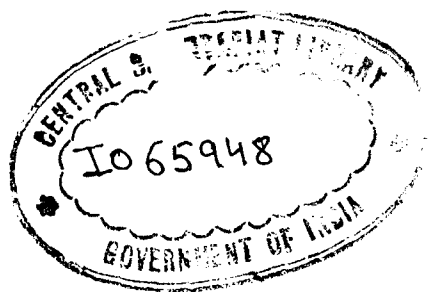

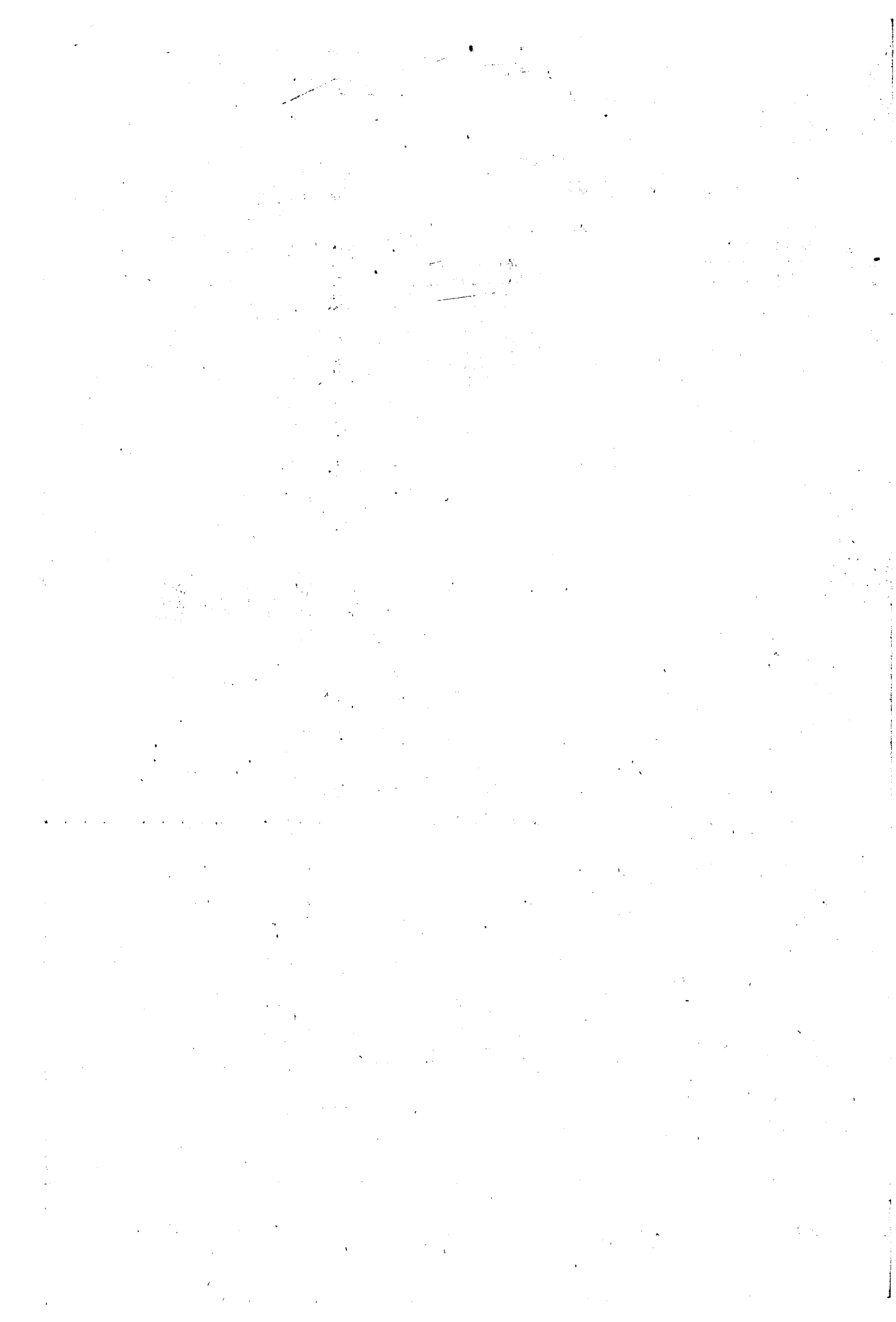

GLOSSARY

1. Growth Rate

Percentage of Increase in the reference period over previous period.

2. Work Participation Rate

Percentage of Participation of Persons in some gainful economic activity to total population.

3. Main workers

Persons who have worked for a major part (183 days or more in a year) of the year preceding the enumeration

4. Marginal workers

Persons who have worked any time at all during the year preceding year of enumeration but who have not worked for more than 183 days in the year preceding the enumeration

5. Total Workers

Include all Main Workers and Marginal Workers

6. Poverty line

The level of per capita per day expenditure, which **meets** a normative minimum standard of living, deemed **reasonable**.

7. Birth Rate

Number of Live Births Per thousand Population in a given Year.

8. Death Rate

Number of Deaths Per thousand Population in a given Year.

9. Age Specific Fertility Rate

Number of Live Births in a specific age group of Women per thousand Female Population of the same age group

10.Total Fertility Rate

The average number of children that would be born to a woman if she experiences the current fertility pattern throughout her reproductive span (15-49 years).

11. Infant Mortality Rate

Number of Infants dying under one year of age in a given Year per thousand Live Births.

12. Age Specific Death Rate

Number of Deaths In a specific age group per thousand Population in the same age group in a given Year.

13. Household

A group of Persons who commonly live together and would take their meals from a Common Kitchen unless the exigencies of work prevented them from doing so. A Household may be of Persons related by blood or unrelated Persons or having a mix of both.

14. Literate

A person who is 7 years and above and who is able to read and write with understanding in any one language

15. Cultivator

A Person who is engaged as employer or worker in cultivation of certain crops on land owned by him or held by him for payment in money, kind or share. Cultivation includes supervision or direction of cultivation.

16. Agricultural Labourer

A Person working in another Person’s land for wages in cash or kind. He has no risk of cultivation.

17. Pupil-Teacher Ratio

The average number of students per teacher for a particular type of school

$$\text{Pupil-Teacher Ratio in a school} = \frac{\text{Total enrolment in the school}}{\text{Total number of teachers in the school}}$$

18. Enrolment Ratio for Primary Stage (I-V)

$$\frac{\text{Total enrolment in classes I -V}}{\text{Total population in the age group 6-11 years}} \times 100$$

19. Dropout Rate at Primary Stage (I-V)-

$$\frac{\text{Enrolment in class I preceding four years} \\ \text{minus enrolment in class V during the year}}{\text{Enrolment in class I preceding four years}} \times 100$$

20. Effective Couple Protection Rate

Number of Couples currently protected by different methods of Family Planning

21. Labour Force

Total persons working (or employed) and seeking or available for work (or unemployed).

22. Labour Force Participation

Participation of Labour Force (15 years and above) in some gainful economic activity.

23. Labour Force Participation Rate

Number of persons in the Labour Force per 1000 persons.

24. Work Force

Persons engaged in any gainful activity are considered workers (or employed). They are the persons assigned any one or more of the nine activity categories under the first broad activity category (i.e.) working or employed.

25. Unemployment Rate

Number of persons unemployed per 1000 persons in the Labour Force.

26. Usual Activity Status

The activity status of a person during the reference period of 365 days preceding the date of survey.

27. Current Daily Activity Status

The Current Daily Activity Status for a person is determined on the basis of his / her activity status on each day of the reference week using a priority-cum- major time criterion (day to day labour time deposition).

28. Forests

All actually forested areas and the lands classed or administered as forests under any legal enactment dealing with forests whether state owned or private.

29. Barren Land

All Barren Land like mountains etc. (i.e.) which can not be brought under cultivation unless at a high cost whether such land is in isolated blocks or within cultivated holdings.

30. Land Put to Non-Agricultural Uses

All lands occupied by buildings, roads and railways or under waters, e.g., rivers and canals and other lands put to uses other than agricultural.

31. Permanent Pastures

All grazing lands whether they are Permanent Pastures and meadows or not Village common and Grazing Lands within forest areas are included under this category.

32. Culturable Waste

Lands available for cultivation but not taken up for cultivation or abandoned after a few years for one reason or other. Such lands may be either fallow or covered with shrubs and jungles, which are not put to any use. They may be assessed or not assessed and may be in isolated blocks or within cultivated holdings. Land once cultivated but not cultivated for five years in succession is also included in this category.

33. Net Area Sown

Area Sown to crops counting areas sown more than once in the same year, only once.

34. Area Sown More than Once

Area on which crops are cultivated more than once during each agricultural year.

35. Total Cropped Area

The sum of the areas covered by all the individual crops, area sown with crops for more than once during the year being counted as separate areas for each crop.

36. Operational Holding

All land which is used wholly or partly for agricultural production and is operated as one technical unit by one person alone or with others without regard to the title, legal form, size or location.

37. Operated Area

Operated Area will include both cultivated and uncultivated area, provided part of it is put to agricultural production during the reference period.

38. Marginal Holding

A Holding having an area of below one Hectare.

39. Small Holding

A Holding having an area between 1-2 Hectares.

40. Semi-Medium Holding

A Holding having an area between 2-4 Hectares.

41. Medium Holding

A Holding having an area between 4 -10 Hectares.

42. Large Holding

A Holding having an area of more than 10 Hectares.

43. Gross State Domestic Product At Factor Cost

The gross output of all commodities, industries etc. evaluated at factor cost less the purchasers' value of intermediate inputs within the geographical boundaries of the State.

44. Net State Domestic Product

Gross State Domestic Product less consumption of Fixed Capital.

45. Per Capita Income

Ratio of Net State Domestic Product and estimated midyear population.

46. Registered Factory

A Factory which is registered under sections 2 m (i) and 2 m (ii) of the Factories Act, 1948.

47. Manufacture

All activities relating to the transformation of materials as well as all types of repair services. The production of goods for the sole purpose of domestic consumption will not be considered as Manufacture.

48. Industrial Dispute

Temporary stoppage of work by all employees or a group of employees of an establishment (strike) to express a grievance or to press a demand. Similarly temporary withholding of work from a group of employees by employer (lockout).

49. Man Days Lost

Adding up of the actual resultant vacancies caused directly and/or indirectly during work stoppage in each shift of each potential working day (excluding weekly offs and other holidays).

50. Productivity of Labour

Productivity of Labour is the turnover of gross value of output per worker / employee in the Manufacturing Sector.

51. Plant Load Factor of Electricity Generation

It indicates the percentage of actual power generation to the total generating capacity of the machine per annum



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
