1975-76

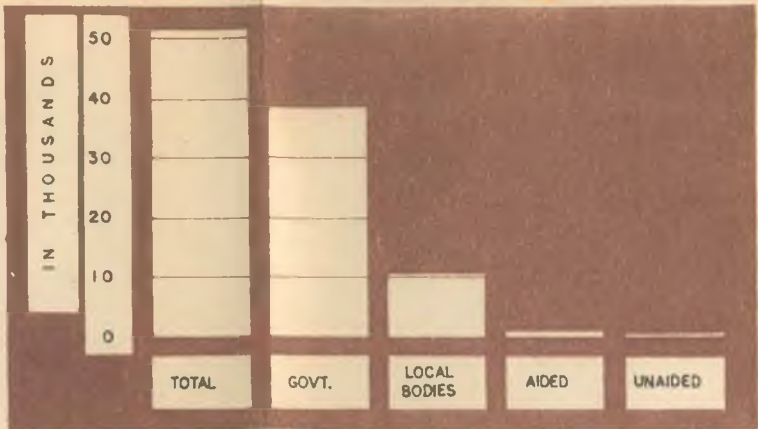


DIAGRAM - 2

1975-76

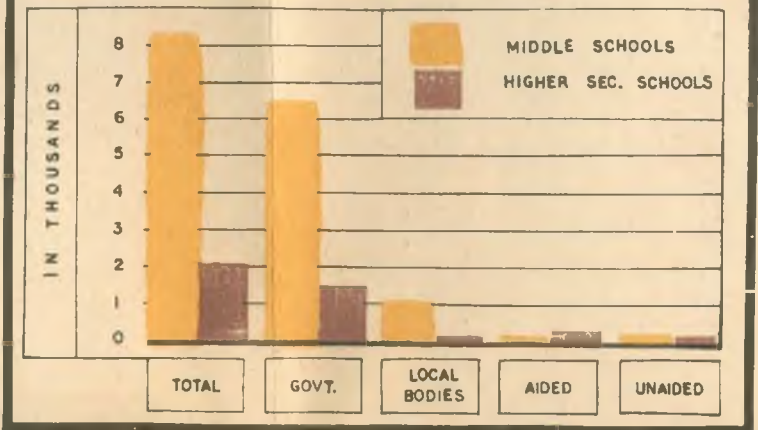


DIAGRAM - 3

1975-76

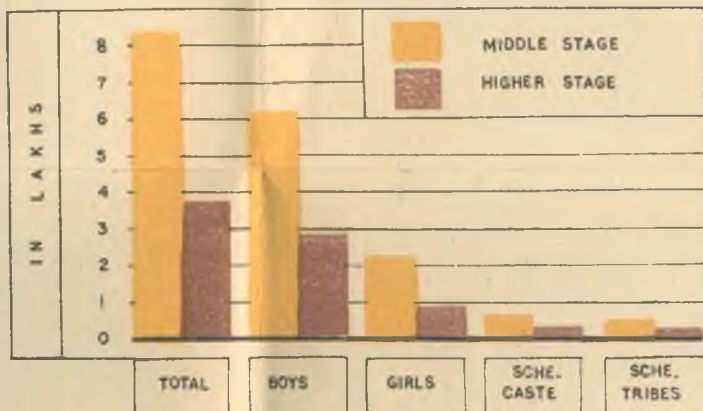
