1974 - 75

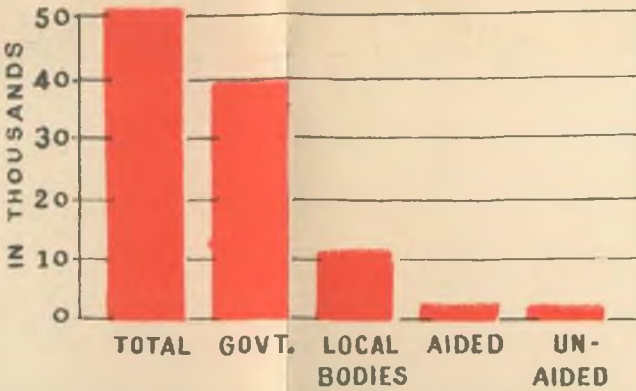


DIAGRAM-2

ACCORDING TO MANAGEMENT. 1974-75

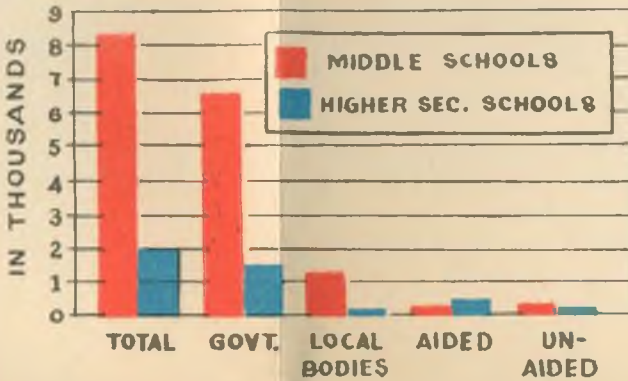
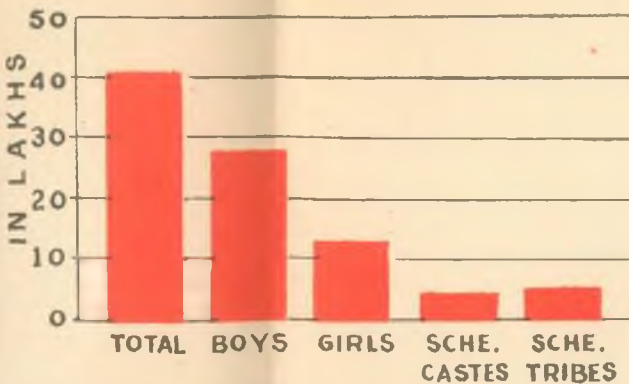


DIAGRAM-3

ENROLMENT AT MIDDLE AND HIGHER SECONDARY STAGE 1974 - 75

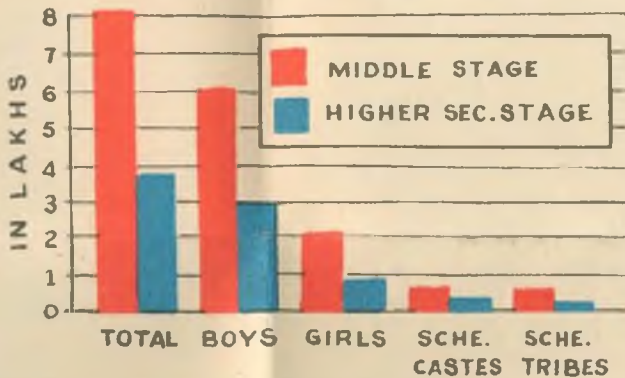
