PREFACE

Regional imbalances in the field of educational development prevailing in the country have to be reduced in order to create an infrastructure for a egalitarian society. For this purpose it is essential to make collection of statistics from different regions.

To highlight the regional disparities in educational developments in different regions of the country it was decided to collect the educational statistics on district-wise basis and publish quinquennially viz. once in five years. Accordingly such statistics was collected and published by NCERT for the year 1960-61. Afterwards the study was repeated for the years 1965-66 and 1970-71 by the Ministry. The current publication relates to the data for the year 1976-77.

I take this opportunity to express my thanks for the supply of the required data and other help received from the office of the Director of Education, Government of Maharashtra for bringing out this publication.

## INTRODUCTION

The Ministry of Education & Culture collects and publishes the educational statistics at State level on annual basis. However, keeping in view the wide disparities within a State, educational data at district level is collected and published on quinquennial basis separately for each State. This Volume is the Twenty-Second in series of the educational statistics - district-wise for the years 1970-71 - 1976-77.

2. For making inter-district comparisons, important educational indicators such as enrolment ratio, co-efficient of equality for scheduled castes & scheduled tribes, teacher-pupil ratio, cost per student and population served by an institution etc. have been worked out at district level. These indices show wide range of variation among the districts and are of great use for formulating educational development plans at district level as recommended by the Education Commission.

II - AREA AND POPULATION

3. Maharashtra State consists of 26 districts. The number of districts in the State remained the same during the period 1971 to 1977. The total area of the State being 3.08 lakh sq. kms. also remained the same during the period under review. Among the districts the area varies from as high as 25,641 sq. kms. in case of Chanda to as low as 603 sq. kms. of Greater Bombay.

4. The total population of the State was 504.12 lakhs (261.16 males and 242.96 females) in 1971 as per Census. Among the districts the highest population was 34.78 lakhs in Greater Bombay and the lowest was 6.14 lakhs in Kolaba. The population of the State is estimated to have increased to 568.24 lakhs (293.60 lakhs males and 274.64 lakhs females) in 1977. The annual growth of the population works out to be 2.12% during the period under consideration.

5. The density of population for the State as a whole was 164 per sq. km. in 1971 which is estimated to have increased to 185 by the year 1977. In 1977 the highest density of population was 1116 in Greater Bombay and the lowest in Chanda 72. Statement (1) depicts the district-wise information on area, population and density of population figures for the years 1971 and 1977. Table (1) below gives district-wise percentage share of area and percentage share of population for the year 1977.

6. Total population of the districts and the State for the year 1971 has been taken the same as in Census.



Population of different age-groups of the State for the years 1971 and 1977 as on 31st March of the respective year are based on the population estimates available from the office of the Registrar General of India whereas the district-wise population estimates for the age-groups 6-11, 11-14 and 14-17 for the year 1976-77 (as on 1.3.1977) have been worked out by using the following formula:-

We assume that -

$$\frac{P_{6-11}}{P} = \frac{P_{6-11}^i}{p_i} = K, \quad i = 1, 2, 3, 4$$

$$\therefore P_{6-11} = K P$$

Where K is estimated from the formula,  $K = \frac{P_{6-11}}{P}$

$P_{6-11}$  = 6-11 age-group population of the State

P = Total population of the State

$P_{6-11}^i$  = 6-11 age-group population of the ith district

$p_i$  = Total population of the ith district

7. For getting sex-wise break-up of the population in various age-groups first the girls population is estimated by the above formula by replacing total population by the girls population. Boys population can be obtained by subtracting estimated girls population from the total estimated population.

8. Of the total population for the age-group 6-11 was 75.78 lakhs (38.53 lakhs boys and 37.24 lakhs girls) forming 13.3% in 1976-77. Population in age-group 11-14 was increased from 35.50 lakhs in 1971 to 42.37 lakhs (21.48 lakhs boys and 20.89 lakhs girls) in 1977. Population for age-group 14-17 was 31.04 lakhs (16.21 lakhs boys and 14.84 lakhs girls) in 1971 which increased to 38.89 lakhs (19.92 lakhs boys and 18.97 lakhs girls) in 1977.

9. Thus of the total population of 568.24 lakhs in 1977 school going population in age-group 6-17 was 157.06 lakhs (79.90 lakhs boys and 77.12 lakhs girls) forming 27.6%. School going population of boys is 30.6% and for girls 31.7% in 1977. District-wise estimated population figures for different age-groups are given in Statement (2).

### III - LITERACY

10. In 1971 the effective literacy rate viz. total number of literates per one hundred of population excluding 0-4 age-group was 45.0 for the State as a whole. The literacy rate for males was 58.4 whereas for females it was quite low i.e. only 30.6 at State level. Among the districts the highest literacy was in case of Greater Bombay 71.9 followed by Jalgaon 52.6 and Poona 52.0. Satara reported the lowest literacy rate viz. only 21.0. District-wise details of literacy can be seen from Statement No.(3).

### IV - GENERAL VIEW

#### (a) INSTITUTIONS

11. There were 52,956 recognised institutions of all types of education in 1970-71 in the State which increased to 57,767 in 1976-77. The increase works out to 1.5% during the period under review. In 1976-77 Poona had the highest number of institutions 3,681 followed by Ratnagiri 3,546 and Greater Bombay 2,941. The lowest number of institutions 1,062 was in case of Wardha.

#### (b) ENROLMENT

12. The total enrolment in all types of institutions was 86.54 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 110.18 lakhs by 1976-77. The average annual growth of enrolment works out to 4.6% during the period under consideration. Among the districts the percentage share was the highest 14.6 in case of Greater Bombay and the lowest 1.6 in Wardha in 1976-77.

13. The increase in enrolment was observed in all the districts.

14. The sex-ratio of enrolment viz. number of girls enrolled for every 100 boys was 33 in 1970-71 which increased to 39 in 1976-77.

15. The total enrolment in all educational institutions as a percentage to the population increased from 17.2% in 1970-71 to 19.4% in 1976-77 for the State as a whole. Among the districts it varied from 12.4% in case of Parbhani to 24% in case of Greater Bombay.

(c) TEACHERS

16. Total number of teachers in all types of educational institutions in the State increased from 2,87,046 in 1970-71 to 3,50,471 in 1976-77 showing an annual growth rate of 3.7% during the period. Number of teachers increased in all the districts.

17. In 1976-77 out of total number of teachers in the State, 3,20,405 were employed in schools forming 91.4% of the total strength of teachers in all types of institutions. Among the school teachers 88.4% were trained. Among the districts this percentage varies from 93.8 in Sholapur to 47.1 in Parbhani. The corresponding figures for men and women teachers is same for 1976-77. District-wise particulars of trained and untrained teachers have been given in Statement No.(6).

(d) EXPENDITURE

18. The total expenditure incurred on all types of institutions in the State increased from Rs.138.42 crores in 1970-71 to Rs.251.53 crores in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 14.8%. In 1976-77, the percentage share of expenditure was the highest in case of Greater Bombay 20.3% and the lowest in case of Nagpur 0.3%.

19. The expenditure on education per head of institution was Rs.26,153 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.45,274 in 1976-77. Among the districts, the expenditure per head of institution varied from Rs.1,80,716 in Greater Bombay to Rs.21,020 in Kolaba in 1976-77.

20. The educational expenditure per head of population was Rs.27.5 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.46.0 in 1976-77. The per capita expenditure among the districts varied from Rs.79.0 in case of Greater Bombay to Rs.26.5 in Parbhani in 1976-77. The per capita expenditure increased in all the districts in 1976-77 as compared to that in 1970-71. District-wise educational expenditure, expenditure per institution and per capita expenditure can be seen from Statement No.(7).

(e) EXTENT OF COVERAGE OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

21. The total enrolment of scheduled caste students in the State was 12,06,878 (7,89,995 boys and 4,16,883 girls) forming 11.0% of the total enrolment at State level. The enrolment percentage for scheduled caste boys was 11.8 and for girls it was 9.7. Among the districts the enrolment percentage for scheduled castes varied from the highest of 21.0 in Bhandara and Chanda to 5.0 in Thana.

22. Percentage of scheduled castes population to total population in the State was 6.0 in 1970-71. The extent of coverage of scheduled castes population is estimated to be 180.0 in all types of educational institutions at State level in 1976-77. Among the districts the extent of coverage varied from 650.0 in Wardha followed by Kolaba 460.0 to 80.0 in Kolhapur. District-wise particulars of scheduled castes enrolment percentages and extent of coverage are given in Statement (8).

23. Total enrolment of scheduled tribes community in educational institutions of the State was 4,46,877 in 1976-77. This comprised 3,00,379 boys and 1,46,498 girls. In terms of percentage this was 4.1% (4.5% boys and 3.4% girls). Percentage of scheduled tribes enrolment to the total enrolment among the districts varied from 17.8 in Dhulia to 0.2 in Ratnagiri. Extent of coverage worked out to 70% for the State as a whole. Statement (9) gives district-wise enrolment percentage and extent of coverage.

#### V - PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

##### (a) PRE-PRIMARY SCHOOLS

24. There were 704 recognised pre-primary schools in the State in 1970-71 which increased to 794 in 1976-77. In 1976-77, Greater Bombay reported 119 schools followed by 107 in Buldana and the lowest number of schools 5 each in Ahmednagar, Osmanabad and Wardha.

##### (b) ENROLMENT

25. Total enrolment in all the pre-primary schools increased from 51,371 in 1970-71 to 61,398 in 1976-77. However, the enrolment of children in pre-primary classes which is reported to be 58,034 (31,630 boys and 26,404 girls) in 1970-71 increased to 1,45,831 (83,296 boys and 62,535 girls) by 1976-77. Among the districts, the highest enrolment 14,699 in pre-primary classes was in Greater Bombay.

26. Population of scheduled castes & scheduled tribes community formed 6.0% and 5.9% respectively in the State in 1976-77. The enrolment percentage of scheduled castes & scheduled tribes students in pre-primary classes worked out to 9.2 and 4.4 respectively in 1976-77. The extent of coverage of scheduled castes & scheduled tribes in pre-primary classes worked out to 153.3% and 74.6% respectively in 1976-77.

(c) TEACHERS

27. Teachers in pre-primary schools increased from 1,636 to 1,737 during the period. In 1976-77, female teachers formed 96.9% in these schools.

(d) EXPENDITURE

28. Total expenditure incurred on pre-primary schools was Rs.37.3 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.66.5 lakhs in 1976-77, showing an average annual growth of 13.0% during the period.

District-wise details of institutions, enrolment, teachers and expenditure in respect of pre-primary education are given in Statement (10).

VI - PRIMARY EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS

29. Total number of primary schools increased from 28,735 in 1970-71 to 32,326 in 1976-77 at the average rate of 21% during the period. The number of institutions increased in all the districts except Nanded and Nagpur.

30. The average area served by a primary school was 10.7 sq. kms. in 1970-71. Educational facilities improved during the period as for every 9.5 sq. kms. area a primary school could be made available in 1976-77.

31. Population served by a primary school was 1,754 in 1970-71 whereas for every population of 1,758 a primary school was available in 1976-77.

(b) TEACHERS

32. Number of teachers was 63,366 in 1970-71 which increased to 85,029 in 1976-77 at the rate of 5.7 during the period under review. The increase of teachers has been observed in all the districts except Parbhani, Bhir and Nagpur. District-wise particulars of primary institutions, teachers, area served by a primary school and population served by a primary school are given in Statement (11).

(c) ENROLMENT

33. Enrolment in classes I-V and 58.50 lakhs (35.08 lakhs boys and 23.42 lakhs girls) in 1970-71 which is reported to have increased to 75.18 lakhs comprising 43.63 lakhs boys and 31.50 lakhs girls by 1976-77 at the State level. This shows annual growth rate of 4.8% during the period. The growth rate for boys comes out to 4.1% and for girls 5.7%.

34. The enrolment ratio in classes I-V to the population of age-group 6-11 gives an index of facilities created at the primary stage of education. For the Maharashtra State as a whole this ratio increased from 86.2 to 99.2 during the period 1970-71 to 1976-77. The corresponding enrolment ratio for boys increased from 101.6 to 113.4 and for girls from 70.2 to 84.6 during the period under consideration. Taking both boys and girls together this enrolment ratio among the districts varied from the highest of 128.4 in Ratnagiri followed by 114.5 in Satara to 66.2 in Parbhani in 1976-77. In 15 districts the enrolment ratio was more than that for the State. District-wise details of enrolment are given in Statement (12). Enrolment figures in 1976-77 as percentage of 1970-71 for the districts are given in Table No.(2) below.

(d) SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES ENROLMENT

35. Of the total enrolment 7.51 lakhs belonged to scheduled castes & tribes in 1970-71 in classes I-V. Of this enrolment scheduled caste & tribes 4.99 lakhs forming 14.2% of the total enrolment of boys. Scheduled caste in classes I-V formed 10.7% of total enrolment of girls in these classes. Scheduled caste enrolment formed 11.7% (11.3% boys and 10.6% girls). Taking boys enrolment percentage for scheduled castes varies among the districts as Bhandara to 5.5 in Thana. In classes I-V scheduled tribe students form 4.9% girls). Among the districts there is a large variation of scheduled caste which varies from 22.1 in Dhulia to 0.2 in Ratnagiri and Kolhapur. Ratio of scheduled caste & scheduled tribes population was 6.0 and 5.9 respectively of coverage of scheduled caste & scheduled tribe students separately is respectively in 1976-77. District-wise details of enrolment of scheduled in primary classes are given in Statement (13).

The co-efficient of equality or extent of coverage is defined as--

(e) EXPENDITURE

36. The expenditure on all primary schools of the State increased from 1971 to Rs.44.91 crores in 1976-77 showing the average annual growth rate of under review. The expenditure is reported to have increased in all the districts incurred on primary schools as percentage of total educational expenditure which slightly increased to 17.2% in 1976-77 for the State as a whole. Among districts the highest percentage was in case of Chanda 33.5% and the low

37. The average expenditure for a primary school was Rs.7.2 thousand in 1971 and increased to Rs.13.9 thousands in 1976-77 at State level.

38. The expenditure on primary schools as per head of population has increased from Rs.4.4 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.7.9 in 1976-77. Among the districts it was Rs.4.4 in Kolhapur in 1976-77.



39. The average cost per student in primary schools was Rs.98.9 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.141.9 in 1976-77. The cost per student varied among the districts from Rs.293.7 in Saroli to Rs.91.7 in Akola in 1976-77.

40. In 1970-71 one teacher was available for every 33 students in primary schools whereas facilities in this respect slightly decreased as 1 teacher had to serve 37 students on an average. Statement (14) gives district-wise details of expenditure on primary schools, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio in primary schools. Table (3) below gives expenditure per head of population, percentage share of expenditure on primary schools, cost per student and teacher pupil ratio in primary schools.

VII - MIDDLE SCHOOL EDUCATION

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

41. Total number of middle schools in the State was 16,547 in 1970-71 which decreased to 16,305 in 1976-77. In 12 districts number of schools increased but decreased in 14 districts. This decrease in middle schools is due to that number of such schools are upgraded into higher secondary schools.

Among the districts the highest number of middle schools was 1,621 in Ratnagiri followed by 1,155 in Poona and the lowest in Wardha 127 in 1976-77. The average area served by a middle school was 18.7 sq. kms. in 1970-71 for the State as a whole whereas 18.9 sq. kms. in 1976-77.

42. During 1970-71, on an average a middle school was available for every population of 3,047 whereas in 1976-77 a middle school was available for a population of 3,046 persons. Among the districts the population served by a middle school varied from as low as 1,384 in Nasik to as high as 10,820 in Greater Bombay.

43. The total number of teachers employed in middle schools was 1,20,130 in 1970-71 which decreased to 96,586 in 1976-77. District-wise details of institutions and teachers are given in Statement (15).

(b) ENROLMENT

44. Total enrolment in middle schools was 41.50 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 45.49 lakhs by the year 1976-77 at State level. At the same time enrolment in middle classes for the State as a whole was 14.48 lakhs (9.93 lakhs boys and 4.55 lakhs girls) in 1970-71 and by the year 1976-77, the enrolment in these classes has gone up to 18.50 lakhs (12.05 lakhs boys and 6.45 lakhs girls) at the annual growth rate of 4.6% during the period. Among the districts the highest enrolment was 311.5 thousands in Greater Bombay followed by 143.5 thousands in Poona and the lowest in case of Parbhani 26.9 thousands.

45. The enrolment ratio at the middle stage which is defined as the percentage of enrolment in classes VI-VIII to the total population in the age-group 11-14 years gives an index of facilities created at the middle stage education for the State as a whole the enrolment ratio was 40.8% (53.8% for boys and 26.7% for girls) in 1970-71. In 1976-77 the enrolment ratio slightly declined to 38.9% but increased in case of boys 56.1% and girls 30.9% in 1976-77, the percentage enrolment among the districts was the highest in case of Greater Bombay 62.1% followed by Nagpur 57.2% and the lowest of 21.2% in Parbhani. District-wise details of enrolment in middle education classes are given in Statement (16). Table (4) below indicates district-wise position of enrolment in 1976-77 as percentage of enrolment in 1970-71.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

46. In 1970-71 total number of scheduled caste & scheduled tribe students enrolled in classes VI-VIII was 1,39,400 (1,07,547 boys and 31,859 girls) constituting 9.6% of the total enrolment in these classes at State level. In 1976-77 the enrolment of scheduled castes in classes VI-VIII was 1,74,351 (1,25,117 boys and 49,234 girls) forming 9.4% of total enrolment. Boys and girls separately formed 10.4% and 7.6% of their total respective enrolments. Of the total enrolment of scheduled castes formed 2.3% (Boys 2.5% and Girls 1.8%).

47. The extent of coverage of scheduled caste & scheduled tribe students in classes VI-VIII was as high as 79.3% in 1970-71.

48. The extent of coverage works out to be 156.7% for scheduled castes and 39.3% in case of scheduled tribes. District-wise details of enrolment for scheduled castes and scheduled tribes are given in Statement (17).

(d) EXPENDITURE

49. Total expenditure on middle schools for the State as a whole was Rs.41.84 crores in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.76.86 crores after 6 years in 1976-77 showing an annual increase of 13.9% in expenditure during the period under consideration. The total expenditure incurred on these schools increased in the all the districts and doubled in 8 districts during the period under consideration. Among the districts expenditure incurred on middle schools varies from the highest of Rs.13.34 crores in Greater Bombay to Rs.47.78 lakhs in Wardha followed by Rs.94.17 lakhs in Nagpur in 1976-77.

50. Expenditure incurred on middle schools as per head of population was Rs.13.6 in 1970-71 which slightly increased to Rs.14.1 in 1976-77 at State level. In 1976-77 among the districts the expenditure per head of population varies from Rs.20.5 the highest in Ratnagiri to Rs.4.3 the lowest in Nagpur.

51. Total expenditure made on middle schools for the State as a whole formed 30.2% of the total educational expenditure in 1970-71 whereas in 1976-77 similar expenditure formed 29.4%. In the later year among the districts the percentage expenditure for middle schools varied from the highest of 48.7% in Ratnagiri to the lowest of 6.7 in Nagpur.

52. Cost per student in middle schools was Rs.100.8 in 1970-71 for the State as a whole which increased to Rs.169.0 in 1976-77. Among the districts it varied from Rs.299.3 in Greater Bombay followed by Rs.213.4 in Parbhani to Rs.110.9 in Sangli in 1976-77. In only 8 districts cost per student in middle schools works out to more than the State average.

53. For the State as a whole average pupil-teacher ratio in middle schools was 34 in 1970-71 which remained the same in 1976-77 also. Among the districts, it varied from 38 in Kolhapur followed by 37 in Greater Bombay, Ahmednagar and Sholapur in 1976-77. As may be seen there exists a negative correlation between the cost per student and pupil teacher ratio in middle schools. This implies that when cost per student increased pupil teacher ratio decreases and when cost per student decreased pupil teacher ratio increased. Statement (18) indicates the district-wise details of expenditure on middle schools, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and pupil teacher ratio. Table (5) below indicates percentage of educational expenditure to the total expenditure, expenditure per head of population and cost per student for the districts separately.

VIII - HIGH/HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOLS

(a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

54. There were 5,200 high/higher secondary schools in the State in 1970-71 which increased to 5,771 in 1976-77 showing an average annual growth rate of 1.8% during the period under consideration. In 1976-77 the highest number of such institutions 692 was in Greater Bombay followed by 343 in Poona and the lowest in Wardha 117.

55. In 1970-71 the average area served by a high/higher secondary school was 59.2 sq. kms. Conditions improved in 1976-77 as for every 53.3 sq. kms. one such institution was available. In 1976-77, the average area served by a high/higher secondary school varies from 0.9 sq. kms. in Greater Bombay to 175.6 sq. kms. in Chanda.

56. Average population served by a high/higher secondary school in the State was 9,695 in 1970-71 against 9,847 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 average population served by a high/higher secondary school varied from 7,424 in Nagpur to 14,167 in Parbhani.



57. Total number of teachers employed in high/higher secondary schools in the State was 75,549 in 1970-71 which increased to 98,103 in 1976-77 showing average annual increase of 5% during the period. Statement (19) shows district-wise statistics of high/higher secondary schools, teachers employed area and population served by high/higher secondary schools.

(b) ENROLMENT

58. Enrolment in high/higher secondary schools was 19.17 lakhs in 1970-71 which increased to 26.12 lakhs in 1976-77. The enrolment of IX-XII classes increased from 8,60,847 (5,31,793 boys and 2,29,054 girls) in 1970-71 to 9,81,421 (6,82,701 boys and 2,98,720 girls) in 1976-77 at the annual growth of 2.33% during the period. The corresponding growth rate for boys 4.7% and for girls 5.1%. It may be seen that enrolment in these classes in all the districts except 5 districts during the period under review. In 1976-77 the enrolment varied from 2,11,332 in Greater Bombay to 11,413 in Parbhani. / has increased

59. At the State level, enrolment ratio at the high/higher secondary classes i.e. enrolment in classes IX-XII as percentage to the population of corresponding population in the age-group 14-17 years decreased from 27.7% to 25.2% during the period of 6 years. In case of boys it decreased from 89.0% to 34.3% but in case of girls it increased from 15.4% to 15.7% during the period under consideration. In 1976-77 among the districts the enrolment percentage varied from 45.8% in Greater Bombay district to 24.8% in Parbhani. District-wise details of enrolment are given in Statement (20). Table No. (6) below gives enrolment in 1976-77 as percentages to that of 1970-71 and percentage of girls enrolment.

(c) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

60. In 1970-71 of the total students 8.5% were of scheduled caste & scheduled tribes community. In 1976-77 8.8% enrolment was of scheduled castes and 2.4% of scheduled tribes in classes IX-XII at State level. Scheduled caste boys accounted for 9.8% and scheduled caste girls accounted for 6.5% in 1976-77. Enrolment of scheduled tribe students in IX-XII classes is 2% corresponding percentage are 2.9% and 1.8% respectively when compared with total boys and girls enrolment. Among the districts the percentage of scheduled caste enrolment varied from 21.7 in Chanda followed by Bhandara 21.1 to the lowest in Kolaba 2.8.

61. In 1970-71 the population of scheduled castes & scheduled tribes taken together was 11.9% and the extent of coverage or co-efficient of equality was estimated to be 71.7 in classes IX-XII. In 1976-77 the extent of coverage works out to be 147% for scheduled castes and 34% for scheduled tribes separately in high/higher secondary classes. District-wise details of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes enrolment are given in Statement (21).

(d) EXPENDITURE

62. Total expenditure on high/higher secondary schools in the State was Rs.41.27 crores in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.83.28 crores in 1976-77. Annual growth rate of expenditure works out to 16.9% during the period of 6 years. There has been appreciable increase in expenditure in all the districts during the period under review. Among the districts the expenditure incurred on high/higher secondary schools varied from Rs.17.84 crores the highest in Greater Bombay to Rs.1.31 crores the lowest in Parbhani district in 1976-77.

63. Expenditure on high/higher secondary schools as per head of population was Rs.8.2 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.14.7 in 1976-77 for the State as a whole. In 1976-77 among the districts it varied from Rs.26.5 the highest in Greater Bombay to Rs.7.7 the lowest in Parbhani. In 7 districts the expenditure on high/higher secondary schools was more than the State average.

64. Per capita expenditure in high/higher secondary schools was Rs.215.3 in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.318.8 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 among the districts cost per student varies from Rs.402.2 in Satara followed by Rs.348.8 in Sholapur to Rs.267.5 in Parbhani. In 13 districts per capita expenditure in these schools was more than the State average. Pupil teacher ratio was 25 in 1970-71 which increased to 27 in 1976-77. In 1976-77 pupil teacher ratio was the highest of 29 both in Thana and Nagpur.....

followed by 28 each in Ahmednagar, Amravati and Wardha. There is generally observed a negative correlation between cost per student and pupil teacher ratio in the districts. Statement (22) gives district-wise details of expenditure on high/higher secondary schools. Table (7) below gives district-wise particulars of expenditure on high/higher secondary schools as percentage of total expenditure, expenditure per head of population, cost per student and pupil teacher ratio.

IX - PROFESSIONAL, VOCATIONAL, SPECIAL & OTHER (SCHOOL) EDUCATION

65. Total number of institutions of professional, vocational, special and other (school) education was 797 in 1970-71. In 1976-77 the number of institutions increased to 1,621. Total enrolment of these institutions was 8,83,745 (4,48,466 boys and 4,35,279 girls). This enrolment includes substantially 8,36,183 (4,22,516 boys and 4,13,667 girls) of adult education institutions of school standard in 1970-71. The enrolment decreased to 88,016 comprising 58,499 boys and 29,517 girls.

66. Out of total enrolment of scheduled caste/scheduled tribe students were 4,052 (2,184 boys and 1,868 girls) in 1970-71. In 1976-77 there were 3,242 scheduled caste students and 1,336 scheduled tribe students.

67. Total number of teachers employed in these institutions also declined from 3,448 in 1970-71 to 2,516.

68. The expenditure incurred on all types of institutions of professional, vocational, special and other (school) education was Rs.2.32 crores in 1970-71 which increased to 3.14 crores in 1976-77. Statement (23) gives district-wise particulars of number of institutions, enrolment, teachers and expenditure for the institutions of professional, vocational, special and other (school) education.

## X - HIGHER EDUCATION

### (a) INSTITUTIONS AND TEACHERS

69. Total number of all types of institutions of higher education was 884 in 1970-71 which increased to 950 in 1976-77. Out of the total number of higher institutions in the State there were 10 universities, 1 deemed to be university, 1 institution of national importance, 17 research institutions, 14 agricultural colleges, 51 institutions of education, 10 engineering, technology and architecture colleges, 21 law colleges and 39 medical colleges in 1976-77. The number of arts, science & commerce colleges was 390.

### (b) ENROLMENT

70. Total enrolment in all types of higher education courses was 3,90,556 in 1970-71. In 1976-77 the enrolment increased to 5,51,491 of this 20,768 were studying in universities and deemed to be universities, 4,03,785 in arts, science & commerce colleges, 4,678 in agricultural & forestry colleges, 8,532 in institutions of education, 9,704 in engineering colleges, 17,752 in law colleges, 14,614 in medical colleges and 3,875 in institutions of other higher education. District-wise details are given in Statement (25). Statement (26) also furnishes district-wise particulars of enrolment in general higher education and professional higher education by stage of higher education for the year 1976-77. Total stage-wise enrolment in general higher education was 3,10,315 (2,23,273 boys and 87,042 girls) and 1,17,807 (93,429 boys and 24,378 girls).

71. Total number of teachers employed in all institutions of higher education was 20,917 in 1970-71. In 1976-77 of the total number of teachers 14,273 (11,484 men and 2,789 women) were employed in arts, science & commerce colleges alone, 1027 in universities, 796 in engineering, technology & architecture institutions and 2,179 in medical colleges, districtwise details of institutions and teachers are given in Statement No.(24).

(o) ENROLMENT OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

72. In 1970-71 the enrolment of scheduled caste & scheduled tribe communities jointly was 35,966 (30,416 boys and 5,550 girls) forming 9.4% of total enrolment in classes of higher education. In 1976-77 the corresponding enrolment of scheduled caste community was 38,327 consisting 32,669 boys and 5,658 girls. On the other hand 5,343 students (4,686 boys and 657 girls) of scheduled tribe community were enrolled in 1976-77. Percentage enrolment of scheduled caste students and scheduled tribe students was 11.0 and 1.5 respectively in classes of higher education in 1976-77. District-wise details of scheduled castes & scheduled tribes enrolment have been given in Statement No.(27).

(d) EXPENDITURE

73. Total expenditure on all types of institutions of higher education was Rs.30.91 crores in 1970-71 which increased to Rs.62.52 crores in 1976-77 at the annual growth rate of 17.0% during the period under consideration. Total expenditure on institutions of higher education in 1976-77 formed 23.9%. Corresponding percentage share was 22.3% in 1970-71. In 1976-77 of total expenditure of higher education Rs.91,761 thousands, 14.7% was on universities, deemed to be universities, institutions of national importance & research institutions, Rs.4,11,431 thousands. 65.8% for affiliated institutions, Rs.20,566 thousands, 3.3% for non-affiliated institutions of degree level and Rs.1,01,433 thousands, 16.2% for non-affiliated institutions of below degree level. However maximum percentage share of 43.5% or Rs.2,71,788 thousands was meant for arts & science colleges. Statement (28) gives district-wise details of expenditure made on higher education.
