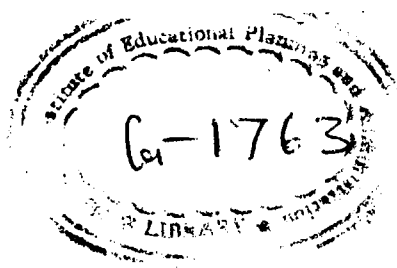

_P_R_E_F_A_C_E_

This publication entitled "Second Educational Statistics 1976-77" is the second in the new series to be brought out annually. This replaces the previous publication of this Ministry entitled 'Educational Statistics at a Glance' which included a few more items. The sixth National Conference on Educational Statistics recommended that as far as possible current statistics should be published during the same year to which they relate, at least in respect of the most essential items.

The reference date for the statistics contained in this publication is 30th September, 1976. Since we were anxious to bring out this publication quickly, the collection and compilation of the data has not been subjected to thorough scrutiny and therefore, may be treated as provisional. Population estimates based on 1971 census age distribution have been incorporated and it has involved many changes in enrolment ratios.

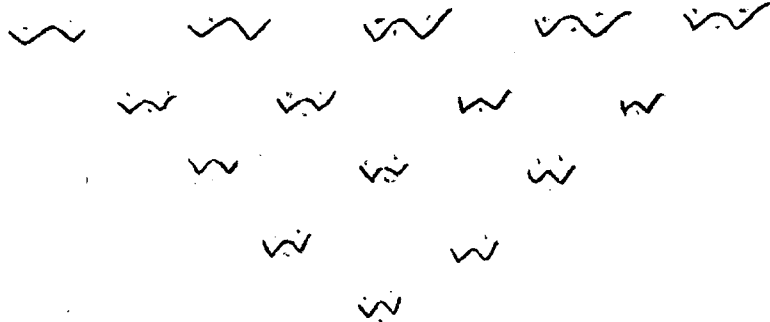

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A B S T R A C T

1. POPULATION

The estimated population of India on the basis of 1971 age distribution has been estimated for 1976 as 60.6 crores. Of this about 8.3 crores (13.7%) belonged to age-group 6-11, 4.5 crores (7.4%) to age-group 11-14 and 4.1 crores (6.7%) to age group 14-17 years and 16.9 crores (27.8%) to age-group 6-17. For the year 1977 out of 61.8 crores, about 8.34 crores (13.5%) belonged to age-group 6-11, 4.6 crores (7.4%) to age-group 11-14 and 4.2 crores (6.8%) to age-group 14-17 years and 17.1 crores (27.7%) to age-group 6-17.

2. INSTITUTIONS

There was an all round increase in the number of educational institutions, table I below gives a comparative position of some categories of institutions in 1975-76 and 1976-77.

3. ENROLMENT

The enrolment in school, classes I-V, VI-VIII and IX and above changed from 647.1, 159.4 and 88.1 lakhs in 1975-76 to 675.3, 170.1 and 87.7 lakhs respectively in 1976-77.

4. TEACHERS

The number of teachers in primary, middle and high/higher secondary schools increased from 12.43, 7.79 and 7.17 lakhs in 1975-76 to 13.40, 7.15 and 7.36 lakhs respectively in 1976-77. The total number of teachers in all types of school for general education increased from 27.39 lakhs (20.48 lakh men and 6.91 lakh women) in 1975-76 to 27.94 lakhs (20.72 lakh men and 7.19 lakh women) in 1976-77, the rate of increase being about 2%. The percentage of trained teachers in primary, middle and high/higher secondary schools was 85.5, 86.1 and 84.8% respectively.

5. BUDGET PROVISION

The total budgeted expenditure (Education Departments only) in respect of the States and Union Territories increased from Rs. 1583.61 crores in 1975-76 to Rs. 1821.25 crores (Rs. 164.53 crores plan and Rs. 1656.72 crores non-plan) in 1976-77 showing an increase of about 15%. The percentage of budgeted expenditure on education to total State budget ranged from 9.2% in Sikkim to 37.1% in Kerala in respect of States and 8.2% in Arunachal Pradesh to 39.4% in Delhi in case of Union Territories. But per capita budgeted expenditure on education in the States was lowest in Bihar (Rs 17.7) and highest in Nagaland (Rs 100.3), while in case of Union Territories it was lowest in Arunachal Pradesh (Rs 48.0) and highest in Chandigarh (Rs 158.4)
