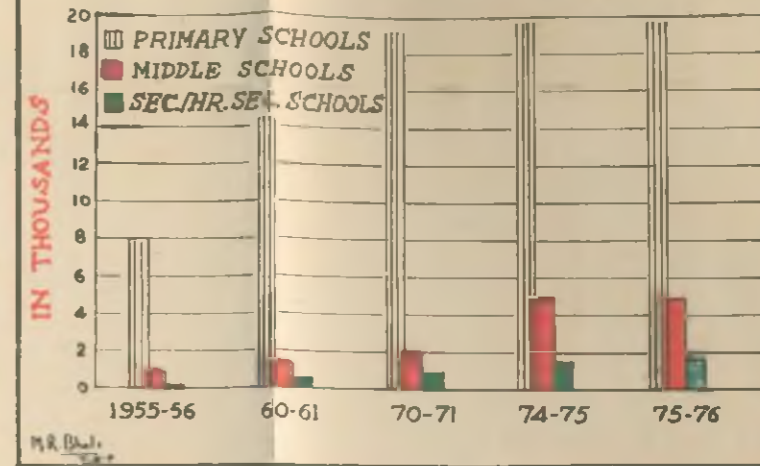

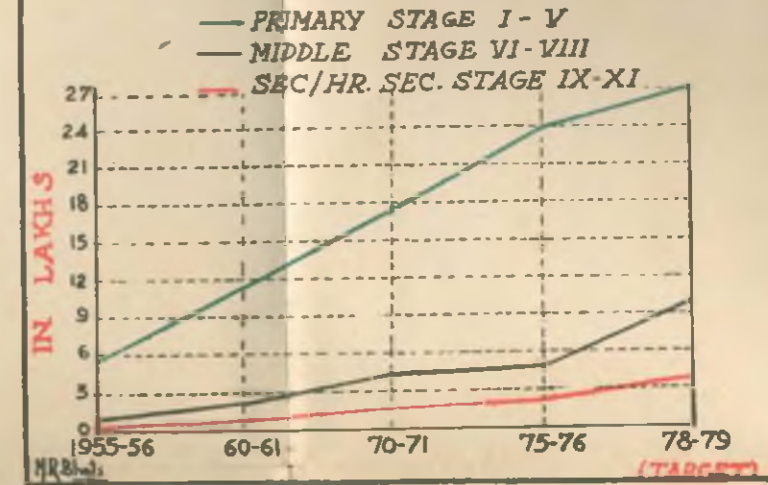

NO. OF TEACHERS

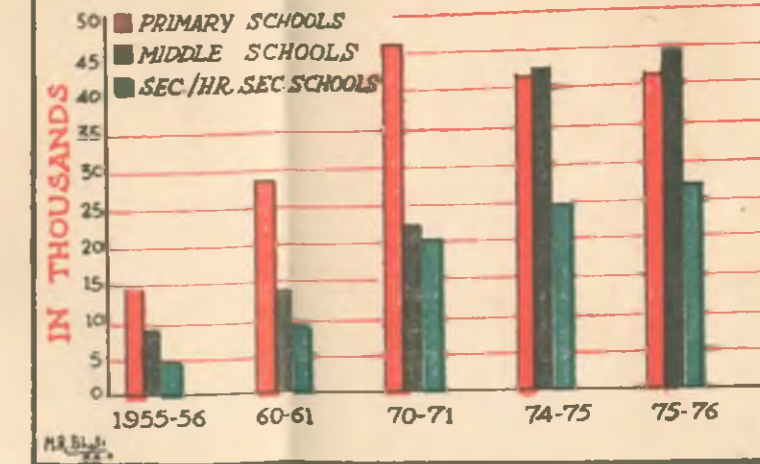
