## Chapter I.

I. General Information: The District Report on the fifth All India Educational survey is prepared based on the 128 tables. This report furnished information about various facilities available in each block village as well as urban area as on 30.9.86.

Topography of the District:
This District wa- carried from the ersthwhile Composite' Ramanathapuram District on 15 th March 1985 with Ramanathapuram as District Headquarters. Other important pilgrim centres are Thiruppullani, Thiruuttarakosamangai Nainnrkovil and Tiruvadarai. Ramandthapuram was the capital of the sethupathi Kings.
