

The Board is a federation of the voluntary agencies and is their home.

Second, the Board is also the voluntary agencies base for the State Resource Centre, which is one of the most active in India. It places all its technical resources at the service of the Centre.

As part of these two functions, one unit of the Secretariat also runs a few pilot projects with the help of the Govt. of India.

It is hoped that the Board will become this year a more effective servicing agency for the adult education voluntary agencies in Tamilnadu.

GOVERNING ORGANSA. General Council

A meeting of the General Council of the Board was held on 2.11.1985. The minutes of the meeting has been circulated. The decisions of the Council are:

1. To request all the Voluntary Agencies to make the fullest use of the SRC in all activities relating to Adult Education post-literacy programmes, non-formal education programmes and the mass literacy programmes.
2. It decided as follows regarding the Annual subscription for the year 1986-87 for individuals Rs.15/- and for institutions Rs.50/-. The payment of arrears as on date may not be insisted upon.

B. Executive Committee

The monthly activities of the Tamil Nadu Board of Continuing Education are directed by the Executive Committee of the Tamil Nadu Board of Continuing Education. The Committee met regularly once in two months and concentrated on its function as a federation of the Voluntary Agencies of Adult Education in the State. It considered all matters relating to the problems of Voluntary Agencies in implementing Adult Education in the field. To have a first hand field experience, it also runs projects directly. The progress of the projects are also reviewed in these meetings.

During the year under report, it completed the running of 3 Adult Education Projects and 3 Post-literacy Projects in May '85 but could not start the new projects during the year till 31.3.'86.

During the year, it also decided to invite voluntary agencies to depute a representative to the Executive Meeting to know first hand their strengths and weaknesses in running their adult education programmes. On this basis it invited 9 agencies to the meetings:

"Education is a unique investment in the present and the future. This cardinal principle is the key to the National Policy on Education".

The critical development issue today is the continuous upgradation of skills so as to produce manpower resources of the kind and the number required by the society. Since participation by beneficiaries in the developmental programmes is of crucial importance, systematic programmes of adult education linked with national goals such as alleviation of poverty, national integration, environmental conservation, energisation of the cultural creativity of the people, observance of small family norm, promotion of women's equality, etc. will be organised and the existing programmes reviewed and strengthened.

The whole nation must pledge itself to the eradication of illiteracy, particularly in the 15-35 age group. The Central and State Governments, political parties and their mass organisations, the mass media and educational institutions must commit themselves to mass literacy programmes of diverse nature. It will also have to involve on a large scale teachers, students, youth, voluntary agencies, employers etc. Concerned efforts will be made to harness various research agencies to improve the pedagogical aspects of adult literacy. The mass literacy programme would include, in addition to literacy, functional knowledge and skills, and also awareness among learners about the socio-economic reality and the possibility to change it.

A vast programme of adult and continuing education will be implemented through various ways and channels, including -

- (a) establishment of centres in rural areas continuing education;
- (b) workers' education through the employers, trade unions and concerned agencies of government;
- (c) post-secondary education institutions;
- (d) wider promotion of books, libraries and reading rooms;
- (e) use of radio, TV and films, as mass and group learning media;
- (f) creation of learners' groups and organisations;
- (g) programmes of distance learning;
- (h) organising assistance in self-learning; and
- (i) organising need and interest based vocational training programmes.

With this positive note under National Education Policy, we are entering this year 1985-86.

Further our State Government have reconstituted the State Board of Adult Education with our Education Minister as Chairman and Thiru Kovai Thambi as Vice-Chairman. Our President is also the member of the State Board. So under these circumstances you all can well imagine, the large strides we can put in the days to come.

Before actually inviting the new members to our fold, I wish to state effective steps had already been taken on the many recommendations you had made in the previous conference in 1984-85.

Under the National Education Policy, Govt. of India is having lot of exercises, to make Adult Education a technological mission. Very soon we will hear about it. Regarding some of our problems under physical facilities, Govt. has a sympathetic view and processing all our requests. Further as a booster to improve our morale of voluntary agencies, our State Govt. has constituted, a High Power first Class Committee to go into the problems of voluntary agencies which are really doing good work to the people. Govt. feels these agencies are only translating into action the policies of the government. This Committee in future we can hope will come handy to us to solve most of the intricate problems in the implementation of Adult Education Programme.

By my cataloguing, now you might understand we have hereafter three forums to solve the problems of voluntary agencies in the state. The forums are:

1. Tamil Nadu Board of Continuing Education
2. State Board of Adult Education
3. High Power Committee on Voluntary Agencies -
Constitute by the State Government .

Let me now enumerate some of the chronological events which are significant during the year under report. We have 42 Government aided voluntary agencies in the field of Adult Education during this year. It has increased by 11 new entrants in the field of Adult Education, than last year.

This year, we undertaken to survey the various aspects in the implementation of Adult Education, for the year 1985-86 and 1986-87. We sent a questionnaire and requested the voluntary agencies to respond. 12 voluntary agencies provided information

for 1985-86 and we were able to provide the information in the tables. 16 voluntary agencies responded and gave details for 1986-87 and we have given the particulars in the tables. We could not include the particulars of some of the agencies which despatched their replies late and by then we had completed our tabulation. We thank all the agencies for their responses and we hope that they would continue their patronage and co-operation in future also.

To have a first hand experience of the Adult Education Programme, Tamil Nadu Board of Continuing Education is running adult education centres. The report of which is appended.




