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INTRODUCTION

Manpower and Employment Planning is an integral part of development planning. It has come to be recognised in India as one of the adjuncts of socio-economic planning since the early years of planning era. The need for integrating the manpower planning with educational planning and planning for economic development is being increasingly felt particularly in the context of current educated unemployment. Situational analysis of the problem of unemployment is reflected in our development plans and generation of employment opportunities has been one of the main objectives of the development plans. It is also now recognised that such integrated approach to planning should be attempted at a reasonable dis-aggregated level to ensure proper utilisation of human resources. In view of this it has become imperative to build-up a manpower information system at State level so as to cover various aspects of technical and educated manpower. Keeping in view the importance of this information system, Manpower Division of Planning Department, H.P. has brought out a comprehensive compendium of manpower information which is Ninth in the series of "Fact Book on Manpower". This publication consists of four broad sections viz. Population and Work Force; Employment and Unemployment; Education and Training and Health Sector with a summary of each part in the beginning.

I. POPULATION AND WORK FORCE

The population characteristics of Himachal Pradesh are highlighted in this section. It consists of first 21 tables giving a fair idea about the size, structure and growth of total working population disaggregated by area and sex. Table - 1.1 shows total population and its decennial growth rate. In order to give some time series perspective, data has been given from 1901 to 2001. The total population of Himachal Pradesh in 1901 was 19,20,294 which came down to 18,96,944 in 1911. This is the only decade in which a negative growth rate of (-) 1.22% was recorded. The density of population during this period remained 34 persons per Sq. Km. Since 1911, there has been a continuous increase in the population which increased to 51,70,877 in 1991 with 20.79% decennial growth rate and density of population was 93 whereas for 2001 census, the population was recorded as 60,77,900 with density of population as 109 persons per Sq. Km. The decennial Growth rate has declined to 17.54 %. This, in fact, is an encouraging trend.

Table 1.2 shows the comparative picture of population in various small States and Union Territories. The population of the State constitutes 0.59% of India's population and ranks 21st amongst all States and Union Territories of the country. The position of sex ratio in the State in 2001 census is 968 females, comparatively better than the sex ratio of 933 females in the country. However, in Himachal Pradesh sex ratio has registered a decline. It has come down from

976 to 968 which has attracted the attention of the policy makers. The density of population in the State of Himachal Pradesh is quite low i.e; 109 persons per square Km. compared with all India average of 324 persons per Sq. Km.

Most often, manpower planners have to refer to the structure and level of development of State economy as reflected in the State Domestic Product and its sectoral distribution. SDP which is the most appropriate composite economic indicator for measuring the economic growth is shown in table 1.3 and 1.4 both at current and constant prices. SDP which was recorded Rs. 5825.03 crore in 1994-95 at current prices has been gradually increasing during subsequent years. It went upto Rs. 14968.64, crore in 2000-01, Rs. 16075.40 crore in 2002-03 and Rs.17938.33 crore in 2003-04. A fluctuating trend was witnessed in growth rate of SDP at constant prices. While registering a gradual increase from 1994-95 to 2003-04, SDP increased from Rs. 5243.93 crore to Rs. 9163.59 crore. The growth rate fluctuated between 4.5 to 9.6 percent during 1994-95 to 2003-04. Whereas, the highest growth rate at constant prices was observed during 1994-95 i.e; 9.6 percent, during 2003-04 it was 8.1 percent.

The demographic features of the State are given in Table 1.5 to 1.9 showing district-wise distribution of area, population and density of population. District-wise population by Sex, Quinquennial age groups and that of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes. It is observed that density of population of all districts except Lahaul & Spiti has increased over the decade (1991-2001). The sex-ratio- in Himachal Pradesh increased during decade (1981-91), but declined in the decade (1991-2001). In 2001 census, lowest sex-ratio is in Lahaul & Spiti district and highest is in Hamirpur district followed by Mandi district. In 1991 census, the percentage of SCs and STs is highest in Solan and Lahaul & Spiti districts respectively, but during the decade (1991-2001), the highest percentage of SCs is in Sirmour district and percentage of STs keeps on highest in Lahaul & Spiti.

Table 1.10 shows percentage of workers, marginal workers and non workers to total population over the decade 1991 to 2001. Though there has been substantial increase in main workers as there has been in total population, percentage of main workers to total population has declined from 34.41 percent in 1991 to 32.31 percent in 2001. Similarly, marginal workers have also increased in the decade under review whereas non-workers have declined to 50.76% from 57.17% over the decade under review. Table 1.11 shows the working population by Industrial Category and Sex. During the decade from 1991 to 2001 there has been a substantial increase in working population which has gone-up to 29,92461 during the decade.

Since Himachal Pradesh is predominantly an agricultural State, out of the total working population, 20,49,041 are engaged in agriculture as cultivators and agriculture labourers and rest are engaged in other economic

activities. As is evident from Table-1.12 and 1.13 the predominance of agriculture sector in absorbing the work force is further explained by the fact that during 1991 census out of the total working force, 16,29,125 were recorded as engaged in rural areas whereas urban areas had a work force of 1,49,975 only in 1991 whereas in 2001, it was 27,72,351 in rural areas and 2,20,110 in urban areas.

Table 1.14 and 1.15 shows the comparative picture of 1991 and 2001 and give a detailed account of district-wise distribution of labour force by industrial categories. Table 1.16 depicts distribution of workers by districts for 1991 and 2001-sex-wise and Area-wise classification in Himachal Pradesh. Table 1.17 depicts district-wise, area-wise and sex-wise percentage of main and marginal workers to total workers as per 2001 census. In 2001 census, the maximum workers are cultivators and the highest number is in Kangra and Mandi Districts whereas Lahaul & Spiti has the lowest number of cultivators depending on its topography and population.

Table 1.18 depicts the decadal changes in the work participation rates. The overall district-wise and the sex-wise picture reveals the increase in the work participation rate. Lahaul & Spiti and Kullu Districts has a decreased work participation rate in 2001 whereas in all other Districts, it has shown an increasing trend.

Table- 1.19 shows the work participation rates by States and Union Territories according to 1981, 1991 and 2001 Census. The data reveals an increasing trend in work participation rate from 33.45 in 1981 and 37.46 in 1991 to 39.26 in 2001 for all India and 42.40, 42.82 and 49.30, respectively, for Himachal Pradesh which is more than the all- India Work participation rate in all the three decades.

II. EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT

One of the principal objectives of economic planning is the progressive reduction of unemployment. The rationale behind the growth of economy is not only to increase production but also expand the capacity for absorbing the backlog of unemployment and disguised unemployment. The solution of the problem of unemployment and poverty has to be found through a high rate of overall economic growth.

While formulating Development Plan, Employment and Manpower Planning has to be viewed as the basic approach to tackle the Socio-economic problems. The task is one of adopting a suitable structure of investment and production, appropriate types of technology and mix of production technique and organisational support which would help to promote growth in productive

employment. With this objective in view, preparation of a suitable data base has become imperative for the use of Manpower Planners.

Whereas the previous section provides the work status of the population as recorded by the census, the present section intends to throw light on the employment status of the population as shown by Employment Market Information collected by Employment Exchanges, Annual Survey of industries conducted by CSO (Industrial Wing) and Labour Force Surveys conducted by the National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO) every five years. This is more or less an information on the organised sector of the economy covering factories and registered units of production. The unemployment data is based upon both the live registers of the employment exchanges and NSS.

Though Himachal Pradesh is predominantly an agricultural State having a comparatively weak industrial base, yet there has been a gradual growth in number of industries/factories being established and in the number of workers being employed in these factories for the last few years both in Private and Public Sector. This is evident from table-2.1 to 2.3 which shows that during the year 2001 there were 1951 registered factories employing 76,121 workers in the State. This number in 2010 had gone-up to 3949 factories and 2,44,944 workers. In the intervening years also there has been a gradual increase in both factories as well as workers in them.

Table 2.4 to 2.6 depicts an erratic trend in employment in establishments (covered under E.M.I)for the period ending 31st March 2001 to 31st March 2010, both in public and private sectors.

The overall growth trend of employment in the organised sector remained erratic. The highest annual growth of 8.08 % was observed during the year 2007.(table 2.7)

The district-wise and industry-wise employment for the year 2001 to 2010 is given under tables 2.8 to 2.17 .The public sector, community social and personal services sector is providing employment to the largest extent whereas the contribution of mining and quarrying sector is the lowest. The total employment in all industry divisions increased from 304494 to 387562 during the period March, 2001 to March, 2010.

Table 2.18 depicts the year-wise total employment in the public sector at different levels in the State viz Central Govt. Sector, State Govt. Sector, Local Bodies and Quasi Govt. Sector. During the period 2001 to 2010 the annual growth trend of employment remained erratic.

The district-wise details of employment in the Public sector from the year 2001-2010 are given in table-2.19. The district -wise/ year-wise growth trend

during the period remained erratic in all the districts. Lahaul & Spiti district observed the constant trend during the year 2001 to 2010. It was only in Bilaspur, Chamba, Hamirpur Kangra, Kullu, Shimla , Solan and Una districts that the overall growth of employment witnessed an increasing trend as in the year 2001 and 2010. Whereas in district Kinnaur, Mandi and Sirmour there is an overall decrease in the growth of employment as witnessed in the year 2001 and 2010.

Table 2.20 depicts the year-wise details (from 2001 to 2010) of the number of candidates registered in the Employment Exchanges according to their educational category .The year-wise growth of applicants is showing an increasing trend under category Post Graduates, Graduates categories whereas matric and above, below matric /literate and illiterates are showing a decreasing trend which depicts that maximum Post Graduates and Graduates register themselves for jobs in Government sector whereas others may be seeking for job in the private or unorganised sector as their registration is less.

The Employment Exchange-wise data of applicants according to educational categories as on 31st December, 2004 -2010 has been given in table 2.21 .There was maximum registration under categories Matric and above whereas the registration of illiterates were minimum in the employment exchanges of Himachal Pradesh in the year 201 0. This shows that the illiterates may be seeking for jobs in the Private Sector as unskilled labourers etc.

Table 2.22 highlights the occupational distribution of applicants registered for different trades according to their educational qualification on Live Registers of Employment Exchanges since 2001 to 2010. Different occupations for which the registrations made in Employment Exchanges are categories as Professional and Technical, Administrative Executive and Managerial, Clerical and Allied works, Transportation and Commerce, Craftsmen, other skilled workers and unskilled workers. It is observed that out of total job seekers registered in Employment Exchanges majority of them are usually unskilled workers.

The year-wise details of vacancies notified and filled in the Public and Private Sectors are given under Table 2.23 and 2.24. The maximum vacancies i.e, 6127 were filled during the year 2006-07 and during the year 2009-10 as many as 1147 vacancies were filled up which are at the minimum side in the public sector. Similarly, for the Private sector, maximum vacancies 4378 were filled up during the year 2006 and minimum vacancies i.e, 306 were filled during the year 2007.

Table-2.25 depicts the year-wise magnitude of unemployment with regard to educated and uneducated job seekers during the years 200 1 to 2010. It is seen that every successive year from 2001 to 2003 is witnessing continuous multiplication in number of unemployed persons whereas from the year 2004

to 2007 there is a decrease in the number of job seekers. In the year 2008-2009 there is erratic trend. There is seen an overall decrease in the number of Job seekers from the year 2001 to 2010. Unemployment situation is quite conspicuous in the comparatively over populated districts like Kangra, Shimla and Mandi for obvious reasons. The educational category-wise position of unemployed persons is shown in detail in table 2.26.

Based on 64th round of the National Sample Survey, the distribution of usually employed persons by their employment status is depicted under Table-2.27. In the rural areas majority of the persons under both the status groups i.e Principal Status and Principal Subsidiary Status are self employed and a very small number is employed as regular and casual. But in the urban areas, the regular employment is on the top followed by self employment and casual employment. Education specific worker population ratio for persons of age 15 years and above according to Usual Principal Status in H.P. is depicted in Table 2.28.

III. EDUCATION AND TRAINING

With a view to present a fair picture of the pattern and the varieties of education and training facilities available in Himachal Pradesh, this section includes selected tables. Efforts have been made to cover not only technical education but also general school, college and university education. Attempt has also been made to provide information on sanctioned intake capacity, actual intake/admission and outturn of all the education and training institutes with a view to helping an educational planner to have an idea about the nature and extent of the field of education existing in the State and also to prepare estimates of supply of educated and technical manpower over a certain period of time. For supply projections as well as for giving historical perspective to the data, it has been ensured that educational tables contain information for at least 5 to 10 years subject to the availability of the Data.

Himachal Pradesh had tremendous strides in the field of literacy during the past decade. Literacy percentage which was recorded by the census of 1991 as 63.86% has increased to 76.50% in 2001. Table 3.1 reveals that percentage of literates is higher in Himachal Pradesh as compared to All India level. In the Inter-State comparison of literacy rate the State occupies the seventh position (Table 3.2) District-wise position of literates in H.P. is given in detail in Table-3.3. Hamirpur district has the highest percentage of literacy i.e, 82.5 followed by Una, Kangra and Shimla districts. The lowest literacy was observed in Chamba district. District-wise distribution of primary schools in Himachal Pradesh is depicted in table 3.4. In 2000-01 total number of Primary Schools in Himachal was 10633 which went upto 10725 in 2009-10.

Keeping in view the upper and lower age limits required for each standard in the school the total number of students enrolled have been divided into three broad groups viz. Primary Enrolment which has the students of age 6-10 years, Middle Enrolment which has the students who fall within the age of 11-13 years, and Secondary Enrolment within those of 14-16 years of age. The progress of enrolment in Primary, Middle and Secondary institutions are given in detail under table -3.5.

During the year 2000-01 the number of students enrolled in class I-V were 6.63 lakhs which included 3.37 lakh boys and 3.26 lakh girls. The primary enrolment decreased to 4.40 lakh in 2009-10 (table-3.6) This is because of lowering of birth rate and decline in population growth. The enrolment rates are above 100% in this group now.

Percentage of total enrolment in the school to total population in the age group of(6-11) from 2001-2010 is 100 percent.

In 2000-01, there were 60472 teachers teaching in Primary , Middle, High and Higher Secondary Schools in Himachal Pradesh. Out of which 37228 were male and 23244 were female. Number of trained teachers were 56155 only which included 35498 male and 20657 female. In 2009-10, this number increased to 68693 out of which 42143 were male and 26550 were female. Sex- wise distribution of trained and untrained teachers is given in detail in table 3.7

Table 3.8 gives number of students appeared and passed in High /Hr. Sec. School and Senior Secondary Schools in H.P. In the year 2000-01, in high/Hr. Sec. Examination, 126594 pupils appeared out of which 58962 were declared as pass. Also 88826 students appeared in 10+2 examination in the same year out of which 35199 were declared successful. In 2009-10, students who appeared in High/Higher Secondary Examination were 137216 and 107317 , respectively, whereas the No. of those who cleared these examinations were 86704 and 67688 respectively.

Table-3.9 gives an account of the sanctioned intake, actual intake and outturn of B.Ed. degree holders in H.P. for a period of 2000-01 to 2008-09. In 2000-01 only 1300 candidates were enrolled for B.Ed. out of which 1192 were declared successful which included 659 male and 533 female.

Table-3.10 gives an account that in 2000-01 there were 12 JBT and one Teacher Training Certificate School with an intake of 28 candidates out of which 27 were declared successful. All this intake and outturn were of females only. Whereas during the years 2002-03 to 2004-05, the actual intake again came down to 25.

Table 3.11 depicts that in 2000-01 there were 64 colleges with a stock of 1679 teachers. The total number of students enrolled in them were 72021. District-wise number of colleges, and the number of teachers and enrolment in H.P is depicted in table 3.12.

In 2000-01, the out-tum of degree holders of BA, B.Sc., B.Com, B.B.A & B.C.A was 15638, 2436, 2304, 91 & 17 respectively. During this period, erratic growth trend was observed under all the categories(Table-3.13)Under the postgraduate courses of Arts, Science, Commerce, MBA & MCA , out-tum of degree holders in 2000-01 was 5524, 759, 1125, 58 and 36 respectively. During this period, erratic growth trend was observed under all the categories from 2000-01 to 2009-10.(Table-3.14)

Table 3.15 depicts the outturn of Shastri & Acharya Degree Holders in Himachal Pradesh from the year 2000-01 to 2009-10 indicating an erratic trend in the outturn pattern.

There was only one Regional Engineering College at Hamirpur which started functioning from the year 1986-87. Before this, the State Government used to sponsor the candidates to the engineering institutions situated in other States. In the year 2000-01, 223 candidates in different trades were enrolled in this college. This strength in 2001-02 went up to 230. Again in 2003-04, the enrolment decreased to 218 and it increased to 288 during the year 2005-06 and showed an increasing trend during the consequent years in the trades of civil, Electrical, Electronic, Computer Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Architect at this institute.(Table 3.16)This is now a National Institute of Technology.

As regards out-turn of Engineering Graduates from this college, during the year, 2009-10, 45 Civil, 52 electronics, 60 electrical, 42 computer, 57 mechanical and 22 Architect graduates passed out their degrees.(Table-3.17)

The State has private institutions of higher learning in engineering for which the data has been gathered and included in this version of the fact book. The institution-wise detail of intake capacity and Enrolment in Graduate Courses in Private Engineering Colleges from 2000-2001 to 2009-10 is given under table 3.18

Government Polytechnic Institutions functioning in Himachal Pradesh, located each at Sunder Nagar, Hamirpur, Rohroo, Kandaghat Gagret and Kangra and the intake capacity and enrolment of these institutions is given under table 3.19.

Table-3.20 gives Year-wise Enrolment, Outturn and Engineering Diploma Holders in H.P from 2000-01 to 2009-10.

Table-3.21 depicts Intake Capacity and Enrolment in Diploma courses in Women's Polytechnic College Kandaghat, District Solan from 2000-01 to 2009-10 whereas dropout and Outturn is given in Table-3.22. The total intake capacity and enrolment during 2000-01 was 75 and 224 respectively whereas during 2009-10 the intake capacity increased to 160. During 2000-01, enrolment capacity, dropouts and outturn of Women ' s Polytechnic Co11ege Kandaghat was 224, 01 and 44 respectively. Whereas during the later years there is an erratic trend.

Trade-wise enrolment, dropout and outturn under non-engineering and engineering trade's in H.P during the year 2000-01 to 2009-10 is given in table 3.23 and 3.24.

Himachal Pradesh has one agriculture and one horticulture university at Palampur and Solan, respectively. Actual intake and outturn of Agricultural Graduates and Postgraduates produced by HP Krishi Vishwa Vidyalya Palampur is given in detail in Table-3.25. In 2009-10, the enrolment of candidates in B.Sc. (Agriculture) which is a four year degree course was 227, in M.Sc. 97 and in Ph.D was 26 respectively. In Veterinary (Bsc),182 candidates were enrolled ,under Msc., 70 was the enrolment Whereas in Ph.D. only 2 candidates were enrolled. Similarly, under Bsc. Home Science and Basic Science, 39,152 respectively were enrolled during the year 2009-10.

In Horticulture and Forestry University in H.P.in 2009-10, enrolment in B.Sc., M.Sc., Ph.D.(Hort.) was 58, 52 and 23, respectively. While in Forestry 50,35 and 13 students were enrolled in B.Sc., M.Sc. and Ph.D respectively. This is given in detail in table -3.26

IV. HEALTH

An additional information on Year-wise/Category-wise Enrolment .& Outturn of Health institutions i.e; Allopathic, Ayurvedic, Homeopathic and Dental colleges and Hospitals, both Government and Private has been added in the present issue of Fact Book on Manpower in Himachal Pradesh on the basis of the available information from the year 2000-0 1 to 20 10-11.

Himachal Pradesh has one Ayurvedic college at Paprola in District Kangra which produces BAMS, GAMS and Ayurvedacharyas. Details of total enrolment, dropout and outturn is given in table 4.1 whereas table 4.2 depicts enrolment, dropout and outturn under MD in Ayurvedic college at Paprola from the year 2006-07 to 2009-10.

Table 4.3 depicts enrolment, dropout and outturn in Solan Homeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Kumharhatti, Himachal Pradesh since 2004-05 to 2009-10.

Year-wise/Category-wise Enrolment & Outturn of Indira Gandhi Medical College Shimla and Dr. Rajindra Prasad Medical College Tanda (Kangra) from 2000-01. to 2010-11 is given in table -4.4 and 4.5.

Table-4.6 contains the Intake Capacity, Enrolment & Outturn of Candidates for Para Medical Three Year Degree Courses in Himachal Pradesh under Medical Technology, Anaesthesiology & B.Sc Radiology from the year 2003-04 to 2009-10.

Table-4.7 contains the Intake Capacity, Enrolment & Outturn of BDS from the year 2000-01 to 2009-10 and MDS from 2006-07 to 2009-10 of H.P . Dental College & Hospital, Shimla.

Table-4.8 depicts the Intake Capacity, Enrolment & Outturn of Dental Hygienists and Dental Mechanics only for the year 2006-07 and 2009-10.

Table-4.9 to table 4.11 shows the Intake Capacity, Enrolment & Outturn of BDS and MDS of Himachal Institute of Dental Sciences Paonta Sahib, District Sirmaur, H.P, Himachal Dental College Sundernagar and Bhojia Dental College and Hospital Budh, Nalagarh.
