CHAPTER I

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Formerly Periyar District was a part of Coimbatore District . In the year 1979 due to the vastness of the Coimbatore District, it was bifurcated for an effective administration. This new District is named Periyar. This District is situated on the eastern side of Coimbatore District. Salem District is in the East of Periyar. Thiruchi District is in the south and Karnataka state is in the north of Periyar District.

This District consists of seven Taluks with a population of 1923660 in Rural Areas as per 1981 Census. The break of figure of this population is as follows:
Male : 992480 and Female : 9,31,180 . The population of urban areas of this District is 4,97,599, Male:2,56,639, Female 2,40,960. The total S.C. Population of this District is 2,34,124 and the S.T Population is 14,301.

The Population in Rural Areas is mostly preoccupied with Agriculture and allied occupations. Urban Areas like Erode, Gobichettipalayam, Bhavani etc., are thickly populated due to industries and growing business. Almost 70% of the population are literates . When compared with the male literates 40% of the Female population are literates. Rivers like Cauvery, Bhavani, Amaravathy, Noyyal, with their perennial water make this District fertile. Agriculture is the main occupation of the Rural folks, Paddy, Turmeric, and sugar cane are the main crops of this district.



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II. FIFTH ALL INDIA EDUCATIONAL SURVEY

Fifth All India Educational Survey is based on the dates as on 30.9.86. For this purpose separate District Educational Officers(Survey) were appointed for each Revenue District. The Block level Officials namely the Deputy Inspector of Schools were given an intensive training for Five days to undertake this important task. The Deputy Inspectors in turn gave similar training to the heads of Elementary and Middle Schools. For Collecting data regarding villages, Schools, & Urban areas the heads of institutions were supplied with Village Information Forms (VIF) Urban Information Form (UIF) and School Information Forms (SIF)

The Estimated population of the village and the Child population of the village, & the educational facilities available in the village are collected through Village Information Forms . Similarly the above information were collected through Urban Information Forms for Urban Areas.

The School age population, the building facility in the schools, No.of teachers, No.of class rooms, Block Boards, adequacy of furniture, Library sanitary condition of the school, Drinking water, Lab facilities, Play Area, are some of the important Items of Information collected through the School Information Forms .

The Informations collected through the above forms were consolidated and block level tables were prepared by the block level officers. The District Educational Officer (Survey) toured thorough out Periyar District in order to scrutinize and give guidance for the preparation of Block Level Tables.

Periyar District consists of 3916 habitations with a population of 18,10,420. A cluster of houses having a population of 25 and above is considered as a habitation in the survey 3114 Habitations are provided with primary schools. In this survey 165 Schools are proposed for the needy habitations which satisfy the norms and criteria prescribed for opening new schools.

PRIMARY SCHOOLS:

In Periyar District there are 1440 Primary Schools with 4807 teachers and 176 Middle schools with 1748 teachers. 79.52% of the population of this District are provided with Primary Educational facilities in this survey, since it is proposed to open 165 new schools , and additional 6% of the population will be benefited. Out of 1440 Primary Schools, 1187 schools have bucca buildings, and 908 schools have more than one instructional class rooms. There are 8276 sections as a whole in all the primary schools . Out of this ,6494 sections are provided with usuable blackboards . 908 classes do not have usable black boards. Only 884 sections have no black boards atall. Drinking water facilities are available in nearly 75% of the Primary schools. most of the Primary Schools do not have adequate play area. Efforts are being taken to make 100% enrolment by the Officers and Teachers of the Education Department. To achieve this end Non Formal Educational Centres for the age group 12-25 are also functioning. Emphasis is given for the enrolment of female and SC/ST children. The heads of institutions who enroled a considerable female and SC/ST children are suitably awarded at various public functions.

UPPER PRIMARY:

In this District 60.6% of the population dwelling in 2372 habitations have upper primary Educational facilities, 140 upper primary schools are proposed, and a population of 8.10% will be benefited, if the above proposal is implemented.

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There are 176 Middle schools with 1748 teachers. 480 Habitations have SC/ST Populations among this 291 Habitations have facilities for Primary Education and 94 habitations have upper primary schools. All 176 Middle schools have more than five instructional class rooms.

The upper primary schools which have a play area of one acre are provided with physical Education Teachers. Pre-vocational subjects like weaving, & Agriculture are introduced in all most all the schools. Each and every school do have library facilities but the books are not classified and kept properly for want of suitable furniture. Students are to be encouraged for the optimum use of the books available in the library. Majority of the schools have drinking water facilities but lacking in sanitary facilities. According to this survey 52196 boys and 32933 Girls are studying in upper primary classes. Every year many Elementary schools with more than 20 students in terminal classes are being upgraded as middle schools by harnessing the cooperation of the local persons.

SECONDARY & HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION:

There are 107 High Schools ie. Secondary Schools in Periyar District . In these schools 1513 teachers are working Out of 3916 habitations 87 habitations have secondary schools within the habitations itself. 646 habitations have secondary schooling facilities within a distance of 2kms. 62.64% of the total population of this district are provided with Higher Secondary schools within a distance of 8 kms. There are 107 secondary schools and 48 Hr.Secondary schools in this district. In the Hr.Secondary schools 2073 teachers are working in all stages. well maintained libraries are there in High and Higher Secondary Schools in Urban Areas. Issue of books to students are not properly done in the Rural areas High and Higher Secondary Schools due to lack of interest among the students.

They may be encouraged to use the libraries to the maximum extent possible.

As far as Higher Secondary Schools are concerned students have opportunity for doing experiments in laboratories . But some other secondary schools are not having fully equipped laboratories. For these schools mobile Science van is to great use in demonstrating experiments . Encouraging strength of SC/ST Students are not coming for +2 stage because of their family circumstances. Especially in Rural Areas. 19873 boys and 11850 Girls are studying in Secondary Schools where as 6507 boys and 4406 girls are attending Higher Secondary Schools. Almost all the Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools are provided with Drinking water facilities. Physical Education Teachers are appointed for all the Secondary and Hr.Secodnary Schools. Vocational courses to suit the local resources are being introduced in Higher Secondary Schools.

OTHER EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES:

As far as Pre primary Education is concerned English Medium Nursery schools which are not recognised by the Department of Education are functioning even in remote areas. There are also Balwadiies under the control of Social Welfare Department in all Habitats. More Non Formal Education centres may be opened to provide Educational facilities for the dropouts, who are unable to attend the formal schools as they have to assist the family during the school hours. For the illiterate adults who are toiling in the fields from dawn to dusk may be provided with educational facilities through adult Education Centres. For this the services of retired teachers and unemployed graduates may be utilised. There is one special school for deaf and dumb and also one school for orthopadically disabled students in this District. This District needs teachers training institutions for both Boys and Girls . The above mentioned type of Non Formal Centres may be opened in small habitations where there is no scope for opening new Primary Schools

CONCLUSION: Only after bifurcation of the District in the year 1979 the developments in all fields are being achieved by leaps and bounds. especially in eradicating illiteracy.
