Analysis and Discussion

The results after analysis of data are tabulated and through discussion of results with the help of high percentage of number of schools involved in the effects, the prominent effects due to impact of attendance in learning are collected and mentioned as major findings in respect of effects in learning due to impact of attendance upon learning of pupils of Primary Schools of Purba Medinipur District (2006-2007).

Prominent effects in the form of major findings in learning due to impact of attendance upon learning of pupils of Primary Schools of Purba Medinipur District (2006-2007).


1. Pupils learn easily (98%).
2. They learn systematically (87%).
3. They pay more attention and interest of learning of Lesson (99%).
4. Pupils participate satisfactorily in interaction of learning (99%).
5. They clearly understand use of TLM in learning and learn clearly (83%).
6. Pupils develop calm and quiet attitude of listening of lesson (95%).
7. They gather systematic knowledge of subject (88%).
8. Pupils are satisfied in staying at class during learning of lesson (89%).

After analysis of data are tabulated and through discussion of results with the help of low (below 80%) percentage of number of schools involved in the effects, the effects due to impact of attendance in learning are collected and mentioned as major findings in respect of effects in learning due to impact of attendance up on learning of pupils of Primary schools of Purba Medinipur District (2006-2007).


Low percentage effects in the form of major findings in learning due to impact of attendance up on learning of pupils of Primary Schools of Purba Medinipur District (2006-2007).

1. Pupils preparation not satisfactorily in interaction of learning (71%).
2. Pupils not completion of every day lesion (43%).
3. Pupils not satisfactory of class examination result (76%).
4. Pupils learning rate and quality achievement of class lesion not satisfactory (72%).

Report of impact study under Research and Evaluation intervention S.S.M., Purba Medinipur

Title : Evaluation of impact of attendance upon learning of pupils of Primary Schools.

Area of Study: Pedagogical Intervention.

Name of Principal investigator : Research and evaluation intervention, S.S.M., Purba Medinipur.

Scope and Coverage : Purba Medinipur District 4 Sub-Divisions 25 Blocks 44 Circles.

Objectives of Study

The Government of India has lunched the S.S.M. in 2000 with the following aims:-

1. Admission of the dropouts and never enrolled children.
 2. Retention of those children in the schools.
 3. Improvement of the quality of education of the children.
- West Bengal, like all others States of India has carried out this programme successfully since inception. However, in Purba Medinipur this programme started in 2002 and during last 6 (six) years a huge amount of money has been invested for the benefit of the Primary Schools in this scheme. So it is the time to evaluate the prominent effects of attendance upon learning of pupils of Primary Schools, which is an important objective of S.S.M.

Methodology of Study

In Purba Medinipur District there are 44 Circles under which 3234 Primary Schools exist. For research purpose it is quite impossible to survey each and every school. So five Primary Schools (two are very good, two are moderately good and one is not good ranked on the basis of previous results) from each Circle in consultation with C.P.C.s (Circle Project Co-Ordinators of Schools) that is, a total of 220 Primary school are selected as a sample size. Appointed investigators (unemployed graduate) have surveyed these schools through a well structured Data Capture Forma (DCF which is attached at the end of these papers). All the data, after collecting the above stated method are computerised. Then we have used different statistical tools like simple correlation, multiple regression etc. to derive different useful result via S.P.S.S. package.
