 4. Industrial and Technical Schools
- 5. Agricultural Schools
- 6. Nursing, A. N. M. and Health Visitors' Schools
- 7. Schools for Training in Co-operation
- 8. Commercial Training Schools
- 9. Schools for Village Level Officials
- 10. Schools for Music, Dance, Drama, etc.
- 11. Schools for Drawing and Painting
- 12. Special Schools
- (vii) <u>Industrial and Technical Schools</u>: The category of 'Industrial and Technical Schools' is the residual category of technical institutions. Hence, all those institutions, which could not be covered by polytechnics, industrial training institutes, junior

technical schools and crafts and handicrafts schools, have been shown under this category.

- (viii) Staff: Information on staff was collected under four heads, viz., (i) teaching and instructional staff, (ii) workshop and laboratory staff, (iii) administrative staff, and (iv) class IV staff, by designation. However, on the advice of the Advisory Committee for the Survey of Technical and Vocational Education and Training, these have been regrouped into two broad categories of (a) teaching and instructional staff and (b) other staff. The reclassified category of teaching and instructional staff also includes the technical staff of workshop and laboratories called upon to take practical classes.
- (ix) Expenditure: The break-up of recurring expenditure was not available from a number of institutions. Therefore, only the total recurring expenditure of institutions has been given. Most of the institutions, specially in the public sector, expressed their inability to provide information on the recurring expenditure on land and building because they are looked after by the State public works department.
- (x) <u>Out-turn</u>: In some training institutions, there is no formal examination. The candidates undergoing a course of training are awarded a certificate after completion of the training. All such candidates are included in the out-turn.

Section II

STRUCTURE OF THE REPORT

- 8. The survey data presented in this report are broadly grouped into three parts. Part I-(A) covers inventory of all the recognised institutions imparting technical and vocational education and training in the State. This part presents information on the number of institutions, enrolment, out-turn, staff and recurring expenditure. These items have been further classified by certain characteristics such as rural and urban location, male and female break-up of student body, type of management of institutions, etc.
- 9. Part I-(B) of the report presents a districtwise analysis of the technical and vocational education and training facilities by various characteristics. This analysis of the survey data at the district level will be of immense use for drawing up district education plans. All these taken together will facilitate in determining the number and type of new institutions that could be set up in the future in view of the local requirements of the district.
- 10. Part I-(C) of the report deals with the facilities of technical and vocational education which are provided in the general high/higher secondary schools as elective groups or streams. These data have been collected through the aegis of the National Council of Educational Research and Training, New Delhi. The information on vocational streams of the high/higher secondary schools is provided on the number of institutions, enrolment and staff only. The institutions have been classified by their rural/urban location, type of management and district. The enrolment in different technical and vocational streams is given by rural/urban location of the institution and by type of management. Information on the staff pertains to only the teaching and instructional staff actually in position on the date of reference of the survey.
- 11. In the end, a list of all the institutions which formed the inventory of technical and vocational education and training institutions in the State is provided at Appendix II.

Brief Comments on Tables

- 12. (i) Tables 1 to 5 present the information on institutions and their characteristics such as age of the existing institutions, rural/urban location, type of hostel facility and type of management.
- (ii) Tables 6 to 12 present the information on pupils. This information is provided on intake, enrolment and out-turn of various types of courses separately for boys and girls. Tables 11 and 12 present a standardised classification of the sanctioned intake capacity, enrolment and out-turn according to four stages of general school education, viz., primary, middle, high/higher secondary and post higher secondary. This standardisation of enrolment and out-turn is attempted to have a broad idea of the level of education and training imparted by the technical and vocational education and training institutions. This information read along with similar stagewise enrolment and out-turn of the general education system will enable the educational planners to have a better estimate, if not a precise one, of the pupils in different educational stages. Only those courses, which had a duration of one full academic year, have been considered here. The classification of enrolment and out-turn in these stages has been worked out on the basis of minimum educational qualifications required for admission into various courses and the duration of the course. For example, if a particular course required illiterate or class III pass person and extended over a duration of one or two years, its enrolment and out-turn have been shown under 'primary' stage. Similarly, courses requiring SSLC or higher secondary as minimum educational qualification for admission have been shown under 'post higher secondary' stage. The consolidated information for a particular course, irrespective of its location into a variety of institutions, can also be had from Table 12.
- (iii) Tables 13 to 15 present data on the sanctioned and actual strength of staff of technical and vocational education and training institutions.
- (iv) Tables 18 to 20 provide data on recurring expenditure. While Table 18 presents the total recurring expenditure by type of institution and location, Tables 19 and 20 provide average recurring expenditure per institution and per student for all institutions and institutions meant for girls only, respectively.

- (v) Table 21 is a summary table and presents the information on institutions, staff, enrolment and recurring expenditure by type of management.
- 13. <u>District Tables A, B and C:</u> These tables give the districtwise inventory of technical and vocational education and training facilities. There are three tables for each district providing information on (A) number of institutions, (B) intake capacity, enrolment and outturn, and (C) sanctioned and actual strength of staff. It is considered that these data will be basic and sufficient for drawing up district level plans for technical and vocational education and training.
- 14. <u>Vocational Streams Tables I to VI</u>: These last six tables provide data on the elective streams offered by the high/higher secondary schools of the State.

Section III

SURVEY FINDINGS

- 15. On 31st December 1973, according to the present Survey, the State of Manipur had 51 technical and vocational education and training institutions. 'Schools for music, dance, drama, etc.', 'crafts and handicrafts schools' and 'commercial training schools' were the main types of institutions and they numbered 13, 11 and 9, respectively. There were three industrial training institutes and one polytechnic also.
- 16. Out of the 51 institutions, only twelve were located in rural areas. While the ten institutions located in the rural areas were financed and managed by the Government, only fourteen (out of the total 39) institutions located in the urban areas were financed and managed by the Government. From the point of view of hostel facilities, the institutions located in the rural areas were in a better position as seven of them had complete residential facilities and two others partial residential facilities; such hostel facilities in institutions located in the urban areas were available in eleven and eight institutions, respectively.
- 17. The institutions exclusively meant for girls number ten and they provide vocational training in the fields of handicrafts, nursing and music and dance. These institutions for girls were equally distributed in rural and urban areas (five each). Only two of these institutions did not have any residential facility. As many as seven of the girls' institutions had complete residential facilities. Only two institutions—one commercial and other drawing and painting—were offering part-time courses.
- 18. The districtwise distribution of the technical and vocational education and training institutions in the State shows their concentration in the District of Central Manipur. This district had as many as thirty-nine institutions. This concentration can be explained by the fact that the State's capital Imphal is located in this district. The other five districts of the State had either two or three institutions each.

- 19. The total enrolment in the 51 institutions was 4,767. While 1,393 students were enrolled in technical and industrial courses offered by polytechnics, industrial training institutes, crafts and handicrafts schools, and industrial and technical schools, 3,374 students were in other vocational courses. The sexwise break-up of the students was 3,135 boys and 1,632 girls. About 22 per cent students belonged either to scheduled tribes or scheduled castes. During the academic year 1972-73, as many as 1,681 persons qualified in the various courses.
- All the institutions, except one nursing centre, reported information on staff. The 50 reporting institutions were manned by 513 persons. Two-thirds of the total staff were teaching and instructional and one-third supporting and administrative. About 11 per cent of the total staff were females. There were 72 vacant positions at the end of 1973. The vacancies were mainly reported by the industrial training institutes, other industrial and technical schools and the schools for music, dance, drama, etc. The break-up of the vacant positions among the 'teaching and instructional staff' and 'other staff' was 31 and 41, respectively.
- 21. Information on recurring expenditure was also supplied by the 50 institutions (the special school did not supply this datum). The total recurring expenditure of these reporting institutions was R[§]. 2. 14 million.
- 22. Besides the above, the high/higher secondary schools of the State offered vocational streams in commerce, home science, agriculture, technical trades and music, dance and drama. The enrolment in these vocational streams was 313 students.
