1956-57 TO 1973-74

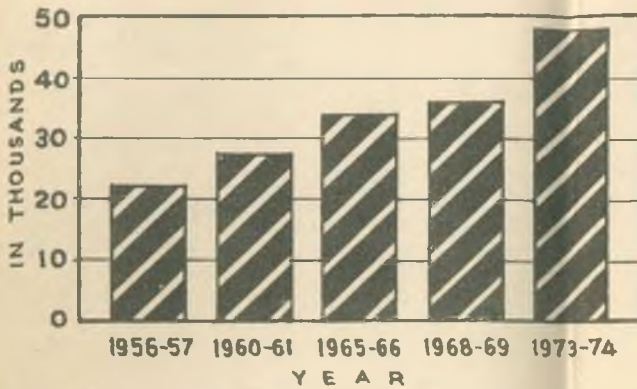


DIAGRAM-2

1956-57 TO 1973-74

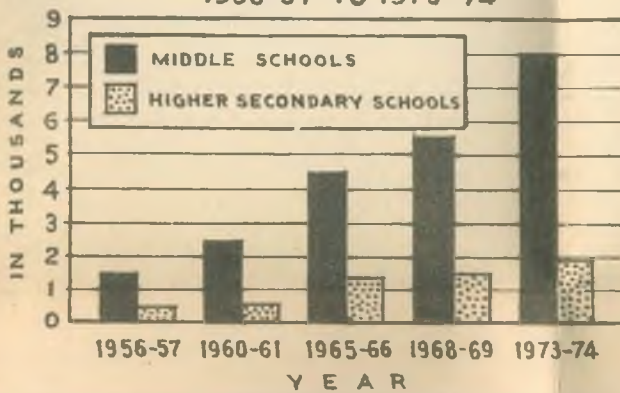
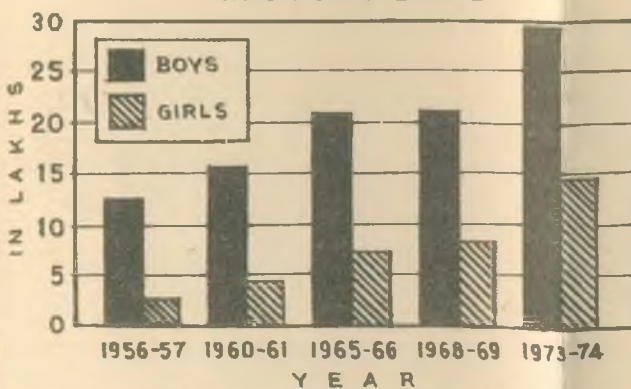


DIAGRAM-3

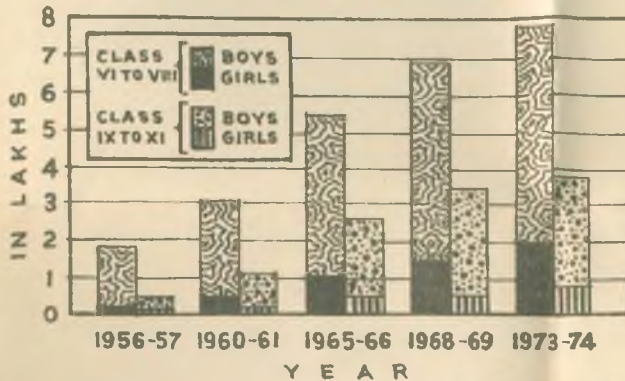
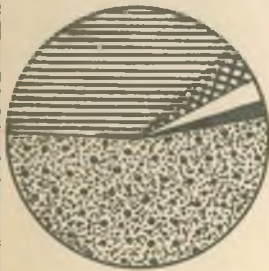
