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CHAPTER I

1.1. General Information

The Pudukkottai Revenue District comprises of 7 Taluks, 13 Blocks and 2 Municipalities.

Developments:

The Pudukkottai District has been notified as a Backward Area and a 'SICOT' is formed to develop Small Scale Industries in the heart of the District. An Industrial Estate is already functioning in Pudukkottai Town. Nationalised and Scheduled Banks are financing unemployed graduates and unemployed skilled workers within the periphery of District Industries Centre under the control of District Collector. To develop various schemes in each Block, additional Block Development Officers for schemes, have been appointed.

Most of the people in this District are having only Agriculture as main profession. Government Agriculture Research Farm at Kudumianmalai of this District, is serving for the development of Agriculture and for the uplift of Agriculturists. They give useful training in field work and also educate them for the improvement of Agriculture, through All India Radio Programmes.

In this District cave temples and ancient sculptures are the highlights particularly in Chittambalam, Kudumianmalai, Kodumbalur, Thirumayam and Avudayarkoil. These places are attractive to foreigners and other visitors.

A Government Museum is also functioning at Thirugokarnam. Actors and Artists are being encouraged in this District

for the development for Art and Culture.
Moreover Pudukkottai is the native District of Mr.Sathiyamoorthy, a great National Leader of India. In ancient days Pudukkottai was a separate 'Kingdom' ruled by 'Thondamans' and this State was merged with Indian Union in 1949. Their Palaces, and Forts are being preserved in this District as Historic monuments, even today.

The Pudukkottai District was newly formed in the year 1974 consisting the former Pudukkottai State area and also comprising some of the neighbouring areas of Thanjavur District like Aranthangi Taluk and Gandaravakottai Block.

1.2. FIFTH ALL INDIA EDUCATIONAL SURVEY:

Fifth All India Educational Survey was commenced during April 1987 and the reference date for the Survey was fixed as 30.9.1986.

Description of questionnaire and their administration:

School Information Form:

This Form was canvased in all recognised schools and complete particulars of the schools including Management, Building, facilities available, incentives to students, teachers employed, enrolment of students in Class I-XII, Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe students, Vocational guidance facilities, courses offered, availability of workshop facilities, were collected and furnished.

Village Information Form:

The figure in 1981 census, or which had came up afterwards, were collected and furnished.

Urban Information Form:

Estimated population of the City, Town and slum seen areas were calculated. Proportionate estimated child population were furnished.

The State Level Training Classes for District Educational Officers (Survey) were conducted at Madras during the period from 22.4.87 to 24.4.87.

District Level Training classes for the preparation of various types of Tables were conducted by the District Educational Officer (Survey) for the Deputy Inspector of Schools at Samskrita Vidyalaya Oriental High School, Pudukkottai on 7.5.87 and 8.5.87. In continuation, Training classes for the preparation of various types of Tables were conducted for the guidance of all Headmasters of High Schools/Higer Secondary Schools of Aranthangi Educational District for 2 days on 11.5.87 to 12.5.87.

Similarly, 2 days Training classes for the Headmasters of Pudukkottai Educational District, were also conducted by the District Educational Officer (Survey) at Sri Brahadambal Government Higher Secondary School, Pudukkottai on 14.5.87 to 15.5.87.

The second stage of Training courses for the District Educational Officers (Survey) were held at the Presidency Girls Higher Secondary School, Madras and simultaneously the second stage of Training Classes for Deputy Inspector of Schools of this District were conducted by the District Educational Officer (Survey) at Sacred Heart Girls High Schools, Pudukkottai from 14.9.87 to 18.9.87 they were given guidelines for the proper and correct preparation and consolidation of Tables at Block level.

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From 19.9.87 to 9.11.87 Block level

Tables were collected, scrutinised and were consolidated at District level and then the District level Tables were duly prepared by the District Educational Officer (Survey)

1. Total No. of Habitations in this District is 2594 and their total population is 1094101 according to Table 10-A. Among these, the number of Habitations and the population served with a Primary Classes within themselves and at different walking distances are as follows:-

Of the total number of 15 Blocks in this District, only 3 Blocks namely Avudayarkoil, Karanbakudi and Menamalgudi are fully served. In the remaining unserved 10 Blocks, the unserved Habitations in Pudukottai Block, have population less than 300. Thiruvarankulam is the only Block where 28 Habitations out of 325, need to be provided with primary schools. In other Blocks the needy Habitations are only below 4%.

2. Among 2594 Habitations, 1969 Habitations have already been served by primary sections with reference to cretaria and in 66 Habitations new primary schools are to be opened. 91% of the Habitutions in this District have already been served by primary sections, only 3% of the Habitutions may be provided with primary sections with the proposed 66 new schools. The rest 6% of Habitutions cannot be provided with primary schools as they do not satisfy the given cretaria.

3. Out of 769 villages in the District, 10 are deserted, and in the remaining 759 villages there is no Scheduled Caste population in 87 villages and no Scheduled Tribes population in 730 villages.

Of the above, for 672 villages with Scheduled Castes population, primary schools are available in 592 villages. For 29 villages with Scheduled Tribes population, all the 29 villages have the facilities of primary education.

In urban area, only one school is in partly pucca and others in pucca whereas in rural areas about 10% of school are in need of pucca buildings.

6. Out of a total number of 1053 primary schools in this District. 499 schools have 2 and more institutional rooms at present; and the remaining 559 schools have zero and one Institutional room which works out about 54% of total primary schools in this District.

7. Among the total number of 1053 primary schools additional rooms are not required for 269 schools and in the remaining schools, schools requiring additional rooms are as follows:-

It is seen from the above data, that about 76% of the schools require additional instructional rooms in this District.

Among 13 Blocks in this District, Manamalgudi is the only Block in which all the sections are having usable Black Boards. Next to it most of the schools in Annavasal Block have usable Black boards (i.e.) only 8 sections are to be provided with Black Boards.

In Gandaravakottai, Viralimalai, Aranthangi and Karambakudi Blocks only 50% of sections are having usable Black Boards and in the remaining Blocks, there are usable Black Boards in more than 50% of the sections.

13. (a) Gross enrolment ratio at primary stage:

Gross enrolment ratio in rural areas is slightly more than in urban areas between boys and girls, the ratio is above 100% for boys due to enrolment of over-aged boys whereas the girls ratio is 94% which is open for improvement.

(b) Age specific enrolment ratio at primary stage

Age specific enrolment ratio in urban areas is more than in rural areas which exceeds 100% due to migration of village children to the urban areas.

The ratio of boys enrolment (110%) is higher than the girls (81%) which reveals that girls education is still open for improvement.

Among 13 Blocks in this District, Manamalgudi is the only Block in which all the sections are having usable Black Boards. Next to it most of the schools in Annavasal Block have usable Black Boards (i.e.) only 8 sections are to be provided with Black Boards.

Among the total number of 13 Blocks in this District, only one Block namely 'Manamelkudi' is fully served as on date; and all the remaining 12 Blocks are in need of Upper Primary sections, as detailed below with regard to distance.

However, in the 3 Blocks unserved by upper primary section, there are no proposals for opening of new sections, as the criteria given, is not satisfied, viz., Pudukottai, Viralimalai and Ponnamaravathy and it is seen that the Annavasal Block only is in very bad need of serving by an upper primary section to the tune of 50% of total Habitations in the Block; and in the remaining Blocks, Habitations are served by existing and proposed sections, to the level of 80% and above.

2. It is seen from the above data that out of a total number of 2594 Habitations, only 1953 Habitations are served. So, 75% or total Habitations are already served; and only 25% is still to be served by upper primary sections.

Out of the remaining 641 Habitations, only 156 Habitations can be covered by opening of proposed upper primary sections (total 66) according to the criteria given which will be 6% coverage in total, and the remaining will remain unserved.

3. For a total number of 769 villages in this District, 10 are deserted. In the remaining 759 villages 154 villages are having facilities of upper primary sections. For villages having Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribes populations, facilities of upper primary sections are available as follows:

Drinking water facilities are not available in 14 schools only in rural areas whereas it is only 2 in urban area and it is open to improvement. Sanitary facilities should also be provided in large number of schools in Rural areas as well as urban area. It is however appreciable to note that medical aid facilities are available in more number of schools in rural areas than in urban area.

This ratio of boys is satisfactory in this age group where the girls enrolment in this age group where the girls enrolment in this age group works out only 55% and it is also open for much improvement.

Age specific enrolment ratio at upper primary stage in urban area is more than that of in rural areas as in the case of primary stage. The girls enrolment in this age group is only a half of that of boys enrolment ratio which reveals that girls enrolment is very low in this stage.

It is seen that there are no Higher Secondary Schools without laboratory facilities both in Government and Aided Managements and in the rural areas. 
