


Prof. A.K. Tikku (SI.No.4) could not join the Committee.

I. Background of the Institution giving details of teaching, research and extension programme.

Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Pondicherry is sponsored by Sri Balaji Educational and Charitable Public Trust (SBECT) which is a registered Charitable Trust created under Indian Trust Act, 1882, vide document No.1649 of 1996 dated 28th August, 1996. The Registered Office of the Trust is located at Mahatma Gandhi Medical College Complex, Pondicherry-Cuddalore Main Road, Pillaiyarkuppam, Pondicherry – 607 402.

The main vision of the Trust is to be in the forefront of higher education in order to give India the high caliber manpower it needs. The mission of the Trust is to provide quality education, to ensure high standards of behaviour and discipline amongst students community, to provide meaningful industrial education, research and training at all levels, to offer a wide range and flexibility of options especially in the areas of non-formal and continuing education, and to set a high standard of professional conduct and ethics for staff and students alike. Apart from the above, the major interest for forming this Trust was to provide education in the fields of Engineering & Technology, Medical, Dental, Nursing and other Sciences. Having realized the fact of dearth of trained personnel in the above fields to meet the country's needs, the Trust established its four institutions one after another.





Tec. Jology in 1997. The Trust then established its Medical Institute in the year 2001 (Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute). In the year 2003 a Nursing College was established by the Trust (Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College) followed by a Dental College which the Trust established in the year 2005 (Indira Gandhi Institute of Dental Sciences).

In order to meet the requirement of UGC guidelines regarding having a separate Trust, the parent society, through a deed of declaration, has changed its name by forming a separate Trust in the name and style of "Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth" in the year 2007 and with this declaration all the movable and immovable properties of of Sri Balaji Education and Charitable Public Trust now stand transferred in the name of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth.



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

IV. OBSERVATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE

The UGC Committee visited the constituent Colleges/Institutions of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Pondicherry, such as (1) Bharathiyhar College of Engineering & Technology, Karaikal, (2) Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Pondicherry, (3) Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College, Pondicherry, and (4) Indira Gandhi Institute of Dental Science, Pondicherry, on 17th, 18th, and 19th October, 2007 and noted the following observations :-


Bharathiyar College of Engineering & Technology, Karaikal

The Bharathiyar College of Engineering & Technology was established in the year 1996. The Institution is located at Thiruvettakudy, Karaikal, which is educationally and economically backward area with rural population. This institution is approx. 150 kms. away from the main campus of Balaji Vidyapeeth at Pondicherry. The College is beautifully elevated, pollution free, facing the Bay of Bengal in East with a good atmosphere ideally suited for educational institutions. The total land area of the Institute is 26.5 acres, owned by Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, having a built up area of 29,020 sq.mt., The building of the College is very beautifully architectured and well furnished.

The institution is presently running five undergraduate courses and two postgraduate courses, such as MCA and M.Tech.(CAD) under Mechanical Engineering Department and is presently affiliated to Pondicherry University. All the courses are approved by the AICTE.

The Institute has its own Administrative Block, class rooms, library, laboratory, guest house, seminar hall, workshop, central computing facility. Computing facility is there with 610 systems – LAN connected with the internet connectivity of 6 Mbps (2+2+2 Mbps) broadband connection. The Administrative Block, Training & Placement Cell, and Library are Wi-Fi enabled. The institution has provided well furnished hostel facility for the comfortable stay of the students.

The College has got well established laboratories with good modern equipments. The management has provided sufficient class rooms for the comfort of students. The institution has well qualified and adequate staff members for all the Undergraduate (UG) Departments including two Postgraduate (PG) Departments. Some of the faculty members are identified

the rield of photonics. The institution has a very good library which is quite spacious with an area of 6456 sq.ft. and has 16008 books, 89 journals, including 43 national journals and 46 international journals and 40 periodicals with 658 back volumes.

Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Pondicherry,

Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute is located at Pillaiyarkuppam, a rural village on the national highway of Union Territory of Pondicherry. It is approx. 16 kms. away from Pondicherry.

The College was established in the year 2001 with the approval from the Medical Council of India for an annual intake of 150 students and also with the approval of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India. The Institute is currently affiliated to Pondicherry University. The Medical College and its Hospital is having a bulilt up area of 93565 sq.mts., located in a land area of 35 acres, owned by Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth Trust. The Institution has well established Medical Hospital and a Medical College situated in a beautiful building. Presently, the College is running UG programme and ten Post Graduate (PG) Programmes. The institution has provided with well equipped laboratories and good museums with beautiful collections.

The Hospital is fully computerized in OPD, MRD and Dispensary etc. Adequate number of staff are working in these units on computer to access the speedy remedies.

The laboratories are decently maintained and well established earmarking with the necessary pre-clinical and clinical laboratories. The institution has its medical, para-medical and non-medical staff with a rich experience and most of the Professors have joined this organization from some of the reputed Medical Institutions, like JIPMER, Pondicherry, CMC, Vellore, and Stanley Medical College, Chennai. The teachers are committed and most experienced with some innovative ideas to help the Institution. The research works are being done in the Departments of Pharmacology, Pathology and Microbiology. The management is cooperative and helpful to the faculty to get involved in innovative programmes and research Most of the faculty have published research papers both at national and activities. international level. While the faculty members have published a good number of research papers. The Committee observed that some of the papers pertain to the period prior to their joining of this Institution. The management has been advised to motivate and provide necessary support to the faculty members to pursue good quality research. The Institute may explore ways and means to collaborate with medical institutions of the country for research oriented programmes.

Adequate staff members are working for the speedy remedies. Within a short period of starting of this Institution, the PG courses started in clinical side which shows their involvement and enthusiasm in academic activities.

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The College has a total number of 270 faculty members, out of which 42 are Professors. It has a strength of 740 non-teaching staff. The Hospital connected with the Medical College is in a separate building having 8 Block on Basement, Ground + 4 floors with five elevators, spacious wards, 630 teaching beds, 23 departments, 7 high dependency areas, such as ICU, CCU, NICU, PICU, IBCU, MICU, POW, BU), Casualty/Emergency, 2 fully equipped ambulances, 10 modern Operation Theatres, labours rooms and dialysis unit. The Hospital has various support services, such as, Central Clinical Laboratory, Central Sterile Supplies Department, Central Gas Supplies, Central Pharmacy, Blood Bank, Central Disinfection Unit, Incinerator, Sewage Treatment Plant, Central Food Services, Laundry, Maintenance, Biomedical Engineering, In-house workshop, and transport. The labs are equipped with all modern equipments, having all major equipments. It has 1000-1250 outpatients daily and 475-550 inpatients, with an inpatient bed occupancy rate of 82-86%. The Institute is having its own community health services and has adopted two Primary Health Centres at Nettapakkam and Kiramambakkam.

The Committee interacted with the parents. They complimented the Mahatma Gandh Medical College and Research Institute, stating that this is the best Medical College next to JIPMER in the Union Terriroty of Pondicherry. The students also expressed their happiness for being opted to join this Institution because of its being a reputed institution.

The Committee members also interacted with the students. The students expressed their satisfaction and happiness about the infrastructure and faculty of the College as well as the facilities at hostels.

Some of the important features of the Institute are strategic location, excellent infrastructure, highly qualified faculty members, high academic standards, service to the poor and rural people, employment to weaker section, planning to start some innovative programmes, continuing research activities, and the strong financial background of the Management. The Institution has well established laboratories with sophisticated instrumentation. The institution has also established a Central Research Instrumentation Lab. for carrying an advanced research in the Institute itself.

The Library presently housed in a spacious place is located in the Medical College itself. Presently the Library has 8400 Books and 137 Journals, including 72 National and 65 International Journals. The number of back volumes needs to be increased. However, the Central Library is under construction and progressing well. Once this library project is completed it is expected to be a novel library with state of the art infrastructure equipped with all modern equipments and audio-visual aids.

The Institute is having a guest house with three fully furnished apartments to accommodate 12 guests/parents and the management has provided well furnished 72 rent-free staff quarters (triple and double bedroom apartments for faculties).

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Gandhi Institute of Dental Science, Pondicherry

Indira Gandhi Institute of Dental Science is located in rural area at Pilliyarkuppam, Pondicherryin, which is 16 kms. away from Pondicherry. This Dental College is built up with 1,00,000 sq.ft. in accordance with the DCI norms in an area of 5.06 acres. The College is attached to a 630 bedded Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, owned by Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth. The college is housed in a three storied building in which the pre clinical, Prosthetics and Operative Departments are provided. The institution has comprehensive clinics which are located on the Ground Floor wherein 100 electrically operated dental chairs are installed. There are two IOPA Radiograph machines and the special equipment like OPG and Cephalostat are also available in the College. Computerized record keeping sections are present in the OPD counter and in the Medical Record Department (MRD).

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There are about 100-150 outpatients as daily OPD and about 30-35 inpatients, as was verified by the Committee from the records collected on site. It is noticed that the inpatient bed occupancy rate at any given time is about to 80-84 %.

There are **about** 9 departments/located in the campus building of Indira Gandhi Insitutte of Dental Sciences.

The Institute has a well maintained library with about 100 seating capacity. The library is having 848 books and 19 journals, including 06 National and 13 International journals. The library has photocopying and book binding facilities.

The College has provided hostel facilities separately for boys and girls.

Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College, Pondicherry,

The Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College is located on the third floor of the existing Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Pondicherry. The College was established in the year 2003 with an annual intake of 60 students and with the approval of Indian Nursing Council and Tamil Nadu Nursing Council as well. The College is presently affiliated to Pondihcerry University.

The College undertakes presently B.Sc. (Nursing) programme with an annual intake of 100 undertake from 2006-07 batch onwards. Most of the students come from Kerala state in addition to Tamil Nadu and Pondicherry. The College does not have its independent building and presently housed in Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute (MGMCRI) building, where one floor is utilized by the College of Nursing. However, the Management brought to the notice of Committee members that they have already initiated construction work of new building exclusively for this Nursing College and that the same will be ready by December, 2008, as they have sufficient funds and land available in the same campus. The College presently has adequate class rooms and laboratories which are well furnished and equipped. The College has an independent library with 2330 books and adequate number of journals are also subscribed by the Institution. The College has adequate faculty, well

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wied for teaching in nursing college. Principal of the College, Prof.(Mrs.) S. Kamalam, has authored a book titled "Essentials in Community Health Nursing Practice". Two more faculties that they registered for Ph.D. and Mrs. Kamalam is awaiting for result.


Critical Observations :-

- 1. Shri Balaji Vidyapeeth submitted its proposal to the Ministry of Human Resource Development for Deemed University status under De-Novo category for the following Institutions : -
 - (1) Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Pondicherry,
 - (2) Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College, Pondicherry, and
 - (3) Indira Gandhi Institute of Dental Science, Pondicherry

The Ministry of Human Resource Development forwarded the proposal of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth to UGC. Later on the M/HRD forwarded the representation of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth to consider for inclusion of its Bharathiar College of Engineering & Technology, Karaikal along with its earlier proposal.

- 2. Though Bharathiyar College of Engineering & Technology, Karaikal has been existing for more than 10 years, but as of now has only two PG Programmes as aginst the general requirement of 5 PG Departments. Further the institution is located far away (150 kms.) from the main campus, thereby the Bharathiyar College of Engineering & Technology, Karaikal was not considered by the Committee.
- 3. The remaining three Colleges viz. Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Pondicherry, Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College, Pondicherry, and Indira Gandhi Institute of Dental Science, Pondicherry are relatively new institutions with existence of period ranging from 2-6 years. Hence, their assessment was done keeping in view the de-novo category.
- 4. These three Colleges, namely Mahatma Gàndhi Medical Coilege and Research Institute, Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College, and Indira Gandhi Institute of Dental Science are located 16 kms. away from Pondicherry, especially in a rural area of Union Territory.
- 5. Though the Medical College is nearly 6 years old, the management has provided a palacious, beautiful building both for the Hospital and Medical College with modern equipment, well furnished class rooms, seminar rooms and auditorium, exceptionally with good infrastructure.

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³The Hospital has fully computerized OPD, MRD and Dispensary etc. Adequate number of staff is working in the computer in these units to assist speed or provedies

- 7. The Management has recruited senior level and well experienced faculty from JIPMER, especially Dr. Dubey former Director, JIPMER is fully associated by working as an Adviser to the Institution.
- 8. The Management is constructing a central library in palacious building well equipped with all modern equipments and audio-visual aids.
- 9. The Committee members were informed that the Management has planned to take up collaboration programme with best Hospitals in UK and Australia. Accordingly, Dr. James, Director of the Institute has already visited some of the Universities in UK and planning to visit some more Institutions in Australia shortly.
- 10. The management has invested in a big way for creating the infrastructure which is no doubt commendable. This, however, needs to be blended with visionary approach for achieving excellence. The Institution, therefore, should create an exclusive R&D unit for designing of innovative programmes relevant to the emerging requirements of Health Sciences in the country. Some projects in this direction are, however, in pipeline to be implemented.
- 11. Further, the Management has plans to promote yoga therapy and music therapy as an innovative programme. It also plans to set up a branch in Indian system of Medicine.
- 12. The Committee was informed that the Management is going to establish an institution exclusively for mentally retarded people.
- 13. The Committee members are fully convinced about potentiality of the management in establishing innovating things in view of the observations made.
- 14. The Committee members appreciated the management for starting 10 PG programmes and a few PG Diploma programmes though the Institute is only 6 years old.
- 15. The Management also informed the Committee members that they have procured a Van fitted with all latest medical gadgets along with satellite connection in tie-up with ISRO so that the van can go to all the rural villages, examine the patients and transmit their examination datas to the Hospital for expert's opinion for the treatment. The patient can also be attended by the Doctors from Hospital through video conferencing.
- 16. The management is going to start some new PG courses. It was observed by the Committee that since the Institute has potential and resource to start new PG courses in emerging areas, the Management was advised to put all its available potential towards emerging & innovative areas.
- 17. There is no Deemed University (either under general or de-novo category) in the entire Union Territory of Pondicherry.

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V. RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMITTEE

In view of the general observations and critical observations made above, the members of the Committee unanimously recommended (1) Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Pillaiyarkuppam, Pondicherry, (2) Indira Gandhi Institute of Dental Sciences, Pondicherry, and (3) Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College, Pondicherry for grant of Deemed University status under de-novo category as the members are fully convinced about the remarkable progress made by the Management in a short period and for their plans for Innovative programmes.

Sub: Chief Secretariat – Higher Education – Legislative Assembly Resolution on "preventing grant of Deemed University Status to private College – Regarding.

I am directed to state that the Legislative Assembly of Puducherry has passed a resolution for "preventing grant of Deemed University Status to private Colleges" a copy of which along with English translation is enclosed herewith.

2. In order to regulate the admissions and fee structures in private professional colleges of this UT, the control of the Government over these institutions is absolutely required. Some professional institutions do not come forward to follow the regulations framed by the UT Government on admission matters on the pretext of being a constituent part of deemed University not located in the UT of Puducherry. Therefore, it is felt that the Government should be necessarily consulted by the University Grants Commission before granting deemed University status to any private professional institutions functioning in this UT.

3. This Administration has already requested the MHRD vide its letter dated 24-10-2006 to amend the UGC guidelines in this regard.

4. It is therefore requested that the UGC may kindly consider the resolution passed by the Legislative Assembly, Puducherry and issue appropriate orders/instructions making it mandatory for the private colleges seeking deemed University status to obtain NOC/clearance from the State/UT Govt. concerned.

5. An early action is solicited.

Also, the other private medical and engineering colleges of this UT are trying to get deemed University status. With a view to honouring the sentiments of the people of this UT, this Legislative Assembly requests the Central Government and the University Grants Commission not to grant deemed University status to any private medical and engineering colleges of this UT and in case of any such institutions having been granted such status, the same may be withdrawn.

It has reference to your letter No. 26-8/2007(CPP-1) dated 24.8.2007 vide which an Expert Committee was constituted to have an on the spot assessment of the institutions of Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Pondicherry for conferment of Deemed to be University status.

AICTE Team, as constituted vide Notification dated 24.9.2007 inspected the institutions along with the UGC Expert Committee. Kindly find enclosed herewith the report of the AICTE Team based on the spot assessment.

The eligibility of the institutions for conferment of Deemed to be University status as per AICTE guidelines has been assessed and it is observed as under:

"17 The Institute had just completed 10 years of existence.

- 2. As against the general requirement of offering Masters and Doctoral programmes in all major departments, the Institute has only one PG course γ leading to Master's degree in CAD in Mechanical Engineering.
 - The only PG programme approved in Mechanical Engineering (CAD) was started in the year 2005-2006 and hence not accreditable.
- 4. Considering the requirement of all accreditable programmes of the institution to be accredited by NBA, it is observed that the only PG programme of the Institute is still not accreditable. Out of the balance five UG accreditable programmes, only three programmes are accredited. (60% of the programmes are accredited).

Based on the general requirements prescribed by the Council, it is therefore observed that the Institution does not qualify for conferment of Deemed to be University status."

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As such it may be seen that the institution does not qualify for conferment of Deemed to be University status as per AICTE guidelines and hence is not recommended for this status.



Medical College is very much essential for Dental College to teach basic preclinical subjects like Anatomy, Physiology and Bio-Chemistry and also the Medical College Hospital is equally important for Nursing College for training the students. This is equally important for the development of inter-disciplinary teaching and research in the same campus and under the same management and the academic and administrative autonomy which would come with the status of Deemed University, can be exercised fruitfully.

It is to be noted that our application was originally made under DE NOVA Category only. There has been some confusion later. Had the institution being assessed under "DE-NOVA" category as above in the case of other colleges ie 1) Mahatma Gandhi Medical College and Research Institute, Pondicherry 2) Kasturba Gandhi Nursing College 3) Indira Gandhi Institute of Dental Sciences there would not have been any reason for non-consideration.

The committee members expressed very positive about their views while interaction. AICTE is well aware of both the remark as stated above both about Accreditation & PG course before the visit. We understand that these conditions are not applicable while considering the case under "DE-NOVA Category". It is important to note that while the committee recommended the other three institutions under DE NOVA category, this college shall also be considered under DE-NOVA category. The copy of the forwarding letters from Ministry and UGC letters enclosed here with may also prove that there is a slight confusion about the assessment under General or DE-NOVA category.

In this context we also wish to state that AICTE- NBA team has now conducted inspection for all the six subjects for granting Accreditation on 19,20th of December 2008 and the same will be issued very shortly. The institute has also applied for three more PG courses for the current Academic year. It is also to be noted that the application for the conferment of Deemed University status is comprising of all the four college ie Engineering, Medical, Nursing and Dental and not for Engineering alone. Being so the PG courses to be run by the University as a whole might have been taken in to account and not individually for Engineering or Medical. As on date we are having 2 PG in Engineering and 16 PG Degree & 10 PG Diploma in Medicine. Irrespective of submission of the above facts, it is requested that the representation may be reviewed under DE- NOVA category as done in the case of other colleges. In this context the Pondicherry University has also issued its NOC dtd 26.12.08(Copy enclosed).

- 1.
