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## <u>PART 1</u>.

#### CHAPTER - I.

#### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

Kanyakumari District is the Southern most part of India comprising four Taluks Thovalai, Agastheeswaram, Kalkulam and Vilavancode of Tamil Nadu. In the annals of ancient History this region was the part of Venadu, a small Independent State later expanded to Travancore State. It was also known as Vanchinad, the glorious land of lakes and hills. The most fertile land, Nanjilnadu, is in Kanyakumari District and is famous for extensive paddy cultivation. The District was highly prosperous and self-sufficient even in ancient periods with a great cultural heritage. The local people had the martial status and they were the great warriors who kept the enemies and conquerers away who came to plunder the a ancient monuments and temples of this district. Chanda Sahib, Mukilan and many other conqurers had to face defeat and extinction when they came to conquer this part of the State. There were so many places connected with their names as Mukilankudi, Muhilankarai and Khankarai in this District.

The famous Bahagavathi Amman Temple at Kanyakumari is known all over India and famous. The Magnificient Temple at Suchindrum is famous for architecture and high Gopuram. The Historic Temple at Thiruvattar is situated in this District. The famous Padmanabhapuram Palace within the ancient fort, the ancient harbour at Colachel and innumerable monuments are here in this small district. There are many ancient Churches, Mosques and Jain Temples carved inside rocks here.

Tourist Centres like Thirparappu Falls, Vattakottai, Great Dams of Pechipparai, Perunchani and Kothayar, vast and intricate canel system like Pattanamkal are here in this District.

Vivekananda Rock Memorial erected on the rock in the sea where Swamy Vivekananda spent three days in Meditation before going to Chicago is considered as one of the most beautiful monuments of the contemporary period.

The total population of the District as per 1981 census is 1411878 of which 245532 are in Urban Areas and 1166346 are in Rural areas. Women population is almost equal in certain areas to men population. Of the total population 711410 are men and 700468 women. The Scheduled Caste Population is 59730 and the Scheduled Tribe Population is 6367. In Tamil Nadu, this district is the most densly populated area. The First English School in the Erstwhile Travancore State was First started at Mylaudy in the present Kanniyakumari District. As it was the part of the Erstwhile Travancore-Cochin State, the percentage of literacy is higher than in any other district in Tamil Nadu. Female Literacy rate is very high and it is nearly equal to male literacy as can be seen from the various statistical data given in the 1981 census and in the present survey.

The District is Backward where industrial development is concerned. The Chief Occupation of the people is traditional cultivation of paddy and coconut besides Plantain and Rubber in certain areas. There are no major industries worth mentioning. Cottage Industries like Matchmaking, Weaving, Cashew Factories are seen in some areas, but any big Industry involving a substantial investment of capital is absent. But the Indian Rare Earths at Manavalakurichy is a Public Sector enterprise worth mentioning. Very recently industries using coconut fibre as raw-material are gradually developing in the Coastal areas. The Rubber Plantation in this district is a great source of income in the Eastern Hilly parts of the District.

The District has different religious groups having a variety of cultural heritage. As already mentioned traditional forms of arts and architecture are preserved and nourished.

#### 2. FIFTH ALL INDIA EDUCATIONAL SURVEY:

The Fifth All India Educational Survey has been completed in this District along with the other districts of Tamil Nadu this year. This was a very comprehensivo survey and the process was an elaborate one. The Survey touched all the aspects of Social Life besides the mainpoint of Educational achievement. The crucial date of the survey is 30-9-1986. Hence all the data were collected as on 30 9-1986 by the appropriate agencies. Block level information were collected by the Deputy Inspectors of Schools through the Headmasters of Primary, Middle, Secondary, and Higher The Headmasters were supplied with Secondary Schools. two types of formats, one relating to the school in which they worked and another one to collect the various statistical data of the revenue village in which the school is situated.

There are 94 Revenue Villages in this district as per the 1981 census out of which only 87 are inhabited. In case the Village has a recegnised school in it, the format was to be filled up by the Headmaster of the school in consultation with the village officer. If the Village has more than one school, the format was to be filled by the Headmaster of the School which has the highest school class. However if the village has no school in it, the form was to be filled by the Headmaster of the school located in the nearest village in consultation with the village officer concerned.

In this connection it will be useful if a brief description of the questionnaire given to the Headmasters to collect various statistical data is given. Three types of questionnaire were given. The first was the school information form (S.I.F.). The Second was the Village Information Form (V.I.F.), and the third the Urban Information Form (U.I.F.). The questionnaire were to be filled up by the Selected Headmasters. All the Headmasters were to fill up the School Information Form whether they were Headmasters of Primary, Middle, In addition to it the Secondary or Higher Secondary Schools. Headmaster of the school which has the highest school class was to fill up the Village Information Form. The Urban Information Form was to be filled up by the District Survey Officer with the help of the concerned Deputy Inspector of Schools after consulting and collecting details from Urban authorities.

#### (A) SCHOOL INFORMATION FORM (S.I.F.):

This form was meant to collect data on schools, their location, enrolment, teachers and other facilities. The form was to be filled up by all Headmasters of recognised schools. Only informations in respect of the recognised schools were incorporated in the 5th All India Educational Survey. The Schools come under four Types: (1) Government Schools, (2) Local Body Schools, (3) Private Aided, and (4) Private Unaided. A school is considered a Boys school if boys are admitted to all classes and admission of girls is restricted to some specific Classes only. Similarly a school is a Girls School if girls are admitted to all classes but admission of boys is restricted to some specific classes only. A school is co-educational if both boys and girls are admitted to all classes in the school. In this questionnaire informations regarding 44 items were to be collected and filled up by the concerned Headmaster.

#### (B) <u>VILLAGE INFORMATION FORM (V.I.F.)</u>:

This Questionnaire seeks information relating to population, schooling and other educational facilities in the village. A village has several habitations. Information has to be provided separately for each habitation in the village. A habitation is defined as a distinct cluster of houses existing in a compact and continuous manner with a local name. Any habitation with population less than 10 in hilly desert areas or with populations less than 25 in plain areas may not be given a separate status of a habitation and its population

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be included in the nearest habitation of the same village. In this questionnaire information regarding centres for nonformal and adult education was also collected. There are 15 items in this questionnaire and the concerned Headmaster was responsible for collecting correct data with the help of the Village Officers.

#### (C) URBAN INFORMATION FORM (U.I.F.):

Information regarding towns and cities is shown in this format. If it is a Municipality the particulars are to be collected after consulting the Municipal Commissioners. In this format particulars of slums and floating population are included. Only particulars regarding the schools situated in the towns and Municipalities are gathered in this questionnaire. In Kanyakumari District there are four Municipalities, Nagercoil, Colachel, Padmahabhapuram and Kuzhithurai. There is only one township at Kanyakumari. Particulars of slum area are collected only from Nagercoil Municipality as there are no slum areas in any other part of the District.

The various informations gathered in the three questionnaire were consolidated by the Deputy Inspectors of Schools in the Printed Forms supplied to them (Block Tables). All the Headmasters were given training regarding the collection of data and filling fhe forms by the District Survey Officer and the Deputy Inspector of Schools. All the 9 Deputy Inspectors of this District were given intensive training before hand for this purpose by the District Survey Officer. After getting the consolidated report from the Deputy Inspectors of Schools the District Survey Officer prepared the District Report and the District Report was submitted to the State Survey Officer to prepare the State Report.

Concepts of habitation and village, and types of schools covered have been explained already. There are 1139 habitations spread over 87 inhabited Revenue Villages in 9 Panchayat, Union Blocks, four Municipalities and a township. From the 1981 census the population of the District was gathered and from this figure the estimated population for the crucial date of 30-9-1986 arrived by adding 1.63% increase for every year. For Tamil Nadu the estimated population could be arrived at by adding 9% for every 5 years.

Some parts of this district are bilingual. In Vilavancode and Kalkulam Taluks there are substantial number of Malayalees. Their children have the facility of learning in mothertongue and in many schools parallel sections are maintained for Malayalam. In Agastheeswaram and Thovalai Taluks also there are some sections in certain schools for linguistic minorities. In the present Survey various data relating to the medium of instruction were also gathered.

One of the salient features of the 5th All India Survey is that it is all comprehensive and vast. Almost all aspects of the Educational level were included. The task was very laborious and time consuming one. Also the full co-operation and sincere effort of all personnel engaged in collecting data were necessary. Those aspects which were left out in earlier surveys have been included in the present survey, so that the Government of India can get a clear picture of the level of achievement better than earlier surveys.

Even minute details regarding the availability of teaching materials like furniture available for teachers and learners, total number of library books available in each school, magazines and news papers available etc., were collected in the present survey. Operation Blackboard has been given a very important place and separate survey on this subject has been taken along with other details. It is not enough to note that a particular school has playground but it should be specifically mentioned whether the playground is owned by the school whether it is adequate and whether it is in usable condition. It is not enough to mention that a particular school has necessary play materials, but specific mention should be made on the items available and whether these items are used or not. From this it can be seen that great importance has been given to collect the information regarding every minute item in the school. Hence the present survey will be a guideline on which the Government of India can proceed to implement the New Education Policy on a National out-look.

#### CHAPTER - II.

#### PRIMARY EDUCATION.

In Kanniyakumari District all the Primary Schools are managed by either State Government, or by Private Management. There are no Panchayat Union Schools in this District.

(1) There are 1139 habitations with a population of 1292982 in this District. Out of which 444 habitations with a population of 758527 are served with Primary Education facility within the habitation, 281 habitations with a population of 219153 within a distance of 0.5 K.M., 254 habitations with a population of 205209 within 1 K.M. and the rest 160 habitations with a population of 110093 are served with the same facility on a distance of above one to two K.ms.

(2) There are 9 Blocks in this District with 1139 habitations. Out of which 979 habitations with a population of 1182839 are served with Primary Education facility within a distance of 1 k.m. and 107 Habitations with a population of 103264 are yet to be provided with primary education facility as proposed in table No.3.

(3) Out of the total 87 inhabited Revenue villages, 79 villages with 25% S.C. population have primary education facility in them. 27 Villages have 25% S.T. population and these villages are also provided with primary education facility.

(4) There are 295 Primary Schools in Rural areas(Government Schools: 193, Private Aided: 101 and Unaided: 1)

and 46 Primary Schools in Urban Areas (Government Schools: 26, Private Aided: 20) in this District. Also **144** Middle Schools (139 in Rural areas - Government run schools 100 and Aided 39) and 5 Middle Schools in Urban area (All Government Schools) are having Primary sections with them. Besides 59 High Schools in Rural areas (51 Government and 8 Aided), 9 High Schools in Urban areas (7 Government and 2 Aided) and 15 Higher Secondary Schools (All Government Institutions) in Rural areas and 6 Higher Secondary Schools (5 Under Government and 1 Aided) are also having Primary sections attached to them.

(5) In Rural areas 207 schools are having pucca
buildings, 33 schools are having partly pucca buildings,
15 Schools are having Kucha buildings and 40 schools are
having thatched huts.

In Urban areas 32 Schools have pucca buildings, 7 Schools have partly pucca buildings, 4 Schools have Kucha buildings, 3 Schools have thatched huts. No school is running in open space.

(6) Out of 341 Primary Schools, 86 Schools have more than 10 rooms, 25 Schools have 8-9 Rooms, 28 Schools have
6-7 rooms, 65 schools have 5 rooms, 33 schools have
4 rooms, 36 schools have 3 rooms, 30 schools have
2 rooms and 38 schools have only one room.

(7) Additional rooms are required for 158 schools One room is required for 21 schools, 2 rooms are required
for 47 schools, 3 rooms are required for 29 schools and

more than 4 rooms are required for 61 schools.

(8) The majority of the primary sections have enough black-boards and roll up black-boards. There are 3609 sections in the 341 primary schools. In all these schools 3201 sections have usable black-boards, 315 black-boards are unserviceable, 93 sections have no black-board at all.

Adequate drinking water facilities are available
 in 285 schools. Urinals are available in 254 schools. Out
 of 254 Urinals, 139 are separately for girls.

Free medical check up is carried out in all Primary Schools. In practice medical check up for all pupils is carried out atleast once in every academic year.

(10) Out of 341 Primary Schools 17 have two teachers,
8 have three teachers, 9 have four teachers, 81 have five
teachers and 226 have more than five teachers in them.
There is no single teacher school in this district.

(11) In primary stages 4902 teachers are working. Out of them 1972 are men and 2930 are women. Among them 3651 teachers are employed in rural areas (1539 men, and 2112 women) and 1251 teachers are employed in Urban areas (433 men and 818 women). There is no untrained teacher in any of these schools.

(12) Enrolment in Primary stage is 245073 pupils.Out of these, 123949 are boys, 121124 are girls.

23488 (Boys: 11971; Girls: 11517) are Scheduled Castes and 466 (Boys: 249, Girls: 217) are Scheduled Tribes. Out of the total enrolment 86.7 are in rural area and 13.3 are in urban area.

(13) Percentage of enrolment in classes I to V (Age group 6 - 11) in Rural area is 99.75% and that in Urban area is 99.85%. The disparities between enrolment of pupils in rural and urban and between boys and girls are only marginal. The gross enrolment ratio in primary stage is 99.75% in rural areas, 99.85% in urban areas. The pupil teacher ratio in rural and urban area is 1 : 35. The percentage of girls enrolment in rural area forms 49.5% and in urban area forms 48.8%.

#### CHAPTER - III

#### UPPER PRIMARY EDUCATION.

(1) Out of 1139 habitation with a population of 1292982 in this district, 267 habitation with a population of 542084 are served with upper primary education facility within the habitation. 816 habitations with a population of 727573 are served with upper primary education within a distance upto 3 K.M. 35 habitation with a population of 19172 are served with upper primary education within a distance upto 4 K.M. 13 Habitation with a population of 2745 are served with upper primary education within a distance upto 5 K.M. and 8 habitation with a population of 1408 are served with upper primary education of 1408 are than 5 K.M.

(2) 1083 habitations with a population of 1269657 are served with upper primary education within a distance upto
3 K.M. and in 11 habitations with a population of 8837, the upper primary sections are proposed to be opened.

Out of 79 villages having Scheduled Castes population, 78 are served with Upper Primary Education. All the
 27 villages having Scheduled Tribe Population are served
 with Upper Primary Education.

(4) There are 144 Upper Primary Schools in this District out of which 105 are Government Schools and 39 are under Primary Management 139 schools are in rural areas and 5 schools are in Urban areas. According to the stage out of total 346 schools having Upper Primary Schools, 200 Schools are Government and 146 are under Private Management, 303 are in Rural areas and 43 are in urban areas.

(5) In rural areas 94 Upper Primary Schools are having pucca buildings, 20 Upper Primary Schools are having partly pucca building, 13 Upper Primary Schools are having Kucha Buildings, 12 Upper Primary Schools are having thatched huts. In Urban Area all the 5 Upper Primary Schools have pucca Buildings. No Upper Primary School is in tents or in open Space.

(6) All the 144 Upper Primary Schools in this district are having library out of which 16 schools are having upto 100 books, 19 schools are having upto 200 books, 60 schools are having upto 500 books, 34 schools are having upto 1000 books and 15 schools are having more than 1000 books.

(7) Out of 139 Upper Primary Schools in Rural areas 111 Schools are having drinking water facilities. 112 Schools are having Urinals 68 Schools are having separate urinals for girls, 48 Schools are having lavatory and 36 schools are having separate lavatory for girls. All the 5 Schools in urban areas are having drinking water facilities and urinals. 4 Schools are having lavotary and separate urinals for Girls.

(8) In Upper Primary Stages there are 3120 (1404 Male and 1716 Female) matriculate trained teachers, 27 (19 Male and 8 Female) Higher Secondary/Inter/PUC trained teachers,
117 (82 male and 35 female) Graduate trained teachers,
30 (23 male and 7 female) Post Graduate trained teachers,
52 (29 male and 23 female) Ianguage teachers and 41 (13 male and 28 female) Other trained teachers. There is no untrained teacher in this District. Out of the total 3631 upper primary stage teachers, 3145 (1470 male and 1675 female) are in rural areas and 486 (189 male and 297 female) teachers are in Urban areas.

(9) The enrolment in Upper Primary stage is 98141 out of which 78768 (41656 boys and 37111 girls) are in rural areas and 19373 (9839 boys and 9534 girls) are in Urban areas.

(10) Percentage of Upper Primary Education in Std.VI-VIII who are in age group 11.14, in Rural area is 80.6% in Urban area is 95.7% (Gross Enrolment ratio in Rural area is 80.6% and in Urban area is 95.7%. Pupil teacher ratio in rural area is 25 and in Urban area 36. Percentage of enrolment in Girls in Rural area is 47.1 and in Urban area is 48.7.

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#### <u>CHAPTER - IV.</u>

#### SECONDARY AND HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION.

(1) Out of 1139 habitation with a population of 1292982 in Kanyakumari District 1116 habitation (with a population of 1290638) are served with secondary education within a distance of 8 Kms. 145 Habitation with a population of 334642 are served with Secondary Education within the habitations.

(2) 1107 habitation with a population of 1281638 are served with Higher Secondary Education within a distance of 8 Kms. Out of which 59 habitation with a population of 151516 are served with Higher Secondary Education within the habitations.

(3) There are 61 Government Secondary Schools and 59
Secondary Schools under Private Managements (Total 120 Secondary Schools). Out of which 104 are in Rural areas and 16 are in town areas. According to the Stage of Secondary Schools,
95 Government Schools and 118 Private Management Schools are having secondary classes (Total 203 Schools have Secondary sections) out of which 165 are in Rural areas and 38 in Urban areas.

(4) There are 34 Government Higher Secondary Schools
 and 49 Under Private Management. Out of the total 83 Higher
 Secondary Schools in this District, 61 are in Rural areas and
 22 are in Urban areas.

(5) 117 Secondary Schools are having library facilities
 out of which 101 are in Rural areas and 16 are in Urban areas.
 All the 83 Higher Secondary Schools are having library

(6) In the Secondary Stages there are 1020 Graduate trained. Teachers, 240 post Graduate trained teachers 391 Language teachers and 373 other teachers. There is no untrained teacher in this District. Out of the total 2024 Secondary Stage teachers 1610 (785 female) teachers are in Rural areas and 414 (195 female) teachers are in Urban areas. Total 1044 male and 910 female teachers are in Secondary Stage.

(7) In the Higher Secondary stage there are 749 Graduate trained teachers 877 post graduate/Doctorate trained teachers 238 Language teachers and 256 other trained teachers. There is no untrained teachers. Out of the total 2120 Higher Secondary stage teachers 1469 (596 female) teachers are in rural areas and 651 (295 female) teachers are in urban areas. Total 1229 male teachers and 891 female teachers are in Higher Secondary stage.

(8) Out of the 120 Secondary Schools 70 Schools in Rural areas and 9 Schools in Urban areas in this District are having laboratories. Totally 79 Secondary Schools have **library** facilities out of which 29 are Government Schools and 50 are under private management.

(9) All the 83 Higher Secondary Schools have
laboratory facilities out of which 67 schools are having
separate laboratory for Physics, Chemistry and Biology and
16 schools are having combined lab. for all subjects.

(10) According to the teachers teaching science subjects at Secondary Stage 231 teachers are having M.Sc., and 489 teachers are having B.Sc., qualification. Total 720 teachers are teaching science subjects in secondary stage. In Higher

Secondary stage 532 teachers are teaching science subject out of which 240 are post graduates (M.Sc.) 292 are graduates (B.Sc.).

(11) In Secondary Stage total enrolment is 41230 out of which 21579 are boys and 19651 are girls. 5461 (2806 Boys and 2655 Girls) are Scheduled Castes and 159 (67 Boys and 92 Girls) are Scheduled Tribes. In Higher Secondary stage, total enrolment is 17577 out of which 9492 are boys and 8075 are girls. 1729 (911 boys and 818 Girls) are scheduled Castes and 43 (26 boys and 17 girls) are Scheduled Tribes).

(12) Out of 120 Secondary Schools, 116 Schools are
having facility for drinking water 118 schools are having
Urinals, 104 Schools are having lavatory and 98 Schools are
having separate lavatory for Girls. Out of 83 Higher Secondary
Schools 73 Schools are having facility for drinking water,
80 Schools are having urinals 69 Schools are having separate
urinals for Girls, 64 schools are having lavatory and
65 schools are having separate lavatory for girls.

(13) All the Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools are having physical Education Teachers.

(14) Out of 83 Higher Secondary Schools 62 Schools
are having arts course, 76 schools are having science course,
64 Schools are having commerce course, 20 schools are having
Agriculture Course, 29 Schools are having Technical Course,
14 Schools are having Home Science Course and 17 Schools are
having Vocational Courses.

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#### CHAPTER - V

#### OTHER EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES

Non formal Education Centred for age group 6 - 14 were not functioning in this District on the Crucial date. This Scheme is intended for dropouts who are unable to continue the school education due to local reasons. But all the Blocks were covered by the S.A.E.P. (State Adult Education Programme). Also the District was covered by R.F.L.P. (Rural Functional Literacy Programme).

Adult Education and Functional Literacy facilities and enrolment particulars are given in District Table 29. Schools for the handicapped are given in Table - 30.

Facilities of Pre-Primary Education in the form of Balwadi/Anganwadi and Preprimary classes and Sections both in Rural and Urban areas are given in Table No.31.




