Pattern of State Grant-in-aid for Institutions  
of Higher Education (Colleges of Higher Education)

1. Maintenance Grant in Rajasthan

(a) Recurring Grant

Category A	80 %	The annual recurring grant-in-aid to the institutions has been given on the basis of estimated expenditure of the current year since 1.4.70 subject to adjustment by the grant payable in the next year.
Category B	70 %

Note: The total recurring grant shall not exceed the difference between the total approved expenditure and income from fees and other sources during the same year including grant from State and Central Govt. / Societies and Local bodies. The maintenance grant is given for pay, O.A. and Advi. O.A. and P.F. It does not include the following allowances:

- (a) Medical Re-imbursment
- (b) House Rent Allowances
- (c) City Compensatory Allowances

(b) Non-Recurring Grant

Building / Hostel

Non-recurring grant up to 50% of the total approved and actual expenditure or actual expenditure whichever is less can be sanctioned on the construction, repairs and extension of buildings including hostel.

Furniture/ Equipment/ Library books

On the above items, grant up to 50% of the approved or total expenditure, whichever is less is sanctioned.

Bus grant

Twenty-five percent of the controlled price for purchase of replacement is allowed after 10 years.

Eligibility for grant-in-aid

The Institution will be eligible for grant-in-aid only if it has existed for one year. But now Government has revised the policy according to which grant-in-aid to any institution shall not be entertained before completing three years for boys and two years for girls.

Grant-in-Aid Committee

There is a Grant-in-aid Committee consisting of the following members:

- a) Director, Primary & Secondary Education
- b) Director of College Education
- c) Director of Sanskrit Education
- d) Director of Technical Education
- e) Dy. Director of Each Range
- f) Chairman, Board of Soc. Education
- g) A representative of Finance Deptt.
- h) Three eminent Non-official Educationists

Expenditure on contingency

Grant-in-aid is also provided to the institutions on the contingency expenditure on the following items as per norms prescribed in the rules.

- 1. Stationery and Printing
- 2. Water & Light charges
- 3. Recurring expenditure on equipment As per norms of the University.
- 4. Ordinary repairs to the building 1% of the cost of pucca building and 2% of Kachha building.
  - a) building
  - b) Furniture & its replacement
- 5. Library books and reading rooms As per norms of the University.
- 6. Games, Physical Education & Extra-curricular activities
- 7. Crafts, Agr. Dairy Home Sc. etc.
- 8. Travelling Allowance of teachers attending conferences
- 9. Postage & Telegram
- 10. Audit fees
- 11. Telephones
- 12. Potty items

Salary Scales of Teachers

In Rajasthan the scales of pay and allowances to the staff of aided institutions are the same as have been prescribed for staff of similar category in Government Institutions. Medical re-imbursment, House rent Allowance and City compensatory allowance, benefit of surrender leave are not given to the staff of aided colleges.

Fees

Fee Income from the fees charged at rates higher than Government rates to the extent of actual excess realized is not considered as income for Grant-in-aid purposes.
