CHAPTER: I

1.1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

The population of the Nilgiris District as per 1981 census was as follows:-

Literacy rate (1981 census) is as compared to that of the State.

Female literacy is as compared to males.

Industrial Co-operative Tea Factories and the Tea Factories owned by Private Estate Owners are the main industry in the District. Small Industrial Units relating to the Tea Manufacturing machineries have come up. Two major Central Government Establishments:

1. Cordite Factory, Aruvankadu (Defence Ministry)
2. Hindustan Photo Films Manufacturing Company

provide labour potential to the residents of the Nilgiris. The Needle Industries(India) Ltd., at Ketti is one of the leading Companies manufacturing Needles and Pins of all kinds which provide Full time and part time employment to about more than 1000 persons.

1.2. FIFTH ALL INDIA EDUCATIONAL SURVEY:

Reference date of the Survey is 30.9.1986. The Questionnaires containing S&F, V&F and U&F were distributed to all the schools under all kinds of managements and particulars obtained regarding the population, enrolment, availability of schools, availability of facilities in the schools etc., and compiled in different tabulated firms. For this purpose special meetings were convened and the Heads of schools and the Deputy Inspector of Schools, Assistant Educational Officers were given clean instructions as to how to supply the particulars.

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All the hamlets, (Blockwise) Estates (Government and Private) and Urban areas were covered. Estimated population of the District according to present survey is 707900.

CHAPTER: II

PRIMARY EDUCATION

1. There are 750 habitations in the four blocks. Total population of 3,59992 was served with Primary Education with schools at distances ranging from upto 5 km to 2 kms.

2. There are Primary Schools within a distance of 1 km in 534 habitations. 41 habitations have to be provided with new Primary Schools.

3. There are 43 villages according to proportion of SC population and 42 villages for ST population and there are facilities for 41 villages for SC population and 38 for ST population.

4. There are 367 Primary Schools (Government - 247, Local Bodies - 19, Aided - 101) under all kinds of managements having 2322 Primary Classes.

5. 317 schools in rural areas and 46 in urban areas are housed in Pucca buildings. Only one school in rural area is housed in partly Pucca Building and three schools are housed in thatched huts in rural areas. There is no distinguishable disparity between the schools in rural and urban areas in regard to buildings.

6. 247 schools in rural and 120 schools in urban areas have instructional rooms of which 34 in rural and 11 in urban areas have "One Room" for instructional purpose. There are no schools with Zero rooms.

7. 134 schools in rural and 78 schools in urban areas require additional class rooms.

8. There is shortage in supply of black boards to the schools as a whole in general. Much disparity is noticed in Kotagiri and Gudalur Blocks.

9. Revaccination and medical checkup is made in almost all the schools.

Nearly half of the schools need facilities in ~~fix~~ Drinking Water and toilet facilities.

10. Teachers are in position according to the needs of the schools. There is no school with 'Z' teacher.

11. There are 676 male and 394 Female teachers (trained) in rural area.

Similarly there are 201 male and 471 Female teachers (trained) in Urban areas. There are no untrained teachers either in rural or in urban areas.

12. Enrolment at Primary stage in classes I to V who are in age group 6 to below 11.

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CHAPTER - III

UPPER PRIMARY EDUCATION

1. There are 750 habitations in the four blocks. Total population of 359092 was served with Upper Primary Schools at distances ranging from upto 1 km to more than 5 km.

In Kotagiri Block only 41 schools are situated at a distance of more than 5 km when the other Blocks have 17, 21 & 21.

In Udhagamandalam Block more schools are situated at a distance of more than 3 km, while the other Blocks have reasonable number of schools.

2. In 750 habitations 515 habitations are already served with, Upper Primary Schools/Sections within a walking distance of 3 km. And the other 235 habitations have schools within a walking distance of 3.1km to more than 5 km. 41 more Upper Primary Schools may be opened.

3. There are 43 villages according to proportion of SC population and 42 villages for ST population and there are facilities for 31 villages for SC population and 31 for ST population.

4. There are 66 Upper Primary Schools under all kinds of managements having 1358 upper primary classes. (Government 48 + Local body 3 + Aided 15)

5. 57 schools in rural areas and 8 schools in urban areas are housed in Pucca Buildings. Only one school in Gudalur Block is housed in partly Pucca Building.

6. 35 schools in rural areas and 19 schools in urban areas have libraries.. 12 schools have to be provided with libraries.

7. 25 schools in rural areas and 21 schools in urban areas have drinking water supply facility. 20 schools in rural areas need drinkingwater facility.

Almost all the schools in urban areas have toilet facilities whereas 50% of the schools in rural areas have yet to be provided with toilet facilities.

8. There are 485 male and 206 Female teachers (Trained) in rural areas.

In urban areas there are 271 male and 281 Female teachers (Trained). There are no untrained teachers either in rural or in urban areas.

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CHAPTER IV

SECONDARY AND HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION (*2 STAGE)

1. In the 750 habitations 636 habitations are served with secondary schools ranging from a distance of within the habitation to 8 km.

114 habitations are served with secondary schools at a distance of more than 8 km.

2. In the 750 habitations 448 habitations are served with higher secondary schools at a distance of upto 8 km and 302 habitations are served with higher secondary schools at a distance of more than 8 km.

3. There are 36 Secondary schools with 227 secondary classes in rural areas and 30 secondary schools 376 classes in urban areas.

4. There are 16 Higher Secondary Schools in rural areas and 22 in urban areas.

5. Library Facilities:

30 Secondary schools in rural areas and 25 schools in urban areas have library facilities. 16 Higher Secondary Schools in rural areas and 23 schools in urban areas have library facilities.

Six Secondary Schools in rural areas and 5(Five) schools in urban areas have to be provided with Library facilities.

All the Higher Secondary Schools have library facilities.

6. There are 362 male teachers and 103 Female teachers teaching Secondary classes in Rural Areas and 272 males and 324 female teachers are teaching secondary classes in urban areas.

7. 491 male and 189 female teachers are teaching Higher Secondary classes in rural areas and 269 male and 288 female teachers are teaching Higher Secondary Classes in Urban areas. In addition, there are 17 male and 14 female untrained teachers teaching Higher Secondary Classes in urban areas.

8. 17 Secondary schools in rural and 15 secondary schools in urban areas have Science Laboratories. 12 secondary schools in rural and 6 schools in urban areas do not have laboratories.

In rural area all the aided schools have laboratories while 50% of Government Institutions have yet to be provided with laboratories. While in Urban area both the Government and aided are equally in want of laboratories for 50% of the schools.

9. Fifteen out of 16 Higher Secondary Schools in rural and 21 schools in urban areas - 15 schools in rural and 21 schools in urban areas have laboratories. Only one school in rural area (Government) has to be provided with ~~new~~ laboratory.

10. 156 teachers(Trained) are teaching Science in Secondary Stage.

107 teachers (trained) and one (untrained) teachers are teaching Science in Higher Secondary Stage.

12. ANCILLARY FACILITIES:

24 Secondary Schools in rural and 28 schools in urban areas have drinking water facility.

75% of the Secondary Schools both in rural and urban areas have toilet facilities.

Revaccination is done in all the schools whereas medical checkup is done in about 60% of the schools both in rural and urban areas.

12 Higher Secondary Schools in rural and 23 urban areas have drinking water facility. Only three schools in rural area have to be provided with drinking water facility.

Almost all the Higher Secondary Schools have toilet facilities.

Medical checkup is done in 13 out of 15 in rural and 18 out of 23 Higher Secondary Schools in urban areas.

13. 36 Secondary schools in rural and 29 schools in urban areas have physical Education teachers.

16 Higher Secondary schools in rural and 23 schools in urban areas have physical Education teachers.


