FOREWORD

In Nagaland, the responsibility of providing employment is viewed as an exclusive preserve of the Government. This is primarily due to the visibility of the huge Government workforce and also due to non existence of private players/enterprises with capacity to provide employment to the large pool of unemployed youths. And understandably, with the annual increase in the number of graduates and the consequent increase in the number of job seekers, the demand for creation of posts within the Government set-up has become widespread.

Meanwhile, the State Government's objective is to right size the Government, to bring about fiscal reforms and also generate employment opportunities for its unemployed youth. But contrary to these objectives and despite constraints of resources, the State Government spends a sizeable amount of its finances on salaries and wages of its employees. This situation necessitated a review of the Government expenditure.

In this backdrop the Directorate of Evaluation was asked to undertake the study 'Cost of Engaging and Maintaining Government Employees'. Accordingly, the Directorate has made an intensive study of the cost of engaging and maintaining Government employees. The annual expenditure incurred by the State Government for maintenance of its total work force of 104594 as well as the anticipated expenditure on account of salaries in the entire career span of an individual employee and that of the total workforce has been worked out and projected. Despite constraints in obtaining data and information gaps the study team has made a very good attempt to analyse and correlate expenditure on salaries and wages, pensions etc vis-a vis the total expenditure with output .

The efforts made by the team led by the Director and her team consisting of Smt. Chubala Aier, Assistant Director, Evaluation Officer, Shri Hegwandui Zeliang, Inspectors of the Evaluation Directorate, Shri Hekuto Sema, Shri Anden Moklong, Shri Paunamhieng, Smti Sanuo, Smti Toshimenla, Shri Chubazulu, Shri Panger Aier is laudable. Special mention must be made of the contribution made by Kumari Khriengü-ü Thevo, Computor, Shri Temsuyanger, Computor and Kumari Vikehieno Zhasa, Typist in meticulously calculating and analyzing the data and that of Smti Shikali Wotsa, Steno in the Planning & Co-ordination Department for typing out and editing the report. Their services were utilized even beyond office hours to concretize the report.

The study provides insight into Government's expenditure and should lead to better delivery of services. I hope the study will lead Government employees, the Departments, the policy makers and the public in general into introspection and retrospection for prospective action.

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COST OF ENGAGING AND MAINTAINING GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES.

Introduction

1.1 As per 2001 census, Nagaland has a population of 19.88 lakhs. Out of this, the estimated work force, both main workers and marginal workers is 8.50 lakhs, constituting 42.74 percent of the total population. Among the workers, 68.03 percent are engaged in agricultural activities, 2.13 percent in household industry and 29.84 percent constitute other workers. Government employees constitute 12.30 percent of the total workforce.(Table:1&2)

1.2 As in the words of former Chief Secretary, Shri R.S.Pandey, “the Government is very visible in Nagaland. As an employer, the Government is perhaps the largest. Nagaland has one of the highest proportions of government employee to civilian population ratio in the country”. In Nagaland, the burden of providing employment has been viewed as an exclusive preserve of the Government. This misconception is on account of its huge workforce. And the magnitude of the workforce is primarily due to non existence of private players/ enterprises with capacity to provide employment to the educated unemployed youths. With the annual increase in the turn out of graduates from educational institutions and the resultant increase in job seekers, there is a widespread demand for creation of posts within the Government set-up to generate employment. This is contrary to the State Government’s objective to right size the government machinery to reduce revenue deficit. Against the objectives of reducing the revenue deficit and constraints of financial resources, the State spends a sizeable amount of its resources on salaries and wages of its employees. In this backdrop, the P & AR Department suggested the need for an evaluation study to assess the expenditure incurred by the Government for upkeep and maintenance of its employees and to assess whether the returns are commensurate the investment/expenditure.

2. Objective of the study.

The objective of the study is : (i) to assess the expenditure incurred by the State Government on its employees during (a) a year and (b) the career span of an employee (ii) to assess the productivity of the worker inter- alia the GDP.

3. Methodology.

Inference has been drawn from the data made available by the Finance Department and the incumbency list furnished by several Departments. The

median of each pay scale has been applied to the respective pay scales for calculating the total emolument of all the employees in a particular pay scale.

4. Composition of Government's workforce.

4.1 As per the data of the Finance Department, during 2006-2007, the Government workforce, both regular salaried employees and fixed pay employees was 102225(One lakh two thousand two hundred and twenty five). The workforce increased by 2369 to 104594 (One lakh four thousand five hundred and ninety four) during 2007-2008 of which, regular salaried employees with a strength of 84640 constitute 80.92 percent and the fixed pay/contingency paid workers with a strength of 19954 constitute 19.08 percent. Inter-se population, persons under Government employment constitute about 4.8 percent of the State's estimated population of 21.76 lakhs for 2007. (*The above figures are exclusive of the employees in the State's public sector undertakings*).(Table:3&4)

4.2 The Nagaland ROP Rules of 1999 has adopted 20 different pay scales. In the State Government's hierarchical structure, posts with pay scales ranging from Rs 8000-275-13500 upwards constitute the grade 'A' posts, scales from Rs 6000-175-7750-200-9750 to Rs 6500-200-10500/- constitute grade 'B', scales from Rs 2750-70-3800-75-4400 to Rs.5500-175-9000 constitute grade 'C', pay scale from Rs 2550-55-2660-60-3200 to Rs. 2610-60-3150-65-3540 constitute grade 'D' posts. Grade-wise, the composition of the workforce in grade 'A', grade 'B', grade 'C' and in grade 'D' is 4.23 percent, 2.82 percent, 80.01 percent and 12.94 percent respectively.

5. Overview of State Government Finances

5.1 The Nagaland Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act 2005(NFRBM) states that the policy of the Government is to provide more funds for development activities and to contain unproductive expenditure to the absolute minimum possible. The Fiscal Policy of the State is therefore to increase the capital expenditure to ensure higher investment and social and fiscal infrastructure. Having identified the area to be accorded priority in the allocation of funds, it is pertinent to have a cursory knowledge of the State's annual financial statement to understand the financial implications due to outgo on salaries and wages.

5.2 The annual financial statement is a summary of the transactions of the State Government and shows the receipts and payments of the Government. Accounts are maintained under three heads; i. consolidated fund ii. contingency fund and iii. public account. The receipt statement is given in the table below.

6. Expenditure

6.1 The size, composition and productivity of public expenditure are important parameters to assess the effectiveness of public expenditure in accelerating the growth engine of the economy. Public expenditure is comprised of the capital expenditure and revenue expenditure. The level of capital expenditure indicates the level of public investment, which not only creates public assets but also accelerates private investment.

6.2 Revenue expenditure is primarily restricted to expenditure that does not lead to capital formation. It indicates particulars of the estimated cost of running the different Departments of the Government by way of salaries and allowances, contingencies, grant-in-aid, maintenance expenditure, pension, interest payments, interest charges, etc.

7. Composition of Expenditure

7.1 Revenue Expenditure

7.1.1 The annual financial statement 2008 indicates that during 2006-07, the total expenditure of the State Government was Rs.2932.63 crores, out of which revenue expenditure constituted 76 percent with Rs.2222.15 crores and capital expenditure constituted 24 percent with Rs 710.48 crores. Within the revenue expenditure, the expenditure on salaries and pensions was Rs.1045.24 crores and Rs.201.74 crores respectively. During 2007-2008(RE), out of the total expenditure of Rs. 3666.01 crores , revenue expenditure constituted 73 percent and capital expenditure 27 percent. Revenue expenditure increased by 21 percent over the preceding year to Rs.2691.04 crores while capital expenditure increased by 37 percent to Rs 974.97 crores. Expenditure on salaries increased by Rs 109.74 crores to Rs.1154.98 crores indicating a 10 percent increase over the previous year and on pension by Rs.54.11 crores to Rs.255.85 crores, indicating an increase of 27 percent. During the two years under reference, salary component constituted more than 40 percent of the revenue expenditure and about 33 percent of the total Government expenditure.

7.1.2 Variances will be observed between the salary figures indicated above and salary figures in the ensuing paragraphs due to inclusion of salaries of employees working in the public sector undertakings, aided schools and colleges and institutions in the former and non inclusion of the same in the latter. Salary/wages figures given in the Demand for Grants also differ with figures above primarily because the figures in the Demand for Grants are outlays and not actual expenditure. As per the Demand for grants, during 2006-

07, amount earmarked for salaries was 1022.85 crores and that for wages was Rs. 25.49 crores and during 2007-2008 it was Rs. 1112.22 crores for salaries and Rs. 27.64 crores for wages.

7.1.3 Therefore a separate exercise was undertaken to estimate the expenditure exclusively on salaries and wages based on the incumbency lists furnished by the Departments. From the date of entry into service till the age of superannuation, a government servant is entitled to numerous pecuniary benefits in the form of annual increment in the pay scale, financial upgradation due to promotion, dearness allowance and dearness pay for insulation against inflation, assured career progression, house rent allowance etc. All these pecuniary benefits including medical allowances which falls within the scope of salaries, have not been taken into account. From the exercise, it emerges that during 2007-2008, the amount spent exclusively on salaries was Rs. 1068.55 crores for 84640 employees, indicating that the Government spends 29 percent of its total expenditure on salaries of 4 percent of its population. Assuming that a Government employee, on an average has 6(six) dependents, the total amount spent on salaries will benefit 23 percent of the population.

7.1.4 The annual volume of salary outgo for the grade ‘C’ employees is the highest with Rs. 820.57 crores followed by the salary outgo for grade ‘A’ employees with Rs.114.68 crores, grade ‘D’ employees with Rs.81.62 crores and the grade ‘B’ employees with Rs.51.67 crores. Of the total salary expenditure, outgo on salaries for grade ‘C’ employees is 76.79 percent, for grade ‘A’ employees it is 10.73 percent, for grade ‘D’ employees 7.64 percent and for grade ‘B’ employees it is 4.84 percent. The volume of expenditure on salaries of the grade ‘C’ category employees is due to the size of the workforce, which is 67727 persons. While the amount spent on the 3580 grade ‘A’ employees is due to the quantum of the remuneration. (Table:7&8)

7.1.5 Department-wise, during the reference period 2007-2008, the expenditure of Police Department on salaries for its 25525 regular employees was the highest with Rs. 258.76 crores followed by the School Education Department with Rs 261.83 crores as salaries for its 17982 regular employees. The regular workforce of these two Departments constitute about 51 percent of the total regular workforce with a total strength of 43507 and their combined salary component works out to more than 48 percent of the total salary component of the entire regular workforce in the Government with Rs.521.30 crores. The third place in salary expenditure is the Health and Family Welfare Department with an expenditure of Rs 92.73 crores for its 6375 regular employees. (Table:4&8)

7.1.6 To ensure that its employees access proper health care facilities, provision for medical allowance /claims and reimbursements are inbuilt in the scope and under the account head ‘salaries’. On an average the Government spends about Rs.2.5 crores on medical re-imbursement annually. Besides, to facilitate its employees in discharging their function, the Government provides travel allowances, duty vehicles, residential quarters/ house rent allowances, office logistics etc. During 2007-2008 outlay on travel expenses was Rs. 18.14 crores, on motor vehicles it was Rs. 46.57 crores, on office expenses it was Rs. 17.76 crores and on rent/rates it was Rs 9.68 crores totaling to Rs.92.15 crores .(Table:9)

7.2 Capital Expenditure.

7.2.1 Although the State’s social indicators show a relatively better position vis-à-vis the national human development indicators at 0.623(source: State Human Development Report 2004), the state has one of the poorest infrastructures. Capital expenditure during 2006-2007 and 2007-2008 was Rs.710.48 crores and Rs.974.97 crores respectively. In percentage terms, the State’s capital expenditure constituted 24 percent and 26.6 percent of the total Government expenditure during the two years respectively. Inter se revenue, expenditure incurred on capital is one third of the revenue expenditure. This reflects that expenditure on development and investment was much less than the expenditure on salaries, interest payments, pensions. (Figure 2 &Table:10)

8. Maintenance Cost of Government employees

8.1 The prescribed minimum and maximum age for recruitment to grade ‘D’ posts is 18 years and 30 years. For grade ‘C’/above posts it is 21 years and 30 years. Based on this, the average age of a person at entry point to grade ‘D’ posts is assumed to be 21 years and for group ‘C’/ above posts is assumed to be 28 years. With the enhancement of the superannuation age from 57 to 60 years, the average length of service of grade ‘D’ employees and grade ‘C’/ above employees will be 34 years and 32 years respectively.

8.2 Hypothetical assumptions have been made for the purpose of calculation in the exercise under taken to assess the expenditure incurred by the

Government for maintenance and upkeep of its employees during their career span. Average number of years rendered by an employee in Government service is taken to be 33 years. The number of regular employees is also assumed to be constant at 84640 for the next 33 years without new recruitment and retrenchment /retirements. Besides enhancement in salary due the annual increment and revision of pay, other financial entitlements have not been taken into account. Due to the difference in the scope of promotion between grades and Departments, enhancement in pay due to promotions have not been taken into account. Promotional avenues have been assumed to be static. Employees appointed on contingency/daily wage basis have also not been considered in the exercise. Dearness pay and allowance too is assumed to be constant at 29 percent.

8.3 Past trends indicate that revision in pay scales take place at an interval of 8 to 10 years and the level of hike between pay scale ranges from 14 percent to 50 percent. Taking the upper limit of 10 years as the interval for a pay revision, during a career span of 33 years an employee will enjoy at least 3 pay revisions. Accordingly, hike due to 3 pay revisions have been effected in all the pay scales. In the instant exercise, past pay revisions have not been taken into account and a uniform base year has been adopted. The scale wise hike as effected in the revision of pay 1999 has been applied to the respective pay scales .

8.4 With 33 years as the length of service of an employee, the fiscal burden on the exchequer of the Government on account of salaries for 84640 employees is worked out to be Rs 54836.70 crores. For its 3580 employees in grade ‘A’, Government’s expenditure will be Rs.7468.72 crores, for 2384 employees in grade ‘B’, it will be Rs. 3164.12 crores , for the 67727 grade ‘C’ employees, it will be Rs.39778.62 crores and for 10949 employees in grade ‘D’, the expenditure will be Rs.4425.26 crores. The volume of salary expenditure for grade ‘C’ employees will be the highest with 73 percent followed by grade ‘A’ employees with 14 percent of the total financial implication. On an average the expenditure on salaries for a grade ‘A’ employee in 33 years would be Rs 245.71 lakhs, for a grade ‘B’ employee it would be Rs 134.38 lakhs, for a grade ‘C’ employee it would be Rs 71.02 lakhs and the expenditure on salaries for a grade ‘D’ employee in 33 years would be Rs.40.29 lakhs.(Table:11)

8.5 Expenditure on salaries in respect of regular employees of the three Departments which have the maximum employees viz School Education, Police and Health & Family Welfare for 33 years is estimated at Rs.30,006.16 crores. The staff strength of the regular employees of these three Departments constitute 59 percent of the total Government workforce with 49,882

employees. The salary expenditure for the 43812 grade ‘C’ employees in these three Departments will be Rs. 25720.90 crores. The grade ‘C’ category of employees in the Department of School Education are Graduate Teachers, Language Teachers, Instructors, PET/DT, Librarians, Computer Operators. In the Police Department the grade ‘C’ category of employees are the Sub-Inspectors, Assistant Sub-Inspectors, Havildars, Lance Naiks, Constables, Computer Operators are the grade ‘C’ employees. While in the Health & Family Welfare Department Compounders, Nurses, Primary Health Workers, Technicians and Computer Operators constitute the grade ‘C’ employees.(Table:12)

8.6 In the Police Department the total outgo on salaries for the 25525 Departmental employees in 33 years would be Rs.12607.53 crores. Out of which the salary outgo for its 23628 grade ‘C’ employees is estimated at Rs. 11214.61 crores. These category of employees constitute 92.56 percent of the Departmental workforce. In the School Education Department there are 17982 regular employees and the estimated expenditure on the salaries on these employees in 33 years is Rs.13368.99 crores. Out of which the salary outgo for the 16325 grade ‘C’ employees in 33 years is estimated at Rs. 12093.74 crores. These category of employees constitute 91 percent of the total work force of the Department and the outgo on their salaries also constitute almost 91 percent of the Departmental expenditure on salaries. In the Health and Family Welfare Department, the Department having the third largest workforce of 6375 regular employees, the estimated expenditure on salaries in 33 years is Rs 3438.83 crores. The grade ‘C’ employees constitute 60.53 percent of the Departmental workforce and the salary outgo for these category of employees is estimated at Rs. 1821.76 crores.(Table:12(a),12(b) & 12(c))

8.7 For the service rendered, an employee continues to enjoy Government’s largesse even beyond his service tenure, through pensions and gratuity entitlements. According to the data furnished by the office of the Accountant General, Nagaland, as on 29.02.2008, the expenditure incurred by the Government as pension payment for 36,088 pensioners(26777 pensioners and 9311 family pensioners) during the last three years was Rs.514.99 crores, an annual average of Rs. 171.66 crores . Finance Department indicate a higher outgo, with an annual average expenditure of Rs.212.37 crores on pensions during the corresponding period. Relief due to hike in the cost of living is not confined to the service tenure alone but is also extended beyond the service period. Hike in dearness allowance is effected in the pensions and family pensions. With enhancement in the dearness allowance and the anticipated pay revision there will be increased outgo on pensions and on gratuity payment

8.8 The investment of the Government on its workforce is enormous. In addition to the monetary benefits, there are several intangible privileges enjoyed by a government employee, in the form of service security, opportunity cost etc. Despite the huge investment, a large section of the Government workforce is not motivated enough to deliver professionally and enthusiastically. Although the overall benefits which Government servants enjoy are unquantifiable and productivity of the employees cannot be measured, it is pertinent to qualitatively assess their contribution /output. A measurement could be through the efficiency assessment of the public delivery mechanism, the successful and timely implementation of the programmes and projects of the Government.

8.9 Public Administration, which is primarily the expenditure of the Government on salaries and wages of its employees is a constituent of the GDP. The State Gross Domestic Product is the total market value of all the goods and services produced within the State during a year. It is an indicator of the economic health of a State. Unlike other sectors where output is the result of investment, in the case of Public Administration, it is the expenditure of the Government which is accounted as the value of output of the employees. During the period 1999-2000 to 2005-2006, the share of Public Administration in the State GDP ranged between 12.91 percent and 15.60 percent indicating the share of output of employees vis-a-vis value of output of other sectors in the GDP. However, the question remains whether these Government employees contribute commensurately to the society or not?(Table:13 & 14)

9. Conclusion

9.1 The development process in Nagaland will be closely linked to the quality of workforce, the policy and focus of the Government and technology linkages available in the state. Expenditure on salaries and pensions is critical if the state is to achieve fiscal correction and to reduce revenue deficit. In a

resource scarce economy, voluminous revenue expenditure will have a crowding-out effect on capital investment. A sustainable level of public expenditure should therefore focus on building new infrastructure, maintaining assets and on social development activities. As stated in the budget document, the increasing dependence of the State Government on the Centre is due to non availability of revenue earning assets and services. This is reflected in the share of revenue generated from its own source in its total revenue receipts. Increased spending on infrastructure which will generate revenue through increased capital investment will be required to improve the share of revenue earnings. This will also improve the quality of services and quality of life. Reduction in revenue expenditure and increase in capital expenditure is therefore necessary to accelerate the pace of asset creation and infrastructure development.

9.2 Simultaneously, it is crucial to re-orient the large human capital base to make them more responsive to the needs of the people and for development. Taking into account the volume of expenditure of the Government, the employees should be morally responsible for value addition in decision making, governance and delivery of services. Sensitisation, capacity enhancement, skill upgradation, motivation , improving the efficiency of delivery mechanism with checks and balances, enthusing work ethics and culture, and fully utilizing the human resource already available will increase the input and output of the employees. Ways to wean off the callous attitude of employees to work could be devised. The State Government could also consider to look into restructuring of the staff position in each government department and recruitment procedures made more stringent. Unwilling workers may perhaps be retrenched by providing incentives and through compulsory retirement as per rules. Future creation of posts and employment in the government should be project-specific and need based.
