The reasons for the lower percentage of enrolment in rural area when compared to Urban area are due to the following factors:

1. The School age children in rural area have to assist the parents in their occupation since the income of the parents are very low. Eventhough the supply of free books, cloths and Noon-Meals are provided in rural areas, the parents are not interested in sending off the children to schools, mainly due to poverty and ignorance,. Change of school time according to the environment of rural areas will not be fruitful, unless the school teachers residing in the same village for which necessary facilities are to be provided in the villages.

2. The No. of School-age children studying in unrecognised schools were not taken into account under the school going children. The Children studying in recognised schools were alone taken into account under the column number of pupils under instruction. The Procedure of collecting statistical particulars from unrecognised schools even at the time of organising the educational survey is not followed. Hence the coverage of cent percent enrolment could not be achieved in Urban area. As a result of existence of nursery schools in Urban area, the enrolment of pupils of age group 6-11 decreases year by year and the teacher pupil ratio in primary stage is not enough when compared to the teacher-pupil ratio in Rural area.



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
