This volume on District-wise Educational Statistics for the State of Maharashtra is the twelfth in the series of such volumes which will be brought out for all the States and Union Territories for the quinquennial year 1981-82. The main aim is to highlight the inter-district variations in a State by giving educational data at district level with the help of some important indices such as enrolment-ratio, percentage of trained teachers, teacher-pupil ratio etc.

In order to ascertain whether the educational imbalances have added or narrowed down with time, the data for the year 1981-82 have been compared with those for the year 1976-77.

I take this opportunity to place on record our appreciation of the co-operation received from the Director of Education, Maharashtra and the Project Staff of the Planning, Monitoring and Statistics Division who have prepared this report.

INTRODUCTION

Regional imbalances exist in the field of Educational Development just as in Urbanisation, industrialism, distribution of income and wealth. With a view to highlight National variations in the educational sector, the Ministry of Human Resource Development brings out the publication "Educational Statistics - District-wise" quinquennially.

2. A volume of this nature was first published by National Council of Educational Research and Training in 1960-61. There after it was decided that such reviews will be brought out in respect of each state every five years by the Ministry of Human Resource Development. Accordingly, the reviews for the year 1965-66 were brought out by this Ministry in respect of some states. However for the quinquennial year 1976-77, such reviews were brought out for all the states and Union Territories with legislature.

3. For making inter-district comparisons possible, some important indices such as Enrolment Ratio, Percentage of Trained Teachers and Teacher-Pupil Ratio etc. have been worked out. These indices show wide range of variations between the districts and are of much need for formulating educational plans at the district level.

II. AREA AND POPULATION

4. Total Area of state is 307690 (Provisional) sq. kms. as per 1981 census. It

had 26 districts in 1976 but just after 1981 census, two new districts namely Jalna and Sindhudurg were formed thereby making 28 districts in the state. District-wise area in Maharashtra varies from 603 sq. kms. in case of Greater Bombay to 25923 sq. kms. in case of Chandrapur district followed by Ahmednagar (17048 sq. kms.).

5. The population of Maharashtra was 562.24 lakhs in 1977. The estimated population in 1982 was 641.74 lakhs (331.28 lakhs males & 310.46 lakhs females). The highest population in 1977 was in Greater Bombay and the lowest in Wardha viz. 67.30 lakhs and 3.80 lakhs respectively, which increased to 84.26 lakhs and 9.47 lakhs respectively in 1982.

The two new for these districts, the required data on district viz. Sindhudurg & Jalna were formed after the 1981 census, and area and population is not available. Most of the area of Sindhudurg and Jalna were taken from Ratnagiri and Aurangabad districts respectively. Therefore while calculating indices in comparison to Area and Population for 1981-82, the data has been combined for Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg and Aurangabad and Jalna.

6. The overall density of population per sq. km. was 185 in 1977 which is estimated to have increased to 209 in 1982. The density of population per sq. km. in 1982 varied widely among districts viz. from 13973 the highest in Greater Bombay to only 81 the lowest in Chandrapur. The area, total population and density of population for

different districts for the years 1976-77 and 1981-82 are given in Statement No.2. The table below gives a general view of the extent of variations in area, population and the density of population in 1982.

7. The total population of the state as well as population of different age groups for the year 1977 and 1982 given in this report are based on the revised population projections (as on 31st March of the year) available from the office of Registrar General of India. District-wise population in the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 are based on the following formula:

We assume that :

To get the sex-wise break up of the total population in the various age-groups of the district, first of all the girls' population is estimated using the above equation with the only difference that in the above formula total population is replaced by the girls' population. The boys population is obtained by the residual method i.e.

Boys population in the age-group 6-11 = Total population in the age-group 6-11 - Girls population in the age-group 6-11

Similar formula ~~is~~ used for estimating the district-wise population in the age-groups 11-14 and 14-17 years.

8. The total estimated population of children in the age-group 6-11 years was 79.92 lakhs in 1982 (41.20 lakhs boys and 38.72 lakhs girls) which constituted 12.45 % of the total population of the State.

9. Similarly the estimated population in the age-group 11-14 years was 45.81 lakhs in 1982

(23.84 lakhs boys and 21.97 lakhs girls) which constituted ~~1~~ of the total population of the State.

10. The population in the age-group 14-17 in 1982 estimated was 54.81 lakhs consisting 28.74 lakhs boys and 26.07 lakhs girls. They formed 8.5% of the total population of the State.

11. Thus out of the total population of 641.74 lakhs of the State, the school going population in the age-groups 6-17 years was 180.54 lakhs consisting of 93.78 lakhs boys and 86.76 lakhs girls. The population in the age-group 6-17 years constituted 28.1% of the total population. This percentage for boys and girls were 28.3 and 27.9 respectively.

III. LITERACY

12. According to the 1981 census, the literacy rate for the State as a whole was 66.6 %.
For males and females, these ^{were} reported as 74.5% and 57.8% respectively indicating a wide gap between the two sexes. The literacy rate in respect of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes

is reported to be 35.6% and 22.3% respectively at the State level sharing wide disparities between these communities and General Population. District-wise details of literacy rates in general as well as that of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe population are given in Statement No.6.

IV. GENERAL VIEW

a) Institutions :

13. The total number of educational institutions (schools) in Maharashtra was 56817 in 1976-77 which increased to 68289 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 20.2% during the period of 5 yrs. In 1981-82, Pune district had the largest share of institutions (6.3%). The lowest share was in Jalna district (1.6%). The district-wise position of institutions is given in Statement No.1.

b) Enrolment:

14. The total enrolment in all recognised educational institutions (school level) in the State increased from 105.80 lakhs in 1976-77 to 125.97 lakhs in 1981-82 showing an average annual growth rate of 3.8%. Bombay had the largest share of enrolment (13.1%) whereas Jalna had the lowest share (1.1%) in 1981-82. District-wise position of total enrolment and their percentage share are given in Statement No.1.

15. The percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment was 39.5% in 1976-77 which slightly increased to 40.9% in 1981-82. Among the districts Wardha had the highest (45.5)

percentage of girls enrolment to total enrolment whereas Jalna had the lowest (30.5) percentage in 1981-82. In 1981-82 out of the 28 districts, only 13 districts had more percentage of girls enrolment to that of states' percentage implying educational backwardness in large number of districts (22). Details are shown in Statement No.4.

(c) Extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes :

16. The extent of coverage of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes or the co-efficient of equality is defined as :-

$$I = \frac{\text{Percentage of enrolment of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total enrolment}}{\text{Percentage of population of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes to total population}} \times 100$$

17. In Maharashtra State, in 1981-82, the percentage of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes students to total number of students was 13.5% (14.5% for boys and 12.4% for girls) and 6.0% (6.6% for boys and 5.1% for girls) respectively. The percentage for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribe population to the total population was 7.1% and 9.2% respectively. Therefore, the extent of coverage or the co-efficient of equality for the year 1981-82 has been worked out as 190% in respect of Scheduled Castes and 65% in respect of Scheduled Tribes.

In case of Scheduled Castes students the highest extent of coverage was in Wardha (52%) and the lowest was in Kolhapur (100%). However, this trend seems to be on account of the fact that Neo-Buddhists have been counted in the enrolment figures of SCs in the state but not in the population figures published in the census documents.

The extent of coverage was the highest in Beed (157%) and the lowest in Ratnagiri (14.0%). The district-wise details are given in Statements No.7 & 8.

(d) Teachers:

18. The total number of teachers in the State in all educational institutions (School level) increased from 324280 in 1976-77 to 359575 in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase rate of 2.2% during this period. Bombay had the lion's share of teachers (13.5%) to the total number of teachers in the state, whereas Jalna district had the lowest share (1.1%). The details may be seen in Statement No.1.

19. In 1981-82, the total number of school teachers was 359575 (246630 males and 112945 females) out of which 321974 teachers (222233 males and 99741 females) were trained. The percentage of trained teachers to the number of male, female and total teachers in schools was 90.1%, 88.3% and 89.5% respectively. The percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers had only little variations among different districts of the state viz. 94.3% in Bombay to 79.3% in Chandrapur district. Taking males and females together percentage of trained teachers was higher in as many as 15 districts as compared to the state's percentage and in as many as 16 districts as compared to the All India's percentage (88.9). The details may be seen in Statement No.5.

V. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION:

20. The number of Pre-Primary schools in Maharashtra was 794 in 1976-77 which decreased to 660 in 1981-82, but the number of teachers which were 1764 in 1976-77 increased to 1793 in 1981-82. Total enrolment in Pre-Primary classes decreased from 145831 in 1976-77 to 134975 (76421 boys and 58551 girls) in 1981-82. Enrolment in these classes for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in 1981-82 was 13374 (7805 boys and 5569 girls) and 10716 (5600 boys and 5116 girls) respectively as against 13461 (8074 boys and 5387 girls) and 6455 (4016 boys and 2439 girls) in 1976-77. In 1981-82 there were only 161 Pre-Primary schools in Rural Areas in Maharashtra. Total enrolment in Pre-Primary classes in Rural schools was 54727 (30644 boys and 24083 girls). The district-wise details are given in Statement Nos. 9 & 10.

VI. Primary Education

(a) Institutions and Teachers

21. The total number of Primary schools in Maharashtra increased from 32326 in 1976-77 to 36093 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 11.7% during the period. The highest percentage of Primary schools was in Pune (6.2%) and the lowest in Sindhudurg (1.0%).

22. On an average in 1976-77, a Primary school was serving an area of 9.5 sq. kms. Over a period of 5 years the position improved considerably and a Primary school was serving

over an area of 8.5 sq. kms. in 1981-82. In 1981-82 the average area served by a Primary school was the minimum (0.5 sq. kms.) in the case of Bombay and the maximum (14.4 sq. kms.) in Chandrapur district.

23. The population served by a Primary school in the state registered only a marginal increase from 1753 to 1778 during the period of five years. Among the districts, the population served by a Primary school varied from the lowest of 1024 in Raigad to the highest of 6398 in Bombay in 1981-82. The district-wise details are given in Statement No.11.

24. Total number of Primary school teachers increased from 85029 in 1976-77 to 104940 in 1981-82, showing an average annual increase of 4.7% during the five years period. During this period the number of teachers increased in most of the districts. The number of women teachers formed 34.2% of the total number of teachers in 1981-82. The highest percentage of teachers was 12.4% in Bombay while lowest percentage (1.2%) was found in Sindhudurg district. The pupil-teacher ratio was 37 in 1976-77 and 40 in 1981-82. The pupil-teacher ratio varied from 31 in Sindhudurg district to 45 in Aurangabad. The teacher-pupil ratio in 1981-82 was higher in 10 districts as compared to the State's ratio and in 8 districts was even higher than for All India's figure of 39. Percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers in Primary schools was 90.5% (90.5% for men and 90.4% for women) in 1981-82. The percentage was higher in 15 districts to that of State's percentage and was even higher for 20 districts than that of the All India's corresponding ratio of 86.8% taking male and female together.

(b) Enrolment:

25. In 1976-77, the total enrolment in Primary schools in Maharashtra was 31.65 lakhs which increased to 41.50 lakhs in 1981-82. In classes I-V, the enrolment increased from 75.18 lakhs (43.68 lakhs boys and 31.50 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 to 86.01 lakhs (48.89 lakhs boys and 37.17 lakhs girls) in 1981-82 showing an average annual growth rate of 2.88%. The enrolment growth rates in these classes separately for boys and girls are worked out to be 2.36% and 3.60% respectively, which shows that girls education is getting better deal in the State.

26. The percentage of enrolment in Classes I-V to the total population in the age group 6-11 (also called enrolment ratio) gives the index of the facilities created at the Primary stage of education. In Maharashtra state it increased from 99.2 in 1976-77 to 107.6 in 1981-82 during the period of five years. In the case of boys alone the increase in percentage was from 113.4 in 1976-77 to 118.6 in 1981-82 and in the case of girls from 84.6 to 96.0 during the same period. Among the various districts, taking boys and girls together, the enrolment ratio in 1981-82 was the highest in Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg (131.4) and the lowest in Parbhani (79.8%). In 1981-82, the enrolment ratios were higher in 14 districts than the corresponding States ratio and even higher in almost all districts as compared to the All India enrolment ratio of 86.9%.

(c) Enrolment of SC and ST

27. Of the total enrolment of 75.18 lakhs in Classes I-V in 1976-77, 7.51 lakhs

students belonged to Scheduled Castes and 3.68 lakh students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 11.7% and 4.9% respectively of the total enrolment in these classes. In 1981-82, out of the total enrolment in these classes viz. 86.01 lakhs, the enrolment of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes was 11.80 lakhs and 5.58 lakhs respectively forming 13.7% in case of Scheduled Castes and 6.5% in case of Scheduled Tribes to the total enrolment in Classes I-V. The district-wise details are given in Statement Nos. 14 & 15.

(d) Education in Rural Areas

28. Of the total number of Primary schools in the state, 31,620 (87.6%) were located in rural areas in 1981-82. Percentage of pucca schools in the rural area was 57.0, highest \angle the being in Akola 79.9 and lowest in Osmanabad 37.4. Of the total enrolment in Primary schools in 1981-82, 41.50 lakhs, 26.63 lakhs were in Rural Areas forming 64.2% of the total enrolment in these schools. District-wise details of institutions, their enrolment and enrolment in Class I-V are given in Statement No.16.

29. The total number of habitations in the state were 63974 out of which 40195 had a primary school in themselves in 1981-82, and 55640 had a primary school upto a distance of kms. District-wise details are given in Statement No.17.

VII. MIDDLE EDUCATION

(a) Institutions and Teachers

30. The total number of Middle schools in the state decreased from 16305 in 1976-77 to 15435 in 1981-82. This decrease is on account of upgradation of Middle schools to High/Higher Secondary schools. In 1981-82, the largest number of Middle schools was recorded in Pune (1132) forming 7.3% of the total number of Middle schools in the state and lowest in Pune (135) having a share of 0.9% only.

31. On an average in 1976-77, a Middle school served an area of 18.9 sq. kms. which increased slightly in 1981-82 as a Middle school was then available for an area of 19.9 sq kms. In 1981-82, the average area served by a Middle school was the lowest in Bombay (1.2 sq kms.) and the highest in Chandrapur district (66.1 sq. kms.).

32. The average population served by a Middle school in the State increased from 3485 in 1976-77 to 4157 in 1981-82. Among the districts the population served by a Middle school in 1981-82 varied significantly from 1345 in Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg districts to 11205 in Bombay district. The details are given in Statement No.18.

33. The number of teachers in Middle schools decreased from 135480 in 1976-77 to 121008 in 1981-82 showing a decrease of 10.68% during the period of 5 years. The decline is not factual but on account of upgradation of Middle schools to High/Higher Secondary schools during the said period. In 1976-77 pupil teacher ratio was 34 which increased to 37 in 1981-82. Among the districts the pupil teacher ratio varied from 28 in Sindhudurg to 44 in

Pune district in 1981-82. Teacher-pupil ratio in Middle schools was higher in 16 districts than that for the whole State's and in 5 districts than that for All India's being 34 in 1981-82. Percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers in 1981-82 was 93.1% (93.8 for males and 91.5 for females). Taking male and female together this percentage was highest in Dombey (98.9) and lowest in Parbani (81.9). The percentage was higher in 14 districts than State's percentage and in 21 districts than India's (89.8). The details can be seen in Statement No. 20.

(b) Enrolment

34. The total enrolment in Middle schools was 45.49 lakhs in 1976-77 which decreased to 31.04 lakhs in 1981-82 which again is because of their upgradation to high/higher secondary level. The enrolment at the middle stage i.e. in classes VI-VIII increased from 18.50 lakhs (12.05 lakhs boys and 6.45 lakhs girls) in 1976-77 to 24.24 lakhs (15.40 lakhs boys and 8.84 lakhs girls) in 1981-82, showing an annual growth rate of 6.2% (5.6% for boys and 7.4% for girls) during the period under consideration. This shows that girls were getting better facilities at Middle level.

35. The percentage of enrolment in Classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age group 11-14 also called enrolment ratio or Index of the educational facilities at the Middle stage. In Maharashtra, this percentage was 38.9 in 1976-77 which increased to 52.9%

in 1981-82. In case of boys the enrolment ratio was 56.1% in 1976-77 and 59.1% in 1981-82. The corresponding ratios for girls were 39.9% in 1976-77 and 43.1% in 1981-82. Taking boys and girls together, the percentage enrolment in 1981-82 was higher than the corresponding State's percentage and was higher compared to the corresponding India's percentage of 43.3% in 1981-82. At this stage, this percentage indicates some disparities between the districts. However the situation has improved considerably from 1976-77 to 1981-82. In 1981-82, the highest enrolment ratio was in Bombay taking boys and girls together (68.8) and the lowest in Dharwad. The details may be seen in Statement No. 19.

(c) Enrolment of SC/ST

36. Of the total enrolment of 18.50 lakhs in Classes VI-VIII belonged to Scheduled Castes and 0.43 lakhs students belonged to 9.4% and 2.3% respectively in 1976-77 of the total enrolment at a total enrolment of 24.24 lakhs, the number of students belonging to 2.85 lakhs and that of Scheduled Tribes was 0.80 lakhs forming total enrolment in Classes VI-VIII respectively. District-wise statements No. 21 & 22.

(d) Middle School Education in Rural Areas

37. Out of the 15436 Middle schools in the State as many as 12761 or 82.7% were located in Rural Areas. Ratnagiri and Sinchudurg districts cover the highest number (1534) of Rural Area Middle Schools followed by Pune (823) whereas Wardha had the lowest (131) in the State during 1981-82. Percentage of Pucca schools in the State was 85.7, the highest being in Akola (99.4%) and the lowest in Osmanabad (55.7%). Total enrolment in rural Middle schools was 31.04 lakhs during 1981-82. Total enrolment in Classes VI-VIII in rural areas in 1981-82 was 12.03 lakhs (8.27 lakhs boys and 3.81 lakhs girls). District-wise position of the rural area education at Middle level has been depicted in Statement No. 23.

38. Out of 63974 habitations in the State, only 14510 had a Middle school in themselves. 40796 habitations had a school upto a distance of 2 kms. and 57907 habitations had a middle school between 2-5 kms. Details can be seen in Statement No. 24,

Enrolment by classes

39. Statement No. 31 depicts the class-wise enrolment from Class I to VIII. At the state level, the decreasing trend of enrolment in each class over the previous class shows the extent of drop-outs in different classes. Percentage enrolment of Class V to that of Class I worked out to be 38.4% and of Class VIII to Class I as 20.9% during 1981-82 showing high drop-out rates at Primary & Middle stages.

VIII. High/Higer Secondary Education

Institutions and Teachers

40. There were 5771 High/Higer Secondary schools in 1976-77 which increased to 6237 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 8.1% during the period of 5 years. During 1981-82, the largest number of High/Higer Secondary schools are reported to be in Bombay having 776 schools or 12.4% of the total number of schools in the state. The lowest number of such schools 74 (1.2%) was in Jalna district.

41. On an average there was a High/Higer Secondary school for every 43.3 sq. kms. in 1976-77. By 1981-82, High/Higer Secondary school was available for 49.3 sq. kms. In 1981-82, in Bombay district a High/Higer Secondary school was available in every 0.8 sq. km whereas in Chandrapur, a High/Higer Secondary school was available for an area of 163.0 sq.

42. At the state level, a High/Higer Secondary school was available for every 9847 persons in 1976-77. By 1981-82 a High/Higer Secondary school was available for every 10289 persons. Among the districts in 1981-82, the average population served by a High/Higer Secondary school varied from as low as 7735 persons in Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg districts to as high as 15846 persons in Parbhani district. District-wise details of High/Higer Secondary schools, area and population served by a High/Higer Secondary school are depicted in Statement No. 25.

43. The total number of teachers in High/Higer Secondary Schools of Maharashtra increased from 96103 in 1971-72 to 139025 in 1981-82 showing an increase of 23% during the period under consideration. The increase in teachers was observed in almost all the districts. Women teachers formed 36.7% of the total number of teachers in High/Higer Secondary schools in 1981-82. Teacher-pupil ratio is worked out to be 27 in 1976-77 and as 30 for the year 1981-82. In 1981-82, this ratio varied marginally from 26 to 32 among all the districts. The teacher-pupil ratio in 1981-82 was higher in 17 districts than the corresponding ratio for the whole state and was even higher in 8 districts as compared to the All India's figure of 27. Percentage of trained teachers to total number of teachers in the state in 1981-82 was 94.9% (94.7 for males and 95.5 for females). Taking males and females together the percentage was higher in 16 districts than the corresponding State's percentage and was higher in all districts than that of India's (82.3%). Details are given in Statement No. 27.

Enrolment:

44. The total enrolment in High/Higer Secondary schools of the state was 26.12 lakhs in 1976-77 which increased to 35.22 lakhs in 1981-82 showing an average annual increase of 6.9%. The enrolment in Classes IX-XI/ITI in 1976-77 was 9.81 lakhs (6.83 lakhs boys and 2.98 lakhs girls). In 1981-82 the enrolment in Classes IX-XI/ITI increased to 13.72 lakhs

(9.41 lakhs boys and 4.31 lakhs girls) showing an average annual increase of 8.0%. The average annual increase in enrolment for boys and girls separately works out to be 7.6% and 8.9% respectively. This shows that educational facilities at High/Higer Secondary stage have been improved considerably.

45. Enrolment ratio for Maharashtra state at the High/Higer Secondary stage i.e. in Classes IX-XI/XII was 25.2% (34.30% for boys and 15.7% for girls) in 1976-77 and 25.0% (32.7% for boys and 16.5% for girls) in 1981-82. Among the districts, in 1981-82, the enrolment ratio at High/Higer Secondary stage varied from 39.2% in Greater Bombay to 10.2% in case of Parbhani district. The enrolment ratio was higher in 8 districts than the corresponding states' percentage and was even higher for 22 districts when compared to that for All India (18.0%). Details are given in Statement No. 26.

Enrolment of SC/ST

46. Of the total enrolment of 9.81 lakhs in Classes IX-XI/XII the number of students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes were 0.86 lakhs and 0.20 lakhs respectively in 1976-77 forming 8.8% and 2.0% respectively of the total enrolment at this stage.

In 1981-82, out of the total enrolment of 13.72 lakhs in Classes IX-XI/XII, 1.48 lakhs belonged to Scheduled Castes and 0.35 lakh students belonged to Scheduled Tribes forming 10.8% and 2.5% of the total enrolment respectively. The details of enrolment for SC and ST Communities and their enrolment percentages are given in Statements Nos. 28 and 29.

High/Higher Secondary Education in Rural Areas

47. Out of the 6237 High/Higher Secondary Schools in 1981-82 in the State, 3726 (59.7%) were in rural areas. Among the rural areas of different districts, the largest number was in Ahmednagar (227) and the lowest in Jalna district (50). Percentage of Pucca schools in the State at High/Higher Secondary level was 66.9. The highest one (100%) was in Parbhani and the lowest of 50% in Nasik. Out of the total enrolment of 25.22 lakhs in High/Higher Secondary schools in the State, 15.13 lakhs or 43.1% were confined to the institutions in rural areas. In classes IX-XI/XII in rural area, the enrolment was 4.12 lakhs (3.14 lakhs boys and 0.98 lakhs girls) in 1981-82. The detailed district-wise position is given in Statement No. 30.

Professional, Vocational, Special and Other (School) Education:

48. The number of schools for Professional, Vocational, Special and other (School level) Education in 1976-77 was 1621 which increased to 9853 by 1981-82. This abnormal increase may be due to inclusion of Social (Adult) Education centres, under this category during the said period. The total enrolment in Professional, Vocational, Special and Other (School) Education schools increased from 88016 in 1976-77 to 336231 (192363 boys and 143868 girls) in 1981-82. During 1976-77 the enrolment belonging to Scheduled Castes was 3242 and that of Scheduled Tribes being 1336. In 1981-82, there were as many as 71799 (45311 boys and 26488 girls) students belonging to Scheduled Castes and 69152 (49774 boys and 19378 girls) students belonging to Scheduled Tribes enrolled in these courses. Total number of teachers in these institutions also increased from 3875 in 1976-77 to 12933 (8088 males and 4750 females) in 1981-82. District-wise details are given in Statement No. 31.
